STARTING FIVE

1. The Tulane University men's basketball team returns to action for the first time in 21 days on Wednesday night to take on Memphis. Tulane's home matchup with Memphis will mark the beginning of league play for both teams. The game will tipoff at 7 p.m. CT inside the Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse.
2. The Green Wave enters their meeting with Memphis in the hopes of rebounding from their 86-72 set back to the College of Charleston back on Dec. 7 at home.
3. Tulane had each of its last three games (at Texas A&M - Dec. 14; vs. Grambling - Dec. 18; New Orleans - Dec. 21) cancelled due to COVID-19 protocols.
4. This season, Hunter's staff welcomes back six letterwinners, six newcomers and three starters, including preseason All-American Athletic Conference honoree Jaylen Forbes. Forbes is one of three players on the team, averaging 10-or-more points per game. Freshman Jalen Cook leads the team with 19.0 points per game - a figure that ranks second in the American Athletic Conference. As a team, Tulane is averaging 72.1 points per game and connecting at a 44.8 percent clip.
5. The Green Wave have won the turnover battle in eight of their nine games this season. During the 2021-22 campaign, Tulane won the turnover battle in 19 of its 23 contests last season while also forcing opponents into at least 15 mishaps on 11 occasions. During the 2019-20 campaign, the Green Wave committed equal or fewer turnovers than its opponents in 28 of 30 contests while ranking in the top 15 nationally in turnover margin (+4.3).

The Tulane men's basketball team suffered a 61-46 road setback at Memphis back on Feb. 24, 2021. Jordan Walker led all players with 18 points and matched his career-high with six steals, while Jaylen Forbes compiled 12 points and 10 rebounds for his first career double-double. Despite trailing 21-12 after seven straight points by Memphis, The Tigers got a lift from a pair of 3-pointers by Boogie Ellis inside the final two minutes to stretch their advantage to 31-21 at halftime. Tulane shot 8-of-32 (.250) from the field in the first half and forced 13 turnovers, while Memphis shot 12-of-26 (.462) overall while generating nine turnovers and owning a 24-17 rebounding advantage. The Green Wave chipped into the deficit on a 3 by Forbes with 17:31 left to make it 33-26, but a 12-2 run by the Tigers widened the margin to 45-28 with 11:09 remaining. Despite several opportunities, Tulane was unable to close the margin below double-digit points, as Memphis made late free throws to close out the 15-point victory. The Green Wave finished the night shooting 15-of-58 (.259) overall, 2-of-19 (.105) from 3-point range and 14-of-23 (.609) at the foul line. The Tigers shot 21-of-54 (.389) from the field, 5-of-17 (.294) beyond the arc and 14-of-25 (.560) at the foul stripe while owning a 53-29 advantage on the glass despite 26 turnovers.

LAST TIME OUT: Tulane Falls Short at Home to College of Charleston

- The Tulane University men's basketball team suffered a tough 86-72 loss to the College of Charleston back on Dec. 7 inside Avron B. Fogelman Arena in the Devlin Fieldhouse.
- The loss was the Green Wave's second loss to the Cougars this season and their first loss by more than five points.
- Sophomores Jaylen Forbes and Kevin Cross led the way with 17 points each on 5-of-11 and 6-of-12 shooting, respectively. Cross also led the team in rebounds with seven. Freshman Jadan Coleman also joined Forbes and Cross in double figures, as he tied a career high with 13 points.
- Offensively, the Green Wave shot 40.0 percent from the floor and hit at a 39.0 percent clip from long range.
- While Tulane was able to win the turnover battle 18-13 for the eighth time in nine games, they were outrebounded 40-29.
- The first half was a back-and-forth battle as the Green Wave would hold the lead at 34-30 heading into the locker room. Tulane had 13 points off College of Charleston turnovers and were outshooting the

Cougars 37.5-18.2 percent from long range. Fifteen of Forbes' 17 points came in that frame.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Sophomore Jaylen Forbes needs 73 points to reach 600 career points at Tulane.
- Sophomore Kevin Cross needs two points to reach 500 for his career. He also needs 23 rebounds for 300 in his career.
- Senior Scott Spencer needs 59 points for 500 in his career.
- Senior DeVon Baker needs 54 points to reach 1,200 in his career. Baker also need just one more appearance for 80 games played in his career.
- Sophomore Nabal Days needs one rebound to reach 200 in his career.

COOK MAKES IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Freshman Jalen Cook has been named to the American Athletic Conference Honor Roll twice this season, earning a spot on Nov. 15 and Nov. 22.
- Cook currently ranks second in the American Athletic Conference with 19.0 points per game.
- Most recently, Cook was selected to the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship All-Tournament Team.

FORBES' THE FLAMETHROWER

- In his two outings from Nov. 29 - Dec. 5, sophomore Jaylen Forbes averaged 22.5 points per game, a figure which ranked second in the American Athletic Conference. On Dec. 6, Forbes was selected to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll.
- Earlier this season against Drexel, Forbes poured in a season-high 30 points in the Green Wave's 90-87 win.
- Last season, he poured in a career-high 37 points on 9-of-15 shooting and made his first seven attempts from 3-point range while going 12-of-15 at the free throw line at Cincinnati on Feb. 26, 2021. The Florence, Mississippi, native's 37 points are the most by a Green Wave player in a regulation game since Jerald Honeycutt had 38 against Xavier on Jan. 16, 1997.
- His seven treys are tied for the second most in a single game in program history with Cameron Reynolds being the last to make seven against Alcorn State in November 2017.

