SOCIAL MEDIA

■ Fans and working media can engage with Houston Basketball on a daily basis by following the team's social media accounts. The Cougars can be found on Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat by searching for "UHCougarWBB". Each account provides regular updates on the team, including breaking news, behind-the-scenes pictures, infographics, videos and more.

CREDENTIALS

■ All requests for working press, radio, television, photography or scouting credentials should be made by emailing Roman Petrowski, Assistant Director for Strategic Communications, at rwpetrow@central.uh.edu, at least 48 hours before tipoff. Press row seating at Hofheinz Pavilion is for working media only.

■ All space for the working press, radio and television is allocated by the Houston Athletics Communications Office, which reserves the right to deny credentials to any outlet. Spouses, dates, children and non-workers are restricted from press row. Any abuse of a working credential will result in the media agency losing credential privileges. Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. Admission to press row is by pass only.

CREDENTIAL GUIDELINES

■ Only full-time, salaried employees intending to provide actual game coverage may receive credentials.

■ A requesting media agency must represent a collective, organizational editorial voice, not simply the offerings of a single individual.

■ Membership in a writer's association does not automatically qualify an agency for credentials.

■ A media agency may assign one of its credentials to its online entity.

■ An online entity, not associated with a traditional media agency, may qualify for one credential, subject to the following conditions:

1. An on-line entity may receive a credential only if its own full-time staff writes a majority of that site's material.
2. Online entities that focus primarily on University of Houston Athletics and sponsor message boards or chat rooms, may receive credentials provided they adhere to a policy that requires that a posted message or opinion is identified with the actual name and city of the individual posting the message.
3. Any online service that is recognized as an outlet intended primarily for the purpose of delivering news related to the recruitment of student-athletes will not qualify for credentials.
4. Online entities will not receive photography credentials.
5. Online entities (other than those identified above) registering 20,000 legitimate unique users per month in each of the past 12 months will be given first consideration.

ATHLETICS COMMUNICATIONS OFFICE

■ The University of Houston Athletics Communications Office is located in the Ted Nance Suite (No. 2008) on the second floor of the Athletics/Alumni Center.

■ The Athletics/Alumni Center is located at 3100 Cullen Blvd., between Cougar Field (baseball stadium) and Hofheinz Pavilion.

WNBA SCOUTS

WNBA scouts will be provided media credentials on a space-available basis. Credentials for WNBA scouts should be requested by the parent club on letterhead.

INTERVIEWS

■ All interviews with Houston coaches, student-athletes and administrators MUST be coordinated through the Athletics Communications Office.

■ Arrangements to speak with a member of the women's basketball program should be made with **Assistant Director for Strategic Communications Roman Petrowski (713-743-9391/rwpetrow@central.uh.edu)** at least one day prior to the desired interview date. Student-athletes and coaches are generally available after practice.

■ The locker rooms, training room and weight room inside the Athletics/Alumni Center and Hofheinz Pavilion are off-limits to reporters.

■ On game days, no Houston student-athletes will be available until the postgame media session.

GAME DAY

■ Pregame packets, including notes and statistics, will be available in the Hofheinz Pavilion media room (located concourse level at the north end of the facility behind section 128) prior to each home contest.

■ Timeout, halftime and final statistics plus running play-by-play, postgame notes and quotes will be provided.

■ Stat monitors will be set up along press row to provide up-to-the-second information.

■ Postgame interviews for head coach Ronald Hughey and selected student-athletes will be held in the Hofheinz Pavilion media room (located concourse level at the north end of the facility behind section 128) following each home game.

■ After a brief cooling-off period, Hughey and selected student-athletes will be brought to the media room to answer questions.

PRESS SEATING AND PARKING

■ Press row seats are for working newspaper writers, radio and television reporters and Houston Athletics staff, and are allocated by the Houston Athletics Communications Office, which reserves the right to deny credentials to any outlet.

■ Admission to press row is by pass only.

■ Media members who require parking in Lot 15A (located in-between Hofheinz Pavilion and the Athletics/Alumni Center) must make their request to **Assistant Director for Strategic Communications Roman Petrowski (713-743-9391/rwpetrow@central.uh.edu)** at least 24 hours before tipoff.

