#WF vs TUL AT A GLANCE

THE MATCH-UP

- Wake Forest opens the 2016 season on Thursday, September 1, as the Demon Deacons play host to Tulane at BB&T Field.
- Kickoff is set for 7:00 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN3. Taylor Zarcour and former Wake Forest head coach Al Groh are on the call.
- Thursday's game can also be heard on the Wake Forest Sports Network. Stan Cotten and Tommy Elrod have the call with Dave Goren reporting from the sideline.

WAKE FOREST STORYLINES

- Wake Forest enters its third season under head coach David Clawson after a 3-9 season in 2015.
- Junior tight end Cam Serigne was named to the Mackey Award preseason watch list, presented annually to the top tight end in the country.
- John Wolford was named the team's starting quarterback at the end of fall camp. A starter in each of the last two seasons, Wolford has started 22 career games and has 3,828 career passing yards.
- The Demon Deacons welcome 29 freshmen to their roster, with six members enrolling early to participate in spring practice.
- Freshman Cade Carney is expected to be the first true freshman running back for Wake Forest in at least the past 65 years.

THE OPPOSITION & SERIES HISTORY

- Tulane is led by first-year head coach Willie Fritz, and the two programs are meeting for the first time in 21 years.
- Tulane leads the all-time series 2-0, with the teams meeting in 1995 and 1959.
- Thursday is the first time the teams will meet at Wake Forest, as each of the first two meetings took place in New Orleans.
- The Green Wave finished 2015 with a 3-9 record and a 1-7 mark in AAC play.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Wake Forest hits the road for its first road contest of the season as it travels to Durham, North Carolina, to take on Duke on September 10.
- The game, the first ACC league game for both teams, is set for a 3:30 p.m. kickoff and will be broadcast on ESPN3.

INTERVIEWS & POLICIES

Weekly Press Conference

Wake Forest's weekly press conference begins each Tuesday at 11 a.m. in the Miller Center on campus. Selected players are available first to the electronic media in the Team Meeting Room on the first floor. The players will then meet the print media in the Rovere Room immediately following. Lunch will then be served and Dave Clawson will meet with the media at 11:45 a.m. in the team meeting room followed by lunch with the print media in the Rovere Room. Any specific player requests must be made before noon on Monday. Quotes and video of the press conference will be posted on WakeForestSports.com.

ACC Weekly Teleconference

Dave Clawson participates in the ACC's weekly teleconference every Wednesday at 12:00 p.m. For the media access number, contact the ACC Media Relations Office or the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. The teleconference is archived online at theACC.com.

Wake Forest typically conducts its practices on campus at the Doc Martin Practice Complex adjacent to the Pruitt Football Center. Coach Clawson is available in person most days of the week and players are available Tuesday and Wednesday after practice.

The Dave Clawson Show

Coach Clawson's weekly radio show with the Voice of the Deacons, Stan Cotten, airs on the Wake Forest IMG Sports Network and online at WakeForestSports.com. The show will be held live on location at Bib's Downtown through Oct. 10 and then held at the IMG College studios in downtown Winston-Salem.

Coach Clawson Interviews

Aside from the previously mentioned Tuesday press conference, Wednesday teleconference and radio show, Dave Clawson is available for phone interviews on Thursday afternoons between 3-4 p.m. and by appointment only. Please schedule those with the Athletic Communications Office.

Player Interviews

Players are available at Tuesday's weekly press conference and after practice Tuesday and Wednesday. Phone interviews will be scheduled on an individual basis, contingent on class schedules. Please schedule those with the Athletic Communications Office.

PERMANENT CAPTAINS

- Wake Forest elected five permanent captains for the 2016 season following spring practice and were voted on by the players.
- The defensive captains include senior LB Marquel Lee, senior S Ryan Janvion and junior DE Wendell Dunn.
- The offensive captains include junior TE Cam Serigne and senior OG Tyler Hayworth.

SERIGNE AMONG NATION'S TOP TIGHT ENDS

- Junior tight end Cam Serigne was named to the Mackey Award preseason watch list. The Mackey Award is presented yearly to the top tight end in the country.
- Serigne has more receptions over the last two years than any tight end in the nation.
- Over the 2014 and 2015 seasons, Serigne has caught 100 passes (54 in '14, 46 in '15).
- Over the last two years, Florida International's Jonnu Smith is second with 97 receptions. Smith leads all active FBS tight ends with 136 career receptions.
- Serigne is second nationally among tight ends with 100 career catches.
- The junior has a catch in 24 consecutive games (every game he has played).

