Looking Ahead

Tulsa returns home to the Reynolds Center after their four-match road trip for a pair of weekend matches against Tulane on Friday before taking on Houston Sunday. The Hurricane went five sets in their previous meeting with both the Green Wave and the Cougars, falling to Tulane in the fifth set after rallying to win the fourth and fifth sets to defeat Houston two days prior.

The Hurricane will look to even the all-time series against Tulane once again after the Green Wave took a 14-13 series lead on their 27th meeting on Oct. 2. Tulane is led by the duo of Sarah Ray and Justine Bowers, who rank third in the AAC in kills and first in assists, respectively.

TU holds a 15-7 series lead on Houston dating back to 2005 and have won two of the last three, with each road team coming away with victories in the previous three match-ups.

Last Time Out

The Hurricane dropped their sixth and seventh straight matches as they fell in a pair of road contests to UCF and USF last weekend. Despite being swept by the Knights, Tulsa played all three sets tough in a tightly contested match as every set was decided by just two points. After dropping the opening set against USF on Sunday, the Hurricane responded with a dominant 25-15 set win but could not repeat in the following two sets. Tulsa recorded a .242 hitting-percentage in the match, their highest in a match since they tallied a .250 in a win over Oral Roberts on Sept. 16.

Sophomore Rachel Moore hit .611 with 12 kills as one of three different Hurricane attackers to reach double-digit kills while the TU defense had four different players record double-digit digs against USF.

Pink Out Match

Tulsa will play their annual "Pink Out Match" for Breast Cancer Awareness on Friday as they take on Tulane. TU won their "Pink Out Match" against UConn last season in a five-set battle after defeating SMU the season prior. The first 75 fans will receive a white and pink 'Cane rally towel.

Rating Percentage Index (RPI)

Tulsa fell 11 spots down from 68 to 79 on the latest NCAA RPI that was released on Monday. The Hurricane rank fifth among American Athletic Conference competition on the index, who as a conference ranks sixth nationally with five teams in the top 80.

Double-Doubles

Senior outside hitter Rebecca Reeve recorded her 10th double-double of the season on Friday as she compiled 10 kills and 13 digs in the Hurricane loss to UCF on the road. Through 22 matches this season, Reeve has tallied double-digit kills 15 times and double-digit digs 14 times, posting a season high of 17 and 23, respectively.

2,000 Club

Senior libero Brooke Berryhill became the second Hurricane player in program history to reach 2,000 career digs in the first set against Cincinnati on Sept. 22 in the Reynolds Center. Berryhill currently sits second on the all-time career digs list at TU with 2,180 digs, 257 digs behind Jessica Adams' (2009-12).

New Number Two

Senior outside hitter Erica Bohannon moved into sole possession of second all-time on TU's career kills list on her very first swing against Temple on Friday afternoon, passing Kristien Van Lierop's (1997-00) mark of 1,510 career kills. Bohannon currently sits at 1,587 kills in her career. Earlier in the season, Bohannon moved into second all-time on Tulsa's list for total attempts and currently sits at 4,352.

Tulsa Volleyball Invitational

The Hurricane won their third tournament title in as many weeks, going 3-0 at the Reynolds Center on Sept. 16-17 as they wrapped up non-conference tournament play. On Friday evening, Tulsa defeated cross-town rival Oral Roberts 3-1 behind Erica Bohannon's match-high 22 kills and 30 digs from Brooke Berryhill. In their first match on Saturday morning, the Hurricane defense held Northwestern State to a .052 hitting-percentage while racking up 96 digs. In a battle for the weekend crown later in the day, Tulsa rallied from behind in the first two sets to jump out to a 2-0 lead in the match before closing Louisiana Tech out in a dominant fourth set, 25-14.

A-State Invitational

Tulsa earned their second weekend tournament title in as many weeks, going 3-0 at the A-State Invitational in Jonesboro, Ark. on Sept. 9-10. The Hurricane swept UT-Martin on Friday morning before defeating Central Arkansas in four sets to set up the tournament deciding match on Saturday with host Arkansas State. Tulsa held off a push from the Red Wolves in the second set on their way to completing the sweep in a match in which all three sets were decided by two points.

Fresh Faces

This year's Golden Hurricane squad has a mix of youth and experience as three freshmen are providing impact along with six seniors. Newcomers Taylor Horsfall and Mariah Pardo have seen action in all 86 sets this season while Haley Coulter has played in 60. Horsfall is fourth on the team in digs (208), while Pardo and Coulter have added 387 assists and 117 kills, respectively.

Creeds and Crests Classic

Tulsa won their first weekend tournament title of the season after going 3-0 at the Creeds and Crests Classic Sept. 2-3, earning wins over Kennesaw State, Stephen F. Austin, and Texas State. TU racked up 102 digs against Stephen F. Austin on Friday while senior libero Brooke Berryhill compiled 33 digs in the match on her way to being named The American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Week. Berryhill was named to the all-tournament team along with fellow seniors Erica Bohannon and Rebecca Reeve, who was named MVP of the weekend.

Hurricane Classic

Tulsa finished play at the Hurricane Classic on Aug. 26-27 with a 2-1 record, earning wins over Incarnate Word and Alabama before dropping the final game to South Dakota. TU's win over Incarnate Word in the season opener marked the seventh time in the last nine seasons that Tulsa has won their opening game. In the Friday nightcap, the Hurricane bested Alabama for the second consecutive year in a five-set thriller that saw TU win the fifth set of a tightly contested match, 17-15. Both squads were effective on the attack as Tulsa hit .303, including a .462 attacking percentage in the first set before hitting .447 in the third to grab a 2-1 match advantage. Senior Brooke Berryhill was named the all-tournament selection for the Hurricane.

Home Sweet Home

Tulsa returns home to the Donald W. Reynolds Center this weekend for the Tulsa Volleyball Invitational. TU has posted a 107-38 record at the Reynolds Center dating back to the 2005 season, helping to make it the most-winningest era in program history. In 2010, the Hurricane finished with a perfect 11-0 mark at home and followed it up with a 9-1 home record in 2011. Tulsa went 18-5 at the Reynolds Center in 2012 before tallying a 16-4 mark in 2013 and a 13-3 mark in 2014. The Golden Hurricane finished last season with a 5-10 record on their home floor.
