STARTING FIVE

- Tulane is coming off of its seventh straight trip to the postseason (18th overall) and seventh straight 20+ win season.
- Last season also witnessed Tulane tying the program's longest run in the WNIT, knocking off Alabama & Georgia Tech to reach the third round.
- Kolby Morgan (First Team) and Leslie Vorpahl (Second Team) were named Pre-season All-American Athletic Conference selections.
- Tulane was picked to finish fourth in the preseason AAC coaches poll behind UConn, Temple and USF. The Wave were also predicted to make the NCAA Tournament field by College Sports Madness.
- Tulane went 14-3 at home last season, tying the program record for most wins inside Fogelman in Devlin.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 524-254 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 461-227 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

SERIES HISTORY - GRAMBLING

- Tulane trails the overall series against Grambling, 2-1. The two first squared off in 1981 in what was an 80-66 loss for the Wave.
- Tulane got its first win against Grambling in their last meeting on Nov. 10, 2000, when the Wave cruised to a 92-64 victory at home in the Preseason Women's NIT.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

- Last season, Grambling finished with a 17-14 overall record, while performing admirably in the SWAC, achieving a 13-5 conference mark.
- The Tigers averaged 65.1 ppg with a -1.0 scoring margin, shooting .395 from the field, but just .259 from three-point range. Grambling also suffered from a -4.9 rebounding margin.
- Sophomore guard Shakyla Hill returns after a stellar freshman campaign, in which she led the squad with 13.0 ppg. Hill also boasted the best rebounding average at 6.1 boards per game.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise and acknowledgment when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

SEASON OPENERS

Since the inception of Tulane women's basketball in the 1975-76 season, the Green Wave are 26-15 in season-openers, including winners of 11 straight. Furthermore, the Wave are 17-5 when opening the season at home (which includes the year in which Tulane played in Lubbock, Texas, due to Hurricane Katrina). The Olive and Blue have not lost a season opener at home since dropping a 61-58 decision to Alabama on Nov. 22, 1991, under then head coach Candi Harvey.

Thus, current head coach Lisa Stockton is 18-4 in season openers, including a perfect 13-0 inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse.

CLOSER LOOK AT THE EXHIBITION

Courtne Latham, Kolby Morgan and Shakira Harding all finished with double-digit points en route to the Wave's 75-53 exhibition win over Loyola New Orleans. Latham led the way with 18 points on 7-of-14 shooting, in which 12 of her points came in the first half. Morgan logged a double-double with 10 points and a team high 10 rebounds. Lastly, Shakira tallied 12 points which would have been a career high for her.

Team wise, Tulane who had shot 42.9 percent in the first half, settled for 35.4 percent overall in the game. The Wave also outrebounded the Wolf Pack 56-41.

1,000-POINT MILESTONE

Morgan's stellar sophomore campaign resulted in 601 total points, which ranked 54th in the country and seventh all-time at Tulane. Combine that with her freshman season total and Morgan enters her junior year with 1,002 career points. Thus, the New Orleans native became the 27th member of the program's 1,000-point club. Not only that, Morgan became the first player in Tulane history to cross over the 1,000-point plateau in her first two seasons.

Before Saturday's season opener vs Grambling, Morgan will be presented with a commemorative ball celebrating her 1,000-point milestone.

VORPAHL IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Vorpahl's 5.4 assists per game last season ranked second in the conference, 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane. Furthermore, Vorpahl finished with a total of 189 assists on the year, which ranked 20th in the country and placed her third on the program's all-time top-10 list for most in a season. The top-two spots belonged to Ashley Langford at No. 2 (207), followed by 2015 alum Jamie Kaplan at No. 1 with 209.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS PRESEASON NOD

During College Sports Madness' Preseason Top-44 countdown, the Green Wave were selected at No. 43 in the nation and predicted to finish second in The American. The popular collegiate basketball website predicted the Wave's post-season fate to be the NCAA Tournament.

A RUN IN THE WNIT

The Green Wave participated in their seventh WNIT last season and tied their longest run in the tournament by reaching the third round, last achieved in 2013. Tulane first knocked off Alabama, 53-52, utilizing a defensive stand in the final seconds. Then the Wave traveled to Georgia Tech where they staved off the Yellow Jackets, 64-61, in the final seconds as well with yet another defensive stand. WNIT runner-up FGCU halted the Wave's run in the third round via a 73-61 victory.

