### 2016-17 NOTES

•- Is the first road game for the Cowgirls this season

•- Opened the season with five straight home games

•- Cowgirls will play six of its next seven games on the road including two at the Patrick Harrington Tournament (Dec. 19-20).

•- McNeese has lost the last eight straight and 10 of last 12 games against Tulane.

•- The last McNeese win over Tulane was in 1983 (82-80). The last win against Tulane in New Orleans came in 1986 (85-72).

•- As a team, the Cowgirls lead the nation in rebounds (51.6), rank 7th in in offensive rebounds per game (19.0) and 8th in defensive rebounds per game (32.0)

•-Frederica Haywood ranks 20th in the nation in offensive rebounds per game with 5.0 per game.

•- McNeese has three players averaging in double figures. Senior Victoria Rachal is leads the team with 16.8 ppg. Mercedes Rogers is averaging a double-double with 11.4 ppg. and 10.2 rpg. and freshman Caitlin Davis is averaging 10.2 ppg. and 4.0 apg.

•- Haywood ranks ninth in McNeese career rebounds with 564 career rebounds. She needs three to move into 8th place.

•- Head coach Kacie Cryer is the second youngest Division 1 women's head coach this season at the age of 30, second to Omaha's Brittany Lange who is five months younger than Cryer.

**Cryer Picks Up First Career Win**

First year head coach Kacie Cryer picked up her first win as a collegiate head coach on November 14 with a commanding 94-65 win over Southern-New Orleans in Lake Charles.

**Protecting The House**

McNeese ended the 2015-16 home schedule with a 12-2 record. Dating back to the 2014-15 season, McNeese is 17-3 at home for a combined 29-6 home record.

**Heywood 9th In Career Rebounds**

Junior Frederica Haywood moved into 9th place in career rebounds by grabbing three rebounds against LSU-Alexandria on Nov. 27.

**Rogers Scores Career High**

Junior Mercedes Rogers scored a career high 19 points in the 88-47 win over La. College. Rogers was 5 of 9 from the field and 8 of 10 from the free throw line. She also produced her fourth career double-double by grabbing 13 rebounds.

**Rogers Records Back-To-Back Double Doubles**

Junior Mercedes Rogers been productive on both the offense and defense, having recorded back-to-back double doubles against Louisiana College and Wiley College.

**Cowgirls Hit the Century Mark**

McNeese scored 100 points for the first time this season and for the first time since its 104-101 double overtime win over Incarnate Word in 2015 with its 100-66 win over LSU-Alexandria on Nov. 27.

**Among The Youngest In The Nation**

Head Coach Kacie Cryer is the second youngest Division 1 women’s head coach this season at the age of 30, second to Omaha’s Brittany Lange who is five months younger than Cryer.

**Cryer Makes Head Coaching Debut Against Former High School Coach**

Cryer’s collegiate head coaching debut came on Nov. 12, 2016 against Garry Brodhead, Cryer’s high school coach and a former McNeese assistant coach. The Cowgirls held the lead until early in the 4th quarter before falling 77-70.

**HEAD COACH KACIE CRYER**  
**6th Season at McNeese**  
**First as Head Coach**  
**4-1 Career Record**

Kacie Cryer, who for seven years played a big part in the success of the Cowgirls' basketball program and one of the youngest head coaches in the nation was promoted to head coach in April.

"Kacie is known as a rising star among assistant coaches across the U.S. and she has a passion for women's collegiate athletics," said Hemphill. "She has the unique perspective of both a collegiate student-athlete and a Division I assistant coach. She is an excellent recruiter and was instrumental in bringing in all of the Cowgirl recruits for the past seven years.

"She cares deeply for her players' welfare as athletes and students and I know she will carry on the tradition of community and university service that has become a trademark of Cowgirl Basketball.

"Kacie has a tremendous work ethic and the tenacity to quickly make this team her own."

Cryer plans on continuing the success the Cowgirl program has had. "I will work extremely hard to get this program to a higher level."

A native of Abbeville and one of the rising young coaches in the business, Cryer began her coaching career at McNeese back in 2008 as a graduate assistant and has spent the last five seasons as the program's recruiting coordinator. In those five years as the head of recruiting, the Cowgirls won a total of 103 games, an average of 20 wins a season.

In addition to her recruiting duties, Cryer has coached both the guard and post positions during her tenure at McNeese, developing standout players such as Cecilia Okoye, Allison Baggett and Jayln Johnson.

After taking a year off from coaching basketball following the 2010 season, Cryer returned to the McNeese bench for the 2011-12 slate to help guide the Cowgirls to their second consecutive Southland Conference Tournament championship and NCAA Tournament appearance.

A year later the Cowgirls began their streak of four straight Women's Basketball Invitational appearances, and in 2013, advanced to the championship game.

In 2013, Cryer played a major part in the Cowgirls' run to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) game in Detroit. McNeese has participated in the WBI the last four years.

Under Cryer's recruiting leadership, the Cowgirls have signed eight players out of high school that have played on state championship teams, seven state tournament MVP's (Louisiana, Texas, Mississippi), 18 All-State high school players, six All-State MVP's, nine Louisiana All-Star game participants, two Texas Girlz Prep Report Terrific 20

players, and one Greater Area Houston All-Star game MVP.

As a player, Cryer spent her collegiate career at LSU-Shreveport from 2004-08 where she earned her bachelors degree in general studies and her masters degree from McNeese in 2012.

The Teurlings Catholic High product was a member of the 2002 state championship team and was selected to the first team all-district and all-parish teams.

Cryer has been around sports her entire life having been raised under a coaching tree. She is the daughter of Charlie and Kristie Cryer. Her father is the head football coach at St. Louis Catholic High School in Lake Charles. She has two brothers, Cody, who is a former member of the McNeese men's golf team, is attending chiropractor school lives in Houston, Texas with his wife Christy, and younger brother Chris, is a football coach at St. Louis Catholic High.
