### News & Notes

- St. John's plays away from home for the fifth time out of the last six games when it meets Tulane on Friday at Avron B. Fogelman Arena. The Red Storm's last true road contest was on Nov. 18 when the Johnnies poured in 86 points at Minnesota.
- The Red Storm leads the BIG EAST and ranks 10th in the nation averaging 7.0 blocks per game. Sophomore Kassoum Yakwe is coming off a career-high seven block performance against Delaware State on Tuesday. The 6-foot-7 forward ranks seventh in the nation averaging 3.7 blocks per game.
- St. John's is one of the youngest teams in the nation and has only one player with more than two years of Division I experience. First-year Johnnies Marcus LoVett (18.9 ppg), Shamorie Ponds (15.3 ppg) and Bashir Ahmed (11.6 ppg) have combined for 61 percent of the team's scoring through seven games this season.
- The Johnnies return home after Tulane to play their next four games in New York City, beginning with a pair at Carnesecca Arena in Queens against Cal State Northridge and Fordham. St. John's then heads to Barclays Center for a matchup with LIU Brooklyn in the BROOKLYN HOOPS Winter Festival followed by its debut at Madison Square Garden versus Penn State.
- St. John's had four players finish in double-figures for the third time this season Tuesday versus Delaware State. Bashir Ahmed had a team-high 19 points on 7-for-12 shooting including four 3-pointers.

#### Overview

St. John's meets Tulane for the fourth time in program history. The Red Storm rolled to an 82-57 victory in its last meeting with the Green Wave on Dec. 28, 2014 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn. Sir'Dominic Pointer led St. John's with 24 points and seven steals while D'Angelo Harrison added 21 points. The first matchup was on March 20, 1992 in the NCAA Tournament First Round in Atlanta. Friday's contest marks the first meeting between St. John's and Tulane in New Orleans.

#### Coaches

Chris Mullin is in his second year as head coach at St. John's. He was named the 20th coach in program history on April 1, 2015. Mullin returned to his alma mater with nearly a decade of NBA front office experience in the Golden State Warriors and Sacramento Kings organizations. Mullin is the only current Division I coach to be inducted into the Hall of Fame as a player. Mike Dunleavy, Sr. is in his first season leading Tulane. It is his 18th season as a head coach and first at the collegiate level. Dunleavy spent 17-years as a head coach in the NBA for the Los Angeles Lakers, Milwaukee Bucks, Portland Trailblazers and Los Angeles Clippers. The Brooklyn native owns a 651-749 record as a head coach in the NBA.

## Last Time Out

Delaware State 79, St. John's 72

November 29, 2016

Carnesecca Arena - Queens, N.Y.

Delaware State made 58 percent of its shots from the floor overall and 53 percent of its attempts from beyond the three-point arc, defeating St. John's, 79-72, at Carnesecca Arena on Tuesday.

Bashir Ahmed led the Red Storm with a career-high 19 points on 7-of-12 shooting to go along with seven rebounds. Three other members of the Red Storm reached double figures, led by Shamorie Ponds with 15 points, nine rebounds, four assists and four steals. Marcus LoVett tallied double-figures for the seventh-straight game with 13 points, while Federico Mussini added 11.

Kassoum Yakwe, the BIG EAST's leader in blocked shots, tied a career-high with seven rejections against the Hornets, while also scoring seven points, dishing out three assists and pulling down four rebounds.

The Hornets nailed 64 percent shot attempts in the first half and carried a 38-34 advantage into halftime.

Delaware State maintained its advantage the entire second half as Devin Morgan poured in 19 of his game-high 26 points in the stanza. Morgan led three Hornets who finished with double-figures. DeVaughn Mallory added 16 points on 8-for-13 shooting and Kavon Waller had 15 points hitting 6-of-9 shot attempts.