RECORD-SETTING FRESHMEN

- Both Chuck Wade and Tabari Hines broke Wake Forest's previous record for receptions in a season by a true freshman last year.
- Wade finished the year with 33 receptions, the fourth-highest total on the team. Hines was just behind him with 32 catches.
- The previous record of 24 had been set by Desmond Clark in 1995.

CLAWSON YEAR 3

- Head coach Dave Clawson enters Year 3 at Wake Forest, his fourth stop as a head coach.
- In his three previous stops at Fordham (1999-2003), Richmond (2004-07) and Bowling Green (2009-13), Clawson's teams averaged 3.25 wins in his first year and 4.25 wins in his second year.
- Year 3 has seen Clawson's teams average 6.0 wins in those three seasons.
- Fordham improved to 7-4 in 2001 after he inherited a 4-7 team the year before he arrived.
- Clawson's 2005 Richmond team went 6-5. He had inherited a 2-9 squad in 2003.
- Bowling Green was 5-7 in 2011 in his third year as head coach.

FRESHMAN RECEPTIONS

- During the 2015 regular season, Wake Forest and TCU tied for the national lead with 131 receptions among freshmen players.
- Wake Forest was led by redshirt freshman Cortez Lewis' 47 catches, 33 by Chuck Wade and 32 by Tabari Hines.
- Tyler Bell had 18 catches out of the backfield while Alex Bachman added one reception.

CLAWSON AIMING FOR 100

- Head coach Dave Clawson is closing in on his 100th career victory.
- Clawson won 29 games at Fordham, 29 at Richmond and 32 at Bowling Green.
- His six wins at Wake Forest give him a total of 96 entering the 2016 campaign.

JANVION CAREER TACKLES

- Senior safety Ryan Janvion enters his senior season with 282 career tackles.
- Janvion ranks 21st in school history in career tackles.
- The Miami, Florida native had 95 tackles as a freshman, 115 as a sophomore and 72 as a junior.
- Wake Forest's school record for career tackles is 460 by LB Ed Stetz (1969-71).
- Janvion needs 44 tackles to reach 10th place in career tackles which is currently held by Brandon Chubb (2012-15) with 326.

2016 WAKE FOREST FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

WAKE FOREST HAD NATION'S MOST IMPROVED OFFENSE IN 2015

- Wake Forest led the nation in percentage of improvement in total offense and rushing in 2015.
- Wake Forest averaged just 36.9 yards rushing per game in 2014.
- The Deacons improved that to 105.2 yards per game in 2015.
- The 65.3 yards per game jump over 2014 was an increase of 163.7 percent.
- South Florida was second nationally with a 128.5 percent increase.
- The Deacons averaged 216 yards of total offense in 2014.
- In 2015, Wake Forest averaged 333.4 yards of total offense per game.
- Wake Forest had the nation's largest improvement with a 54 percent increase in total offense over 2014.
- South Florida was second nationally with a 44.9 percent increase.

WHAT THE MEDIA SAYS

- Kirk Herbstreit of ESPN picks Wake Forest as one of his five surprise bowl teams for 2016.

TRUE FROSH STARTERS

- True freshman Cade Carney, a January enrollee, is expected to start at tailback for the Deacons.
- Carney would be the first true freshman to start his first game on campus at running back in at least 65 years of recorded Demon Deacon history.
- Research back to 1950 has not discovered a true freshman running back who started their very first game after arriving on campus.

TOTAL OFFENSE GAINS

- Wake Forest finished the 2015 season with 4,001 total offense yards.
- It marked the first time since 2011 that the Deacons surpassed the 4,000 yard mark.

100 PERCENT RETURNS

- Wake Forest returns 100 percent of its rushing yards from 2015.
- The Deacons return 99.3 percent of their passing yards.
- Graduated WR K.J. Brent had one completion for 19 yards in 2015.
- Wake Forest returns 76.4 percent of its receiving yards.
- The most significant receiving loss is Brent, who had 583 yards.

