HISTORY LESSON

Thursday's meeting between the Green Wave and Mustangs will mark the 34th all-time with SMU leading the series, 20-13, as winners of each of the last five matchups.

Last season, SMU swept the regular season series, which included an 80-64 win in New Orleans, before mounting a comeback from down 15 points at halftime to upend the Green Wave, 80-75, in Dallas.

Cameron Reynolds scored 15 points and recorded his 500th career rebound, but Tulane dropped its American Athletic Conference home opener, 65-56, to Tulsa on Sunday,
Melvin Frazier also reached double-figures for the 13th time this season with 11 points, while Blake Paul blocked six shots. Samir Sehic added eight points off the bench
Tulsa placed four scorers in double digits, led by Martins Igbanu's 15 points and game-high nine rebounds, while Sterling Taplin also poured in 15. Junior Etou contributed 14 points and six boards, while Curran Scott provided 11 points, six rebounds and three assists off the bench

• The Golden Hurricane owned a 52-30 rebounding advantage while outscoring the Green Wave, 30-20, in the paint and and 10-1 on second chance opportunities.

SCOUTING THE MUSTANGS

Picked to finish fourth in the American Athletic Conference preseason poll, SMU is led by five starters averaging double-digit points per game, including leading scorer and preseason conference player of the year Shake Milton [16.7 PPG].

Thursday will be just the second true road game of the season for the Mustangs, who lead the conference in scoring defense [58.9], 3-point field goal percentage [.423], assists per game [18.2] and assist/turnover ratio [1.5].

SMI also ranks second in scoring margin [*166] steals per game.

SMU also ranks second in scoring margin (+16.6), steals per game [7.9] and turnover margin [+3.7].

MAN OF STEALS

• Melvin Frazier ranks second in the American Athletic Conference in steals [33] and steals per game [2.4], and has at least three hesists in six contests this season.

As a sophomore, Frazier finished the 2016-17 regular season No. 1 in the American Athletic Conference in steals per game [1.9], while his 55 takeaways ranked second overall."

ONA EMBO EMERGES

• Known for his defensive prowess as a freshman in 2016-17, sophomore point guard Ray Ona Embo has broken through on the offensive side of the ball in 2017-18.

Ona Embo played in all 31 games and made 25 starts last season, averaging 6.4 points on 37 percent shooting overall, while making 25 percent [13 of 52] of his 3-pointers. In just 12 games as a sophomore, he's averaging 9.8 points per contest, while making 47 percent of his shots and 45 percent [22 of 49] of his attempts from beyond the arc.

Trailing by 20 points with 17:39 remaining in regulation, Tulane recorded an improbable feat in defeating Nicholls State, 76-69, at home on December 18.

The comeback from down at least 20 points was the second in the last three years for the Green Wave and the first since erasing a 26-point defecit to upend Stephen F. Austin, 60-59, on Nov. 29, 2015 in Nashville.

THE LEGEND OF WEARING 'ZERO'

Redshirt junior Jordan Cornish has a specific reason for wearing number 'O' which dates back to his initial commitment to Tennessee out of high school.

· Following the Volunteers' head coaching change, several members of Tennessee's 2014 signing class agreed to wear No. O at their next schools. Cornish was supposed to get No. O at UNLV but another player already had the number. Cornish finally got his wish to don the zero upon his arrival at Tulane.

Florida State's Phil Cofer wears the number, while Larry Austin wore No. O at Xavier [before transferring to Vanderbilt] and CJ Turman wore No. O when he played at Florida Atlantic.

REYNOLDS SURPASSES 1,000 POINTS

Redshirt senior Cameron Reynolds scored his 1,000th career point in the 81-65 win over Alcorn State on Nov. 29 to

become the 36th player in program history to do it.

While his seventh point of the night gave him 1,000,
Reynolds poured in a season-high 28 points in the effort and
moved from No. 37 to No. 34 on the school's all-time scoring list in that game alone.

FRAZIER EARNS AAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Melvin Frazier recorded the best week of his collegiate career and was rewarded in being named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week on Nov. 20. Frazier is Tulane's first Player of the Week selection since

the Green Wave joined the conference in 2014-15.

In a 3-0 week for the Olive and Blue, Frazier recorded the first two double-doubles of his collegiate career and averaged 237 points, 9.7 boards, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game, while shooting a blistering 26-for-32 [.812] from the field and 9-for-13 [.692] from beyond the 3-point line.

JAMAICAN HISTORY

Tulane became the first team to win an NCAA Division I

college baskethall game in Jamaica in an 80-53 victory over Colorado State at the 2017 Jamaica Classic on Nov. 17.

Melvin Frazier was voted MVP of the tournament, while Cameron Reynolds was chosen to the all-tournament team following Tulane's 2-0 showing in Montego Bay which, was capped by a 63-55 victory against Fordham on Nov. 19.

Frazier scored 23 points in both games and grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds against Fordham, while Reynolds poured in a game-high 25 points against Colorado State.

