2. Kolby Morgan made the week three AAC Honor Roll list averaging 20.5 points and 6.0 rebounds at a 2-0 week at the UTSA Classic.
3. Meredith Schulte registered her first career double-double in the win at UTSA, earning 10 points and 10 rebounds.
4. Senior Leslie Vorpahl set a new single-game program record with her 15 assists vs Grambling in the season opener. Her 7.0 assists per game ranks 11th in the nation.
5. Tulane has won six straight at home, dating back to the end of last season.

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of



528-255 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 465-228 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.

During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

• Tulane improved to 4-1 on the season after a 2-0 weekend at the UTSA Classic. The Green Wave defeated Eastern Michigan, 62-50, followed by a 75-66 win over UTSA.

• Tulane trails the all-time series against McNeese State, 10-12, with an 8-4 record at home.

• However, the Green Wave have won eight straight in the series.

SCOUTING THE COWGIRLS

• Victoria Rachal leads the team with 16.8 ppg on .431 shooting from the field.

• Mercedes Rogers averages a double-double with 11.4 points and 10.2 rebounds per game.

• McNeese State enters Wednesday's encounter with a 4-1 record, defeating the likes of Southern New Orleans, Louisiana College, Wiley College and LSU-Alexandria.

• The Cowgirls are averaging 84.8 ppg on 40.9 percent shooting from the field. Also average 51.6 rebounds and 22.4 forced turnovers.

UTSA ALL-CLASSIC TEAM

Both Kolby Morgan and Leslie Vorpahl were selected to the UTSA All-Classic Team, spearheading the Wave's 2-0 holiday weekend in San Antonio. Morgan averaged 20.5 points and 6.0 rebounds on the trip, while Vorpahl averaged 11.5 points and 6.0 assists.

FLY THE DUB

Sophomore Meredith Schulte registered her first career double-double in the 75-66 win at UTSA on Nov. 27, recording 10 points and 10 rebounds. It also marked the first Tulane double-double on the year and the team's first double-digit rebounding performance as well.

Speaking of rebounding, Schulte has led the squad on the boards the past two games, averaging 9.0 rebounds in that span.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

Tulane got a much needed boost from two particular members of its bench in its 75-66 win on the road at UTSA. Trailing 55-53 early in the fourth quarter, a Shakira Harding three-pointer kick started a 12-2 Tulane run. Ultimately, Harding scored all seven on her points in the final quarter.

In addition, Caylah Cruickshank broke through, scoring a career best 8 points in a career high 18 minutes.

UTSA wasn't the first time Harding shone off the bench. Previously, the senior recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

Overall, Tulane is now averaging 18.6 ppg from its bench.

PICKING YOUR SHOTS

After their first three games, Tulane was ranked No. 1 in the nation in shooting percentage, knocking down 54.4 percent of their shots. Despite a 2-0 weekend at the UTSA Classic, Tulane's ranking dropped to 25th in the country at .472, which also ranks 2nd in the AAC.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl made history in Tulane's season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

After five games, Vorpahl's 7.0 assists per game ranks 11th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. In addition, Vorpahl's 35 total assists ranks 30th in the country.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse, the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 2-0 at home. In those two games, the Wave averaged 82.5 ppg with a +21.0 scoring margin, shooting 57.0 percent from the field. Meanwhile, the Wave defense forced 24.0 turnovers per game.

In addition, Tulane currently boasts a six-game win streak at Fogelman in Devlin, dating back to the end of last season. The last time Tulane won 10 straight at home dates back to January of 2003.

FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

Tulane is making the most of its chances from the free-throw line, as its .787 free-throw percentage ranks 18th in the nation and third in The American. In fact, the Wave utilized its free-throw prowess against UTSA, converting 21-of-24 to take down the Roadrunners, 75-66.

Senior Courtnie Latham continues to impress from the charity stripe, converting 10-of-11 as her .909 percentage ranks 4th in the league. Last season, Latham only missed 12 free throws (64-76), as her .842 shooting percentage ranked as the ninth best in program history

LATHAM BREAKS LOOSE

Latham put her signature on the win vs Southern Miss, scoring 17 points on a career high seven made field goals. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

THOMPSON TOUGH ON THE BOARDS

Sophomore Tene Thompson is co-leading the team in rebounding coming off the bench, averaging 4.8 boards per game. Furthermore, Thompson's 4.2 defensive rebounds per game ranks 15th in the AAC.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Leslie Vorpahl and Courtnie Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

Speaking of Morgan, the junior is now averaging 2.8 steals per game which ranks 4th in the league and 59th in the nation.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game high 20 points.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered Wednesday's contest averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting.

Miss State did prevail with the 66-49 victory on Wednesday, but keep in mind two factors: Tulane only had its senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl for only six minutes in the first half due to early foul trouble, and Preseason First-Team All-Conference selection Kolby Morgan was held to a career low one-point and left early in the second half.

All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Sophomore Meredith Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.
