Tulane Women's Basketball Season Outlook

Big things lie ahead for next season's edition of the Tulane women's basketball team as they'll look to build upon a 2015-16 campaign which witnessed the Green Wave achieve their seventh straight trip to the postseason (reached WNIT Round of 16), seventh straight 20+ win campaign (23-12) and second straight appearance in the American Athletic Conference Tournament semifinals.

Last season's Green Wave team went 2-1 vs ACC competition and a perfect 3-0 vs the SEC, as the latter included the Wave's continued trend of in-state dominance, claiming their fifth victory against LSU in the past six years. Tulane was also quite dominant at home (14-3) as their 14 wins tied the program record for most inside The Fieldhouse. Tulane also proved tough in close games, compiling a 9-3 record in contests decided by 10-points or less, which stood as the best record in the league in said scenario. Adding to the above sentiments, Tulane returns a seasoned squad of nine returnees including the following trio of guards that not only started all 35 games last year, but also all played significant minutes on the 2014-15 team that reached the NCAA Tournament: junior Kolby Morgan and seniors Leslie Vorpahl and Courtnie Latham.

Morgan will return as the league's top scorer, averaging 17.2 points per game last season. The Second Team All-Conference selection made program history last year, becoming the first Green Wave player to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons. Furthermore, the league's top returning scorer will be joined by the league's top assist contributor in Vorpahl, whose 5.4 assists per game ranked 35th in the nation. Vorpahl was named Third Team All-Conference and the AAC's Most Improved Player, tacking on 10.7 ppg as well. Together, the Tulane duo sparked the Green Wave's assault from beyond the arc, each ranking in the league's top-10 in three-point field goals made.

This season's non-conference schedule features six home games, including four straight from Dec. 17-28. In that late December stretch, Tulane could potentially play three schools in last year's RPI Top-60, which includes NC State, NCAA Tournament participant Auburn and America East runner-up Maine. Conference schedule wise, all four of Tulane's fellow post-season participants will compete in The Fieldhouse, as Memphis, Temple, NCAA Tournament second round finisher USF and four-time defending champion UConn all have dates in New Orleans.

Lastly, Tulane moves to a 16-game conference schedule this year, in which they'll play UCF and Tulsa just once at home and East Carolina and SMU just once on the road. Meanwhile, the Wave will play a home-and-away series with Cincinnati, UConn, Houston, Memphis, USF and Temple. In addition, 12 of the 16 league games will be televised, with eight of the games being broadcasted on either ESPN2 or ESPN3.