THE CENTURY MARK

Tulane's 102 points scored in the season opening win over LIU Brooklyn on Nov. 10 marked the first time the Green Wave eclipsed 100 since a 100-92 triple overtime win at East Carolina on Feb. 10, 2016. The last time the Olive and Blue eclipsed the century mark in regulation was the 100-61 home blowout of Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 20, 2014.

· The last time Tulane scored in triple-figures as a team in a season opener came in a 113-72 thrashing of Prairie View A&M at home to begin the 1995 campaign under head coach Perry Clark.

#TULANEinSPAIN

The Green Wave took a foreign tour to Spain in August, exploring Madrid and Barcelona during the 10-day trip.

Tulane went undefeated in four exhibition games, playing

twice in both cities, respectively.

· Activities and sights the team experienced included tours of historic Madrid, the Real Madrid football stadium, a walking tour of a Picasso museum, a guided bike tour through Barcelona, a catamaran ride off the coast of Barcelona which included swimming in the Mediterranean Sea.

The 30-person travel party was extremely fortunate to be isolated from the scene of a terrorist attack in Barcelona on August 17, where a vehicle mounted a sidewalk in a tourist shopping area, fatally injuring 13 pedestrians and wounding more than 130 others. Student-athletes, staff and coaches were divided in groups at the hotel, on the beach and shopping around the city when the event occurred. Within 30 minutes, everyone was accounted for and determined safe. Other than dinner plans for later that evening, no events on Tulane's itinerary were altered in the wake of the tragedy.

2017-18 TULANE MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

REYNOLDS AGAINST RANKED FOES

· Cameron Reynolds has played some of his best basketball against Tulane's toughest opponents over the last two seasons, averaging 19.8 points per game against five teams ranked in the AP Top 25 poll.

· This season, Reynolds scored 18 points with five rebounds and four assists at 13th-ranked North Carolina on Dec. 3.

· In 2016-17, Reynolds scored 21 points against No. 6 North Carolina, 17 points at No. 23 Cincinnati, 20 points against the 20th-ranked Bearcats and 23 points at 19th-ranked SMU.

· In those five contests, he has shot an impressive 50 percent [37-for-74] from the field and 15-for-28 (.536) beyond the 3-point

BLAKE'S BLOCK PARTY

· Blake Paul blocked eight shots in the 89-66 win over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 13, tying the single-game program record. Lawrence Nelson was the only player to accomplish the feat, and he did it twice, with the last time coming nearly 19 years ago on Jan. 24, 1998 against USF.

ONA EMBO WINS FIBA U20 BRONZE

Ray Ona Embo played a big role in France's bronze medal run at the FIBA U20 European Championships in Crete, Greece in July.

· Owning a FIBA world ranking of No. 9, France defeated Iceland, 58-50, Montenegro, 76-73, in overtime and Turkey, 71-54, to win Group B before the tournament advanced to the knockout stage.

After winning Group B with a perfect 3-0 record, France cruised past Czech Republic, 88-61, in the round of 16, before defeating Serbia, 86-67, in the quarterfinals. The five-game winning streak was halted in the semifinals in a 74-52 loss to Israel. France redeemed itself with a 72-58 triumph over Spain in the bronze medal game.

· Ona Embo made at least one basket in each of the first six games of the tournament, which included six points and three rebounds in just nine minutes of action against Israel. He had two steals against Iceland and dished out four assists against Montenegro.

SEHIC'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE DEBUT

After sitting out the the 2016-17 season due to NCAA transfer rules, redshirt sophomore Samir Sehic recorded his firstcareer double-double with 17 points and 14 rebounds against LIU Brooklyn in his Tulane debut on Nov. 17.

· His 17 points, 14 rebounds, seven field goals made, two assists and seven offensive boards were all personal-bests.

LIGHTS-OUT SHOOTING

· Tulane had its best shooting performance in more than two decades in its 94.71 home win over USF on Feb. 18, 2017, shooting 33-for-50 [.660] overall and 12-for-22 [.545] from three-point range, while six players scored in double-digits.

The last time the Green Wave shot better than 65 percent from the field was Dec. 30, 1995 with a 34-for-51 [.667] performance against Mount St. Mary's.

HEAD COACH MIKE DUNLEAVY, SR.

Mike Dunleavy, Sr. is in his second season as Tulane's head men's basketball coach and his 19th overall season as a professional and collegiate head coach.

Over the past 46 years, Dunleavy has played and coached in world championship games, directed hall of fame and NBA all-star players, led NBA franchises, served as a television analyst and played in the NCAA

The 1999 NBA Coach of the Year, Dunleavy brings over 30 years of NBA experience, either as a player, general manager or head coach to the Green Wave.

In his first season with the Green Wave, Dunleavy

made an immediate impact on the development of key reade an immediate impact on the development of key veterans on the team. Forward Cameron Reynolds was named the 2017 American Athletic Conference Most Improved Player of the Year after leading the squad with 17.0 points and 6.8 rebounds per game while knocking down 78 3-pointers. Sophomore guard Melvin Frazier led the league in steals per game [19], senior center Ryan Smith scored in double-figures 12 times after doing so just once in his first three seasons combined, while freshman Ray Ona Embo was named American

while freshman Hay Una Embo was named American Conference Rookie of the Week twice.

