THE AMERICAN TODAY

Cincinnati wraps up a three-game homestand hosting Tennessee Tech while USF travels to Indiana for a contest at Butler to highlight Friday action around The American.

The Bearcats are 2-0 against the Golden Eagles in games played at Cincinnati including an 86-70 victory on Jan. 21, 2007. The Bearcats made a season-best 10 3-points in Tuesday's win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff during their last time out. The Bulls, meanwhile, will take its first true road trip of the season when they face the Bulldogs at Hinkle Fieldhouse. USF and Butler will meet for the 3rd time in program history and the Bulls hold a 2-0 advantage in the overall series. The Bulls defeated in-state rival FIU in its last time out on Wednesday behind a team record 16 3-pointers. Laia Flores dished out 17 assists in the matchup and set a new American single-game record in the process.

The 2017 Naismith Trophy watch list was announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club this week and four UConn players - Napheesa Collier, Kia Nurse, Katie Lou Samuelson and Gabby Williams - were named to the list. The midseason list of 30 will be announced on Feb. 8, 2017. Nurse received another honor this week after being named to the 2017 Wade Watch List on Thursday. The Wade Trophy, now in its 40th year, is the oldest and most prestigious national player of the year award in college women's basketball.

UConn remains at No. 2 in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches Polls while USF is one spot out of the Top 25 in both polls. Temple and Tulane are receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

East Carolina redshirt junior Gabrielle Holston is a candidate for the 2017 WBCA Good Works Team®, the Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced on Wednesday. The award, now in its fifth season, recognizes players at all levels of college basketball whose charitable involvement and altruistic acts stand out amongst all other student-athletes participating in the sport.

Four from The American named to Naismith Watch List

The 2017 Naismith Trophy watch list was announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club on Nov. 30, and four UConn players - Napheesa Collier, Kia Nurse, Katie Lou Samuelson and Gabby Williams - were named to the list. The midseason list of 30 will be announced on Feb. 8, 2017.

Nurse Named to Wade Trophy, Nancy Lieberman Watch Lists

UConn junior Kia Nurse was named to the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Watch List on Oct. 25. The award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit the floor leadership, play-making and ball handling skills of Hall of Famer Nancy Lieberman.

Adding to her list of accolades, Nurse was named to the 2017 Wade Watch List on Dec. 1. The Wade Trophy, now in its 40th year, is the oldest and most prestigious national player of the year award in college women's basketball.

Dishing it Out

USF junior Laia Flores set a new American single-game record with 17 assists in the Bulls' win over FIU on Nov. 30. Earlier in the season, Tulane senior Leslie Vorpahl dished out 15 assists in the Green Wave's win over Grambling State on Nov. 12. She set a new program single-game assist record with the output.

Home Court Advantage

Through Thursday, Nov. 1, UConn has won 53 straight home games. Their overall win streak is 81 games. The streak sits only behind the team record of 90 straight set from 2008-10 and the UCLA men's record of 88 consecutive victories.

Block Party

As a freshman, SMU's Alicia Froling recorded 54 blocks, surpassing Sarah Davis' mark of 53 blocks during the 2005-06 season. After breaking a record that stood for nine seasons, the Australian's name stayed at the top of the list for only one year. Fellow Australian and sophomore Stephanie Collins posted 73 blocks in her first full season. Collins entered the 2016-17 campaign with 98 career blocks, while Froling has 99. The duo would become the first pair of teammates of the same class to each record 100 blocks in program history.

Welcome to The American

The American welcomes two new coaches to the conference in Katie Abrahamson-Henderson (UCF) and Travis Mays (SMU).

Stiff Non-Conference Action Awaits American Teams

USF will play in the inaugural Play4Kay Tournament in Las Vegas in December. The field includes 2016 Final Four participant Oregon State. The Bulls will also host Louisville at the Sun Dome in late January.

Memphis' non-conference schedule features SEC, Big Ten and Big 12 members Illinois, Kansas, Arkansas and Vanderbilt. The Tigers play host the Commodores at Elma Roane Fieldhouse in late December.

UConn's non-conference slate includes 10 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. The Huskies will again play in the prestigious Jimmy V Classic, this time vs. Texas at Mohegan Sun Arena, home of the 2017 American Women's Basketball Championship.

Tulane will face SEC foes Vanderbilt, LSU and Mississippi State this year, and will host ACC member NC State in mid-December.

International Competition

Houston, Memphis and Tulsa each participated in foreign tours this summer. The Cougars played exhibition games in Costa Rica while the Tigers traveled to four different cities (Madrid, Toledo, Valencia, Barcelona) during their 10-day foreign tour of Spain. Tulsa traveled to Dominican Republic in August and played exhibition games against the Dominican National Team.

The information will be available from the conference office via release as well as on the league web site.

Annual Awards

The American Athletic Conference will name all-conference teams and individual honors for the league's Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, Coach of the Year, Most Improved Player of the Year, Sportsmanship Award and Sixth Player of the Year. The awards are chosen by a vote of the league's 11 head coaches at the conclusion of the regular season and will be announced in conjunction with the Conference Championship.

The American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team is comprised of players who have an overall grade-point average of 3.00 or better over the previous academic year and completed at least two semesters of academic work. Basketball honorees are announced in the summer.

The American Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year was established to recognize student-athletes who have achieved success in the classroom and on the court. The winner receives a scholarship which may be applied to graduate or professional studies.