## Five Things To Know

- ① The Johnnies are back on the road after making a brief stop in Queens to host Delaware State, which came on the heels of a four game stretch away from home. Friday's contest with Tulane will be the Red Storm's second game in a true road venue this season. Before playing three games in three days against stiff competition at The Battle 4 Atlantis, St. John's young roster got its first taste of a true road venue when it visited Minnesota two weeks ago for the Gavitt Tipoff Games. Behind 54 combined points from first-year guards Marcus LoVett (31) and Shamorie Ponds (23), the Red Storm exploded for its second highest point total of the season finishing with 86 points against the Golden Gophers. Ponds nailed five of the team's 11 3-pointers while Bashir Ahmed recorded his first career double-double (15 points, 10 rebounds).
- ② Prior to its recent five-game slide, St. John's showcased a high octane offense that produced two wins in its first three contests. The Red Storm averaged 87.7 points by shooting 46.2 percent from the field and nailed 11 triples in each of the first three games. The all freshman backcourt of Marcus LoVett and Shamorie Ponds led the way combining for 41.6 points in their first three collegiate games. However, the Red Storm's most efficient performance of the year came in the season opener when sophomore guard Federico Mussini led a balanced scoring attack with a game-high 20 points off the bench to upend Bethune-Cookman, 100-53. St. John's shot a season-best 62.3 percent from the field and forced 18 turnovers.
- ③ Forming one of the nation's premier young backcourt duos alongside LoVett, Shamorie Ponds has also enjoyed a successful beginning to his career in Queens. The Preseason BIG EAST Freshman of the Year ranks second on the squad with 15.3 points per game, eclipsing the 20-point plateau on a pair of occasions and recording his first career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds against Binghamton on Nov. 14. Despite standing at just 6-foot-1 and weighing in at 170 pounds, Ponds is the team's leading rebounder this season, pulling down 6.1 boards per game. The Brooklyn native also tops the team in steals with 10 on the campaign and has dished out 17 assists.
- ④ After leading the BIG EAST and ranking 16th in the nation in blocks per game last season, Kassoum Yakwe has picked up right where he left off in 2016-17, topping the BIG EAST and ranking seventh in the NCAA with 3.7 rejections per outing. The sophomore from Bamako, Mali, has recorded five or more blocks in a game three times this season, including a career-high seven rejections against Delaware State on Tuesday.
- ⑤ Despite a noticeable infusion of talent for the 2016-17 season, the Red Storm remains one of the nation's most inexperienced teams. According KenPom.com, the Johnnies rank 350 out of 351 Division I teams in terms of experience, averaging just 0.75 years of Division I experience per player on their roster. Over the squad's last five games, the Red Storm has consistently started two freshmen, a junior college transfer and a pair of sophomores. Only one player on the squad, Amar Alibegovic is in his third year playing Division I basketball.

## Scouting Tulane

- Tulane returns home to Avron B. Fogelman Arena for the first time since defeating Southeastern Louisiana, 93-76, on Nov. 14. The Green Wave is coming off a two-game road stretch falling at Georgia Tech and to local foe New Orleans.



- The Green Wave dropped all three games in four days at the Tire Pros Invitational in Orlando prior to its recent two game road trip. Tulane suffered losses to Oklahoma, Arizona State and Missouri.
- Despite a game-high 18-point performance by Kain Harris and 17 points from Malik Morgan on Tuesday, Tulane dropped its fifth-straight game with a 74-59 loss at New Orleans. They combined to shoot 14-of-25 (.560) from the field and 5-of-9 (.556) beyond the 3-point arc.
- Cameron Reynolds leads Tulane averaging 16.4 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. He has drained a team-high 21 3-pointers and started all seven games this season.
- Kain Harris (12.7 ppg) and Malik Morgan (10.4 ppg) are also averaging double-figures.
- Tulane has been outrebounded by a 7.0 rebounding margin this season. The Green Wave has allowed 80.4 points per game while team's have shot 47.5 percent from the field.

# CHRIS MULLIN

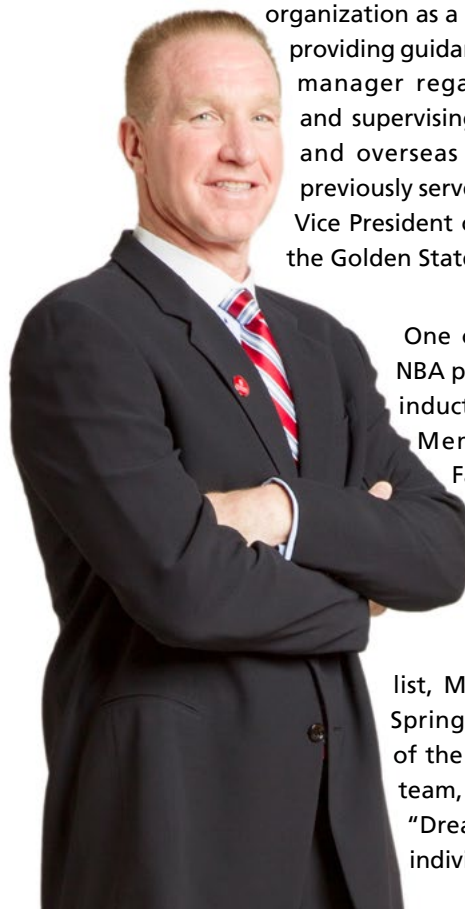
Head Coach • Second Season At St. John's



Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer Chris Mullin is in his second season as head men's basketball coach at his alma mater.

