### Wave Looking to Defend Title

Tulane makes its return to BayCare Ballpark Tuesday after claiming the 2023 tournament title with a dramatic run from the bracket's seven seed.

The team defeated ECU 8-6 in the final to earn the AAC's automatic bid with a 19-40 overall record.

Outfielder Teo Banks earned the tournament's Most Outstanding Player honor and was joined on the All-Tournament team by pitcher Dylan Carmouche, designated hitter Brennan Lambert and infielder Gavin Schulz.

### 2024 Turnaround the Nation's Best

Tulane's regular season win total jumped from 15 in 2023 to 31 a year

later.

That 16-victory improvement tied Florida State for the top spot nationally.

Tulane was picked ninth in the 2024 AAC Preseason Poll, a ranking based on the votes of the conference's 10 head coaches.

### Five Named All-Conference Selections by AAC Coaches

The American Athletic Conference announced its 2024 all-league teams and individual awards Monday and, in it, recognized five Tulane student-athletes.

Third baseman Gavin Schulz was named to the first team, utility player

Michael Lombardi, first baseman Brady Marget, second baseman Connor Rasmussen and catcher Colin Tuft earned a spot on the second team.

The awards were voted on by the league's 10 head coaches. The five selections are the most for the program since 2016 (seven).

Schulz was one of two Tulane players (Marget) to start all 55 games this season, hitting .306 with 10 homers and 44 RBI. He also saw significant time in the outfield this season for Tulane.

Lombardi was a two-way player for the Green Wave, hitting .287 with two homers and 21 RBI at the plate. On the mound, he went 4-3 with a 3.41 ERA, striking out 49 in 37 innings.

Marget led the team in batting average (.330), hits (72), RBI (50) and total bases (110).

Rasmussen was second on the team in batting average (.317) with six homers and 46 RBI and paced the team with six sacrifice flies.

Tuft, who also played some in the outfield this season, was the team leader in runs scored (61), walks (42) and stolen bases (12). His batting average on the season was .269.

### Tonight's Pitching Matchup

Tulane RHP Chandler Welch (6-3, 4.58 ERA) will face Florida Atlantic RHP C.J. Williams (5-4, 3.39 ERA).

In the April 19 meeting between the two teams in Boca Raton, Williams hurled a complete game shutout, limiting the Green Wave to five hits and two walks with five strikeouts in a 111-pitch effort. Tulane then won on Saturday and Sunday to take the series.

### Last Time Out

The Tulane baseball team saw its 7-0 lead evaporate in the late innings of Friday's series finale at Charlotte but gathered itself and rebounded for a 10-8 win in 10 innings to take its final regular season series of 2024.

Tulane goes into next week's American Athletic Conference Tournament at 31-24 overall and finished its league slate at 15-12.

Charlotte fell to 23-32 and 12-15 in the league.

The Green Wave overcame 19 stranded runners with 15 hits, including three by second baseman

Connor Rasmussen and two each from center fielder Teo Banks, first baseman Brady Marget, third baseman Gavin Schulz and shortstop Marcus Cline. Rasmussen, Cline and catcher Colin Tuft scored twice.

The 49ers received three RBI from left fielder Thad Ector and pair of hits by left fielder Carson Bayne, shortstop Dante DeFranco and catcher Kaden Hopson.

A combined 15 pitchers (Charlotte 9, Tulane 6) were used during the game.

Green Wave reliever Will Clements (2-2) got the team's final five outs to get the win. 49ers reliever Joseph Taylor (2-4) took the loss as he was responsible for the ninth and 10th Tulane tallies.

After getting its third quality start in as many games, this time from Billy Price (6.0 IP, 4H, 0R, 4Ks), Tulane enjoyed a 7-0 lead heading to the bottom of the seventh.

However, the home team woke up and answered with eight runs of its own (three in the eighth, five in the ninth) and needed to record just three outs for the victory.

That's when Schulz plated Tuft with a run-scoring bunt single and Rasmussen and Banks followed with RBI in the 10th for the game's final margin.

### Wave is Offensive in 2024

The Green Wave leads the AAC in total bases (896) and home runs (80) and is second in runs scored (392), doubles (107), walks (271), sacrifice hits (31), slugging percentage (.477), triples (12) and RBI (372). In league games, Tulane was also second in the hit by pitch category (46).

In 2024, the Green Wave is 24-2 when it outhits the opposition and 22-6 when it allows five runs or less.

### Good Early Starts Paying Off

The Green Wave is 20-7 this season when it scores first and 22-2 when leading after the fifth inning.

### Tuft a Scoring Machine

Tulane catcher Colin Tuft has been big on the basepaths for the Green Wave. He has 35 runs scored and 24 walks in conference play, figures that stood first and second, respectively in the conference's league games only statistics. He was also second in the hit by pitch category (10) and stolen bases (9).



