STORYLINES

- After an unexpected bye week due to Hurricane Matthew, Tulane (3-2, 0-1 American Athletic Conference | West) returns to the gridiron with a critical matchup at home against Memphis (4-1, 1-0 American Athletic Conference | West) under the Friday night lights in front of a national television audience.
- The Green Wave enter with momentum on their side, riding a two-game winning streak and looking to make it three straight for the first time since winning four in a row (UL Monroe, North Texas, East Carolina and Tulsa) in 2013.
- Tulane is seeking its third conference win at home since joining The American and making Yulman Stadium its home field. The other two victories were against UConn (12-3 on Oct. 11, 2014) and UCF (45-31 on Oct. 3, 2015).
- The last time Tulane boasted a winning record in conference play was during the 2013 season with a 5-3 mark in the school's final season in Conference USA.

- Defense has been the calling card for this Green Wave squad, leading The American and ranking fourth in the nation in turnover margin at 1.6 per game and 12 total turnovers (seven fumble recoveries and five interceptions).
- Tulane is ranked 13th in the nation in total defense (309.3 yards per game) and 10th in total offensive yards allowed (1,545 yards).
- On the offensive side of the ball, Tulane has passed for more than 150 yards in each of its last two games - 181 vs. UL Lafayette and 168 at UMass and - five passing touchdowns.
- The Olive and Blue are also among the top teams in terms of time of possession at 33:16, good for second in The American and 21st in the nation.
- The Wave's triple-option ground attack continues to gain steam with 1,233 yards. The 12 rushing touchdowns are shared between junior Dontrell Hilliard (5) and redshirt seniors Josh Rounds (4) and Lazedrick **Thompson** (3). Twice the season already, all three have scored a touchdown in the same game (Southern and UMass).

SERIES NOTES:

- Friday's game marks the 33rd meeting between Tulane and Memphis and the second time the two teams will meet at Yulman Stadium. The Tigers lead the all-time series 20-11-1.
- Memphis comes into the matchup with a nine-game winning streak in the series. The Green Wave's last win in the series was a 37-14 victory in New Orleans on Nov. 18, 2000.
 - Tulane holds a slight edge in the series in games played at home with 9-8-1 record.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS:

- Memphis (4-1, 1-0 The American | West) is coming off a 34-27 win over Temple on Oct. 6.
- The Tigers scored in all three phases and put up 24 unanswered points in the second half to get past the Owls. Memphis was outgained on offense, 531 yards for Temple vs. 323 yards for the Tigers, in the win.
- Senior placekicker **Jake Elliott** became the school's scoring leader in the game. With 371 career points, Elliott moved past **DeAngelo Williams** (362 points) and **Stephen Gostkowski** (369)

TULANE VS. THE AMERICAN:

- Friday's game vs. Memphis marks the school's 18th game in football as a member of the American Athletic Conference. The Green Wave hold a 3-14 record for their first two-plus seasons in the conference.
- Tulane's last victory over a conference opponent was a 45-31 win over UCF on Oct. 3, 2015.

WHO TO WATCH:

- 2014 First-Team Freshman All-America cornerback **Parry Nickerson**, who grabbed six interceptions to lead the nation among rookies, returns to anchor Tulane's defensive backfield.
- Two First-Team American Athletic Conference honorees from a year ago are back with the Green Wave for their senior seasons in linebacker **Nico Marley** and defensive tackle **Tanzel Smart**.
- Prior to the season, several Green Wave were named to preseason watch lists: Smart (Outland Trophy, Bednarik Award and Senior Bowl), junior running back **Dontrell Hilliard** (Doak Walker Award), senior tight end **Marshall Wadleigh** (Wuerffel Trophy) and senior offensive lineman **Chris Taylor** (Outland Trophy).

WELCOME BACK:

• Back on the field for the Green Wave this season are redshirt senior offensive lineman **Kenneth Santa Marina** and redshirt junior tight end **Sergio Medina**, both of whom redshirted the entire 2015 season. Redshirt sophomore wide receiver **Terren Encalade** also returns after missing the final 10 games of the season and also earning a redshirt

NEW NUMBERS:

- A handful of Tulane players switched numbers in the offseason.
- Senior linebacker **Nico Marley** changed from 20 to 2.
- Sophomore punter **Enrique Carresquero** changed from 96 to 41.
- Junior deep snapper **Aaron Golub** changed from 98 to 96.

NEW POSITIONS:

- In addition to the few players who switched numbers this offseason, a few also switched positions.
 - Junior Trey Camissa moved from the defensive line to tight end.
- Redshirt junior **Tristan Cooper** moved from defensive back to wide receiver.
 - Redshirt junior **Jarrod Franklin** moved from linebacker to safety.
- Redshirt junior **Sergio Medina** moved from running back to tight end. Medina started his career at Tulane as a linebacker.
 - Junior Trey Scott moved from tight end to wide receiver.
 - Senior Marshall Wadleigh moved from running back to tight end.