Thirty years after leading St. John's to the highest point in program history with an appearance in the 1985 Final Four, the longtime NBA star and front office executive was named the 20th head coach in the University's storied men's basketball history on April 1, 2015.

With nearly a decade of NBA front office experience, Mullin spent two seasons working for the Sacramento Kings organization as a senior advisor from 2013-15, providing guidance to the owner and general manager regarding player transactions and supervising the organization's college and overseas scouting program. Mullin previously served five years as the Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations for the Golden State Warriors.



One of the great collegiate and NBA players of all time, Mullin was inducted into both the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2011. A two-time gold medalist who ranks seventh all-time on the USA Basketball Olympic scoring list, Mullin was first enshrined in Springfield in 2010 as a member of the 1992 United States Olympic team, also known as the original "Dream Team." He was the ninth individual affiliated with St. John's

basketball program to be inducted into the national hall.

The most-decorated player in program history, Mullin is St. John's all-time scoring leader with 2,440 career points, starring at the University from 1981-85 under Hall of Fame Head Coach Lou Carnesecca. Mullin gave New York a four-year period to rival any other, leading St. John's to four-straight NCAA Tournaments. He was a two-time All American who also garnered consensus First Team All-America honors as a senior.

Mullin is the only player in conference history to be named BIG EAST Player of the Year three times (1983-85). He is also just one of three players to win the Haggerty Award three times, an honor bestowed upon the best collegiate player in New York City. A member of the 1984 United States Olympic team, Mullin took home his first gold at the 1984 Games in Los Angeles.

In his final season at St. John's, Mullin averaged 19.8 points to lead the program to its second Final Four and its first No. 1 ranking since 1951. Mullin received the John R. Wooden Award at the conclusion of the 1984-85 campaign as the nation's top player. He was also named the Player of the Year by both United Press International and the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.

Mullin not only was the first St. John's player to reach 2,000 points, but he set career records for steals, field goals, and was top five in assists. He still holds St. John's career free-throw percentage and free-throws made records (84.7 pct, 682-of-805), and ranks in the top 10 in program history for 17 different statistical categories.

St. John's conferred Legacy Honors upon Mullin in 2005, permanently enshrining his No. 20 above Carnesecca Arena and at Madison Square Garden during St. John's home games. Mullin was also inducted into the St. John's Athletics Hall of Fame as a member of the Class of 2015.

Selected by the Golden State Warriors with the seventh-overall pick in the 1985 NBA Draft, Mullin spent 13 years of his 16-season NBA career with the organization. He became the sixth player in franchise history to have his jersey number retired when his No. 17 was hoisted to the rafters of Golden State's Oracle Arena on March 19, 2012.

Mullin scored 17,911 points over his career playing for the Golden State Warriors (1985-97, 2000-01) and Indiana Pacers (1997-2000). Mullin guided Golden State to five playoff appearances, and is joined by fellow Hall of Famer Wilt Chamberlain as the only two Warriors to average 25.0 points per game in five-straight seasons (1988-93).

Mullin was a five-time NBA All-Star for the Warriors (1989-93) and garnered All-NBA honors four times, including a selection to the All-NBA First Team in 1992. He averaged 18.2 points per game throughout his career while shooting 50.9 percent from the field and 86.5 percent from the free-throw line. Mullin still holds several Warriors franchise records including games played (807) and steals (1,360), and is fourth on the team's career scoring list.

Following his NBA playing career, Mullin worked in the Warriors' front office from 2002-09 and was named Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations on April 22, 2004. In this role, Mullin oversaw day-to-day operations, including college and international scouting, salary cap management and preparations for the NBA Draft. Mullin served as an NBA analyst for ESPN and ESPN radio for three years before joining the Sacramento Kings' front office on September 5, 2013 as Advisor to the Chairman.

One of New York City's greatest players, Mullin is among the most recognizable figures in the history of Big Apple basketball. The lefty from Brooklyn began his high school career at Power Memorial before starring at Xaverian for his final two years. Mullin led Xaverian on a run to a New York State Championship in 1981 and was named New York State's "Mr. Basketball" and a McDonald's All American that same year.

Born and raised in the Flatlands section of Brooklyn, Mullin and his wife, Liz, who is an alumna of St. John's, have four children, Sean, Christopher, Liam and Kiera.
