### THE AMERICAN TODAY

Three games highlight the American's schedule for Tuesday. Cincinnati makes its home debut hosting Bowling Green at Noon ET (ESPN3), while RV/RV USF welcomes North Florida to the Sun Dome (7 p.m. ET) to open up the season. Houston heads west to take on UNLV at 9 p.m. ET. The Cougars face Long Beach State on Friday to wrap up their two-game road trip.

The American is well represented nationally in the initial NCAA rankings. Cincinnati leads the nation in offensive rebounds per game while Tulane is Top 5 in field-goal percentage and fewest fouls. UCF ranks 10th nationally in rebound margin (24.5). East Carolina is 10th in steals per game while leading the NCAA in total assists.

Napheesa Collier had a game-high 28 points and led three Huskies in double figure scoring as No. 3/1 UConn defeated No. 12/12 Florida State, 78-76, Monday evening in the season opener for both teams. The Huskies extended its winning streak to 76 games, which is the third-longest streak in college basketball history.

Feyonda Fitzgerald led RV/RV Temple with 27 points, nine assists and a career-high tying nine rebounds in the Owls' 86-70 win over crosstown rival La Salle Monday night at McGonigle Hall. Tanaya Atkinson recorded her second-straight 20-point effort while Alliya Butts scored 17 and added her 1,000th career-point in the process.

Gaffney averaged 27.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals per game while shooting 24-for-35 (.686) from the field in a 2-0 week for the Pirates. The Cary, N.C., native opened the week with 23 points on 9-for-12 shooting in a win over Greensboro College on Friday. She scored a career-high 32 points on 15-for-23 shooting with eight boards in Sunday's 83-81 (OT) win over Detroit-Mercy. Gaffney scored six of ECU's 13 points in overtime while making all three of her shot attempts.



#### Freshman of the Week

**Kendrian Elliott • Fr. • F • Tulsa**

Elliott scored 11 points and started her first collegiate game Friday in the Hurricane's 80-70 win at UMKC. It was the first season-opening win for Tulsa since the 2009-10 campaign. Elliott pulled down four rebounds and added a block on the defensive end in 17 minutes of action while shooting 57.1-percent from the field and 75.0-percent from the charity stripe.

## Stiff Non-Conference Action Awaits American Teams

USF will play in the inaugural Play4Kay Tournament in Las Vegas in December. The field includes 2016 Final Four participant Oregon State. The Bulls will also host Louisville at the Sun Dome in late January.

Memphis' non-conference schedule features SEC, Big Ten and Big 12 members Illinois, Kansas, Arkansas and Vanderbilt. The Tigers play host the Commodores at Elma Roane Fieldhouse in late December.

UConn's non-conference slate includes 10 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. The Huskies will again play in the prestigious Jimmy V Classic, this time vs. Texas at Mohegan Sun Arena, home of the 2017 American Women's Basketball Championship.

Tulane will face SEC foes Vanderbilt, LSU and Mississippi State this year, and will host ACC member NC State in mid-December.

## Nurse Named to Nancy Lieberman Watch List

UConn junior Kia Nurse was named to the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Watch List on Oct. 25. The award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

## The American - Well Represented in Rio

The American was well represented in the Olympic Games in Rio this summer with Geno Auriemma (UConn) and Jamelle Elliott (Cincinnati) serving as coaches for USA Basketball. Current Husky Kia Nurse was a member of the Canadian women's national team.

## Four Straight for UConn

UConn won an unprecedented fourth national championship last season. With the title, Geno Auriemma became college basketball's all-time leader in national championship with 11, surpassing John Wooden.

## Postseason Just as Nice

Five American Athletic Conference women's basketball teams were selected for postseason play in 2015-

16. UConn and USF were each selected for the NCAA Tournament while Memphis, Tulane and Temple were chosen for the WNIT. The Owls advanced to the WNIT Quarterfinals.

## Three the Hard Way

The UConn trio of Breanna Stewart, Moriah Jefferson and Morgan Tuck were selected with the first three picks of the 2016 WNBA Draft. It marked the first time in WNBA history the top three selections came from the same school.

## Williams Makes History

Courtney Williams became the first player in USF history to be chosen in the first round of the 2016 WNBA Draft.

## Cardoza Leads U18 National Team

Temple head coach Tonya Cardoza was selected as a court coach for the 2016 USA Basketball U18 National Team.

## International Competition

Houston, Memphis and Tulsa each participated in foreign tours this summer. The Cougars played exhibition games in Costa Rica while the Tigers traveled to four different cities (Madrid, Toledo, Valencia, Barcelona) during their 10-day foreign tour of Spain. Tulsa traveled to Dominican Republic in August and played exhibition games against the Dominican National Team.

The American names a Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week each Monday morning during the season. Winners are chosen from nominations provided by conference sports information directors. The information will be available from the conference office via release as well as on the league web site.

## Annual Awards

The American Athletic Conference will name all-conference teams and individual honors for the league's Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, Coach of the Year, Most Improved Player of the Year, Sportsmanship Award and Sixth Player of the Year. The awards are chosen by a vote of the league's 11 head coaches at the conclusion of the regular season and will be announced in conjunction with the Conference Championship.

The American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team is comprised of players who have an overall grade-point average of 3.00 or better over the previous academic year and completed at least two semesters of academic work. Basketball honorees are announced in the summer.

The American Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year was established to recognize student-athletes who have achieved success in the classroom and on the court. The winner receives a scholarship which may be applied to graduate or professional studies.