A WHOLE NEW STAFF (ALMOST):

• Upon Willie Fritz' arrival at Tulane, the coaching staff went through radical changes, but two names may ring a bell. Walker Ashburn returns for his second season as a defensive graduate assistant, remaining as the only holdover from Curtis Johnson's staff. Additionally, Jordy **Joseph** joined the staff as an offensive graduate assistant after playing quarterback for the Green Wave from 2011-15.

THE STATE OF TULANE:

- The 2016 roster features 53 players from the state of Louisiana, including 32 players from the Greater New Orleans area. Florida has the second-most players represented on the roster with 10.
 - The 2015 roster boasted 66 players from the Pelican State.

LONG DRIVES:

• Tulane's offense has put together some long drives already this season. Only one drive of 70 yards or more did not result in points. And of those that resulted in points, only one was not a touchdown. Here's a look at the Green Wave's drives of 70 yards or more in 2016:

LOUISIANA CONNECTION:

- A new dynamic duo has emerged with the Green Wave this season between two redshirt sophomores, quarterback Glen Cuiellette and wide receiver Terren Encalade. The former roommates from freshman year have reconnected on the field over team's last two games.
- Cuiellette has thrown for five scores so far this season and four of them have been to Encalade. Three of those came in the four-overtime thriller against UL Lafayette on connections of 34, 25 and 7 yards. The fourth was a 36-yarder in the win at UMass.

DEFENSIVELY SPEAKING:

- The Green Wave have earned an interception in two straight games and in three of its five games this season.
- The Green Wave have logged a forced fumble and fumble recovery in its four-straight games.
 - Tulane's seven fumble recoveries are tied for fifth in the nation.

PICK OFF ARTIST:

- Redshirt junior cornernback **Parry Nickerson** is picking up where he left off in 2014 with two interceptions so far this season.
- Nickerson enters the week ranked tied for 21st nationally with his two picks and is second in the nation in interception return yards (133) behind the 155 yards by Western Michigan's Darius Phillips.
- His 96-yard interception return for a touchdown vs. Southern was the first pick-six of his collegiate career.

HONORS:

- Reshirt junior RB Sherman Badie was named American Athletic Conference Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 12 for his performance in the win over Southern. Badie had 175 all-purpose yards, including 135 on kickoff returns highlighted by an 86-yard kickoff return for a touchdown.
- Redshirt junior CB Parry Nickerson was named HERO Sports' Football Bowl Subdivision Defensive HERO of the Week on Sept. 14 for his 96-yard interception return for a touchdown in the win over Southern.
- Junior PK Andrew DiRocco was named Special Teams Player of the Week by the American Athletic Conference and Louisiana Sports Writers Association and one of three Stars of the Week by the Lou Groza Collegiate Placekicker Award on Sept. 26 for making a career-high four field goals, including a career-high 48 yarder, and connecting on all three PAT attempts in the win over UL Lafayette.
- Senior LB Nico Marley was named Co-Defensive Player of the Week recognition by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association on Sept. 26 for 11-tackle effort to go along with 1.0 sacks, 3.0 tackles for loss and one forced fumble in the win over UL Lafayette.

TULANE IN THE NFL:

• A total of 10 former Tulane players are currently on NFL teams with nine on active rosters – Orleans Darkwa (RB, New York Giants), Lorenzo Doss (CB, Denver Broncos), Matt Forte (RB, New York Jets), Ryan Grant (WR, Washington Redskins), Ryan Griffin (QB, Tampa Bay Buccaneers), Rob Kelley (RB, Washington Redskins), Dezman Moses (LB, Kansas City Chiefs), Cairo Santos (PK, Kansas City Chiefs) and Julius Warmsley (DE. Miami Dolphins) – and one on a practice squad – Taurean Nixon (CB, Denver Broncos).

GAME-BY-GAME NOTES:

UMass

- Trailing 14-0, Tulane scored 24 unanswered points to eventually claim the 31-24 victory. It marked the biggest come-from-behind win for the Wave in the post-Katrina era, previously topping the 17-16 victory at Army, down 10-0, on Oct. 3, 2009.
- The Green Wave move to above .500 through the first five games of a season for the first time since 2013 and just the fourth time since the 2000 season (2000, 2003, 2013, 2016).
- With a 3-1 non-conference record, it marks the Wave's the first winning non-conference record since finishing 2-1 in 2004 and most non-conference wins since going 5-0 in 1998.
- Tulane's victory at UMass was their first win this season when trailing at half.
- The win at UMass was the first road victory since a 34-31 triumph at Army on Nov. 14, 2015.
- Tulane recorded its longest scoring drive of the season in plays, yardage and time of possession, when PK Andrew DiRocco connected on a 22-yard field goal in the second quarter. Wave went 85 yards in 20 plays, spanning 8:32.
- RB **Dontrell Hilliard**'s first quarter 11-yard touchdown run was his fifth rushing touchdown of the season and 14th of his career.



