TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of



534-260 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 471-233 during her time at Tulane, including a 211-132 mark in conference play.

During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- A 3-for-19 start from the field set the Green Wave back 21-7 at the end of the first quarter at Temple on Sunday. The double-digit deficit proved too much to overcome, falling, 86-71.

- Tulane shot at least 46 percent the rest of the way, trading shot-for-shot with Temple.

- Morgan scored 21 points in the second half to finish with a game high of 23. Vorpahl followed suit with 19 points. Each had five assists.

- The Olive and Blue did not shoot a free-throw in the game until 4:50 on the clock in the fourth quarter.

SERIES HISTORY - SMU

- Tulane leads the all-time series, 20-13, and have won five against the Mustangs, including the last three at Moody Coliseum.

- Last year, the Wave swept SMU in the regular season series, defeating the Mustangs at home, 76-64, and on the road, 54-42.

- In the last 10 encounters, all but one game was decided by 12 points or less.

SCOUTING THE MUSTANGS

- SMU is 10-5 overall and 1-1 in AAC play. The Mustangs defeated Cincinnati, 64-47 on Dec. 31, before dropping a 58-57 contest on the road at East Carolina.

- Alicia Froling is the only player in the conference averaging a double-double with 15.0 points per game and a league best 10.9 rebounds.

- SMU ranks third in The American in scoring defense, holding opponents to 57.3 points per game. In addition, the Mustangs lead the league in in blocks (93) and rebounds (657).

- McKenzie Adams also averages double figures at 10.6 ppg.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

MORGAN'S DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK

Just two days after being held scoreless for the first time of her career at Middle Tennessee, Morgan erupted for a career high 34 points on a career best 14 made field goals at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5. Morgan has since produced nine straight games with double-digit points, including four of 20+. In that span, Morgan has averaged 197 ppg in which her three-point shooting percentage (.450) has been higher than her field goal percentage (.441).

Furthermore, in the last game at Temple, Morgan scored 21 points in the second half alone to finish with a game high of 23 points. The junior went 8-of-12 in the half.

VORPAHL HEATING UP

Vorpahl has recorded double-digit points in six of the last seven games, averaging 14.4 points on 48.0 percent shooting. Along the way, the senior achieved the following:

- Scored 9 of her final 15 points in the fourth quarter in the win over NC State.
- Named to the Tulane Classic All-Tournament Team after wins against Eastern Washington and Auburn.
- Recorded her first double-double of the season with 11 assists and 24 points vs Maine, as the latter marked a season high.
- Became the 28th member of Tulane's 1,000 career point club.

Lastly, in the previous two games, Vorpahl has played all 40 minutes, shooting a combined 15-for-25 from the field (.600), including 5-of-8 from three, good for 35 total points.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

When looking at the last seven games, the Wave have received big contributions from its two preseason American All-Conference players in Morgan and Vorpahl. In fact, the duo have scored a combined 233 total points which represents 51.9 percent of the team's scoring in that seven-game stretch.

EYE ON THE RPI // BRACKETOLOGY

According to NCAA RPI rankings, Tulane sat at No. 106 as of Dec. 12. After a season high five-game win streak and notable wins over NC State and Auburn, the Green Wave jumped all the way up to No. 35, before dropping down to No. 40 after suffering back-to-back losses to No. 20/21 USF and (-/RV) Temple.

The Olive and Blue wrap up their gauntlet of facing six straight RPI Top-100 teams when they square off with No. 71 SMU.

TREY-MENDOUS STRETCH

After knocking down five treys at ECU, eight vs USF, and nine at Temple, Tulane's 7.3 three-pointers per game in league play ranks first in the conference, while their .361 three-point shooting percentage ranks second.

Tulane has been heating up from beyond the arc as of late, connecting on at least seven made three-pointers in five of their past seven games, including a season high of 10 vs N.C. State.

In fact, in the last six games, Tulane jumped its made three-pointer average from 5.2 to 6.2 and its three-point shooting percentage from .311 to .338.

Kolby Morgan has played a major role in the three-point surge. The junior has averaged 3.0 made three's in the last seven games, connecting on 45.7 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. She has since raised her three-point shooting percentage from .348 to .402, which ranks fifth in The American and 54th in the nation. Meanwhile, Morgan's made three-pointers average has increased from 1.8 to 2.3, which ranks fourth in the league.

