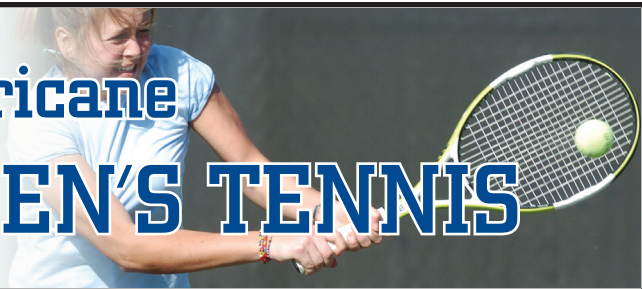

DEAN ORFORD WINS ITA CENTRAL REGION COACH OF THE YEAR

University of Tulsa women's tennis head coach Dean Orford was named the Central Region Head Coach of the Year on May 15th by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association.

Orford led the women's tennis team to a 23-6 record this season, marking the most wins in a single season in school history. The Hurricane also made its third consecutive NCAA appearance, after finishing second at the Conference USA Women's Tennis Championship. It is the first time in Orford's career to win the ITA regional head coach of the year honor.

TULSA FALLS TO NO. 28 TCU 4-1 IN NCAA FIRST ROUND

The 36th-ranked Tulsa women's tennis team dropped a 4-1 decision to 28th-ranked TCU in the first round of the NCAA Tennis Championships on May 9th in Fayetteville, Ark.

TCU won the doubles point with victories in the top two flights. Anastasia Erofeeva and Jie Zeng fell to Kayla Duncan and Katariina Tuohimaa, 8-4, in the No. 2 position first, followed by Thalia Diaz-Barriga and Marta Marcinkowska dropping a tough 8-6 decision to 39th-ranked Macall Harkins and Anna Sydorska in the top slot. Alexandra Kichoutkin and Rebecca Row's match against Nina Munch-Soegaard and Idunn Hertzberg in the third position was left unfinished after the Horned Frogs clinched the point, with the match tied 8-8.

The Horned Frogs pushed the lead to 2-0 with 90th-ranked Macall Harkins defeating junior Jie Zeng, 6-1, 6-2, in No. 2 singles. Freshman Ewa Szatkowska earned Tulsa's only point with a 6-2, 6-2, win over Gaby Mastromarino in the sixth position, cutting the lead to 2-1.

TCU responded with Idunn Hertzberg topping junior Rebecca Row, 6-4, 6-4, in the No. 5 slot, and Kayla Duncan completed the 4-1 win with a 7-5, 6-4, victory over freshman Anastasia Erofeeva in the fourth position.

TULSA FINISHES SEASON RANKED NO. 36 IN ITA NATIONAL POLL

The Hurricane completed the 2009 season ranked No. 36 in the final national team poll released on May 22nd by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association. Tulsa advanced to the NCAA tournament for the third-straight season and finished second at the Conference USA Championship.

KICHOUTKIN/MARCINKOWSKA RANKED IN FINAL NATIONAL DOUBLES POLL

Sophomore Alexandra Kichoutkin and Marta Marcinkowska finished the season ranked No. 84 in the final ITA National Doubles poll released on May 29th. The duo went 7-4 on the season including a win over Arkansas' Nanar Airapetian and Anouk Tigu, who finished the season ranked No. 16 in the country.

HURRICANE SETS SINGLE-SEASON WINS RECORD WITH 23 VICTORIES

Tulsa finished the 2009 season with a 23-6 record, setting a new school record for most wins in a single season. The previous record was set by the 2008 team that finished with a 22-6 record. It also marks the third consecutive season that the Golden Hurricane has won at least 20 matches.

THREE PLAYERS NAMED TO ALL-CONFERENCE TEAMS

Sophomore Alexandra Kichoutkin, senior Thalia Diaz-Barriga and freshman Anastasia Erofeeva were all named to All-Conference USA teams as voted on by league coaches and announced on April 29th.

Kichoutkin was named to the all-C-USA first team after going 25-10 in singles action, including a 19-6 record during the duel campaign. Kichoutkin was 4-1 against conference opponents this year with one of those victories coming against then 68th-ranked Kellie Schmitt of Marshall in the Conference USA Women's Tennis Championship semifinals.

Thalia Diaz-Barriga earned second team honors after compiling a 23-12 singles record and a 20-6 mark this spring. Freshman Anastasia Erofeeva was named to the third team after posting a 31-6 singles record, which includes a team-best 23 wins during the duel season.

DIAZ-BARRIGA NAMED TO C-USA ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM

The University of Tulsa's Arnau Bruges and Thalia Diaz-Barriga were selected to the 2009 Conference USA All-Academic Team as announced on April 15th by the league office. The teams consisted of six men and seven women student-athletes who earned at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average and are a regular participant on their team.

