TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 532-258 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 469-231 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

• Morgan paved the way with 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including 4-for-6 from three, as Tulane edged out Auburn 61-59. Vorpahl also finished in double figures with 10 points and six assists.

• Leading only 52-51 with 4:08 remaining, both Schulte and Vorpahl connected on clutch three-pointers, setting up the Wave defense to clinch the victory.

• Tulane out-rebounded its opponent, 34-27.

SERIES HISTORY - MAINE

• Wednesday marks the third ever meeting between the two programs.

• The two first met in Maine back in Dec. of 1987, where the Black Bears took it, 65-57. Maine then competed in the Tulane Classic in Dec. of 1998, where the Wave claimed victory, 85-76

SCOUTING THE BLACK BEARS

• Maine enters the contest 7-6 on the season. Three of their losses came to ranked opponents: No. 10 Mississippi State, No. 3 South Carolina and No. 11 Miami.

• Maine attempts over 20 three-pointers per game, which ranks 34th in the country.

• Maine averages 57.6 ppg while allowing 59.3. The Black Bears shoot 40.4 percent from the field but suffer from a -5.2 rebounding margin.

• Sigi Koizar is the lone player who averages double-figures at 14.2 ppg. Koizar ranks 37th in the nation in free-throw percentage (.875).

• Tanesha Sutton leads the rebounding effort at 5.5 boards per game to go with her 7.5 ppg.

WHO'S HOT

After being held scoreless for the first time of her career, Morgan has since caught fire, averaging 21.0 ppg over the past five games. Morgan has shot 45.6 percent from the field & 51.4 percent from three-point range (19-37). Furthermore, the junior has averaged 3.8 made three-pointers in that span as well.

Lastly, Morgan has been named to The American's weekly Honor Roll list for three straight weeks.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse, the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 6-0 at home. In fact, the Olive and Blue are averaging 72.3 ppg at home, with a +13.0 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 48.3 percent from the field and 36.4 percent from three-point range. Defensively, Tulane is forcing 19.8 turnovers per game.

Individually, Morgan is averaging 21.3 ppg at home, up from her 17.9 season average. In addition, Morgan (.506), Schulte (.515), Latham (.538) and Wyatt (.552) are all shooting above 50 percent at home.

Last but certainly not least, Tulane currently boasts a 10-game win streak at Fogelman in Devlin, dating back to the end of last season. The last time Tulane won at least 10 straight at home dates back to January of 2003 when they won 12 in a row.

1,000-POINT CLUB

Senior Leslie Vorpahl is within striking distance on becoming the 28th member of Tulane's 1,000 career point club. Vorpahl currently sits at 993 career points and is averaging 10.5 points per game this season.

AN EYE ON THE RPI

According to NCAA RPI rankings, Tulane sat at No. 106 as of Dec. 12. Now, with their current three-game win streak and wins over NC State and Auburn, the Green Wave have jumped all the way up to No. 53.

The Olive and Blue will have ample opportunities to continue to increase the ranking, squaring off with No. 72 Maine, No. 96 ECU, No. 39 USF, No. 56 Temple and No. 67 SMU, in said order.

MORGAN'S TREYMENDOUS MONTH

In the last three games, Morgan has been prolific from beyond the arc, averaging 4.3 made three-pointers in that span. As a result, the junior has raised her three-point field goal percentage from .348 to .420, which ranks fifth in The American and 60th in the country. In addition, Morgan's now 2.4 made three-pointers per game ranks fourth in the AAC.

TULANE CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the ninth straight year and 17th time overall, the Green Wave were Tulane Classic champions. The Wave first bested Eastern Washington, 63-51, before edging out Auburn, 61-59.

Morgan was named MVP of the tournament after averaging 16.5 ppg and 6.0 rebounds. Vorpahl was named to the All-Tournament team after netting 11.0 ppg and 7.0 assists.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

After prevailing with the 61-59 victory over Auburn, Tulane improved to 3-1 this season in games decided by 10 points or less. The Wave previously dispatched NC State, 63-58, and UTSA, 75-66. The lone exception came at Middle Tennessee, 62-59.

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

During the non-conference season, Tulane has received a much needed boost from its bench in several key instances.

Sophomore Tene Thompson recorded a career day in the Wave's 61-59 win over Auburn, producing highs in points (9), made field goals (4) and minutes (22).

