LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 526-255 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 463-228 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

• Tulane defeated Southern Miss, 86-67, this past Sunday. Kolby Morgan led with 21 points as Courtnie Latham followed suit with 17 points. Senior Shakira Harding then added a career high 16 points off the bench.

• Tulane converted 29 Southern Miss turnovers into 27 points. The Wave also shot 56.1 percent from the floor.

SERIES HISTORY - EMU

• Tulane leads the series, 1-0.

• The Wave won the lone encounter, 71-65, in the Tulane Classic in December of 2012.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

• Eastern Michigan is coming off of an 89-61 loss at Wake Forest. The Eagles are averaging 67.8 ppg, shooting 35.3 percent from the field but just 23.9 percent from beyond the arc.

• Last season, EMU went 22-12, falling in the semifinals of the MAC Championships before reaching the second round of the WNIT.

• Junior guard Sasha Dailey is averaging a team leading 22.5 ppg off the bench, averaging 27.5 minutes per game. Dailey is shooting 43.7 percent from the field and 31.3 percent from three-point range.

SERIES HISTORY - UTSA

• The series is even at 2-2.

• The series dates back to Jan. 31, 1987, in which UTSA won 69-66 in overtime. The Green Wave have won the last two encounters, previously claiming a 68-54 victory in San Antonio in February of 2014.

SCOUTING THE ROADRUNNERS

• UTSA is off to a 1-3 start with their lone win being a 70-44 victory vs Texas A&M-Kingsville. Most recently, UTSA suffered a 77-63 loss at Oregon.

• The Roadrunners enter the tournament averaging 66.0 points per game on 39.4 percent shooting with a -4.2 scoring margin. Also average 41.0 rebounds per game and 16.3 turnovers.

• Junior guard Loryn Goodwin is averaging a team leading 22.8 ppg on 46.0 percent shooting from the floor.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LEADING THE NATION

Though it's a small sample size of three games, Tulane is off to a hot shooting start as their .544 shooting percentage ranks first in the nation.

Sophomore Meredith Schulte currently ranks second in The American in field goal percentage, shooting 68.8 percent. She is followed by both Courtnie Latham and Leslie Vorpahl, who are tied for eighth with their .571 shooting percentage.

Meanwhile post-players Harlyn Wyatt, Madison Wells and Ksenija Madzarevic are a combined 19-for-25 from the field.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl made history in Tulane's season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

After three games, Vorpahl's 7.7 assists per game ranks 10th in the nation and tied for first in the AAC. In addition, Vorpahl's 23 total assists ranks 21st in the country.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

SAN ANTONIO HOMECOMING

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl returns to her hometown, just in time for the holidays. Vorpahl grew up in San Antonio, Texas, and attended Winston Churchill High. Meanwhile, fellow senior guard and Houston native Courtnie Latham returns her home state.

LATHAM BREAKS LOOSE

Speaking of Latham, the senior broke out in Sunday's win over Southern Miss, scoring 17 points on a career high seven made field goals. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Kolby Morgan and Courtnie Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high.

Morgan is now averaging 3.3 steals per game which ranks second in the league and 35th in the nation.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

With the victory over Southern Miss, the Wave have now won six straight at home, dating back to the final month of last season. Currently, the Olive and Blue are averaging 82.5 ppg with a +21.0 scoring margin inside Fogelman in Devlin, shooting an impressive 57.0 percent from the field.

Last season, Tulane achieved 14 wins at home, which tied the school record.

THOMPSON TOUGH ON THE BOARDS

Sophomore Tene Thompson is leading the team in rebounding coming off the bench, averaging 6.3 rebounds per game, which is almost triple the amount of any of the five starters. Thompson's 6.3 rebounds per game is tied for 14th in the AAC, while her 5.7 defense rebounds per game is tied for fifth.

SIXTH WOMAN OF THE GAME

Senior Shakira Harding recorded a career day off the bench this past Sunday vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game high 20 points.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered Wednesday's contest averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting.

Miss State did prevail with the 66-49 victory on Wednesday, but keep in mind two factors: Tulane only had its senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl for only six minutes in the first half due to early foul trouble, and Preseason First-Team All-Conference selection Kolby Morgan was held to a career low one-point and left early in the second half.

All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Sophomore Meredith Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

A JOB WELL(S) DONE

Speaking of stellar starts, freshman forward Maddison Wells got off to a hot start by recording double-digit points in her Green Wave debut. Wells shot 4-for-4 from the field and finished with 10 points.

Then vs. No. 10/9 Miss State, Wells reeled in a team high five rebounds.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

The top-returning scorer in the league picked up right where she left off last season, as Kolby Morgan led the Green Wave with 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including a career high tying nine successfully made free throws vs Grambling on Nov. 12. Then a week later vs Southern Miss, Morgan registered 21 points yet again, converting 8-of-18 from the field, including her first two three-pointers of the season.

Last year, Morgan averaged 17.2 ppg and secured 13, 20+ scoring games (now up to 17 in her career).