A CALL TO THE HALL

- Tulane University men's basketball associate head coach Ray McCallum was named to the 2022 Men's Induction class this week by the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame.
- McCallum, who has served as the Green Wave's associate head coach since the start of the 2019-20 campaign, received the Hall of Fame nod after he posted a standout career during his time as a high school player, a collegiate student-athlete and his contributions as a head coach.

A PARADISE MARATHON

- The Tulane University men's basketball team needed over six hours, two courts, two separate pairs of jerseys and an overtime session, but in the end, the Green Wave picked up their second win of the season, as it defeated Drexel 90-87 back on Nov. 22.
- Tulane overcame a four-hour delay in the first game of the Baha Mar Nassau Championship and finished the game on the tournament practice court after standing water on the primary game court made the contest unplayable.

RON HUNTER

HEAD COACH | 470-351

Third Season (28th Overall) | Miami (Ohio), 1986

Ron Hunter was introduced as the 25th head coach in the 109-year history of Tulane men's basketball on March 26, 2019.

During the 2020-21 campaign, Hunter guided the Green Wave through the COVID-19 pandemic and led Tulane to its best RPI in over 20 years. He also helped advance to the Quarterfinals of the American Athletic Conference Championship following a win over seventh-seeded Tulsa.

Under Hunter's watchful eye, transfer guard Jaylen Forbes burst on the AAC scene and averaged 16.4 points per game en route to earning Second Team all-league honors.

In his first season leading the Green Wave, Hunter made the program's impact felt nationally and across the American Athletic Conference. Tulane secured a neutral court win over Utah, marking the team's first win over Pac-12 Conference opponent since the 1950's. The Green Wave also posted league wins over Cincinnati and SMU at home, as well as road victories over UCF and Temple.

Hunter arrived at Tulane after spending eight seasons at the helm of Georgia State University's program where he compiled a record of 171-95. In 27 years on the bench, Hunter owns a career record of

467-345 and has been named conference coach of the year three times. His 374 wins at the Division I level prior to taking the helm in New Orleans made him the winningest coach ever hired to lead Green Wave basketball.

During his eight-year tenure at GSU, Hunter directed the Panthers to six postseason appearances, including three trips to the NCAA Tournament in his final five seasons.

Hunter significantly changed the national perception of the Georgia State program. Prior to his arrival, the Panthers had broken .500 just nine times in 49 years. During Hunter's eight-year tenure at GSU, he directed the Panthers to seven winning seasons and is responsible for six of the nine most successful seasons in program history.

His stint at Georgia State also featured three Sun Belt Conference titles in the last five years. In 2014-15, the Panthers won 25 games and advanced to the third round of the NCAA tournament following the shocking upset of No. 3 seed Baylor.

It was the 2014-15 season that put Georgia State on the map. After winning the Sun Belt regular season title for the second year in a row, the Panthers claimed the tournament title for just the third time in program history. In the postgame celebration, Hunter tore his Achilles, a clip that went viral across the nation.

Coaching in the NCAA tournament from a stool, the Panthers trailed by 12 with 2:53 to play, before mounting a furious 13-0 run, capped by a 30-foot 3-pointer from son R.J. that sent Hunter off his stool and became one of the most watched clips of the tournament and a part of 'One Shining Moment.'

Prior to his arrival at GSU, Hunter spent 17 seasons at IUPUI, where he guided the program through its transition from the NAIA and Division II levels into NCAA Division I and the Summit League. He is the school's winningest coach, both in number of victories and winning percentage, and he led IUPUI to its only appearance in the NCAA tournament in





2003 in just the school's third season as a Division I program.

Named Summit League Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006, Hunter led IUPUI to the conference championship game five times from 2002-10, including the 2003 title game victory over top-seeded Valparaiso. Between 2005 and 2010, the Jaguars never finished lower than fourth in the league standings under Hunter, including runner-up finishes in 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2010.

Hunter also established a reputation for developing players, as he has coached 27 all-conference honorees and five conference player of the year selections during his head-coaching career at Georgia State and IUPUI.

He also mentored George Hill at IUPUI, who was drafted in the first round of the 2008 NBA Draft (26th selection) by the San Antonio Spurs. Seven years later, he would see his son R.J. Hunter get selected in the first round of the NBA Draft by the Boston Celtics.

Prior to his arrival at IUPUI, Hunter spent one year as the top assistant coach at his alma mater, Miami (Ohio), under current Arizona State head coach Herb Sendek. During that season, the Redhawks were 19-10, finishing second in the Mid-American Conference (MAC) and making an appearance in the postseason National Invitation Tournament (NIT).

Hunter's coaching career began in 1987, when he served as an assistant at Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

Off the court, Hunter earned national notoriety for his humanitarian efforts, partnering with Samaritan's Feet, an organization that collects shoes for underprivileged children around the world.

Hunter's resume includes numerous national honors including an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service, the 2009 Giant Steps Award from the National Consortium for Academics and Sport (NCAS), a Minority Achievement Award from the Center for Leadership Development (CLD) and the 2018 Gene Bartow Award.

He was one of seven head coaches who served on the Division I Basketball Academic Enhancement Group, as appointed by late NCAA President Myles Brand, and he is a member of the National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) Board of Directors. He served as President of the NABC in 2015-16 and served on an ad hoc committee to the NCAA Selection Committee in 2016-17.

He was honored by the American Diabetes Association in May 2015 as its Father of the Year and a week later earned the Positive Collegiate Coach of the Year at the Georgia Positive Athlete Awards.
