STARTING FIVE

1. Wednesday marks the 12th all-time meeting between Tulane and Mississippi State. The Bulldogs hold a slight 6-5 advantage and have won three straight, including the NCAA First Round matchup between the two in Durham in 2015.

2. With Tulane's 79-56 win over Grambling, the Wave moved to 19-4 in season openers under Coach Stockton.

3. Senior Leslie Vorpahl set a new single-game program record with her 15 assists vs Grambling. Vorpahl bested the previous record of 14 set by Ashley Langford in both 2006 and 2007.

4. Junior Kolby Morgan picked up right where she left off, leading the team with 21 points. It marked her 16th career 20+ point scoring game.

5. Sophomore Meredith Schulte landed on the AAC Week One Honor Roll list after her career high 20-point performance, sinking 8-of-9 from the field.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of



525-254 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 462-227 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.

During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tulane defeated Grambling, 79-56, in its season opener this past Saturday. Coach Stockton improved to 19-4 in season openers, including a perfect 13-0 mark at home.

- Kolby Morgan led the way with 21 points, marking her 16th career game with 20+ points. In addition, Meredith Schulte tallied a career high 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting.

SERIES HISTORY - MISS STATE

- Tulane trails the overall series against Mississippi State, 6-5. The Bulldogs have won three straight against the Wave.

- The last time these two programs met up was the first round of the NCAA Tournament in March of 2015 in Durham, North Carolina. Miss State prevailed with the 57-47 victory that day.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Miss State is off to a 2-0 start, defeating Villanova, 108-62, followed by Maine, 87-43.

- The Bulldogs have now won 30 of its last 31 regular season non-conference games, dating back to the 2014-15 season. That tally also includes their current 10-game streak.

- State is ranked No. 10 in the AP poll, marking their 38th straight week inside the top-25.

- Victoria Vivians was named a Preseason All-SEC selection and was also just named the MVP in the Maine tournament this past weekend, where she averaged 15.0 ppg.

- Redshirt junior Roshunda Johnson was tabbed to the all-tournament team after averaging 17.5 ppg in her Miss State debut.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

RECORD SETTING DAY

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl made history in Tulane's season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12. The San Antonio native recorded 15 assists, setting a new single-game program record, previously held by Ashley Langford's 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Vorpahl's 15.0 assists per game lead all Division-I players in the country right now.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

The top-returning scorer in the league picked up right where she left off last season, as Kolby Morgan led the Green Wave with 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including a career high tying nine successfully made free throws.

Last year, Morgan averaged 17.2 ppg and secured 13, 20+ scoring games (now up to 16 in her career).

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Sophomore Meredith Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

A JOB WELL(S) DONE

Speaking of stellar openers, freshman forward Maddison Wells got off to a hot start by recording double-digit points in her Green Wave debut. Wells shot 4-for-4 from the field and finished with 10 points.

NATIONAL CHART TOPPING OPENER

The Green Wave currently rank in the top-10 in the country in two team categories. Tulane ranks second in field goal percentage after shooting .580 (29-50) against Grambling. In addition, partially thanks to Vorpahl's record-setting day, the Wave's 24 assists per game ranks eighth in the nation.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise and acknowledgment when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.

STOCKTON SIGNS EXTENSION

Back in October, head coach Lisa Stockton signed a contract extension taking her through the 2020-21 season. Stockton has led the Wave to 17 trips to the postseason, including 11 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Most recently, the Wave have accomplished seven straight 20+ win seasons, and in their first two seasons in The American, have booked a ticket to the NCAA Tournament and tied their longest run in the WNIT (third round).

STOCKTON INKS FOUR TO CLASS OF 2017

Three days before the season started, Coach Stockton welcomed Kaila Anderson (Baton Rouge, La.), Sierra Cheatham (Houston, Texas), Krystal Freeman (Pineville, La.) and Tatyana Lofton (Madison, Miss.) all to the Green Wave family.

WAVE COMING TO A TV NEAR YOU

Once the Green Wave begin its third year in league play come 2017, they'll have 12 of their 16 conference games aired on T.V. or streamed on the web. Tulane will have three games broadcasted on ESPN2 and five on ESPN3. In addition, the Wave will air once on CBS Sports Network and SNY, and streamed twice on the American Digital Network.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS PRESEASON NOD

During College Sports Madness' Preseason Top-44 countdown, the Green Wave were selected at No. 43 in the nation and predicted to finish second in The American. The popular collegiate basketball website predicted the Wave's post-season fate to be the NCAA Tournament.

