^{3/2} UConn makes its home debut on Thursday hosting ^{2/4} Baylor in a battle of Top 5 teams at Gampel Pavilion. The game will air live on SNY/ESPN3 at 7:30 p.m. ET. Memphis kicks off the American women's basketball action of the day with a 1 p.m. ET matchup at Illinois, while Tulsa faces crosstown rival Oral Roberts at the Mabee Center at 8 p.m. ET. The Huskies defeated ^{12/12} Florida State, 78-76, Monday night in Tallahassee while Memphis and Tulsa are both 1-1 over their last two decisions.

Four American Athletic Conference teams - UConn, USF, Temple and Tulane - are ranked or receiving votes in the second AP/USA Today national polls released earlier in the week.

The American is well represented in the last NCAA statistical report with UCF, East Carolina, Temple and Tulane ranked Top 5 in multiple categories:

- Field-Goal Percentage - Tulane (No. 2)
- Assists Per Game - East Carolina (No. 3)
- Fewest Fouls - Tulane (No. 3)
- Free-Throws Made - Temple (No. 5)
- Rebound Margin - UCF (No. 5)
- Steals - East Carolina (No. 5)

Zykira Lewis scored a game-high 26 points for UCF while recording a career-best seven steals to help Knights post its second road win of the 2016-17 campaign with a 57-38 victory over Davidson on Wednesday. For the third consecutive game, UCF has held its opponent under 60 points.

Four Pirates scored in double-figures for the third-straight game as East Carolina defeated UNC Wilmington, 75-65, in front of 4,958 fans Wednesday afternoon at Williams Arena in Minges Coliseum. The attendance is the second highest ever for an ECU women's basketball game.

Kiara Perry scored a career-high 17 points and grabbed a career-best 14 rebounds for her third career double-double to lead SMU to a 75-63 victory at Kansas. It was the program's first win at Kansas in four road games.

Gaffney averaged 27.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals per game while shooting 24-for-35 (.686) from the field in a 2-0 week for the Pirates. The Cary, N.C., native opened the week with 23 points on 9-for-12 shooting in a win over Greensboro College on Friday. She scored a career-high 32 points on 15-for-23 shooting with eight boards in Sunday's 83-81 (OT) win over Detroit-Mercy. Gaffney scored six of ECU's 13 points in overtime while making all three of her shot attempts.

Stiff Non-Conference Action Awaits American Teams

USF will play in the inaugural Play4Kay Tournament in Las Vegas in December. The field includes 2016 Final Four participant Oregon State. The Bulls will also host Louisville at the Sun Dome in late January.

Memphis' non-conference schedule features SEC, Big Ten and Big 12 members Illinois, Kansas, Arkansas and Vanderbilt. The Tigers play host the Commodores at Elma Roane Fieldhouse in late December.

UConn's non-conference slate includes 10 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. The Huskies will again play in the prestigious Jimmy V Classic, this time vs. Texas at Mohegan Sun Arena, home of the 2017 American Women's Basketball Championship.

Tulane will face SEC foes Vanderbilt, LSU and Mississippi State this year, and will host ACC member NC State in mid-December.

Nurse Named to Nancy Lieberman Watch List

UConn junior Kia Nurse was named to the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Watch List on Oct. 25. The award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

The American - Well Represented in Rio

The American was well represented in the Olympic Games in Rio this summer with Geno Auriemma (UConn) and Jamelle Elliott (Cincinnati) serving as coaches for USA Basketball. Current Husky Kia Nurse was a member of the Canadian women's national team.

Four Straight for UConn

UConn won an unprecedented fourth national championship last season. With the title, Geno Auriemma became college basketball's all-time leader in national championship with 11, surpassing John Wooden.

Postseason Just as Nice

Five American Athletic Conference women's basketball teams were selected for postseason play in 2015-

16. UConn and USF were each selected for the NCAA Tournament while Memphis, Tulane and Temple were chosen for the WNIT. The Owls advanced to the WNIT Quarterfinals.

Three the Hard Way

The UConn trio of Breanna Stewart, Moriah Jefferson and Morgan Tuck were selected with the first three picks of the 2016 WNBA Draft. It marked the first time in WNBA history the top three selections came from the same school.

Williams Makes History

Courtney Williams became the first player in USF history to be chosen in the first round of the 2016 WNBA Draft.

Cardoza Leads U18 National Team

Temple head coach Tonya Cardoza was selected as a court coach for the 2016 USA Basketball U18 National Team.

International Competition

Houston, Memphis and Tulsa each participated in foreign tours this summer. The Cougars played exhibition games in Costa Rica while the Tigers traveled to four different cities (Madrid, Toledo, Valencia, Barcelona) during their 10-day foreign tour of Spain. Tulsa traveled to Dominican Republic in August and played exhibition games against the Dominican National Team.