- FS **Jarrod Franklin** recorded his second interception of his career and first of 2016 in the second quarter off a 28-yard pass in Tulane's own territory.
- On UMass' opening drive of the third quarter, DT Tanzel Smart recorded his first forced fumble of 2016 and the third of his career.
 Franklin then earned his first fumble recovery of the season and second of his career.
- QB Glenn Cuiellette's 36-yard touchdown pass to WR Terren Encalade in the third quarter respectively marked a career long pass and reception for the duo. It also marked Cuiellette's fifth touchdown pass this season and Encalade's fourth touchdown reception.
- Encalade set a new career high in receiving yards with 125. Also tied his career high in receptions with seven thus marking the second straight week with seven receptions.
- Tulane's third-quarter touchdown drive, which began from a forced fumble recovery, marked the fourth touchdown this season resulting from a defensive takeaway from the previous drive.
- RB **Lazedrick Thompson**'s 19-yard touchdown run in the third quarter marked his third rushing touchdown of the season and eighth of his career. The 19-yard carry also marked a new season long.
- The Green Wave went 3-for-4 on fourth down conversions, successfully achieving a conversion in each the first and second quarter. Tulane moves to 9-for-16 on fourth downs this season.
- WR Chris Johnson recorded his first career collegiate catch late in the fourth quarter, reeling in an 18-yard reception.
- RB **Josh Rounds**' 10-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter was his fourth rushing touchdown of the season and fifth of his career. Also earned a season best in carries (16) and vardage (77).
- With rushing touchdowns from Rounds, Thompson and Hilliard, it marked the second time this season that trio all recorded a rushing touchdown in a game, previously achieving the feat against Southern on Sept. 10.
- WR **Darnell Mooney** tied his career high in receptions with three. Mooney netted three in the quadruple overtime victory over UL Lafavette.
- CB **Donnie Lewis, Jr.** carried out the No. 18 Flag in honor of former Green Wave player **Devon Walker**.
- Game captains were Hillard, senior NB **Richard Allen**, redshirt junior DE **Ade Aruna** and redshirt sophomore TE **Kendall Ardoin**.

UL Lafayette

- The game marked the first four-overtime game in program histories for both teams.
- It was the first overtime game ever played in Yulman Stadium. It was the first overtime game this season and the first overtime game for Tulane since 38-31 loss in double overtime to Tulsa on Aug. 28, 2014.
- It was the first overtime win since topping East Carolina 36-33 in three overtimes on Oct. 12, 2013.
- Tulane scored all four of its touchdowns in the air after entering the game without a passing touchdown this season.
- The Green Wave tallied 11 tackles for loss in the game, hitting double-digits in the category for the first time since making 10 at Army in 2015.
- QB **Glen Cuiellette** threw four touchdown passes for the first time since **Jordy Joseph** completed the 2015 season with with four touchdown passes against Tulsa. Cuiellette had a career day throwing for 165 yards and four touchdowns.
- WR Terren Encalade was the first player to catch three touchdown passes in a game since **Roydell Williams** did so against UAB on Oct. 23, 2004.
- Encalade and Cuiellette combined for their first career touchdown, as the 34-yard pass was the first passing touchdown for Cuiellette and the catch was Encalade's first scoring catch.

- Encalade posted his first 100-yard receiving game with 103 yards. He also set career highs with three touchdown receptions, two of which came in overtime, and seven receptions.
- LB **Nico Marley** made 11 tackles in the game, reaching double figures in the category for the eighth time in his career. Marley's first-quarter sack was the third of the season. He has 6.5 in his career.
- DT **Tanzel Smart** finished the game with a career-best 10 tackles, his first game with double-digit tackles.
- DE **Peter Woullard** recovered the second fumble of his career, making it back-to-back games with a fumble recovery. Woullard made it back-to-back games with a sack, he has two in his career. He made the start at defensive end, the first start of his career.
- DE **Quinlan Carroll** finished with a career-high six tackles and made the first sack of his career in the second quarter, he made it the first multi-sack game of his career with another to start the fourth quarter.
- Tulane tallied four sacks (Marley, Carroll, Smart and Woullard) in the first half topping its previous single-game season high of three. The Green Wave entered the game with five sacks on the year and finished with five sacks in the game.
- PK **Andrew DiRocco** made a career-high four field goals, hitting a career-long 48-yarder to force a fourth overtime. He also connected from 22, 35 and 20 yards. DiRocco's four field goals was the first time a Tulane player has hit four since **Cairo Santos** made four against East Carolina on Oct. 12, 2013.
- Tulane allowed a blocked punt for the first time since the Army game in 2015 when P **Zachary Block**'s punt was blocked in the third quarter.
- NB **Richard Allen** recovered a fumble for the first time this season as he fell on a muffed punt in the third quarter.
- WR **Darnell Mooney** recorded his first collegiate stats as had a fouryard rush in the second quarter and 19-yard reception in the fourth. He also scored the first touchdown of his career, grabbing 25-yard pass in the second overtime.
- CB Parry Nickerson made his second interception of the season in the second quarter.
- CB **Donnie Lewis, Jr.** finished with a career-best eight tackles. He made the first interception of his career in the second quarter, returning it 12 yards
- QB **Johnathan Brantley** made his second-straight start at quarterback.
- Marley carried out the No. 18 Flag in honor of former Green Wave player **Devon Walker**.
- Game captains were Encalade, Smart, RT **John Leglue** and SS **Roderic Teamer**.