STAT ANALYSIS - AMERICAN PLAY

Through three games in league play, Vorpahl is shooting 50.0 percent (16-of-32) from the field, which leads all Green Wave and ranks 10th in The American. Vorpahl is also connecting on 45.5 percent of her shots from three which ranks 7th.

Morgan's 3.3 assist-to-turnover ratio leads the league.

Wyatt's 6.3 rebounds per game ranks 10th while her 1.7 blocks per game ranks 2nd.

CAN'T BUY A FREE-THROW

Tulane, who attempted just three free-throws against No. 20/21 USF last week, only attempted nine in the game at Temple on Jan. 8. The kicker there was the fact that the Wave did not obtain its first free-throw attempt until 4:50 on the clock in the fourth quarter.

NEW STARTING FIVE

For the first time all season, a new starting five debuted at Temple on Jan. 8, as Tene Thompson replaced fellow sophomore Meredith Schulte. In American play, Thompson is averaging the third most points on the team (6.7) and second most rebounds (4.7).

FEATS AGAINST NO. 22 USF

On Jan. 4, Tulane held then No. 22 USF to a season low in points (62) and second lowest shooting percentage (.375). The Wave also held USF leading scorer Kitija Laksa, who averages 21.1 ppg, to 12 points, including just three in the second half.

IN EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl recently became the 28th member of Tulane's 1,000-career point club back on Dec. 28. Vorpahl now sits with 1,057 points in her career. On the assists side, Vorpahl currently ranks fourth on the all-time list at 465, chasing No. 3 Olivia Grayson at 499.

If Vorpahl surpasses the 500 career assist milestone, she would become just the second player in program history to achieve 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. The lone Tulane women's player to achieve the feat ---> all-time assist leader Ashley Langford (2005-09) with her 1,047 points & 722 assists.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The first month of the new year will see the Green Wave be hardened by battles away from home, as five of Tulane's seven league games in January are on the road: Temple, SMU, UConn, Cincinnati and Houston - with two home games sprinkled in between: Houston and Tulsa.

On the flip side - five of the Wave's seven games in February will be competed at home in New Orleans.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse (14), the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 7-0 at home before dropping their first contest on Jan. 4 to then No. 22 USF, 62-53. The loss also snapped the Wave's 11-game home win streak that dated back to last season, marking the longest win streak at home since 2003.

The Olive and Blue are averaging 70.5 ppg at home, with a +10.5 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 47.3 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from three-point range. Individually, Morgan & Vorpahl are averaging 20.9 ppg and 12.5 ppg at home, respectively.

BEST DEFENSIVE SHOWING

On New Year's Eve, Tulane held East Carolina to opponent season lows in points (45) and field goal percentage (.293). The Wave out-scored ECU 15-4 in the second quarter, holding the Pirates to just one field goal at 7:19 on the clock, and scoreless for the last 4:50 of the half. The Wave defense continued to smother ECU in the third, holding them to without a field goal for the final 5:34 of the quarter.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Vorpahl is averaging 6.8 assists per game, which ranks 15th in the nation and 3rd in the AAC. Furthermore, Vorpahl's 108 total assists ranks 10th in the country.

Vorpahl made history in the season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Vorpahl, who has since dished out 12 assists at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5 and 11 assists vs Maine on Dec. 28, is now up to seven double-digit assist games in her career.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

Through the first half of the season, Tulane has received a much needed boost from its bench in several key instances.

Sophomore Tene Thompson recorded a career day in the Wave's 61-59 win over Auburn, producing highs in points (9), made field goals (4) and minutes (22).

Junior Caylah Cruickshank provided the spark in the 63-58 win over NC State. Cruickshank scored all eight of her points in the fourth quarter, including two clutch three-pointers. Furthermore, it might have occurred in a loss, but Cruickshank achieved a career high nine points at Temple on Jan. 8, knocking down a pair of three's.

