TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

LISA STOCKTON BIO

In her 23rd season at the helm of the Tulane women's basketball program, Lisa Stockton embarks into her third year in the American Athletic Conference after leaving Conference-USA the winningest program (179 conf. wins). Her career record of 537-261 as a collegiate head coach is good for a 67.0 winning percentage and she is 474-234 during her time at Tulane, including a 214-133 mark in conference play.



During her tenure with the Green Wave, Stockton has led her team to the postseason 17 times (11 NAAs, 6 WNITs) and claimed Conference Coach of the Year honors three times (Metro in 1995, C-USA in 2007 and 2010). In addition, Tulane has won C-USA regular season crown four times and the tournament title on five occasions. In her first year in The American during the 2014-15 season, Stockton's Wave went 22-11 and received their first at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since 2003. Last season, the Wave tied its longest run in the WNIT by reaching the third round.

Stockton has guided Tulane to 15, 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 1996-97 and 1999-2000. 24 different student-athletes have earned all-conference honors 37 times, including 11 who received All-Freshman recognition. In addition, five former Tulane players have gone on to play in the WNBA.

Prior to coming to Tulane for the 1994-95 season, Stockton served as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 1990-94, head coach at Greensboro College from 1987-90 and as the volunteer assistant at North Carolina in 1986-87.

Stockton graduated from Wake Forest in 1986 and was a four-year letterwinner for the Demon Deacons where she set school records in points, assists and steals. She earned her master's from North Carolina in 1987.

LAST TIME OUT

• Vorpahl (21 pts) & Morgan (20 pts) combined for 41 points to power the Green Wave to a 70-65 win over the visiting Tulsa Golden Hurricane.

• Up just 49-44 to start the fourth quarter, Tulane recorded an 11-0 run to garner its largest lead of the game at 60-44.

• Morgan grabbed a season high eight rebounds and tied her career best with nine made free-throws (9-of-12).

• Vorpahl & Morgan scored a combined 26 points in the second half.

SCOUTING THE BEARCATS

• Cincinnati enters with a 14-6 overall record and 5-2 mark in AAC play. Bearcats opened American play with a loss at SMU, but bounced back with five straight wins before dropping a 64-44 loss at UCF this past Tuesday.

• Bearcats rank 63rd in the nation in scoring defense, limiting its opposition to 59.3 ppg.

• Shanice Johnson leads the way with her 15.5 ppg and 9.6 rpg. The junior forward ranks 27th nationally with nine double-doubles this season. Johnson also ranks 44th in the country in rebounds per game and 22nd in steals per game (3.00)

• Cincy is also powered by Ana Owens and Bianca Quisenberry who each average double-figures at 12.7 and 10.7 ppg, respectively. Quisenberry ranks 34th in the nation in free-throw percentage (.864).

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

MORGAN'S HOT STREAK

Morgan has produced a career high streak of five straight games of 20+ points, averaging 21.6 points on 43.3 percent shooting in that span. The junior is now up to 12 total 20+ performances this season after producing 13 total last season.

In addition, Morgan has achieved 13 straight games with double-digit points, tying her career high streak set last season. The streak started just two days after being held scoreless for the first time of her career at Middle Tennessee - Morgan then erupted for a career high 34 points on a career best 14 made field goals at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5.

IN EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

Senior point guard Leslie Vorpahl recently became the 28th member of Tulane's 1,000-career point club back on Dec. 28. - now sitting with 1,113 points which ranks 16th all-time. On the assists side, Vorpahl currently ranks fourth on the all-time list at 484, chasing No. 3 Olivia Grayson at 499. Vorpahl would be just the third person to surpass 500 career assists behind Jamie Kaplan (582) and Ashley Langford (722)

If Vorpahl surpasses the 500 career assist milestone, she would become just the second player in program history to achieve 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. The lone Tulane women's player to achieve the feat ---> Langford (2005-09) with her 1,047 points & 722 assists.

