THE AMERICAN TODAY

Thanksgiving week sees seven American teams - UCF, East Carolina, Memphis, USF, SMU, Tulane and Tulsa - competing in holiday tournaments. The Knights head to Indiana for a game at Butler before returning home to host the UCF Thanksgiving Classic, while the Pirates will compete in the Savannah Invitational against Marist, No. 19 West Virginia and Ball State.

The Tigers travel west for the Nugget Classic hosted by Nevada while the Bulls, who are receiving votes in this week's AP poll, defeated Jacksonville on Monday before heading to the Bahamas for the Junkanoo Jam. The field in the Lucaya Division includes North Carolina, Georgia and Minnesota. The Mustangs welcome Prairie View A&M to Dallas on Tuesday before facing Boston College on Friday in the opening day of the Omni Hotel Classic. The Green Wave will battle Eastern Michigan and host UTSA in the UTSA Classic in San Antonio.

UConn, who is ranked No. 2 in the latest AP poll, returns home to Gampel Pavilion for a matchup against Dayton on Tuesday at 7 p.m. ET (SNY/ESPN3). The Huskies' 78-game win streak is the third longest in college basketball history.

Cincinnati travels to Miami (Ohio) on Tuesday (Noon ET, ESPN3) before returning home on Saturday to face Howard. The Bearcats are 2-1 over their last three games and fell to Indiana State in their last time out on Saturday.

Houston and Temple each play at home this week. The Coogs take on Texas State and Mercer on Wednesday and Friday, respectively, while the Owls play one game this week, a post Thanksgiving matinee, against Quinnipiac on Sunday.

Katie Lou Samuelson • So. • G/F • UConn

Samuelson averaged 19.3 points and 4.7 rebounds per game while shooting 52.2-percent (12-of-23) from 3-point range in a 3-0 week for UConn, which included wins over a pair of Top 12 opponents in Florida State (No. 12) and Baylor (No. 2). The sophomore was nearly perfect from the charity stripe and made 92-percent (12-of-13) of her shots last week. She put together the best game of her career on Sunday in a 76-53 win at LSU after scoring a career-high 28 points to go along with seven 3-pointers and a career-best eight rebounds.



Freshman of the Week

Crystal Dangerfield • Fr. • G • UConn

Dangerfield averaged 11.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while shooting 52-percent (13-of-25) from the floor, including 5-10 from 3-point range, in a 3-0 week for UConn. The rookie led the Huskies with 19 points and added four rebounds and five assists in Thursday's 72-61 win over No. 2/4 Baylor. She was 8-of-14 from the floor against the Lady Bears and made three of her five attempts from long-range. Dangerfield followed that up with a 10-point, three-rebound game in the win at LSU on Sunday.

Nurse Named to Nancy Lieberman Watch List

UConn junior Kia Nurse was named to the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Watch List on Oct. 25. The award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

Stiff Non-Conference Action Awaits American Teams

USF will play in the inaugural Play4Kay Tournament in Las Vegas in December. The field includes 2016 Final Four participant Oregon State. The Bulls will also host Louisville at the Sun Dome in late January.

Memphis' non-conference schedule features SEC, Big Ten and Big 12 members Illinois, Kansas, Arkansas and Vanderbilt. The Tigers play host the Commodores at Elma Roane Fieldhouse in late December.

UConn's non-conference slate includes 10 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. The Huskies will again play in the prestigious Jimmy V Classic, this time vs. Texas at Mohegan Sun Arena, home of the 2017 American Women's Basketball Championship.

Tulane will face SEC foes Vanderbilt, LSU and Mississippi State this year, and will host ACC member NC State in mid-December.

International Competition

Houston, Memphis and Tulsa each participated in foreign tours this summer. The Cougars played exhibition games in Costa Rica while the Tigers traveled to four different cities (Madrid, Toledo, Valencia, Barcelona) during their 10-day foreign tour of Spain. Tulsa traveled to Dominican Republic in August and played exhibition games against the Dominican National Team.

The American - Well Represented in Rio

The American was well represented in the Olympic Games in Rio this summer with Geno Auriemma (UConn) and Jamelle Elliott (Cincinnati) serving as coaches for USA Basketball. Current Husky Kia Nurse was a member of the Canadian women's national team.

Cardoza Leads U18 National Team

Temple head coach Tonya Cardoza was selected as a court coach for the 2016 USA Basketball U18 National Team.

Postseason Just as Nice