Tulane is now 8-8 all-time in the WNIT.

HOME SWEET HOME

Tulane went 14-3 inside The Fieldhouse this past season, tying the program record for most wins at home.

At home last year, Tulane posted a +9.4 scoring margin, averaging 68.3 ppg while shooting 43.8 percent from the field. The Wave also recorded a +1.2 turnover margin, forcing 17.6 turnovers per game.

The Wave boast a 383-181 record at home all time, good for a .679 winning percentage.

SUCCESS VS SEC & ACC

In three match-ups vs SEC opponents last season, Tulane went undefeated at 3-0, defeating LSU (67-63), Ole Miss (61-59) on the road, and Alabama (53-52). In addition, the Wave went 2-1 against ACC opposition, downing both Virginia (67-62) and Georgia Tech (64-61), and only falling by six to a ranked Florida State squad (78-72).

ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS

A couple of Green Wave players picked up end of the season awards last March as announced by The American on March 3. Kolby Morgan earned Second Team honors, while Leslie Vorpahl was named a Third Team selection along with Most Improved Player.

Morgan became the 11th player in Tulane history to earn multiple all-conference honors, after last season becoming the first freshman to receive all-conference recognition.

It marked Vorpahl's first career all-conference honor with the Third Team nod. In addition, Vorpahl joined the ranks of previous American Most Improved winners such as UConn's Moriah Jefferson and Louisville's Asia Taylor.

ASSISTING WITH THE BEST OF THEM

Inheriting the starting point guard position in her junior season, Vorpahl certainly made the most of it. Not only did Vorpahl average the second most points on the team with 10.7, but also distributed the ball extremely well with her 5.4 assists per game average. That assist average ranked 35th in the nation while her 189 total assists ranked 20th. In addition, Vorpahl's 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio ranked 6th in the conference.

On Jan. 10, Vorpahl earned her third double-double on the year, in which she dished out a career high 11 assists - which also stood as the highest assist performance from an AAC member this past year. Then on Feb. 14,

Vorpahl earned 10 assists vs UCF, marking her fourth double-digit assist game on the year and in her career.

THE MORGAN TRAIL

A year after her 12.2 points per game led Kolby Morgan to become the first freshman in school history to be an all-conference selection, the standout guard went above and beyond in year two, averaging 17.2 points per game which ranked 4th in The American.

The New Orleans native achieved 13 20+ scoring games this season, compared to two in her freshman season. Morgan even recorded a new career high of 30 points at No. 22/20 South Florida on Feb. 9. Her 11 made field goals (11-of-27) in Tampa also set a new personal best.

Versus in-state rival LSU on Nov. 23, Morgan recorded her second career double-double with 18 points and a career tying 11 rebounds.

Morgan had just three games in which she was kept to single-digit points and more importantly produced a career best 13-game double-digit scoring streak, including nine straight with 19 or more points.

Furthermore, on March 16 vs Alabama in the first round of the WNIT, Morgan recorded a career best 9-for-9 night from the free-throw line, including the go-ahead free-throws with 18 seconds left.

Simply put, Morgan did it all for the Wave, ranking first on the team in scoring, field goals made, free throws made and steals, while ranking second in three-pointers made, rebounds, assists, blocks, minutes and three-point field goal percentage.

TRIPLE CHANCE @ TRIPLE DOUBLE

After wrapping the 76-64 win over SMU on Feb. 14, Leslie Vorpahl sat with a career high nine rebounds and dished out 10 assists to go with her eight points, marking the third time last season that the junior had almost achieved the first ever triple-double in the Stockton era.

Previously, in Tulane's 92-49 win vs Jackson State on Nov. 17, Vorpahl recorded 15 points and 10 assists, but finished with eight rebounds. A month later, in the team's 74-53 win over UNCG on Dec. 20, Vorpahl netted 11 points and 10 assists, once again falling just short in rebounds with seven.

ON FIRE FROM THREE

Tulane was a hot shooting team from three-point range all last season. The Green Wave shot 33.3 percent from beyond the arc, which ranked third in the conference and 74th in the nation. Not only that, the .333 ranked 10th in Tulane history, with the top spot belonging to the 2002-03 squad's .362. Last season, the Wave shot .310 as a team.