Navy

- Tulane held Navy scoreless in the first quarter, marking the second time this season (at Wake Forest) that the Green Wave have not allowed their opponent to score in the opening quarter.
- For the first time in his head coaching career, **Willie Fritz** lost a game when his team was +2 or better in turnover margin.
- LB **Nico Marley** notched the first game of his career with multiple sacks finishing with two against Navy for 13 yards lost. Marley's 14 tackles made it the seventh game of his career with 10+ tackles.
- RB **Josh Rounds** scored Tulane's first touchdown, totaling 52 yards on five carries on the scoring drive.
- DE **Peter Woullard** recorded his first career sack. He entered the game with one career tackle and finished the Navy game with five. Woullard's fourth quarter fumble recovery was the first of his career.
- FS **Jarrod Franklin** forced a fumble for the first time this season. On the same play, DE **Ade Aruna** recovered a fumble for the first time in his career.
 - SS Roderic Teamer made a career-high eight tackles.

Green Wave Game Notes

- CB Donnie Lewis, Jr., tallied multiple pass breakups in a game for the second time in his career.
- OB Johnathan Brantley, NT Braynon Edwards and DT Eldrick Washington and DE Quinlan Carroll all made their first career starts.
- DT Tanzel Smart carried out the No. 18 Flag in honor of former Green Wave player Devon Walker.
- Game captains were seniors Marley, Rounds, redshirt senior LT Todd Jacquet and senior TE Marshall Wadleigh.

Southern

- The win over Southern marked Tulane's first victory in a home opener since defeating Jackson State, 34-7, on Aug. 31, 2013.
- The Green Wave have scored 30 or more points in three of its last five games with two resulting in wins – 34-31 at Army on Nov. 14, 2015 and 66-21 vs. Southern on Sept. 10, 2016.
- The last time Tulane scored 60+ points in a game was 63 against Louisiana Tech on Nov. 26, 1998.
- The last time Tulane scored 40+ points in a home opener was a 47-33 victory over Southeastern Louisiana on Sept. 3, 2011.
- Tulane's 66 points scored are the most in Yulman Stadium history, topping the 45 points scored by Tulane vs. UCF on Oct. 3, 2015 and the 45 points scored by Tulsa vs. Tulane on Nov. 17, 2015.
- Tulane's 437 total rushing yards mark the first time the Green Wave have rushed for more than 400 yards since totaling 407 against VMI on Sept. 29, 1973. The 437 yards rank as the third-highest, single-game total in program history.
- The one-yard, first-quarter touchdown run by RB **Dontrell Hilliard** marked the third-consecutive game in which Tulane scored on the opening drive.
- DT Tanzel Smart's first-quarter fumble recovery was the second of his career with the other one coming at Georgia Tech on Sept. 12, 2015.
- LB Nico Marley's first-quarter interception was the fourth of his career. Marley snared one interception in each of his first three seasons.
- Hilliard recorded the third multi-touchdown game of his career (two vs. Maine on Sept. 19, 2015 and two at Memphis on Oct. 31, 2015) and his first game with three touchdowns.
- Hilliard's 103 yards and OB **Johnathan Brantley**'s 119 yards rushing mark the first time two Tulane players ran for 100+ yards in a game since **Shaun King** (109) and **Toney Converse** (103) did so against BYU on Dec. 31, 1998. On the first play of his collegiate career, Brantley rushed for 63 vards.
- CB Parry Nickerson's first-quarter interception was the seventh of his career. His 96-yard interception return for a touchdown was four yards short of the school record of 100 yards by **David Herbert** on Sept. 25, 1971. Herbert's return also went for a touchdown.
- The last time Tulane had an interception return for a touchdown was at Florida Atlantic on Nov. 2, 2013 on a 69-yard pick six by Lorenzo Doss.
- RB **Sherman Badie**'s first-quarter, 86-yard kickoff return for a touchdown was the first for Tulane since Jeremy Williams ran a kickoff back 88 yards for a touchdown vs. UTEP on Nov. 7, 2009. It was Badie's first kickoff return for a touchdown and the longest kickoff return of his
- RB Lazedrick Thompson recorded the first multi-touchdown game of his career after an 11-yard rushing score in the second quarter and a nin-yard run in the third.
 - LB **Zachery Harris** made the first start of his career.
- Nickerson carried carried out the No. 18 Flag in honor of former Green Wave player **Devon Walker**.
- Game captains were seniors Thompson, CB Richard Allen, WR Larry Dace III and LB Eric Thomas.