■ Visiting media who request credentials in advance can be added to a parking list and may park in the same lot. All others may be charged.

TELEPHONES/INTERNET

■ Phone lines are available on press row on a first-come, first-serve basis. Hofheinz Pavilion is also equipped with wireless Internet during games.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

■ Photographers and videographers are allowed to shoot from the baseline only.

■ Only those on assignment and with proper media credentials will be allowed to shoot game action. No flash attachments, monopods or tripods may be used at Hofheinz Pavilion.

RADIO/TELEVISION BROADCASTS

■ All requests for radio/TV broadcasts must be made in advance through the Associate AD of the Houston Athletics Communications Office.

VISITING RADIO

■ Phone lines for originating radio broadcasts (two ISDN, one POTS) will be provided on a reciprocal basis. Please contact **Assistant Director for Athletic Communications Roman Petrowski (713-743-9391/rwpetrow@central.uh.edu)** to obtain those numbers in advance of game day.

Five names, numbers, news items and storylines that you need to know about the Tulane game.

WATCH IT LIVE	Houston's matchup against Tulane on Saturday will air live on ESPN3 with Fran Harris and Steffi Sorensen on the call.
OLD RIVALS	The series between Houston and Tulane dates back to 1978 when the two teams met in Tulsa, Okla. Saturday's meeting will be the 40th between the two schools.
SCORING MACHINE	Freshman guard Jasmyne Harris has been on fire of late. She is averaging 13.7 points per game over her last 10 contests and leads all American Conference freshmen in scoring.
SO MUCH DEPTH	Houston's bench has played a key role in the scoring this season. The Cougars have won the bench points battle in 13 of their 16 contests.
ON THE GLASS	Houston has been a force on the glass this season, outrebounding opponents by nearly a rebound per game.

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Houston enters play this weekend with an 8-8 record and a 1-2 mark in American Conference play after falling 62-48 against UCF on Wednesday. ■ Houston has been led offensively by junior guard Chyanne Butler who has tallied 10.5 points per contest. Freshman guard Jasmyne Harris ranks second on the team at 10.4 points per game, while Kierra Graves adds 8.8 per contest. ■ The Cougars have been impressive on the glass this season, led by Serithia Hawkins who has pulled down 7.8 rebounds per contest. Jasmyne Harris is averaging 6.5 boards per game, while junior Brianne Coffman pulls down 4.1 per game. ■ Houston has received tremendous support from its reserves and has outscored its opponents in bench points throughout 13 of their first 16 games, with the most recent advantage being 23- 13 against Cincinnati. ■ Tulane enters Saturday's contest with an 11-6 overall record and a 2-2 mark in American Conference play. The Green wave are 7-1 in New Orleans this seasons, but dropped their most recent contest at home 62-53 against USF. As a team Tulane shoots 43.8 percent from the field while averaging 66.2 point per game, while allowing opponents to shoot 38.2 percent and score 62.2 points per contest. ■ Individually the Green Wave is led offensively by Kolby Morgan who averages 18.1 points per game, while Leslie Vorpahl contributes 12.2 per contest. - Saturday's game marks the 40th time the two squads will meet on the hardwood, dating back to 1978. The two teams have previously met 18 times in New Orleans.
 - Tulane has won five straight contests against the Cougars dating back to Dec. 30, 2014 and have won nine of the last 10 overall.
 - The Green Wave won 70-48 on Dec. 30, 2015 and then 59-56 in Houston on Feb. 6, 2016 to sweep the series last season. Houston trails the all-time series 13-26, and 6-12 on the road.

THE FINEST PRACTICE FACILITY IN THE NATION

In late September 2014, both the University of Houston Men's and Women's Basketball programs celebrated their bright futures when renderings for the Basketball Development Center were unveiled.

Designed by DLR Group and Page, the Development Center is located adjacent to Hofheinz Pavilion at the corner of Cullen Boulevard and Holman Street on the UH campus. Construction on the \$25 million facility began in September 2014 and is expected to be completed by fall 2015. Austin Commercial will be the construction manager.

