TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 534-260 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 471-233 during her time at Tulane, including a 211-132 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NCAAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tulane shot 60.0 percent in the first quarter, building a 40-30 halftime lead at SMU. The Mustangs narrowed the gap to 53-47 at the end of the third but Morgan & Vorpahl scored the team's first 11 of 13 points to help cruise to the 71-59 final.

- Morgan registered her second straight game with 20+ points with 21. Vorpahl netted her third straight in double-digits with 18. Schulte recorded a career high 11 rebounds. Madzarevic tied her career high of eight points.

- Tulane out-rebounded SMU, 36-33. The Mustangs were the second best rebounding team in the league at the time.

SERIES HISTORY - HOUSTON

- Tulane leads the all-time series, 26-13, and have not lost to Houston since joining The American, winners of five straight. In fact, the Wave have won by an averaging scoring margin of 19.4 points.

- Tulane has won nine of the last 10 games. Houston's lone win - a 471-70 double overtime victory in New Orleans.

- Last season, the Wave cruised to a 70-48 victory at home but narrowly escaped with a 59-56 win on the road in Houston.

SCOUTING THE COUGARS

- Houston is off to an 8-8 start overall, with a 1-2 mark in conference play. The Cougars began league play with a 71-66 win over Tulsa before falling 85-64 at Cincinnati and 62-48 at home to UCF.

- Houston boasts two players with double-digit scoring averages: Chyanne Butler (10.5) and Jasmyne Harris (10.4). Serithia Hawkins leads the rebounding effort at 7.6 boards per game to go with her 7.5 ppg.

- The Cougars rank 26th nationally in three-point field goal percentage defense at 26.7 percent. Also rank nationally in turnovers forced with their 18.9 per game landing in at No. 69.

DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK

Just two days after being held scoreless for the first time of her career at Middle Tennessee, Morgan erupted for a career high 34 points on a career best 14 made field goals at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5. Morgan has since produced 10 straight games with double-digit points, including five of 20+.

Speaking of, Morgan has produced two straight games of 20+ points, averaging 22.0 points on 44.7 percent shooting in that span.

VORPAHL HEATING UP

Vorpahl has recorded double-digit points in seven of the past eight games, including three straight. In the last three games, Vorpahl is averaging 17.7 points on 56.8 percent shooting and a prolific 60.0 (9-of-15) percent shooting from three-point range. As a result, Vorpahl has raised her scoring average from 9.9 to 12.2 ppg.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

In the last three games, Morgan and Vorpahl have combined for 110 points, which equates to 56.4 percent of the team's scoring.

AMERICAN GIRL

Vorpahl has certainly been putting her signature stamp on conference play, ranking in the top-15 in nine different categories: 15th in scoring (14.5), 9th in FG% (.500), 3rd in assists (6.3), 13th in steals (1.8), 6th in 3PT FG (2.3), 3rd in 3PT FG% (.500), 8th in A/TO ratio (1.9), 15th in D-Reb. (4.0) and 4th in minutes (37.2).

EYE ON THE RPI // BRACKETOLOGY

According to NCAA RPI rankings, Tulane sat at No. 106 as of Dec. 12. After a season high five-game win streak and notable wins over NC State and Auburn, the Green Wave jumped all the way up to No. 35, before dropping down to No. 40 after suffering back-to-back losses to No. 20/21 USF and (-/RV) Temple.

After the SMU win, the Wave are back up to No. 37.

The Wave just wrapped a stretch in which 11 of its last 13 opponents all ranked inside the RPI Top-100.

TREY-MENDOUS STRETCH

Tulane is averaging 7.3 made three-pointers per game on 36.3 percent shooting from beyond the arc in AAC play, which both rank 2nd amongst conference teams.

Tulane has been heating up from beyond the arc as of late, connecting on at least seven made three-pointers in six of their past eight

games, including a season high of 10 vs N.C. State.

In fact, in the last seven games, Tulane jumped its made three-pointer average from 5.2 to 6.2 and its three-point shooting percentage from .311 to .340.

Kolby Morgan has played a major role in the three-point surge. The junior's 2.3 three-pointers per game ranks fourth in the league, while her .390 three-point percentage ranks fifth.

In league play only, Vorpahl's 2.3 three's ranks sixth, while her .500 three-point percentage ranks third.

SECURITY CHECK

Latham is ranked No. 1 in the assist-to-turnover category in league play only, checking in her with 3.3 ratio. Latham is also averaging 3.3 assists per game in AAC play, which ranks 12th.

BOARDS OFF THE BENCH

Since coming off the bench, Schulte is averaging 8.5 rebounds, up from her 5.1 season average, including a career high 11 rebounds at SMU on Jan. 11 -- the performance marked her third double-digit rebounding effort this season and allowed the Wave to out-rebound one of the top-rebounding teams in The American, 36-33.

CAN'T BUY A FREE-THROW

Tulane, who attempted just three free-throws against USF on Jan. 4, only attempted nine in the game at Temple on Jan. 8. The kicker there was the fact that the Wave did not obtain its first free-throw attempt until 4:50 on the clock in the fourth quarter.

NEW STARTING FIVE

For the first time all season, a new starting five debuted at Temple on Jan. 8, as Tene Thompson replaced fellow sophomore Meredith Schulte. In American play, Thompson is averaging 5.5 points and 3.5 rebounds. The Wave are now 1-1 with this new line-up.