CLIMBING THE ALL-TIME CHARTS

Morgan, who became the first player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points in her first two seasons, now sits at 1,374 career points, which ranks 8th all-time. Up next: No. 7 Olivia Grayson (2009-13) - 1,442 points

EYE ON THE RPI // BRACKETOLOGY

According to NCAA RPI rankings, Tulane sat at No. 106 as of Dec. 12. After a season high five-game win streak and notable wins over NC State and Auburn, the Green Wave jumped all the way up to No. 35.

After a 4-3 start to American play, Tulane now sits at No. 36.

According to Real Time RPI on Jan. 25, Tulane's strength of schedule ranked No. 29 in the country.

UConn marked the Wave's 10th opponent inside the current RPI Top-100, in which Tulane boasts a 4-6 record.

Lastly, in the latest ESPN Bracketology on Jan. 23, Tulane was part of the 'last four in' as a No. 9 seed.

AMERICAN GIRL

New Year, New Me, for Vorpahl, whose shooting has heated up since the start of conference play back on Dec. 31. Since then, the senior has raised her field goal percentage from 40.0 percent to 46.4 percent, and her three-point percentage from 26.9 percent to 37.6 percent.

In league play only, Vorpahl is shooting a prolific 50.0 percent from three (15-of-30), which ranks first in The American. Vorpahl is also shooting 52.2 percent from the floor, which ranks 7th.

The senior has certainly been putting her stamp on conference play, ranking in the top-15 in seven different categories: 7th in FG% (.522), 4th in assists (5.6), 5th in 3PT FG (2.1), 1st in 3PT FG% (.500), 8th in A/TO ratio (1.2), 14th in D-Reb. (3.9) and 11th in minutes (34.1).

RAIDERS OF THE ARC

In AAC play only, Tulane is shooting 32.8 percent from beyond the arc, while holding its opposition to just 28.9 percent -- both rank second amongst conference teams.

The Green Wave have connected on at least seven made three-pointers in seven of their past 11 games, including a season high of 10 vs N.C. State.

Individually, Vorpahl has provided a spark from deep, recording four three-pointers twice in the past four games.

MORGAN AT THE LINE

Morgan has made 28 of her last 32 free throws, raising her free-throw percentage to 83.8 percent which ranks 5th in The American and 59th in the nation. The Nola native has converted 86.7 percent of her free throws in AAC play. Recently, Morgan tied her career high of nine made free-throws (9-of-12) vs Tulsa on Jan. 25.

MAKING HER 'POINT' AT GUARD

Vorpahl is averaging 6.5 assists per game, which ranks 15th in the nation and 2nd in the AAC. Furthermore, Vorpahl's 130 total assists ranks 14th in the country.

Vorpahl made history in the season opening win over Grambling on Nov. 12, setting a new single-game program record of 15 assists. Ashley Langford previously held the top mark with 14 assists set back in both 2006 and 2007.

Vorpahl, who has since dished out 12 assists at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5 and 11 assists vs Maine on Dec. 28, is now up to seven double-digit assist games in her career.

Last season, Vorpahl averaged 5.4 assists per game which ranked 35th in the nation and fifth all-time at Tulane.

NOTABLES VS TULSA

Morgan grabbed a season high eight rebounds vs Tulsa on Jan. 25, along with tying her career high of nine made free-throws. In addition, Shakira Harding supplied eight points off the bench in a career high 23 minutes of play. Harding also tied her career high in steals (3) and season high in assists (3).

NOTABLES FROM NO. 1 UCONN

Tulane kept the game within singles digits for the opening 13.5 minutes and was only trailing by 11 points with two minutes before the half. The Olive and Blue were up 19-16 in the rebounding battle at the half before losing by just one at 31-30 at the conclusion.

The Wave's 56 points were the most they've scored against UConn in their short six-game series between the two. However, the match-up marked the first time an opponent scored triple digits against Tulane since Feb. 25, 1991, when Florida State dropped 104 points.

Lastly, Tulane attempted its first free-throws in Gampel Pavilion in their third year of trying. Wave finished 10-of-15 from the line.

EVERYONE LENDS A HAND

During Tulane's 82-56 win over Houston on Jan. 14, all 11 rostered players tallied points for the first time this season.