The 53,000 square-foot facility will provide the environment that the Houston Men's and Women's Basketball student-athletes need to excel throughout the season in all areas. The first level will house a dedicated practice court for each team as well as sports performance and sports medicine areas, which will be used by both programs. The second level will feature the teams' areas, which include locker rooms and academic/film theaters. The team rooms contain spacious, modern lockers, multiple video screens for television and comfortable furniture. The third level will hold office space for both Men's and Women's Basketball coaching and support staffs.

"I am really excited about the Development Facility, but I am more excited about the commitment and the confidence that Dr. Renu Khator, our athletics administration and the entire student body have shown with us," said Head Coach Ron Hughey. "This opens endless possibilities with the recruits that we can bring in. This is the mecca of #ChasingGreatness."

The Houston Cougar Women's Basketball team dropped a 62-48 decision to UCF inside Hofheinz Pavilion on Wednesday. Freshman Jasmyne Harris notched her second double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds.

The Cougars raced out to a 6-0 lead to open the contest led by back-to-back 3-pointers from junior Mariah Mitchell. Houston shot 4-of-4 from the beyond the arc in the frame and finished 6-of-13 from the field to take the lead 17-15 at the first break. Scoring was at a premium in the second quarter, with each of the defenses locking down in the game. The Cougars held the Knights to just four field goals in the quarter, while holding UCF to 44.0 percent from the field in the half. Houston entered the locker room up 26-25.

Houston struggled to find a rhythm coming out of the half. As a team, Houston shot just 15.4 percent in the third quarter and missed seven straight 3-point field goals after making their first four. The Knights outscored the Cougars 22-9 in the quarter to take a 47-35 lead into the final period.

The Knights went on a 6-0 run to take the lead at the beginning of the second half at 31-26, prompting a Cougar timeout. By the end of the quarter, UCF had extended its lead to 12, and Houston was never able to pull any closer.

FRESHMAN SENSATIONS

Houston Head Coach Ronald Hughey brought in five freshman with his second recruiting class during the 2016 season, and the freshman have not let down since arriving on campus. After getting much needed time on the court during the summer's Costa Rica trip, the Cougar freshman have gelled with their teammates nicely and are some of the top contributors on the squad.

Guard Angela Harris led the Cougars in scoring through the first eight games, while Jasmyne Harris (no relation) ranks second on the glass with 6.5 boards per contest. The duo earned three straight American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week awards, with Angela taking the honor on Nov. 28 and Jasmyne Following in back-to-back weeks on Dec. 5 and Dec. 12.

Jasmyne Harris has 13.7 points per game over the last 10 contests and sits at 10.4 per game over the course of the season. Harris leads all freshmen in the American Athletic Conference in scoring.

HUGHEY'S TOP MARK

With seven wins throughout the non-conference season, Head Coach Ronald Hughey has set a new high for wins during his tenure at Houston. The previous best was six during his first two seasons at the helm.

ANOTHER TOP SIGNING CLASS

Despite signing just one freshman for the 2017-18 season, Hughey made an impact on the recruiting trail with his second ESPN Hoopgurlz Top-100 signee in as many years.

On Nov. 9, the Cougars signed Julia Blackshell-Fair, a 5-10 guard out of Vanden High School in Fairfield, Calif. Blackshell-Fair was the 26th rated guard for the Class of 2017 and the 4-star prospect entered her senior season ranked No. 92 in the nation in the class.

Blackshell-Fair plays for coach Allison Johnson at Vanden High School where she was the 2015-16 Solano County Athletic Conference Player of the Year as well as a member of the Max Preps Division II Second Team. The newest Cougar has averaged 14.3 points and 4.6 assists per game during her high school career.

CLOSE OUT DEFENSE

Houston has been one of the top teams in the nation this season defending shots from beyond the 3-point line. The Cougars lead the American Athletic Conference, allowing just 26.7 percent from deep, and are ranked 22nd among all teams in the NCAA.