FRESHMEN RUSHING CORPS

- Wake Forest's top three rushers in 2015 were true freshmen.
- The Deacons were the only team in FBS whose top three rushers were all true freshmen.
- UMass was led by a true freshmen and two of its top three rushers were true freshmen.
- Syracuse's top two rushers were true freshmen and four of the top eight were rookies.
- RB Tyler Bell led the Deacons with 451 yards rushing on a team-high 129 carries.
- QB Kendall Hinton was second on the club with 390 yards on 93 carries.
- RB Matt Colburn finished third with 239 yards on 66 carries.
- A pair of sophomores were the fourth and fifth leading rushers.
- RB Isaiah Robinson had 120 yards on 39 carries.
- QB John Wolford netted 67 rushing yards on the season.
- When QB Kendall Hinton ran for 101 yards vs. Army, it was the first time in 36 games that WF had a 100-yard rusher.
- It was the longest streak of games without a 100-yard rusher since records began in 1949.

NON-CONFERENCE COLOR RUN

- Wake Forest's three home non-conference opponents are the Green Wave of Tulane, the Blue Hens of Delaware, and the Black Knights of Army West Point.
- In addition, the Deacons will open ACC play in Durham against the Duke Blue Devils.
- Wake Forest's first home ACC game will be against the Orange of Syracuse.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

- Wake Forest lost four games by eight points or fewer in 2015.
- 31-24 vs. Indiana (Sept. 26)
- 24-16 vs Florida State (Oct. 3)
- 20-19 vs Louisville (Oct. 30)
- 27-21 vs Duke (Nov. 28)

EXPERIENCED OFFENSIVE LINE

- In 2015, Wake Forest entered the season with just 58 career starts on the offensive line.
- Those were spread among Dylan Intemann (30), Josh Harris (12), Ty Hayworth (9), A'Lique Terry (7).
- In 2016, Wake Forest will start the season with 78 career starts: Harris (25), Hayworth (21), Justin Herron (12), Phil Haynes (9), Terry (7), Ryan Anderson (4).

10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY

- The 2016 season marks the 10 year anniversary of Wake Forest's 2006 ACC Championship.
- In 2006, the Demon Deacons were selected to finish last in the ACC Atlantic before shocking the league with a 6-2 finish in ACC play.
- Wake Forest opened the season 9-1, which included a 21-14 upset victory over Boston College and a 30-0 win at Florida State.
- In the ACC title game, Sam Swank connected on a trio of field goal attempts to lead the No. 16 Demon Deacons past No. 23 Georgia Tech, 9-6.
- Swank would go on to earn MVP honors in the game and send Wake Forest to the Orange Bowl.

FOUR-H CLUB

- Wake Forest could start as many as four offensive linemen whose last name starts with H.
- C Josh Harris, OG Ty Hayworth, OT Justin Herron and OG Phil Haynes are all returning starters.
- Other offensive H's that are expected to see playing time on offense include QB Kendall Hinton and WR Tabari Hines.
- CB Amari Henderson is the only "H" on defense.

WAKE FOREST 13TH IN YARDS RETURNING

- According to Phil Steele, Wake Forest returns 90.16 percent of its offense, making it the 13th-most experienced team in FBS.
- Steele's experience is determined by adding rushing yards, passing yards and receiving yards returning and subtracting last year's totals.
- Wake ranks 45th on defense with 67.94 percent of tackles returning

CH-CH-CH-CHANGES

- Tabari Hines has switched his jersey number from 6 to 1 this season. It marks the first time a Deacon has worn No. 1 since Chris McCoy (1998-2000).
- Other number changes include WR Chuck Wade from 89 to 9; DT Willie Yarbary from 92 to 48; LB Jaboree Williams from 39 to 6; PK Mike Weaver from 18 to 7; WR Alex Bachman from 87 to 17; DE Rashawn Shaw from 90 to 49; Steven Claude from 14 to 81.

BB&T MILESTONES

- Wake Forest's next home victory will be the 120th since BB&T Field opened in 1968.

OVER 7 MILLION SERVED

- Wake Forest will be playing its 49th season in BB&T Field in 2016.
- In those 49 years, the Deacons have drawn a total of 6,829,352 fans to the stadium.
- With seven home games, the Deacons need only 170,648 fans to reach 7 million.

TOUGH SCHEDULE IN 2015

- Wake Forest played four teams that finished in the top 10 of the College Football Playoff rankings in 2015.
- The Deacons played at No. 8 Notre Dame, No. 10 North Carolina and hosted No. 9 Florida State and No. 1 Clemson.
- Georgia Tech is the only other ACC schools to have played

four top-10 teams in 2015.

- The Yellow Jackets played at Notre Dame and Clemson and hosted North Carolina and Florida State.