IN EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl recently became the 28th member of Tulane's 1,000-career point club back on Dec. 28. Vorpahl now sits with 1,075 points in her career. On the assists side, Vorpahl currently ranks fourth on the all-time list at 473, chasing No. 3 Olivia Grayson at 499.

If Vorpahl surpasses the 500 career assist milestone, she would become just the second player in program history to achieve 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. The lone Tulane women's player to achieve the feat ---> all-time assist leader Ashley Langford (2005-09) with her 1,047 points & 722 assists.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Vorpahl is averaging 6.8 assists per game, which ranks 13th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. Furthermore, Vorpahl's 116 total assists ranks 9th in the country.

Vorpahl made history in the season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Vorpahl, who has since dished out 12 assists at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5 and 11 assists vs Maine on Dec. 28, is now up to seven double-digit assist games in her career.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME CHARTS

Morgan, who became the first player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons, now sits at 1,310 career points, which ranks 11th all-time. Next up:

No. 10 Christy Thomaskutty (1992-96) - 1,331
No. 9 Terry Johnson (1978-81) - 1,358

FEATS AGAINST NO. 22 USF

On Jan. 4, Tulane held then No. 22 USF to a season low in points (62) and second lowest shooting percentage (.375). The Wave also held USF leading scorer Kitija Laksa, who averages 21.1 ppg, to 12 points, including just three in the second half.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The first month of the new year will see the Green Wave be hardened by battles away from home, as five of Tulane's seven league games in January are on the road: Temple, SMU, UConn, Cincinnati and Houston - with two home games sprinkled in between: Houston and Tulsa.

On the flip side - five of the Wave's seven games in February will be competed at home in New Orleans.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse (14), the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 7-0 at home before dropping their first contest on Jan. 4 to then No. 22 USF, 62-53. The loss also snapped the Wave's 11-game home win streak that dated back to last season, marking the longest win streak at home since 2003.

The Olive and Blue are averaging 70.5 ppg at home, with a +10.5 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 47.3 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from three-point range. Individually, Morgan & Vorpahl are averaging 20.9 ppg and 12.5 ppg at home, respectively.

BEST DEFENSIVE SHOWING

On New Year's Eve, Tulane held East Carolina to opponent season lows in points (45) and field goal percentage (.293). The Wave out-scored ECU 15-4 in the second quarter, holding the Pirates to just one field goal at 7:19 on the clock, and scoreless for the last 4:50 of the half. The Wave defense continued to smother ECU in the third, holding them to without a field goal for the final 5:34 of the quarter.

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

Through the first half of the season, Tulane has received a much needed boost from its bench in several key instances.

Sophomore Tene Thompson recorded a career day in the Wave's 61-59 win over Auburn, producing highs in points (9), made field goals (4) and minutes (22).

Junior Caylah Cruickshank provided the spark

in the 63-58 win over NC State. Cruickshank scored all eight of her points in the fourth quarter, including two clutch three-pointers. Furthermore, it might have occurred in a loss, but Cruickshank achieved a career high nine points at Temple on Jan. 8, knocking down a pair of three's.

Speaking of bench play, senior Shakira Harding has twice scored all of her points in the second half to lend a boost to Tulane. First, Harding tallied seven of her points in the final quarter at UTSA, before chipping in eight points in the second half vs Maine. In addition, Harding previously recorded a career day vs Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

Most recently, sophomore Ksenija Madzarevic earned her time to shine, tying her career high of eight points in the win at SMU on Jan. 11.

VORPAHL'S DAY TO REMEMBER

Vorpahl certainly recorded a day to remember vs Maine on Dec. 28. Needing just seven points to reach the 1,000 career point milestone, Vorpahl exploded for a season high 24 points on an impressive 7-of-8 shooting, including a perfect 3-for-3 mark from three-point range. Vorpahl's 24 points were just three shy of her career high.

Not only did Vorpahl reach a program milestone and set new season highs, but also registered her first double-double of the season, dishing out 11 assists.

TULANE CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the ninth straight year and 17th time overall, the Green Wave were Tulane Classic champions. The Wave first bested Eastern Washington, 63-51, before edging out Auburn, 61-59.

Morgan was named MVP of the tournament after averaging 16.5 ppg and 6.0 rebounds. Vorpahl was named to the All-Tournament team after netting 11.0 ppg and 7.0 assists.

WYATT'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Harlyn Wyatt secured her first career double-double in the Wave's 63-51 win over Eastern Washington on Dec. 21. Wyatt earned career highs in points (14), field goals (6), assists (2) and minutes (38), while tying her season high of 10 rebounds.

FOURTH QUARTER HEROICS

Trailing by as much as 13 points in the third quarter and by seven to kick-off the fourth, Tulane rallied by outscoring NC State 28-16 in the final period. Morgan (10), Vorpahl (9) and Cruickshank (8) combined for 27 of those points, shooting 60.0 percent from the field in the fourth. The come-from-behind win stopped the Wave's first three-game losing streak in three seasons.

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game and season high 20 points.

Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered the matchup against Tulane averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting. All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

STOCKTON SIGNS EXTENSION

Back in October, Coach Stockton signed a contract extension taking her through the 2020-21 season. Stockton has led the Wave to 17 trips to the postseason, including 11 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

STOCKTON INKS 4 TO 2017 CLASS

Three days before the season started, Coach Stockton welcomed Kaila Anderson (Baton Rouge, La.), Sierra Cheatham (Houston, Texas), Krystal Freeman (Pineville, La.) and Tatyana Lofton (Madison, Miss.) all to the Green Wave family.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.
