TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 529-258 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 466-231 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- Turnovers plagued the Green Wave last Sunday, committing 30 all-together in which LSU converted into 37 points, as the Tigers prevailed with the 69-51 victory.

- Morgan was the lone Tulane player in double-figures with 11 points.

- LSU also took advantage of getting to the free-throw line, sinking 21-of-30 compared to Tulane's 8-of-10.

SERIES HISTORY - NC STATE

- Saturday marks just the third ever meeting between the two programs as each team as claimed a victory on their home court.

- NC State took the first ever meeting in Raleigh, 69-55, in Nov. of 2013. Tulane then retaliated with a 60-51 victory in New Orleans in Nov. of 2014.

- In the 2014 meeting in New Orleans, the game featured 13 lead changes and four ties as Kolby Morgan led with 15 points.

SCOUTING THE WOLFPACK

- NC State enters the contest with a 9-2 record and the winners of four straight. Their lone losses came at the hands of Kansas State (67-50) and a familiar foe in LSU (59-58).

- Saturday marks the Wolfpack's first true road game.

- NC State is averaging 76.3 ppg while shooting 44.1 percent from the field and 35.1 percent from beyond the arc. They also boast a +7.5 rebounding margin and +4.5 turnover margin.

- Miah Spencer and Jennifer Mathurin average double-digit points for the Wolfpack at 11.1 and 10.2, respectively. Spencer is connecting on an impressive 50.7 percent of her shots, including 47.6 percent from three-point range.

- Chelsea Nelson leads the rebounding effort at 5.7 boards per game to go along with her 9.7 ppg.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

WHO'S HOT

Morgan was named to the week five American Honor Roll list after averaging 22.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals in two games this past week. Latham also averaged double figures in the two-game stretch at 11.0 ppg, shooting a combined 9-for-15 from the field.

TURNOVER TREACHERY

30 turnovers did Tulane in on Dec. 11 at LSU, as the Tigers secured 21 steals and converted that into 37 points en route to their 69-51 win. It marked the first time in program history an opponent recorded 20+ steals against Tulane, and it also marked the most turnovers since Jan. 18, 2014.

STOPPING THE STREAK

When Tulane hosts NC State on Saturday, they will be looking to end its current three-game losing streak. The last time the Wave had a three-game skid dates back to the conclusion of the 2013-14 season when they dropped four straight.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse, the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 3-0 at home. In fact, the Olive and Blue are averaging 82.3 ppg at home, with a +19.7 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 56.6 percent from the field and 39.5 percent from three-point range. Defensively, Tulane is forcing 22.7 turnovers per game.

Individually, Morgan is averaging 22.7 ppg at home, up from her 17.2 season average. Meanwhile, Schulte is shooting a prolific 73.7 percent at home, averaging 12.3 ppg.

In addition, Tulane currently boasts a seven-game win streak at Fogelman in Devlin, dating back to the end of last season. The last time Tulane won 10 straight at home dates back to January of 2003.

MORE FROM MORGAN

Just two days after being held scoreless by Middle Tennessee for the first time of her career, Morgan erupted with a career high 34 points at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5. Morgan made eight of her first 11 shots, before setting a new career high in made field goals at 14-of-26 for the night. The junior also tied her career best of five made three-pointers, finishing 5-of-9 from beyond the arc. Morgan's 34 points were just two points shy of cracking Tulane's all-time single-game top-10 list.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Vorpahl is averaging 6.9 assists per game, which ranks 13th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. Furthermore, Vorpahl's 62 total assists ranks 14th in the country.

Vorpahl made history in the season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Most recently, Vorpahl dished out 12 assists at

Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, marking her 6th double-digit assist game of her career.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME CHARTS

Morgan, who became the first player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons, now sits at 1,157 career points, which ranks 15th all-time. Next up is No. 14 Sherri Fuqua at 1,189 points followed by No. 13 Teana McKiver at 1,204 points.

In addition, Vorpahl's 419 career assists just surpassed Sarah Goree (418) for the No. 5 spot all-time. Up next is No. 4 Susan Owens with 429 assists.

PICKING YOUR SHOTS

Despite their recent troubles, Tulane's shooting percentage still ranks amongst the best in the country, as the Wave's .455 shooting mark ranks 36th nationally and second in The American.

Both Morgan and Schulte each rank in the top-15 in the league in field goal percentage. Schulte ranks 13th, connecting on 46.6 percent of her shots, while Morgan ranks 15th at .463.

THE EMPIRE STRIKES BACK

A year after going 3-0 against SEC competition, the SEC has struck back, as member institutions are responsible for three of Tulane's four losses this season: No. 5 Miss State, (RV) Vanderbilt and LSU.

DOUBLE TROUBLE ON THE BOARDS

After garnering just four rebounds through the first three games, Wyatt has since raised her rebounding average from 1.3 to 5.1. In the last six games, Wyatt has garnered at least five rebounds in each, averaging 7.0 boards in that span. In addition, the sophomore recorded her first double-digit rebounding performance of the season at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, nearly earning a double-double with eight points and 10 rebounds.

Meanwhile, Schulte has led the team in rebounding in five of the past six games, as her 4.4 rebounding average ranks second on the team, behind Wyatt.

AN EYE ON THE RPI

After facing two straight opponents with top-40 RPI rankings, the grind continues this weekend vs NC State, who enters with a RPI of No. 56. Then, lurking ahead at the Tulane Classic is either Auburn or Drake who currently sit in the top-50 as well.

PROTECTING THE LEAD

The Green Wave are 5-1 when possessing the lead at the end of the first quarter and 4-1 when leading at the half and at the start the fourth quarter. The lone exception came at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, when Tulane was up 20-12 at the end of the first, up 33-26 at half, and up 45-44 at the start of the fourth, before losing 74-63.

MORE KEYS TO VICTORY

Tulane, who is averaging 67.3 ppg, is a perfect 4-0 when they reach the 70-point marker in games this season.

In addition, the Wave are 5-1 when they attempt more free-throws than its opponent, compared to 0-3 when the opponent shoots more.

SCHULTE'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Meredith Schulte registered her first career double-double in the 75-66 win at UTSA on Nov. 27, recording 10 points and 10 rebounds. The performance still stands as the lone Tulane double-double on the year.

FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

Latham has sunk 14 straight free-throws, as her .933 free-throw percentage (14-of-15) leads the squad. Last season, Latham only missed 12 free throws (64-76), as her .842 shooting percentage ranked as the ninth best in program history

PAINTING THE PICTURESQUE WIN

In Tulane's 82-65 win over McNeese State on Nov. 30, the Green Wave tallied 50 points in the paint. That total marked the most points in the paint in over three seasons for the Wave.

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

Tulane got a much needed boost from two particular members of its bench in its 75-66 win on the road at UTSA. Trailing 55-53 early in the fourth quarter, a Shakira Harding three-pointer kick started a 12-2 Tulane run. Ultimately, Harding scored all seven of her points in the final quarter.

In addition, Caylah Cruickshank broke through, scoring a career best 8 points in a career high 18 minutes.

UTSA wasn't the first time Harding shone off the bench. Previously, the senior recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

LATHAM BREAKS LOOSE

Latham dropped 17 points on a career high seven made field goals vs Southern Miss on Nov. 20. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

Latham now boasts three double-digit scoring performances on the season, most recently netting 14 points at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

Furthermore, Morgan is now averaging 2.4 steals per game which ranks 4th in the league and 77th in the nation.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game and season high 20 points.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.