HOME SWEET HOME

A year after tying the program record for most wins inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse (14), the Green Wave are back at it again, starting the season off 7-0 at home before dropping their first contest on Jan. 4 to then No. 22 USF, 62-53. The loss also snapped the Wave's 11-game home win streak that dated back to last season, marking the longest win streak at home since 2003.

The Olive and Blue, now 9-1 at home this season, are averaging 71.6 ppg inside Fogelman in Devlin, with a +11.5 scoring margin. The Wave are also shooting 46.7 percent from the field and 37.2 percent from three-point range. Individually, Morgan & Vorpahl are averaging 20.9 ppg and 13.4 ppg at home, respectively.

CAN'T BUY A FREE-THROW

Tulane, who attempted just three free-throws against USF on Jan. 4, only attempted nine in the game at Temple on Jan. 8. The kicker there was the fact that the Wave did not obtain its first free-throw attempt until 4:50 on the clock in the fourth quarter.

NEW STARTING FIVE

For the first time all season, a new starting five debuted at Temple on Jan. 8, as Tene Thompson replaced fellow sophomore Meredith Schulte. Thompson has since started the past five games. In American play, Thompson is averaging 4.6 points and 4.9 rebounds. The Wave are now 3-2 with this new line-up.

FEATS AGAINST NO. 22 USF

On Jan. 4, Tulane held then No. 22 USF to a season low in points (62) and second lowest shooting percentage (.375). The Wave also held USF leading scorer Kitija Laksa, who averages 21.1 ppg, to 12 points, including just three in the second half.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The first month of the new year will see the Green Wave be hardened by battles away from home, as five of Tulane's seven league games in January are on the road: Temple, SMU, UConn, Cincinnati and Houston - with two home games sprinkled in between: Houston and Tulsa.

On the flip side - five of the Wave's seven games in February will be competed at home in New Orleans.

TULANE GREEN WAVE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

PROTECTING THE LATE LEAD

The Green Wave are 11-1 when possessing the lead at the start of the fourth quarter. The lone exception came at Vanderbilt on Dec. 5, when Tulane was up 45-44 at the start of the fourth, before losing 74-63.

BEST DEFENSIVE SHOWING

On New Year's Eve, Tulane held East Carolina to opponent season lows in points (45) and field goal percentage (.293). The Wave out-scored ECU 15-4 in the second quarter, holding the Pirates to just one field goal at 7:19 on the clock, and scoreless for the last 4:50 of the half. The Wave defense continued to smother ECU in the third, holding them to without a field goal for the final 5:34 of the quarter.

A BENCHMARK FOR SUCCESS

During the first half of the season, Tulane received a much needed boost from its bench in several key instances.

Junior Caylah Cruickshank provided the spark in the 63-58 win over NC State. Cruickshank scored all eight of her points in the fourth quarter, including two clutch three-pointers. Furthermore, Cruickshank achieved a career high nine points at Temple on Jan. 8, knocking down a pair of three's.

Speaking of bench play, senior Shakira Harding has twice scored all of her points in the second half to lend a boost to Tulane. First, Harding tallied seven of her points in the final quarter at UTSA, before chipping in eight points in the second half vs Maine. In addition, Harding previously recorded a career day vs

Southern Miss, scoring 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-4 showing from three-point range, as all three statistics marked career highs.

Most recently, sophomore Ksenija Madzarevic earned her time to shine, tying her career high of eight points in the win at SMU on Jan. 11.

VORPAHL'S DAY TO REMEMBER

Vorpahl certainly recorded a day to remember vs Maine on Dec. 28. Needing just seven points to reach the 1,000 career point milestone, Vorpahl exploded for a season high 24 points on an impressive 7-of-8 shooting, including a perfect 3-for-3 mark from three-point range. Vorpahl's 24 points were just three shy of her career high.

Not only did Vorpahl reach a program milestone and set new season highs, but also registered her first double-double of the season, dishing out 11 assists.