### **Linn, Welch Earn Weekly Honors**

The American Athletic Conference has announced the winners of the league's weekly baseball honors (Player of the Week, Pitcher of the Week) for the penultimate week of the regular season.

Jackson Linn helped lead the Green Wave to sweep over first-place East Carolina by hitting .467 (7-15) with five runs scored, four home runs and five runs driven in last week. In Sunday's game, he hit two home runs, including a game-tying two-run shot in the eighth inning before scoring the winning run in the 10th inning.

Chandler Welch earned the win the Green Wave's 7-3 win on Saturday against East Carolina, pitching 7.1 innings with six strikeouts and three runs given up.

### **Welch Named AAC Pitcher of the Week**

Tulane junior pitcher Chandler Welch was named American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week on Monday following a spectacular showing by the Slidell native on Saturday.

Welch was dominant in the 6-2 win over Northwestern as he registered a career-high 10 strikeouts to lift the Green Wave to its first victory of the season. He allowed just one hit and a hit batter in the five-inning, 78-pitch effort.

Also earning recognition was second baseman Connor Rasmussen for the AAC Honor Roll. The Fort Mill, S.C. native hit .444 this week (4-for-9) with three runs scored and seven RBI. He also posted an on-base percentage of .571 and a slugging percentage of .889 with eight assists and no errors. Unquestionably, his biggest moment of the weekend came in Sunday's rubber match with the Wildcats when he blasted a grand slam over the wall in right center to clinch the series victory.

### **Green Wave Opens 2024 Campaign Against Northwestern**

Tulane Baseball, fresh off its 2023 American Athletic Conference championship, will kick off its 2024 season at home with a three-game weekend series against Northwestern on the newly-refurbished Greer Field at Turchin Stadium.

The two teams will square off Friday at 6:30, followed by games at 2 and 1 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, respectively. The games will all be streamed on ESPN+ with a trio of individuals handling the Tulane Sports Network from Learfield radio call on 88.3 FM WRBH. Voice of the Green Wave Corey Gloor will call the action on Friday, while Paul Boron will handle Saturday before handing it off to Tulane Athletics Hall of Famer Todd Graffagnini on Sunday. Airtime for all three games is 15 minutes before first pitch.

On Friday, there will be a team poster and schedule can giveaway to the first 500 fans.

Sunday will be Riptide's Kids Club Day. Kids Club members will receive free admission and there will be a giveaway of collectible Tulane Baseball cards. A postgame autograph session with Michael Lombardi, Wes Burton, Chris Diaz, Tracy Mitchem, Jacob Moore and head coach Jay Uhlman will also be held on the concourse behind home plate.

The Green Wave, which boasts the Preseason AAC Player of the Year in outfielder Teo Banks, will start UCLA transfer Jake Saum on Friday. The 5-11 lefthander went 7-2 during his time with the Bruins, sporting an earned run average of 4.31 with 74 strikeouts and 37 walks in 64 and two-thirds innings. He yielded a .243 batting average against.

The Wildcats will counter with a lefty of their own in Nolan Moor on Friday. The Colebrook, Connecticut native went 2-1 last season with a 12.81 ERA in 19 and two-thirds innings. He posted 19 strikeouts and nine free passes in 2023.

Tulane will start righty Chandler Welch on Saturday. The junior from Slidell, LA went 4-5 last season, whiffing 62 batters against 17 walks in 58 innings.

Northwestern will send Matt McClure to the hill for its second game. The Rancho Santa Margarita, California native is coming off a 2023 season that saw him go 1-6 with a 6.71 ERA in 59 innings. He also struck out 38 and walked 25.

On Sunday, the Green Wave will start 6-5 junior Will Clements. Clements hails from The Woodlands, Texas and led McLennan Junior College to the JUCO World Series a year ago, boasting an ERA of 3.50 to go with his 8-2 record in 81 and two-thirds innings. He also fanned 68 batters.

Northwestern's Sunday starter has not yet been named.

The Wildcats went 10-40 overall last season and 4-20 in the Big Ten. New head coach Ben Greenspan was hired on August 18, 2023 after serving as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator for Michigan in 2023.

# JAY UHLMAN

## HEAD COACH | 53-70

## Second Season | Nevada, 1997

Jay Uhlman was named the 25th head coach of the Tulane Baseball Program on June 7, 2022. He was named to the post after three seasons where he filled the jobs of assistant coach, recruiting coordinator, and interim head coach.

A veteran with more than 26 years of experience in four different conferences including the PAC12, BIG12, AAC, and the WAC, the Redondo Beach, California native was promoted after he led the Green Wave to the AAC Tournament Semifinals to close the 2022 campaign.