STAFF ADDITION

- Clark Lea joined the staff in February of 2016 as an assistant coach in charge of the linebackers.
- Lea spent the past three seasons at Syracuse as a linebackers coach.
- Prior to his arrival at Syracuse, Lea spent the 2012 season on Dave Clawson's staff at Bowling Green.
- The 2012 defense was ranked seventh nationally in passing defense, ninth in scoring defense, and sixth in third-down defense.
- The Selma, Alabama, native has also spent time at UCLA and South Dakota State.

CLASS BREAKDOWN

- Wake Forest features a roster of 46 freshman (29 true, 17 redshirt), 26 sophomores (nine true, 17 redshirt), 22 juniors (seven true, 15 redshirt) and 13 seniors (seven true, six redshirt).
- A total of 11 true and redshirt freshman appear on the offensive and defensive two deep, while an additional two appear on the special teams two deep.

PRESEASON POLL

- Wake Forest was selected to finish seventh in the Atlantic Division in the preseason poll, as voted on by the media.
- The Demon Deacons garnered 347 total points.
- The ACC Sports Journal predicts the Deacons to go 4-8 overall and 2-6 in the ACC.
- ESPN, Sporting News and Phil Steele all pick Wake Forest to finish sixth in the Atlantic Division.
- Athlon predicts a 6-6 overall record, 3-5 in the ACC and a fifth place finish.

TURNOVER MARGIN

- Wake Forest finished 119th in the nation in turnover margin at -1.08 per game in 2015.
- Wake Forest was a school-record minus-13 in turnover margin in 2015.
- The Deacons lost six fumbles and threw 18 interceptions for -24 turnovers.
- The defense recovered five fumbles, intercepted six passes for +11 turnovers.
- The six interceptions gained in a year equals the second fewest in program history. Wake Forest intercepted six passes in 2015 and 2014 while registering five in 1962.
- In Wake Forest's last seven bowl seasons, the Deacons had a minimum of +6 turnover margin.
- In 2015, 80 FBS teams earned bowl/postseason berths.
- 60 of those 80 teams had a 0 or positive turnover margin.

Wake Forest was forced to settle for a field goal after being stopped on three consecutive running plays from the Tulane 4-yard line to get on the board in the second quarter. After two Green Waves touchdowns in the third and fourth quarters, a late 95-yard drive set up a Marlon Estes 7-yard TD reception from LaRue for the final score of the game.

2012: Wake Forest erased a 14-7 third quarter deficit en route to a 20-17 season-opening win over Liberty. A.J. Marshall returned an interception 39 yards to tie the game late in the third quarter. Wake Forest went ahead for good on a 2-yard score by DeAndre Martin that was set up by a 28-yard Tanner Price toss to Tommy Bohanon.

2005: Wake Forest trailed Vanderbilt 17-6 and battled back to take a 20-17 lead before the Commodores scored the game-winner late in the fourth quarter to claim a 24-20 win over the Deacons at BB&T Field. Micah Andrews powered his way to 254 yards on the ground while Vandy quarterback Jay Cutler threw for 278 yards and a touchdown.

2001: Tarence Williams ran for 158 yards and a touchdown as Wake Forest beat East Carolina 21-19 in its first game under head coach Jim Grobe. The Deacons went with a no-huddle offense and caught ECU off-guard early. Ed Kargbo-Okorogie intercepted a David Garrard pass to set up Williams' touchdown run that staked the Deacons to a 12-0 lead. After ECU pulled to 15-13 in the third quarter, Anthony Young hit Jax Landfried with a 44-yard scoring pass. ECU scored with 3:48 to play in the game to close to 21-19 but Garrard was stopped on a run up the middle on the 2-point conversion.

The improvement in the Wake Forest football program in 2015 was noticeable in nearly every facet of the program. The Deacon offense and defense both improved in the NCAA statistical rankings with the defense ranking 38th in total defense.

And for a second consecutive year, the Deacons brought in a recruiting class that will fill a number of needs.

For head coach Dave Clawson, the 2016 season is already well underway. From the addition of McCreary Field House, one of the nation's top indoor practice facilities, and an expanded weight room, Clawson and the Deacons are moving full speed into 2016.

Known for his prowess in building programs, Clawson has shown dramatic improvement at every stop including a noticeable increase in Year Three. The 2016 season marks Clawson's third year with the Demon Deacons.