Speaking of bench play, senior Shakira Harding has twice scored all of her points in the second half to lend a boost to Tulane. First, Harding tallied seven of her points in the final quarter at UTSA, before chipping in eight points in the second half vs Maine. In addition, Harding previously recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

Most recently, at East Carolina on Dec. 31, Tulane's bench outscored the Pirate bench 23-6, as Kayla Manuirirangi knocked down two three's in the final 3:30 of the game to seal the 61-45 road win.

VORPAHL'S DAY TO REMEMBER

Vorpahl certainly recorded a day to remember vs Maine on Dec. 28. Needing just seven points to reach the 1,000 career point milestone, Vorpahl exploded for a season high 24 points on an impressive 7-of-8 shooting, including a perfect 3-for-3 mark from three-point range. Vorpahl's 24 points were just three shy of her career high.

Not only did Vorpahl reach a program milestone and set new season highs, but also registered her first double-double of the season, dishing out 11 assists.

TULANE CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the ninth straight year and 17th time overall, the Green Wave were Tulane Classic champions. The Wave first bested Eastern Washington, 63-51, before edging out Auburn, 61-59.

Morgan was named MVP of the tournament after averaging 16.5 ppg and 6.0 rebounds. Vorpahl was named to the All-Tournament team after netting 11.0 ppg and 7.0 assists.

WYATT'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Harlyn Wyatt secured her first career double-double in the Wave's 63-51 win over Eastern Washington on Dec. 21. Wyatt earned career highs in points (14), field goals (6), assists (2) and minutes (38), while tying her season high of 10 rebounds.

Morgan, who became the first player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons, now sits at 1,289 career points, which ranks 11th all-time. Next up:

No. 9 Terry Johnson (1978-81) - 1,358

FOURTH QUARTER HEROICS

Trailing by as much as 13 points in the third quarter and by seven to kick-off the fourth, Tulane rallied by outscoring NC State 28-16 in the final period. Morgan (10), Vorpahl (9) and Cruickshank (8) combined for 27 of those points, shooting 60.0 percent from the field in the fourth. The come-from-behind win stopped the Wave's first three-game losing streak in three seasons.

BOARDING SCHOOL

Schulte has led the team in rebounding in seven of the past 13 games. The sophomore also leads the squad in defensive rebounds at 3.5 per game. Schulte tied her career high of 10 rebounds vs NC State on Dec. 17 - her nine defensive boards in the game still stands as the high mark amongst Wave players this season. Earlier, at UTSA on Nov. 27, Schulte recorded 10 points and 10 rebounds, marking her first career double-double.

Next, in five of the past seven games Thompson has not only grabbed 5+ rebounds, but also logged 20+ minutes. Thompson ranks second on the team in offensive rebounds (1.4), and third in defensive rebounds (3.1) and rebounding average (4.5).

MONKEY OFF THE BACK

Tulane faced four SEC member institutions this non-conference season, in which three of them were responsible for Tulane losses: No. 4 Miss State, Vanderbilt and LSU.

Tulane enacted some revenge on Dec. 22 in the form of a 61-59 victory over Auburn.

PROTECTING THE LATE LEAD

The Green Wave are 8-1 when possessing the lead at the start of the fourth quarter. The lone exception exception came at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, when Tulane was up 45-44 at the start of the fourth, before losing 74-63.

PAINTING THE PICTURESQUE WIN

In Tulane's 82-65 win over McNeese State on Nov. 30, the Green Wave tallied 50 points in the paint. That total marked the most points in the paint in over three seasons for the Wave.

LATHAM BROKE LOOSE

Latham dropped 17 points on a career high seven made field goals vs Southern Miss on Nov. 20. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

Most recently, Latham notched 10 points in the first 11 minutes at ECU on Dec. 31, before finishing with 12 points. The senior now boasts five double-digit scoring performances on the season.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game and season high 20 points.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered the match-up against Tulane averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting. All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

STOCKTON SIGNS EXTENSION

Back in October, Coach Stockton signed a contract extension taking her through the 2020-21 season. Stockton has led the Wave to 17 trips to the postseason, including 11 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

STOCKTON INKS 4 TO 2017 CLASS

Three days before the season started, Coach Stockton welcomed Kaila Anderson (Baton Rouge, La.), Sierra Cheatham (Houston, Texas), Krystal Freeman (Pineville, La.) and Tatyana Lofton (Madison, Miss.) all to the Green Wave family.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.