In 2023, Uhlman rallied his troops with a dynamic run from the bracket's seven seed in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, culminating with the program's first AAC tourney title (ninth overall) and 16th overall conference championship. The Olive and Blue became the lowest seed to ever win the AAC Tournament. The following weekend, Tulane took part in its 22nd NCAA Regional, this one coming in Baton Rouge. At season's end, the Green Wave saw pitcher Dylan Carmouche selected in the 15th Round by the San Francisco Giants and received the ABCA Academic Excellence Award. Tulane was one of just 11 teams in Division I to receive the honor for seven consecutive years.

He is responsible for the 2020-2021 class ranked 25th by Perfect Game, the highest-ranked class at Tulane since 2003, 36th by Collegiate Baseball.

Uhlman has spent time coaching in the junior college ranks while also having stints in the Western Athletic Conference, Pac 12, Big 12 conferences before settling into the AAC. During his career, Uhlman has coached and recruited 117 all-conference honorees, 29 All-Americans, eight conference players of the year, 29 big leaguers and 13 USA Collegiate National Team alums.

Uhlman made the move to the Big Easy in July of 2019. In his first season on the Green Wave staff, Uhlman helped guide Tulane to a 15-2 mark during the 2020 campaign – Tulane's best start to a season since 1972. Tulane's 15 wins at the end of the shortened season were tied for the most in the American Athletic Conference. In addition, Tulane had five players with a batting average of .300-or-better.

Uhlman arrived at Tulane after spending the previous nine seasons as a member of the University of Oregon staff where he was the associate head coach for the last three seasons. During his time in Eugene, the Ducks accumulated 328 wins, with 136 coming over Pac 12 opponents, to post a .606 overall winning percentage.

During his tenure with the Ducks, Uhlman was a part of a program that won 60 percent of their games, including a three-year stretch with 40-plus victories from 2012-14. In 2013, Oregon won a program-record 48 games and finished second in the league with a 22-8 record, as the Ducks qualified for the NCAA Tournament for four consecutive years, twice being selected as an overall national seed and hosting an NCAA Super Regional in 2012.

In six of his nine seasons with Oregon, Uhlman's classes were consistently ranked in the top 40 by Perfect Game, including bringing in a host of players that went on to earn 16 All-America and 39 All-Pac 12 honors. During that time Oregon had a player named as a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year three times, two semifinalists for the Dick Howser Trophy, and three semifinalists for the Golden Spikes Award.

Fifty-five (55) of Uhlman's Oregon players went on to play professionally, with two being first-round picks in the MLB Draft. Fifteen (15) of those have gone on to play in the majors.

For one season in 2011, Uhlman served as the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kansas, helping pull in a class that Perfect Game ranked 32nd nationally. He served as the Jayhawks' hitting coach and worked on the offense, as four players earned All-Big 12 honors and six were Big 12 All-Academic picks and six were drafted one went on to reach the big leagues.

Uhlman began his tenure at Oregon in the summer of 2009, when he served as the Ducks' volunteer assistant coach, working with the hitters and organizing on-campus recruiting efforts. In the program's second year as a varsity sport after being dormant for 28 years, Oregon tied the NCAA record for turnaround wins in a season, going from 14 in that first year back in 2009, to 40 in 2010. Oregon also went from winning four games in conference to 13, qualifying for the NCAA Storrs Regional.

In 2001, Uhlman returned to Nevada, his alma mater, as an assistant. He served as the hitting and infield coach while assisting with recruiting efforts. Nevada qualified for the WAC Tournament for four straight years, from 2006-2009, finishing second in the league three times.

Forty-two (42) Wolf Pack players were All-WAC selections, five were tabbed All-Americans, with three players earning WAC Freshman of the Year to go along with two others earning WAC Player of the Year. During his stint, 41 players went on to play professionally, with 13 receiving the call from a major league club.

Uhlman finished his degree from Nevada in 1998 while serving as a graduate assistant for the Wolf Pack. He then moved on to be an assistant coach at L.A. Harbor Junior College. In 1999 he became the head coach for two seasons at LAHC, eventually finishing with an overall record of 61-22-2 and 35-15 in the South Coast Conference.

In 2001 Uhlman's Seahawks went 33-6-1 on the season and 20-4 in the SCC to claim the league and regional championship, as he was named the conference's coach of the year. 24 total players were named All-SCC, including having the conference pitcher of the year among six All-California Community College Athletic Association picks and two All-Americans.

An All-CIF performer at Redondo Union High School, Uhlman culminated his prep career by being drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays. Uhlman moved on to LAHC where he was a two-time all-conference and All-Southern California shortstop.

He then finished his collegiate career playing at Nevada in 1995 and 1997. Uhlman was an honorable mention All-Big West Conference selection as a shortstop in 1997. The Wolf Pack led the NCAA in double plays and double plays per game during Uhlman's senior season advancing to the Lubbock Regional before the NCAA tournament expanded to 64 teams.