Wake Forest

- Prior to the season starting, Tulane was the lone Division I program that did not have a quarterback on its roster who had not thrown a pass. QB Glen Cuiellette put that to rest in his first start, as the product from Mandeville went 12-for-23 for 134 yards. He also rushed 22 times for 54 vards.
 - CB Parry Nickerson recorded a career-best three pass breakups.
- WR Larry Dace III notched a career-best four receptions for 38
- DT Tanzel Smart posted his second-consecutive game with multiple tackles for loss, as he notched 2.0 at Wake Forest. He had 2.0 against Tulsa in the 2015 season finale.
- The opening-drive score marked the second-consecutive game in which Tulane scored on the opening drive as the team notched a touchdown in the opening drive against Tulsa in the season finale last
- OG Leeward Brown, OB Glen Cuiellette and DT Robert Kennedy made their first career starts.
- Ten true freshmen in QB Darius Bradwell, S Will Harper, WR Chris Johnson, DB Sean Harper, DB P.J. Hall, LB Lawrence Graham, LB Larry Bryant, DS Geron Eatherly, WR Darnell Mooney and WR D.J. Owens made their collegiate debuts at Wake Forest. Brown also made his collegiate debut.
- TE Marshall Wadleigah carried out the No. 18 Flag in honor of former Green Wave player **Devon Walker**.
- Game captains were senior Marley, Smart, Taylor and senior WR Devon Breaux.

DID YOU KNOW:

- Junior linebacker Nico Marley is the son of Rohan Marley (former linebacker at Miami (Fla.)) and the grandson of the legendary reggae musician, Bob Marley.
- Redshirt junior receiver **Devon Breaux** is a two-sport athlete who earned national acclaim in 2014 as a member of the Green Wave's track & field team. Breaux became the first Tulane male track & field studentathlete to qualify for the NCAA Championships in the long jump after posting a mark of 7.56 meters during the NCAA East Regionals. He then notched a 7.44 meter jump at the NCAA Championships in the long jump to earn Honorable Mention All-America status. Breaux is back playing football this fall after taking the spring off.
- Sophomore deep snapper Aaron Golub is a true testament to never giving up the pursuit of your dreams. Golub, who was rated a four-star recruit by RubioLongSnapping.com, is legally blind with no sight in his right eye and limited vision in his left.
- Tristan Cooper's father, Ron Sr., has been the head coach at Eastern Michigan (1993-94), Louisville (1995-97) and Alabama A&M (1998-2001). He is presently the assistant head coach at FIU serving as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach.

WILLIE FRITZ

Head Coach • First Season Shawnee Mission, Kan. Pittsburg State, 1983

Tulane University Director of Athletics Troy Dannen formally introduced Willie Fritz as the school's new football head coach on Dec. 15, 2015. Fritz became the 40th head football coach in the 121-year history of the Green Wave program.

With 193 career victories, Fritz entered the 2016 season ranked the fourth active winningest head coach among coaches in the Football Bowl Subdivision, tied with Kansas State's Bill Snyder

Fritz brings 33 years of collegiate experience as a football student-athlete or coach to the Green Wave. He has led his teams to six combined conference championships (one at every level he has coached) and two bowl appearances. He was also twice named the national coach of the year, including the American Football Coaches Association Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Coach of the Year in 2011 and the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year in

Fritz, 55, came to Tulane from Georgia Southern where he spent two seasons and led the Eagles to a combined record of 17-7, a 2014 Sun Belt Conference (SBC) title and the school's first-ever NCAA postseason bowl game with their berth in the 2015 GoDaddy.com Bowl. Georgia Southern concluded the 2015 regular season with an 8-4 overall record, including a mark of 6-2 in conference play.

Fritz led the Eagles to a 9-3 overall record and a perfect mark of 8-0 in conference play during his first season at Georgia Southern in 2014, and was named the SBC Coach of the Year. However, the school's waiver claim to allow Georgia Southern to play in a bowl despite being in the second year of the NCAA's transition period was denied.

Prior to Georgia Southern, Fritz served as head coach at Sam Houston State from 2010-13. A proven winner with more than 30 years of coaching experience, Fritz joined the Eagles from Sam Houston State, where he led the team to back-to-back Southland Conference titles, NCAA FCS championship appearances in 2011 and 2012, and a third-straight playoff berth in 2013.

The Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year at the FCS level in 2012, Fritz was recognized nationally in 2011 as the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Coach of the Year. Honored as the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012, Fritz was selected by the media and his peers in the Southland Conference as the league's Coach of the Year in 2011after his team went a perfect 7-0 in conference play.

In 2011 and 2012, Sam Houston State posted the two highest single-season win totals in program history with marks of 14-1 (2011) and 11-4 (2012) and Bearkat players were showered with accolades. More than 50 earned All-Southland Conference honors under Fritz in the last four years, not including additional "Player of the Year," "Offensive Player of the Year," "Defensive Player of the Year," and "Newcomer of the Year" awards. All-America status from national coaching and media outlets were bestowed on 11 Sam Houston State

After a highly successful tenure at Blinn College, averaging nearly 10 wins a season during his four years there. Fritz left to revitalize a Central Missouri program and guided it to 11 winning seasons. The NCAA Division II program's ledger included two 10-win seasons with the 2001 Mule squad earning its first postseason trip in more than 30 years.

In 2002, Central Missouri made its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II playoffs and was the Mid-America Athletic Association (MIAA) co-champion a year later. A 97-47 mark in 13 seasons ranks Fritz as the winningest coach in the program's 118-year history. He was the only coach to ever win seven or more games in eight consecutive seasons and his victory total ranked him 15th among active Division II coaches at the time. In addition to his impressive 67.4 winning percentage with the Mules, Fritz coached his student-athletes to achieve their potential both on the field and in the classroom. More than 150 Mules were recognized with All-MIAA honors with 41 first-team selections and 24 All-Americans.