Junior Caylah Cruickshank provided the spark in the 63-58 win over NC State. Cruickshank tied her career high of eight points, all of which came in the fourth quarter, including two clutch three-pointers. It did not mark the first time Cruickshank provided a lift off the bench, as the junior first tallied her career high of eight points in the 75-66 UTSA win back on Nov. 27.

Speaking of bench play, senior Shakira Harding scored all seven of her points in the final quarter at UTSA, proving critical as well. In addition, Harding previously recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Harlyn Wyatt secured her first career double-double in the Wave's 63-51 win over Eastern Washington on Dec. 21. Wyatt earned career highs in points (14), field goals (6), assists (2) and minutes (38), while tying her season high of 10 rebounds.

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME CHARTS

Morgan, who became the first player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons, now sits at 1,217 career points, which ranks 13th all-time. Next up:

No. 12 Danielle Blagg (2011-15) - 1,232
No. 11 Mary Ann Marino (1992-97) - 1,234
No. 10 Christy Thomaskutty (1992-96) - 1,331

Next, Vorpahl's 437 career assists just surpassed Susan Owens' 429 for the No. 4 spot. Up next is No. 3 Olivia Grayson at 499.

BATTLE ON THE BOARDS

After a rough start of the year rebounding wise, Tulane has 'rebounded' in the month of December. The Wave have out-rebounded its opposition in four of the past five games, improving its average from 33.6 to 35.7, and its rebounding margin from -4.7 to -1.2.

FOURTH QUARTER HEROICS

Trailing by as much as 13 points in the third quarter and by seven to kick-off the fourth, Tulane rallied by outscoring NC State 28-16 in the final period. Morgan (10), Vorpahl (9) and Cruickshank (8) combined for 27 of those points, shooting 60.0 percent from the field in the fourth. The come-from-behind win stopped the Wave's first three-game losing streak in three seasons.

MORE FROM MORGAN

Just two days after being held scoreless by Middle Tennessee for the first time of her career, Morgan erupted with a career high 34 points at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5. Morgan made eight of her first 11 shots, before setting a new career high in made field goals at 14-of-26 for the night. Morgan's 34 points were just two

points shy of cracking Tulane's all-time single-game top-10 list.

Two games later vs NC State on Dec. 17, Morgan led the charge again with 27 points, connecting on a career high 6-of-8 from beyond the arc.

Lastly, Morgan's 17.9 ppg ranks 56th in the nation and 5th in The American.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Vorpahl is averaging 6.7 assists per game, which ranks 16th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. Furthermore, Vorpahl's 80 total assists ranks 13th in the country.

Vorpahl made history in the season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Vorpahl, who later dished out 12 assists at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, is now up to six double-digit assist games in her career.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

BOARDING SCHOOL

Schulte has led the team in rebounding in seven of the past nine games. The sophomore also leads the squad in defensive rebounds at 3.8 per game.

Schulte recently tied her career high of 10 rebounds vs NC State on Dec. 17.

Earlier, at UTSA on Nov. 27, Schulte recorded 10 points and 10 rebounds, marking her first career double-double.

MONKEY OFF THE BACK

Tulane faced four SEC member institutions this non-conference season and three of them were responsible for three of Tulane's four losses: No. 5 Miss State, (RV) Vanderbilt and LSU.

Tulane enacted some revenge on Dec. 22 in the form of a 61-59 victory over Auburn.

PROTECTING THE LEAD

The Green Wave are 6-1 when possessing the lead at the end of the first quarter, at the half, and at the start of the fourth quarter. The lone exception exception came at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, when Tulane was up 20-12 at the end of the first, up 33-26 at half, and up 45-44 at the start of the fourth, before losing 74-63.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

PAINTING THE PICTURESQUE WIN

In Tulane's 82-65 win over McNeese State on Nov. 30, the Green Wave tallied 50 points in the paint. That total marked the most points in the paint in over three seasons for the Wave.

LATHAM BROKE LOOSE

Latham dropped 17 points on a career high seven made field goals vs Southern Miss on Nov. 20. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

Latham now boasts four double-digit scoring performances on the season, most recently netting 10 points vs Eastern Washington on Dec. 21.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

Furthermore, Morgan is now averaging 2.2 steals per game which ranks 6th in the league.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game and season high 20 points.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered the match-up against Tulane averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting. All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.
