TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 529-256 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 466-229 during her time at Tulane, including a 210-130 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tulane dropped a 62-59 contest at Middle Tennessee this past Saturday.

Trailing by as much as 14 points in the second half, Tulane rallied to cut the deficit to just one point in the final minutes. The Wave even had a shot to tie with 11 seconds remaining, but couldn't connect.

- Leslie Vorpahl led with 16 points, followed by 13 points from Meredith Schulte.

SERIES HISTORY - VANDERBILT

SCOUTING THE COMMODORES

Vanderbilt is off to a hot 7-1 start to the season, with their lone loss coming at the hands of Indiana, 94-61. Vandy's most notable win was a 77-73 victory over Duke.

Rebekah Dahlman paces Vandy at 14.5 ppg, connecting on 52.4 percent of her shots, including 60.9 percent from three-point range.

Rachel Bell (12.1 ppg) and Christa Reed (10.3) also average double-digit points for Vanderbilt.

Cierra Walker led Vandy to its 73-63 win over SIUE on Saturday, scoring 21 points behind five made three-pointers.

WHO'S HOT

Sophomore Meredith Schulte has reached double-digit points in three straight games, averaging 12.0 ppg in that span. In fact, Schulte recorded her first career double-double at UTSA on Nov. 27, collecting 10 points and 10 rebounds.

Overall, Schulte has started the season shooting a hot 50.0 percent from the field (24-of-48), including a 36.8 percent mark from three-point range.

PROTECTING THE LEAD

The Green Wave are 5-0 thus far when possessing the lead at the end of the first quarter. Tulane also boasts a 4-0 record when leading at the half and a 4-0 mark when ahead to start the fourth quarter.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

PICKING YOUR SHOTS

After their first three games, Tulane was ranked No. 1 in the nation in shooting percentage. Despite a 2-0 weekend at the UTSA Classic, Tulane's ranking dropped to No. 25 in the country, but has since risen to its current spot at No. 15. Tulane is shooting 48.1 percent from the floor, which also ranks second in The American.

Two of Tulane's starters are shooting at least 50 percent from the field. Vorpahl is knocking down 50.8 percent of her shots, which ranks 8th in the AAC, while Schulte sits at 50.0 percent, which is tied for 9th.

FINISHING STRONG

Tulane has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in all but one of its games this season, with Mississippi State being the lone exception (19-17). The Wave are averaging 21.3 points in the final quarter compared to their opponents' 15.4 points, good for a +5.9 scoring margin.

VS THE SEC

The Olive and Blue went 3-0 against SEC competition last season, defeating LSU, Ole Miss and Alabama, with the latter occurring in the first round of the WNIT. The Wave have already faced a SEC opponent this season in then ranked No. 10/9 Mississippi State, falling 66-49 to the Bulldogs in Biloxi.

FLY THE DUB

Sophomore Meredith Schulte registered her first career double-double in the 75-66 win at UTSA on Nov. 27, recording 10 points and 10 rebounds. It also marked the first Tulane double-double on the year and the team's first double-digit rebounding performance as well.

Speaking of rebounding, Schulte has led the squad on the boards the past three games, averaging 7.0 rebounds in that span.

FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

Senior Courtnie Latham continues to impress from the charity stripe, converting 12 straight to earn a .923 free-throw percentage. Last season, Latham only missed 12 free throws (64-76), as her .842 shooting percentage ranked as the ninth best in program history

PAINTING THE PICTURESQUE WIN

In Tulane's 82-65 win over McNeese State on Nov. 30, the Green Wave tallied 50 points in the paint. That total marked the most points in the paint in over three seasons for the Wave.

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

Tulane got a much needed boost from two particular members of its bench in its 75-66 win on the road at UTSA. Trailing 55-53 early in the fourth quarter, a Shakira Harding three-pointer kick started a 12-2 Tulane run. Ultimately, Harding scored all seven of her points in the

final quarter.

In addition, Caylah Cruickshank broke through, scoring a career best 8 points in a career high 18 minutes.

UTSA wasn't the first time Harding shone off the bench. Previously, the senior recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl made history in Tulane's season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

After five games, Vorpahl's 6.9 assists per game ranks 14th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. In addition, Vorpahl's 48 total assists ranks 15th in the country.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

Speaking of the record books, Vorpahl's 405

career assists ranks sixth all-time in program history. Next up is No. 5 Sarah Goree at 418 career assists.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse, the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 3-0 at home. In fact, the Olive and Blue are averaging 82.3 ppg at home, with a +19.7 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 56.6 percent from the field and 39.5 percent from three-point range. Defensively, Tulane is forcing 22.7 turnovers per game.

In addition, Tulane currently boasts a seven-game win streak at Fogelman in Devlin, dating back to the end of last season. The last time Tulane won 10 straight at home dates back to January of 2003.

THOMPSON TOUGH ON THE BOARDS

Sophomore Tene Thompson is leading the team in defensive rebounds, despite coming off the bench, averaging 4.2 per game. Thompson also ranks second on the team in rebounding at 4.6 per game.

LATHAM BREAKS LOOSE

Speaking of Latham, the senior put her signature on the win vs Southern Miss, scoring 17 points on a career high seven made field goals. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

Furthermore, Morgan is now averaging 2.7 steals per game which ranks 5th in the league and 70th in the nation.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game high 20 points.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Sophomore Meredith Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered the match-up against Tulane averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting.

Miss State did prevail with the 66-49 victory, but keep in mind two factors: Tulane only had its senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl for only six minutes in the first half due to early foul trouble, and Preseason First-Team All-Conference selection Kolby Morgan was held to a career low one-point and left early in the second half.

All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise and acknowledgment when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.