Under Fritz, Central Missouri recorded a graduation rate of 84 percent with 144 MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll recipients, 14 Academic All-Region and three

Serving as a graduate assistant for the Bearkat program during the 1984 and 1985 seasons, Fritz earned a master's degree in kinesiology while Sam Houston State posted a 16-6 record and won the 1985 Gulf Star Conference championship. He returned to Huntsville in 1991 after spending two years at Coffeyville College in Kansas under legendary head coach Dick Foster, earning a promotion to defensive coordinator after one year. He stayed another two years to work for head coach Skip Foster and the Red Ravens.

Head coach Ron Randleman brought Fritz back to the state of Texas and Sam Houston State as secondary and special teams coach in 1991, instilling an attitude of excellence on special teams that would last more than a decade. The Bearkats' "block party" racked up 80 blocked punts, field goals and extra points beginning with Fritz in 1991 and lasting through

In Fritz's first year as a full-time assistant coach at Sam Houston State in 1991, the Bearkats won the Southland Conference. That league title and eight-win season launched SHSU to the program's second-ever appearance in the NCAA playoffs.

Fritz would leave Huntsville again, this time for an opportunity to be the head coach at Blinn College, where he would turn around a program that had only five wins in its previous three seasons.

From 1993-96, Fritz and the Buccaneers would rack up 39 victories against only five losses with a tie and claim two national junior college championships. He was inducted into the NJCAA Football Hall of Fame for the environment of success he created at Blinn.

One of seven children, Fritz is the son of the late Harry Fritz, who coached the Central Missouri football team in 1952 before continuing his career as the Executive Director at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) in Kansas City. The elder Fritz also served at several colleges and universities in administration as an athletics director.

Fritz played on two conference title teams and was a four-starter at defensive back for Coach Randleman at Pittsburg State and remained at his alma mater as a student assistant coach for his alma mater in 1982. Early coaching stops included a year at Shawnee Mission Northwest High School (Kansas) in 1983 and Willis High School (Texas) in 1986, with his return to Sam Houston State for graduate school in between those years.

Fritz and his wife Susan have three children, Wesley, Lainie and Brooke.

Yulman Stadium



Yulman Stadium, the crown jewel of the university's athletics complex, opened its doors for the first time in front of a capacity crowd on September 6, 2014 against Georgia Tech. Yulman Stadium marks the beginning of a renaissance of Tulane Athletics, bringing Green Wave football back to campus for the first time in nearly 40 years.

Tulane's new home field advantage came from the generosity of three couples in particular - Richard Yulman and his late wife Janet, Gayle and Tom Benson and Jill and Avie Glazer.

Richard Yulman, the retired chairman and owner of mattress manufacturing giant Serta International, donated \$15 million toward construction of this \$73 million facility. Yulman Stadium is named in honor of Richard, Janet and the Yulman family.

New Orleans Saints owner Tom Benson and his wife Gayle, a member of the Board of Tulane, donated \$7.5 million to Yulman Stadium. Benson Field, which will host the games of Yulman Stadium, is named in their honor.

Jill and Avie Glazer supported the stadium with a multi-million dollar gift. The Jill H. and Avram A. Glazer Family Club, the premium space in which to experience games at Yulman Stadium. is named in their honor.

Construction of Yulman Stadium began in January 2013. Gould Evans and Associates and Lee Ledbetter & Associates served as the project architects, while Woodward Design + Build LLC was the contractor.

Tulane football has been a part of the fabric of New Orleans since the Green Wave played its first season back in 1893. Generations experienced college football at the old Tulane Stadium from 1926-1974.

It is not hard to find a story about someone's experience at old Tulane Stadium. Boy Scouts selling programs, a record crowd of 86,598 watching the Green Wave defeat LSU in 1973, the annual Sugar Bowl and early Saints football, are all part of the story of Tulane Stadium.

Now in its third year, a new chapter continues to be written in a new home by a new (and old) generation of Green Wave fans.



Tulane Stadium was the home to Tulane Football from 1926 until 1974. Built on an old plantation where sugar was first granulated, the original construction cost approximately \$300,000 and was made mostly from brick and concrete. As the site of the annual Sugar Bowl, Tulane Stadium was often informally referred to as "Sugar Bowl Stadium." After its expansion in the 1940's, Tulane Stadium became the largest football stadium in the south.





2016 GAME RECAPS

Game 1 • Tulane 3 - Wake Forest 7

BB&T Field • Winstom-Salem, N.C. Sept. 1 • 24,398 Attendance

The Willie Fritz era kicked off on Thursday night for Tulane football (0-1), but the home team, Wake Forest (1-0), spoiled the debut as the Green Wave fell just short in a 7-3 battle at BB&T Field. The Olive and Blue struck on their opening drive, claiming a 3-0 lead, but the Demon Deacons retaliated by beginning the second quarter with a 12-play, 53-yard drive that resulted in the lone touchdown of the game and the final 7-3 score.