Diaz-Barriga makes her first appearance on the all-academic team after posting a 3.58 GPA in marketing and being named to the TU Dean's List this past fall. The Cordoba, Veracruz, Mexico native finished with a 23-12 singles record this season, marking the third-straight season that she has won 20 or more singles matches.

DIAZ-BARRIGA FINISHES IN SECOND PLACE ON ALL-TIME DOUBLES LIST

Thalia Diaz-Barriga finished her career second on the school's all-time career doubles chart with 86 victories. She fell two doubles wins shy of tying Aleksandra Durska (1999-2003) for the top spot with 88 career victories.

DIAZ-BARRIGA CLAIMS FOURTH PLACE ON ALL-TIME SINGLES LIST

Senior Thalia Diaz-Barriga defeated Kunigunda Dorn of Kansas, 7-5, 6-1, on March 7th, to take sole possession of fourth place on Tulsa's all-time career singles wins list with 74 victories, surpassing Anousjka van Exel (1997-1999).

The Cordoba, Veracruz, Mexico, native finished her career at 82 career singles victories after picking up eight wins in Tulsa's last 12 matches.

FANTASTIC FRESHMEN HELP TO LEAD THE HURRICANE

Tulsa received a significant boost from the play of its freshmen class this season. Anastasia Erofeeva, Yulia Gavenko, Ewa Szatkowska and Caroline Beaulieu have combined for a 64-22 singles record and a 38-24 doubles mark this season.

The freshman class has accounted for 41 percent of the team's singles victories and 57 percent of the team's doubles wins.

Erofeeva led the team with a 31-6 singles record, including a 23-4 record during the duel season. Her 23 duel singles wins were the most on the team this season. The Moscow, Russia, native had her season-high 12-match winning streak snapped against LSU's Hannah Robinson on March 18th.

ANASTASIA EROFEEVA RANKS THIRD ON SINGLE-SEASON WINS LIST

Freshman Anastasia Erofeeva had a terrific freshman season for the Golden Hurricane, compiling a 31-6 singles record which ties her for the third-most wins in a single-season in school history.

Erofeeva is tied with Alicia Pillay who posted two 31-win campaigns during the 2001-02 and 2002-03 seasons, and Anousjka van Exel who achieved the feat during the 1998-99 season.

A SWEEPING TREND

Tulsa was dominant in 10 of its 23 wins this season, winning those 10 contests without dropping a single point. The Hurricane picked up 7-0 sweeps over UALR, Saint Louis, Arkansas State, Seminole State, Oklahoma Baptist and Houston. They earned 4-0 wins over Oral Roberts, 54th-ranked Washington State, Kansas State and UCF.

TULSA FALLS IN C-USA CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS TO #23 SMU, 4-1

The second-seeded Tulsa women's tennis team lost to top-seeded SMU, 4-1, in the Conference USA Women's Tennis Championship title match on Sunday April 19, at the Jake Hess Tennis Stadium in Houston, Texas. The 38th-ranked Hurricane came up short of winning its third-straight conference championship to the 23rd-ranked SMU Mustangs.

Tulsa fell behind early losing the doubles point with losses in the bottom two positions. Anastasia Erofeeva and Jie Zeng lost to 74th-ranked Natalia Buben and Pavi Francis, 8-2, in the second flight, and Alexandra Kichoutkin and Rebecca Row dropped an 8-2 decision to Nicole Briceno and Kseniia Tokarieva in the No. 3 position.

The Mustangs pushed its lead to 2-0 with Kneniia Tokarieva's 6-0, 6-1, win over freshman Ewa Szatkowska in No. 6 singles, but freshman Anastasia Erofeeva breezed past Pavi Francis, 6-0, 6-1, in the No. 4 position to cut the lead to 2-1.

However, that was the closest Tulsa would get as senior Thalia Diaz-Barriga lost to 110th-ranked Aleks Malyarschikova, 6-1, 6-0, in No. 3 singles, and sophomore Alexandra Kichoutkin dropped a 6-2, 6-2, decision to 60th-ranked Marta Lesniak in the No. 1 slot to complete the 4-1 SMU victory.

COACH ORFORD REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

In just four seasons at the helm of the women's tennis program, Head Coach Dean Orford has cemented himself as one of the best women's tennis head coaches in school history. Orford owns the school record for all-time win percentage with .734 after compiling an 80-29 record over the last four seasons.

This season, Orford was named the ITA Central Region Head Coach of the Year after leading the team to a 23-6 record this season, marking the most wins in a single season in school history. The Hurricane also made its third consecutive NCAA appearance, after finishing second at the Conference USA Women's Tennis Championship. It is the first time in Orford's career to win the ITA regional head coach of the year honor.

Orford moved into second place on the all-time women's tennis wins list with 57 career victories after going 22-6 last season. He surpassed current men's tennis head coach Vince Westbrook who finished his women's tennis coaching career with 52 victories back in 1998. Paige McMurray sits a top the list with 104 career victories, which she set between 1998 and 2005.
