# TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of



525-255 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 462-228 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.

During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

• Tulane took on No. 10/9 Mississippi State this past Wednesday night, falling to the Bulldogs, 66-49.

• Leslie Vorpahl, who only played six minutes in the first half due to early foul trouble, finished with a game high 20 points after sinking her first nine shots.

## SERIES HISTORY - SOUTHERN MISS

• Tulane trails the overall series against Southern Miss, 35-29.

• Tulane boasts a 21-12 record at home against Southern Miss.

• The series dates back to Jan. of 1980, in which the Wave claimed the first matchup, 72-62, at Southern Miss.

• The two sides have split the last 10 encounters at five-apiece. The two last met back on March 1, 2014, in which Southern Miss escaped with the 79-67 win.

## SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES

• Southern Miss is off to a 3-0 start after picking up wins against UNO, William Carey and Alcorn State.

• The Golden Eagles are averaging 80.0 points per game with a +35.0 scoring margin. They also boast a +7.7 rebounding margin and a +15.3 turnover margin.

• Southern Miss is led by Brittany Dinkins, who is averaging 16.3 ppg on 48.7 percent shooting, including a .444 mark from three-point range.

• Jayla King follows suit with her 12.3 ppg to go along with her team leading 7.0 rebounds per game. Megan Brown also averages double figures at 10.0 ppg.

# TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## PICKING YOUR SHOTS

Though it's a small sample size of two games, Tulane is off to a hot start shooting wise. The Green Wave's .533 shooting percentage currently ranks first in the conference and third in the nation.

A trio of players lead the way for the Wave in Harlyn Wyatt, Meredith Schulte and Leslie Vorpahl, who all rank inside the top-4 in the league in field goal percentage. Wyatt is shooting .857 from the floor while Schulte and Vorpahl each are at .714, as the latter two rank 16th in the nation.

## MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl made history in Tulane's season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12. The San Antonio native recorded 15 assists, setting a new single-game program record, previously held by Ashley Langford's 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

After two games, Vorpahl sits at 8.0 assists per game, which ranks 7th in the nation and tied for first in the AAC. In addition, Vorpahl's 16 total assists ranks 30th in the country.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

## VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game high 20 points.

## FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered Wednesday's contest averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting.

Miss State did prevail with the 66-49 victory on Wednesday, but keep in mind two factors: Tulane only had its senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl for only six minutes in the first half due to early foul trouble, and Preseason First-Team All-Conference selection Kolby Morgan was held to a career low one-point and left early in the second half.

All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

Sophomore Meredith Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

## A JOB WELL(S) DONE

Speaking of stellar starts, freshman forward Maddison Wells got off to a hot start by recording double-digit points in her Green Wave debut. Wells shot 4-for-4 from the field and finished with 10 points.

Then vs. No. 10/9 Miss State, Wells reeled in a team high five rebounds.

## WYATT RIOT

Sophomore center Harlyn Wyatt emerged in her second start of the season vs. No. 10/9 Miss State, making all four of her shots from the floor to finish with 10 points, marking her first double-digit scoring performance of the season.

## PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

The top-returning scorer in the league picked up right where she left off last season, as Kolby Morgan led the Green Wave with 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including a career high tying nine successfully made free throws in the season opener vs Grambling on Nov. 12.

Last year, Morgan averaged 17.2 ppg and secured 13, 20+ scoring games (now up to 16 in her career).

## AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise and acknowledgment when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.

## STOCKTON SIGNS EXTENSION

Back in October, Coach Stockton signed a contract extension taking her through the 2020-21 season. Stockton has led the Wave to 17 trips to the postseason, including 11 appearances in the NCAA Tournament. Most recently, the Wave have accomplished seven straight 20+ win seasons, and in their first two seasons in The American, have booked a ticket to the NCAA Tournament and tied their longest run in the WNIT (third round).

## STOCKTON INKS 4 TO 2017 CLASS

Three days before the season started, Coach Stockton welcomed Kaila Anderson (Baton Rouge, La.), Sierra Cheatham (Houston, Texas), Krystal Freeman (Pineville, La.) and Tatyana Lofton (Madison, Miss.) all to the Green Wave family.

## WAVE COMING TO A TV NEAR YOU

Once the Green Wave begin its third year in league play come 2017, they'll have 12 of their 16 conference games aired on T.V. or streamed on the web. Tulane will have three games broadcasted on ESPN2 and five on ESPN3. In addition, the Wave will air once on CBS Sports Network and SNY, and streamed twice on the American Digital Network.

## COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS PRESEASON NOD

During College Sports Madness' Preseason Top-44 countdown, the Green Wave were selected at No. 43 in the nation and predicted to finish second in The American. The popular collegiate basketball website predicted the Wave's post-season fate to be the NCAA Tournament.

## A RUN IN THE WNIT

The Green Wave participated in their seventh WNIT last season and tied their longest run in the tournament by reaching the third round, last achieved in 2013. Tulane first knocked off Alabama, 53-52, utilizing a defensive stand in the final seconds. Then the Wave traveled to Georgia Tech where they staved off the Yellow Jackets, 64-61, in the final seconds as well with yet another defensive stand. WNIT runner-up FGCU halted the Wave's run in the third round via a 73-61 victory.

Tulane is now 8-8 all-time in the WNIT.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Tulane went 14-3 inside The Fieldhouse last season, tying the program record for most wins at home.