On December 10, 2013, Clawson became the 32nd head football coach in Wake Forest University history. The head coach at Bowling Green State University from 2009 through 2013, Clawson led the Falcons to the 2013 Mid-American Conference championship with a 47-27 win over No. 16 Northern Illinois.

"This is a special day for Wake Forest University," said Director of Athletics Ron Wellman in making the announcement. "Dave Clawson is a special person and a special football coach. He has proven himself to be a leader and a winner. I had the opportunity to watch his team play a number of games this year and I know our fans will be excited about the brand of football that Dave brings to the Demon Deacons."

Clawson joined the Demon Deacons after five seasons as the head coach at BGSU in Bowling Green, Ohio. He built the Falcons to be explosive both offensively and defensively. The 2013 Bowling Green team ranked 29th in the nation in total offense and tenth in total defense. In 2012, BGSU was ranked sixth in the nation in total defense and 10th nationally in scoring defense, yielding just 16.8 points per game. The Falcons were one of only two non-power conference teams to rank in the top 30 statistically in both total offense and total defense in 2013.

Bowling Green's 2013 team went 10-3 overall under Clawson and won the MAC East title with a 7-1 record. The Falcons received a bid to the Little Caesar's Bowl in Detroit. It marked the third bowl appearance in five seasons for Clawson's team.

In his 16 years as a head coach, Clawson has delivered a conference championship at every stop. Prior to the 2013 Mid-American Conference title at Bowling Green, Clawson helped Richmond to a pair of Colonial Athletic Association titles in 2005 and 2007. His first championship as a head coach came in 2002 when he led Fordham to the Patriot League title.

He has also earned numerous Coach of the Year Awards. He was the Patriot League Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2002 and was awarded the 2005 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year award in just his second year in the league. The 2007 CAA Coach of the Year award marked his fourth conference Coach of the Year honor in his first nine years as a head coach.

In 2002, Clawson was the Schutt Sports/American Football Monthly I-AA Coach of the Year and a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award. In 2005, Clawson earned National Coach of the Year from I-AA.org and was again a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award.

A 1989 graduate of Williams College in Massachusetts, Clawson earned a degree in political economy. A native of

Youngstown, NY, Clawson was a defensive back for Williams and went on to serve as a graduate assistant coach at Albany in 1989 and 1990. He moved to Buffalo for the 1991 and 1992 seasons, tutoring the secondary his first year and the quarterbacks and running backs his second.

In 1993, Clawson was named the running backs coach at Lehigh and helped the Mountain Hawks to a 7-4 record and the Patriot League championship. He was promoted to offensive coordinator in 1994 and spent two years in that role, adding another Patriot League title in 1995. Lehigh won a pair of Patriot League titles in his three years and his offense led the league in scoring, total offense and pass offense in each of his final two seasons.

Villanova hired Clawson as offensive coordinator in 1996 and his offense helped the Wildcats to NCAA FCS appearances in 1996 and 1997. During his tenure at Villanova, Clawson's offense established 70 program records, held the No. 1 ranking in the nation for six weeks in 1997 and won the 1997 Atlantic 10 championship. He tutored Brian Westbrook who became the first player in college football history to gain 1,000 yards both rushing and receiving.

Following the 1998 season, Clawson became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when he was named head coach at Fordham. Inheriting a team that had won just 22 games in the previous 10 years, Clawson turned the Rams into the Patriot League champions in his fourth season at the helm. He was the Patriot League Coach of the Year in both 2001 and 2002. Clawson helped the Rams 2002 FCS Playoffs where they defeated fourth seed Northeastern in the opening round before falling to Villanova.

Clawson was named the head coach at Richmond prior to the 2004 season. He guided the Spiders to the biggest two-year turnaround in school history, improving from 3-8 in 2004 to 9-4 in 2005. In 2007, his final year with the Spiders, Clawson guided Richmond to an 11-3 record, the Colonial South title and the FCS national semifinals.

He left Richmond in 2008 to replace David Cutcliffe as the offensive coordinator under Phillip Fulmer at Tennessee. Following that season, Clawson was named the head coach at Bowling Green in time for the 2009 season.

Clawson and his wife, Catherine, are the parents of two children, Courtney and Eric.

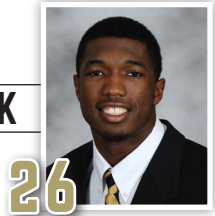

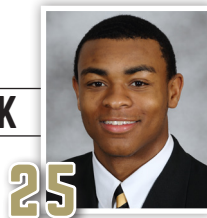