A RUN IN THE WNIT

The Green Wave participated in their seventh WNIT last season and tied their longest run in the tournament by reaching the third round, last achieved in 2013. Tulane first knocked off Alabama, 53-52, utilizing a defensive stand in the final seconds. Then the Wave traveled to Georgia Tech where they staved off the Yellow Jackets, 64-61, in the final seconds as well with yet another defensive stand. WNIT runner-up FGCU halted the Wave's run in the third round via a 73-61 victory.

Tulane is now 8-8 all-time in the WNIT.

HOME SWEET HOME

Tulane went 14-3 inside The Fieldhouse last season, tying the program record for most wins at home.

At home last year, Tulane posted a +9.4 scoring margin, averaging 68.3 ppg while shooting 43.8 percent from the field. The Wave also recorded a +1.2 turnover margin, forcing 17.6 turnovers per game.

The Wave boast a 383-181 record at home all time, good for a .679 winning percentage.

SUCCESS VS SEC & ACC

In three match-ups vs SEC opponents last season, Tulane went undefeated at 3-0, defeating LSU (67-63), Ole Miss (61-59) on the road, and Alabama (53-52). In addition, the Wave went 2-1 against ACC opposition, downing both Virginia (67-62) and Georgia Tech (64-61), and only falling by six to a ranked Florida State squad (78-72).

THE MORGAN TRAIL

A year after her 12.2 points per game led Kolby Morgan to become the first freshman in school history to be an all-conference selection, the standout guard went above and beyond in year two, averaging 17.2 points per game which ranked 4th in The American.

The New Orleans native achieved 13 20+ scoring games this season, compared to two in

her freshman season. Morgan even recorded a new career high of 30 points at No. 22/20 South Florida on Feb. 9. Her 11 made field goals (11-of-27) in Tampa also set a new personal best.

Versus in-state rival LSU on Nov. 23, Morgan recorded her second career double-double with 18 points and a career tying 11 rebounds.

Morgan had just three games in which she was kept to single-digit points and more importantly produced a career best 13-game double-digit scoring streak, including nine straight with 19 or more points.

Furthermore, on March 16 vs Alabama in the first round of the WNIT, Morgan recorded a career best 9-for-9 night from the free-throw line, including the go-ahead free-throws with 18 seconds left.

Simply put, Morgan did it all for the Wave, ranking first on the team in scoring, field goals made, free throws made and steals, while ranking second in three-pointers made, rebounds, assists, blocks, minutes and three-point field goal percentage.

TRIPLE CHANCE @ TRIPLE DOUBLE

After wrapping the 76-64 win over SMU on Feb. 14, Leslie Vorpahl sat with a career high nine rebounds and dished out 10 assists to go with her eight points, marking the third time last season that the junior had almost achieved the first ever triple-double in the Stockton era.

Previously, in Tulane's 92-49 win vs Jackson State on Nov. 17, Vorpahl recorded 15 points and 10 assists, but finished with eight rebounds. A month later, in the team's 74-53 win over UNCG on Dec. 20, Vorpahl netted 11

Tulane was a hot shooting team from three-point range all last season. The Green Wave shot 33.3 percent from beyond the arc, which ranked third in the conference and 74th in the nation. Not only that, the .333 ranked 10th in Tulane history, with the top spot belonging to the 2002-03 squad's .362. Last season, the Wave shot .310 as a team.

GRINDING OUT THE WINS

Tulane's run in the WNIT last March was a perfect microcosm of their season, as the Wave grinded out two big wins, utilizing two strong defensive stands in the final seconds.

All in all, Tulane went an impressive 7-2 in games decided by five points or less and 9-3 in games decided by single digits. The 9-3 record stood as the best in The American in said scenario.

LEAD PROTECTORS

Last season, the Wave went 18-1 when leading at half, with Temple (2/23) being the lone exception. Tulane was also 20-1 when leading heading into the fourth quarter - The lone loss came at the hands of top-20 ranked South Florida at home.
