THE AMERICAN TODAY

East Carolina returns home on Monday hosting in-state foe Presbyterian at Minges Coliseum in the lone American game of the day. The Pirates posted a 2-1 mark at the Savannah Invitational last week and recorded wins over Marist and Ball State. Bre McDonald was named to the all-tournament team for her efforts. The redshirt senior averaged 17.1 points and 6.0 rebounds during the three-day event.

UConn remains at No. 2 in the latest AP poll while USF is one spot out of the Top 25 with 51 points.

Feyonda Fitzgerald (Temple) and Kitija Laksa (USF) are first in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage and 3-point field goals made, respectively. Laksa paced the Bulls in a 3-0 week that included wins over North Carolina and Georgia in the Junkanoo Jam. The sophomore earned Tournament MVP honors after scoring 34 points in both games against the Tar Heels and the Bulldogs. Temple, who defeated Quinnipiac in its last time out on Sunday, returns to action on Thursday with a matchup at Harvard.

UCF went 2-0 at the UCF Thanksgiving Invitational and improved to 6-1 on the year after defeating Rider and Austin Peay, while NR/RV Tulane closed out play at the UTSA Classic with an undefeated 2-0 mark. Kolby Morgan scored a season high 22 points Sunday vs. UTSA, including 12 points in the 3rd quarter.

Dishing it Out

Tulane senior Leslie Vorpahl dished out 15 assists in the Green Wave's season-opening win over Grambling State on Nov. 12. She set a new program single-game assist mark and a new American record with the output.

Home Court Advantage

Through Tuesday, Nov. 22, UConn has won 51 straight home games. Their overall win streak is 79 games. The streak sits only behind the team record of 90 straight set from 2008-10 and the UCLA men's record of 88 consecutive victories.

Block Party

As a freshman, SMU's Alicia Froling recorded 54 blocks, surpassing Sarah Davis' mark of 53 blocks during the 2005-06 season. After breaking a record that stood for nine seasons, the Australian's name stayed at the top of the list for only one year. Fellow Australian and sophomore Stephanie Collins posted 73 blocks in her first full season. Collins enters the 2016-17 campaign with 98 career blocks, while Froling has 99. The duo would become the first pair of teammates of the same class to each record 100 blocks in program history.

Nurse Named to Nancy Lieberman Watch List

UConn junior Kia Nurse was named to the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Watch List on Oct. 25. The award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

Stiff Non-Conference Action Awaits American Teams

USF will play in the inaugural Play4Kay Tournament in Las Vegas in December. The field includes 2016 Final Four participant Oregon State. The Bulls will also host Louisville at the Sun Dome in late January.

Memphis' non-conference schedule features SEC, Big Ten and Big 12 members Illinois, Kansas, Arkansas and Vanderbilt. The Tigers play host the Commodores at Elma Roane Fieldhouse in late December.

UConn's non-conference slate includes 10 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. The Huskies will again play in the prestigious Jimmy V Classic, this time vs. Texas at Mohegan Sun Arena, home of the 2017 American Women's Basketball Championship.

Tulane will face SEC foes Vanderbilt, LSU and Mississippi State this year, and will host ACC member NC State in mid-December.

International Competition

Houston, Memphis and Tulsa each participated in foreign tours this summer. The Cougars played exhibition games in Costa Rica while the Tigers traveled to four different cities (Madrid, Toledo, Valencia, Barcelona) during their 10-day foreign tour of Spain. Tulsa traveled to Dominican Republic in August and played exhibition games against the Dominican National Team.