A 17-year NBA head coach, Dunleavy won 613 regular season games, the 24th-most in NBA history, with four different teams [Los Angeles Lakers, Milwaukee Bucks, Portland Trailblazers, Los Angeles Clippers] and amassed 38 playoff victories in his career.

Along the way, he coached five future Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famers, including Earvin "Magic" Johnson Moses Malone Scottie Pinnen

"Magic" Johnson, Moses Malone, Scottie Pippen, Arvydas Sabonis and James Worthy. A total of six players under Dunleavy were named NBA All-Stars on nine occasions, including Johnson [1992 MVP], Worthy, Elton Brand, Chris Kaman, Rasheed Wallace and Vin Baker. As a general manager, he drafted six players who later earned NBA All-Star selections, including Glenn Robinson [10x], Ray Allen [10x], Vin Baker [4x], Blake Griffin [5x], DeAndre Jordan [1x] and Chris Kaman

Dunleavy's longest tenure was with the Los Angeles Clippers for seven seasons [2003-10]. He led the club to 215 victories and seven playoff victories. The Clippers best season under Dunleavy came during the 2005-06 campaign when he led the franchise to 47 wins and an appearance in the Western Conference semifinals. He stepped down as head coach in 2010 to serve as the team's general manager.

Dunleavy began his coaching career in 1987 as an assistant coach with the Bucks, where he served for three seasons [1987-1990]. He earned his first head coaching job in 1990 with the Los Angeles Lakers, succeeding Pat Riley. During his rookie season [1990-91], he led a lineup that featured the combination of Johnson and Worthy to a Western Conference title and to the NBA Finals where the Lakers lost the series to the Michael Jordan- and Pippen-led Chicago Bulls.

Following the 1991-92 season, Dunleavy became the

head coach in Milwaukee, where he led the Bucks to 107 wins in four seasons [1992-96] while also serving as the team's Vice President of Basketball Operations. He stepped away from the bench prior to the 1996-97 season to concentrate on his general manager duties with the Bucks for one season before taking the head coaching job in Portland.

Dunleavy coached the Trail Blazers for four seasons [1997-2001] and led the franchise to a 190-106 [.642] overall record and four-straight playoff appearances. The Blazers made back-to-back appearances in the Western Conference Finals in 1999 and 2000. Dunleavy's 1999-2000

team won 59 games, which matched the second-best single-season victory total in franchise history. Dunleavy earned the 1999 NBA Coach of the Year award after leading the 1998-99 Blazers to a Pacific Division-winning

35-15 record.

Dunleavy played at South Carolina from 1972-76 under legendary coach Frank McGuire and was a sixth-round draft pick [99th overall] by the Philadelphia 76ers in 1976. He played for the 76ers alongside future Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer Julius Erving and helped the team to the NBA Finals as a rookie.

Over the course of a 12-year NBA career, Dunleavy played in 438 games which included stops with

played in 438 games which included stops with Philadelphia [1976-77], the Houston Rockets [1978-82], San Antonio Spurs [1982-83] and Milwaukee Bucks [1983-85, 88-90] His best season was with the Rockets during the 1980-81 campaign when he averaged 10.5 points per game and started on a team that played in the NBA Finals. In his lone season in San Antonio, Dunleavy led the NBA in three-point percentage, connecting at a .345 [67-194] clip from behind the arc."

A back injury prompted his unofficial retirement following the 1984-85 season and he worked for a New York investment firm before returning to the NBA as an assistant coach with Milwaukee for the 1986-87 season. He stayed on the Bucks' bench through the 1989-90 campaign, but returned to uniform in parts of two seasons [1988-89, 1989-90] when injuries to the Bucks' backcourt forced Dunleavy into the lineup.

A native of Brooklyn, N.Y., Dunleavy played collegiately at the University of South Carolina, where he led the

team in assists as a freshman and finished his career team in assists as a freshman and finished his career third all-time in scoring with 1,586 points. Dunleavy helped the Gamecocks to 81 victories and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. He appeared in III consecutive games, starting his last 105. Dunleavy was a straight-A student, majoring in psychology while at South Carolina. He played his prep basketball at Nazareth High School in Brooklyn, where he earned All-New York City honors as a senior and had his purpher Migragy retired Dunleavy.

as senior and had his number 44 jersey retired Dunleavy was inducted into the New York City Basketball Hall of Fame in 2001 and the Basketball Old-Timers of America Hall of Fame in Brooklyn in May of 2017.

Dunleavy and his wife, Emily, have three sons: Mike, Baker and James. Mike, Jr. was the No. 3 overall pick in the 2002 NBA Draft and finished his 15th NBA season with the Atlanta Hawks in 2016-17. Baker was hired as the men's basketball head coach at Quinnipiac University in March of 2017 after seven successful seasons as an assistant at Villanova University. James is an NBA player agent and Vice President of Basketball at Independent Sports & Entertainment [ISE].