"It was very disappointing," Fritz stated. "We had a few passing situations, and obviously that is not our strength. We had a tough time protecting tonight and it was a four-man rush most of the time. The whole last series was a two or three-man rush. It was just a lot of guys playing their first ball game. Everybody has to do their job, and someone has to make a play."

Tulane's opening drive went eight plays, 51 yards in four-and-a-half minutes, resulting in an Andrew DiRocco 41-yard field goal for the game's initial score. However, Wake Forest's Kendall Hinton punched in a one-yard touchdown run with 14:16 left in the first half, marking the final score of the game.

The Wave ground game and defensive effort pushed Tulane into opponent territory twice in the second quarter, but one drive was stalled by back-to-back penalties, while the second was halted on a four-and-out on Wake's 28-yard line.

The defensive battle waged on in the second half as only 110 total yards were accumulated by both squads in the third quarter. With Tulane still trailing 7-3 midway through the fourth quarter, and facing a 3rd-and-22, quarterback Glen Cuiellette connected with Josh Rounds on a 46-yard pass that moved the ball to Wake's 32-yard line. Later facing a 4th-and-3 on Wake's 16, Cuiellette's rush attempt fell short, losing two yards on the play, resulting in a turnover-on-downs with 4:22 remaining.

However, Tulane's defense delivered once more, halting the Demon Deacons after six plays to get the ball back on their own 36-yard line with 1:35 remaining. On a 4th-and-10, Cuiellette connected with Devon Breaux on a 17-yard catch out-of-bounds on Wake's 47-yard line. Yet three plays later, Tulane couldn't convert on another fourth down, turning the ball over and thus closing out the game.

Game 2 • Southern 21 - Tulane 66

Yulman Stadium • New Orleans Sept. 10 • 27,179

Tulane football (1-1) shone a spotlight of all three phases of its squad in its home opener, as the Green Wave rolled to a 66-21 victory over Southern University (0-2). Offensively, the Wave rushed for 437 yards, most since 1973 and third most in school history, and punched in seven rushing touchdowns on the night - three from Dontrell Hilliard and two each from Josh Rounds and Lazedrick Thompson. Meanwhile, Tulane's defense and special teams reeled in two interceptions, including one for a touchdown, and returned an 86-yard kickoff for a touchdown as well.

Tulane's first five touchdowns were either set up or scored by the Green Wave's defense or special teams. Ade Aruna's fourth career sack coupled with Tanzel Smart's second career fumble recovery set up a five-yard Hilliard touchdown run. Then Nico Marley's fourth career interception resulted in Hilliard's second scoring run of the game.

Parry Nickerson then flashed his defensive prowess at the 6:33 mark in the first quarter, returning an interception 96 yards for the touchdown. After Southern got its first score of the game at the 2:28 mark via a 20-yard touchdown reception to Dillon Beard, it was Sherman Badies' turn to display his speed with an 86-yard kickoff return for a touchdown.

Tulane's impressive first quarter showing wasn't done there, as Jarrod Franklin notched a punt block with 51 seconds remaining, eventually leading to a one-yard Josh Rounds touchdown run just three plays later to begin the second quarter. Rounds and Thompson each added a touchdown on the ground later in the second quarter, extending Tulane's lead to 49-7 at the mid-way point.

Thompson and Hilliard each tacked on one more rushing touchdown in the second half, as the latter achieved his third of the game which marked a career best. Finally, add in an Andrew DiRocco fourth quarter 25-yard field goal and Tulane's 66 total points were the most scored since the Olive and Blue recorded 63 vs Louisiana Tech on Nov. 26, 1998.

Game 3 • Navy 21 - Tulane 14

Yulman Stadium • New Orleans Sept. 17 • 21,503 Attendance

Tulane football battled back-and-forth with Navy possessing a 14-13 lead to start the fourth quarter before falling by the final score of 21-14. In fact, each time the Midshipmen scored, the Green Wave immediately countered with a touchdown drive of their own. With three minutes left in the game, Navy rallied with a 10-play, 72-yard touchdown drive to regain a seven-point advantage and a lead Tulane could not come back from.

The Midshipmen (3-0, 2-0 The American | West) were the first to break through, recording a 15-play, 94-yard touchdown drive, spanning 7:17. Navy's Chris High capped the season-high 15-play drive with a 6-yard touchdown run with 14:28 on the clock.

On the ensuing Tulane drive, running back Josh Rounds caught fire, recording five carries for 52 yards on the drive, including runs of 12, 16 and 18 yards. With 10:22 remaining till half, Rounds capped the impressive eight-play, 75-yard drive with a 2-yard touchdown run.

Navy struck first in the second half, as Shawn White earned a 4-yard touchdown run which capped a nearly five minutes possession midway through the third quarter, but it failed to connect on the PAT following the score.

Tulane proved resilient once more, immediately countering with a touchdown drive of its own on the next series. The Wave offense again received a boost from Rounds when he converted a fourth-and-one on their own 44-yard line, maintaining a drive in which three plays later, Dontrell Hilliard executed a 36-yard touchdown run to hand Tulane the 14-13 lead.