GRINDING OUT THE WINS

Tulane's run in the WNIT last March was a perfect microcosm of their season, as the Wave grinded out two big wins, utilizing two strong defensive stands in the final seconds.

All in all, Tulane went an impressive 7-2 in games decided by five points or less and 9-3 in games decided by single digits. The 9-3 record stood as the best in The American in said scenario.

2015-16 RECAP

- Morgan's 601 points this season ranked 54th in the country and ranked 7th all-time in Tulane WBB history. More importantly, Morgan reached 1,002 career points, thus becoming the first player in Tulane history to cross over the 1,000-point plateau in her first two seasons.
- Second Team All-Conference selection - 11th player to earn multiple all-conference honors in Tulane WBB history.
- Started all 35 games, averaging the 2nd most minutes with 33.1. Played 36+ minutes in 13 of the last 17 games, including all 40 at Georgia Tech. Morgan's 1,159 total minutes ranked 3rd all-time in program history.
- After averaging 12.2 ppg as a freshman, Morgan increased her production with 17.2 ppg as a sophomore, which ranked 4th in The American.
- Only posted 3 games with single-digit points all year and produced a career best 13-game streak of double-digit scoring games, in which she tallied 19+ points in the last 9 games of the streak (averaged 22.1 ppg). Also averaged 6.7 rebounds in those last 9 games, up from her season average of 4.7.
- Had a career night at No. 22/20 USF, scoring 30 points on 11-of-27 shooting, including a 5-for-12 mark from three-point range. It marked the first Green Wave 30+ point performance since Danielle Nunn scored 37 points at Oral Roberts back on March 21, 2011.
- Tallied 13 - 20+ scoring performances compared to two from a year ago.
- Recorded her second career double-double vs. LSU, scoring 18 points while tying her career high in rebounds with 11.
- Increased her 3PT FG% from .301 a year ago to .327 this season, which ranked 12th in the league, while Morgan's 1.8 three-pointers per game average ranked 8th. Morgan's 64 total three's on the season put her in a tie for the 7th most all-time in program history.
- Shot 84.3 percent from the free-throw line during conference play, which ranked 5th. Made 57 of her last 60 and connected on a career best 9-for-9 day from the line against Alabama on March 16. Morgan's 129 made free throws ranked 58th in the country and 10th in program history.
- Morgan's 77 total steals ranked 46th in the nation & 10th all-time.

- Scored a career high 10 points vs Temple on Jan. 26, connecting on a career-tying two treys.

2015-16 RECAP

- AAC Most Improved Player Award Winner & 3rd Team All-Conference Selection
- Started in all 35 games, averaging the most minutes with 33.2. Vorpahl's 1,163 total minutes ranked 2nd all-time in program history.
- Averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 2nd in The American, 35th in the country & 5th in program history. Vorpahl dished out a career high of 11 vs UCF (1/10), which stood as the best assist performance in the league this year. In addition, her 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio ranked 6th in the league.
- With 189 total assists, Vorpahl ranked 3rd on Tulane's all-time list for assists in a season, trailing Ashely Langford (207) and Jamie Kaplan (209). Those 189 assists also ranked 20th in the nation.
- During conference play, Vorpahl ranked in the top-6 in 5 different statistical categories: 2nd in assists (5.6), 5th in 3PT FG% (.400), 6th in 3PT FG (2.0), 4th in A/TO ratio (2.0) and 6th in minutes (34.5).
- Twice in a 10-day span, Vorpahl set a new career high in scoring, first recording 26 points on 10-of-18 shooting, including a career high six three-pointers vs No. 19/16 USF on Jan. 13, then besting that performance with 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting vs ECU on Jan. 23.
- Nearly achieved the first triple-double in the Stockton era three times: Recorded her first career double-double with 15 points and 10 assists vs Jackson State (11/17) with 8 rebounds. Vorpahl then tallied her second double-double with 11 points, 10 assists vs UNCG (12/20), garnering seven boards. Finally, Vorpahl gathered eight points, a career high nine rebounds and 10 assists vs SMU on Feb. 14.
- Only had one game all year in which she didn't achieve a three. Vorpahl's 1.9 made three-pointers per game average ranked 7th in the league, while her .400 three-point percentage ranked 4th. In addition, Vorpahl's 66 three-pointers tied her for 5th all-time for a single season in program history, while her .400 three-point percentage is tied for the 4th best.