TULANE CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the ninth straight year and 17th time overall, the Green Wave were Tulane Classic champions. The Wave first bested Eastern Washington, 63-51, before edging out Auburn, 61-59.

Morgan was named MVP of the tournament after averaging 16.5 ppg and 6.0 rebounds. Vorpahl was named to the All-Tournament team after netting 11.0 ppg and 7.0 assists.

Harlyn Wyatt secured her first career double-double in the Wave's 63-51 win over Eastern Washington on Dec. 21. Wyatt earned career highs in points (14), field goals (6), assists (2) and minutes (38), while tying her season high of 10 rebounds.

FOURTH QUARTER HEROICS

Trailing by as much as 13 points in the third quarter and by seven to kick-off the fourth, Tulane rallied by outscoring NC State 28-16 in the final period. Morgan (10), Vorpahl (9) and Cruickshank (8) combined for 27 of those points, shooting 60.0 percent from the field in the fourth. The come-from-behind win stopped the Wave's first three-game losing streak in three seasons.

MONKEY OFF THE BACK

Tulane faced four SEC member institutions this non-conference season, in which three of them were responsible for Tulane losses: No. 4 Miss State, Vanderbilt and LSU.

Tulane enacted some revenge on Dec. 22 in the form of a 61-59 victory over Auburn.

PAINTING THE PICTURESQUE WIN

In Tulane's 82-65 win over McNeese State on Nov. 30, the Green Wave tallied 50 points in the paint. That total marked the most points in the paint in over three seasons for the Wave.

LATHAM BROKE LOOSE

Latham dropped 17 points on a career high seven made field goals vs Southern Miss on Nov. 20. Latham made her first four shots from the field before finishing 7-of-9.

More recently, Latham notched 10 points in the first 11 minutes at ECU on Dec. 31, before finishing with 12 points. Later, vs Houston on Jan. 14, the senior earned 12 points yet again, marking her sixth double-digit effort on the year.

STEALING A WIN

Tulane's defense helped set the tone in its 86-67 win over Southern Miss on Nov. 20. The Green Wave secured 18 steals, topping any steal total from all of last season. The Wave also forced 29 Southern Miss turnovers, in which they converted into 27 points.

Vorpahl and Latham led the way with five steals apiece, as the latter achieved a new career high. Meanwhile, Morgan secured four steals of her own.

VORPAHL'S STELLAR 2ND HALF

After playing just six minutes in the first half vs. No. 10/9 Mississippi State due to early foul trouble, Leslie Vorpahl came back with a vengeance in the second half, making her first seven shots to ultimately finish 9-of-11 from the field, scoring a game and season high 20 points.

SCHULTE LANDS ON HONOR ROLL

Schulte, who scored a season high 10 points as a freshman, broke out with a career game in the season opener, converting her first six shots before finishing with 20 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three-point range.

The conference recognized the stellar performance by placing Schulte on The American's week one Honor Roll list.

FEATS AGAINST TOP-10 MISS STATE

No. 10/9 Mississippi State entered the match-up against Tulane averaging a prolific 97.5 ppg on 56.9 percent shooting. However, the Green Wave held the Bulldogs to just 66 points on 36.1 percent shooting. All-in-all, the Green Wave outscored Miss State 33-30 in the second half.

STOCKTON SIGNS EXTENSION

Back in October, Coach Stockton signed a contract extension taking her through the 2020-21 season. Stockton has led the Wave to 17 trips to the postseason, including 11 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

STOCKTON INKS 4 TO 2017 CLASS

Three days before the season started, Coach Stockton welcomed Kaila Anderson (Baton Rouge, La.), Sierra Cheatham (Houston, Texas), Krystal Freeman (Pineville, La.) and Tatyana Lofton (Madison, Miss.) all to the Green Wave family.

AMERICAN PRESEASON PICKS

Tulane's top returning guard duo of junior Kolby Morgan and senior Leslie Vorpahl received some high praise when they were both selected as Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections. Morgan received First-Team honors after averaging 17.2 ppg last season, while Vorpahl got the Second-Team nod after averaging 10.7 points and 5.4 assists.