Tulane's Peter Woullard then kept the momentum in the Wave's favor. After a 23-yard carry by the Midshipmen pushed them into Tulane territory at the 32-yard line, Woullard recovered a Will Worth fumble, giving the Green Wave the ball back with 12 minutes remaining in the game.

Forwarding ahead to 7:39 remaining, Navy took over from its own 28-yard line and rallied behind quarterback Will Worth, who carried eight times for 58 yards on the ensuing touchdown drive. After a successful two-point conversion, Navy regained the lead at 21-14 with 2:57 on the clock. On Tulane's final offensive possession, its comeback attempt fell short, suffering a four-and-out and turnover on downs as Navy then kneeled down for the victory.

Game 4 • UL Lafayette 39 - Tulane 41 (4OT)

It was a history-setting night for Tulane football as the Green Wave competed in its first ever four-overtime game in program history, defeating UL Lafayette (2-2), 41-39, in Yulman Stadium on Saturday night. The Wave's defense sealed the dramatic finish when Richad Allen stopped the Ragin' Cajun's two-point conversion attempt, sparking Tulane's bench to rush the field and celebrate the victory.

After four quarters couldn't find a winner with a 16-16 tie, Tulane and UL Lafayette began their four overtime duel. If you blinked, you missed Tulane's first two offensive drives - one-pass, 25 yards on each, as the first went to Terren Encalade and the second to Darnell Mooney.

In the third overtime, Tulane (2-2. 0-1 American Athletic Conference | West) found itself down three points and facing defeat, but Andrew DiRocco connected on a career long 48-yard field goal to send the game into a fourth overtime. The Wave rode that momentum into a 7-yard touchdown pass to Encalade, his third of the game, and eventual two-point conversion pass to Kendall Ardoin. Encalade's three touchdowns marked a career high and the first three touchdown game for a receiver since Roydell Williams in 2004.

Earlier in the night, Tulane found itself in a 6-0 hole in the second quarter, but just under the 12-minute mark, redshirt-junior Parry Nickerson recorded his second interception of the season, returning it 37 yards to UL Lafayette's 13-yard line. Tulane took advantage of the field position with an Andrew DiRocco 22-yard field goal. Around the six-minute mark, Donnie Lewis, Jr., notched his first career interception, returning it 12 yards to UL Lafayette's 12-yard line. The Wave then capitalized once more as DiRocco connected from 35-yards out, tying the game at 6-6, as the two remained deadlocked through half.

Around the 10-minute mark in the third quarter, it was Tulane's special teams that delivered great field position as UL Lafayette's Elijah McGuire muffed a punt catch resulting in a Richard Allen fumble recovery on the 6-yard line, setting up another DiRocco field goal.

Later, tied at 9-9, Cuiellette connected with Encalade on a 34-yard touchdown pass, marking the first score through the air for the Green Wave this season and the first career touchdowns for both Cuiellette and Encalade. UL Lafayette (2-2, 1-0 Sun Belt) retaliated in the fourth quarter, recording a season-high 16-play drive for 53 yards, capped by a McGuire one-yard touchdown run.

Game 5 • Tulane 31 - UMass 24

McGuirk Stadium • Amherst, Mass. Oct. 1 • 14.892 Attendance

Tulane football was down 14-0 in the opening four minutes against Massachusetts on Saturday afternoon, but rallied by scoring 24 unanswered points before eventually claiming the 31-24 victory. It marked the biggest come-from-behind victory in the post-Katrina era, previously besting the time the Wave (3-2, 0-1 American Athletic Conference | West) rallied down 10-0 at Army on Oct. 3. 2009 to win it 17-16.

UMass (1-4) dealt a lightning quick first blow, going 59 yards in four plays on their opening drive, capped by a 12-yard touchdown pass form Andrew Ford to Andy Isabella. Tulane then fumbled on the ensuing kickoff as the Minutemen recovered and struck on another 12-yard touchdown connection between Ford and Isabella.

Down 14-0, the Olive and Blue remained poised and quickly retaliated, driving 75 yards via 10 plays as Dontrell Hilliard punched in an 11-yard run for the score. The touchdown marked the beginning of what would be 24 unanswered points for the Wave, as the Olive and Blue tacked on a second quarter Andrew DiRocco 22-yard field goal, a third-quarter 36-yard touchdown pass from Glen Cuiellette to Terren Encalade and a third quarter 19-yard touchdown carry by Lazedrick Thompson.

Tulane possessed a 24-14 lead to begin the fourth quarter but the Minutemen would not go away, recording a 28-yard field goal with 9:37 on the clock to cut the deficit to seven points.

Yet, the Green Wave responded once more by logging an eight play, 75-yard scoring drive on the ensuing offensive possession, as Josh Rounds tallied a 10-yard touchdown run to extend the lead to 31-17.

Next, UMass countered with a quick touchdown drive, garnering 58 yards in a short two minutes and 47 seconds, cutting the deficit to a touchdown once more at 31-24.

The Minutemen would later get the ball back with 2:18 left in the game, but the Green Wave defense sealed the victory by stopping UMass in its tracks in four plays as they turned the ball over on downs.
