### THE SERIES

This is the first meeting between Tulsa and New Orleans.

### QUICK HITS

- Tulsa is playing its 106th season of basketball in 2016-17.
- Tulsa Head Coach Frank Haith is in his third season at Tulsa, and has led the Hurricane to 20 wins and a postseason appearance in each season.
- Seven players made their debut for the Golden Hurricane in the season opener . . . newcomers accounted for 56 of Tulsa's 73 points.
- Tulsa features three players on its roster that appeared in a game at TU prior to this season – Pat Birt, TK Edogi and Sterling Taplin.
- Tulsa has 10 newcomers to its roster, including two juniors, one sophomore and five freshmen.
- Tulsa is in its third season as a member of the American Athletic Conference.
- The Tulsa schedule features up to 10 opponents that played in the NCAA or NIT tournaments in 2016, six of which participated in the NCAA Tournament. (includes potential opponents in the Diamond Head Classic)
- In two seasons as a member of The American, TU finished second and tied for third place in the regular season, respectively.
- For the third straight year, all of Tulsa's conference games and non-conference home games will be televised on an ESPN network or CBS Sports Network.

**LAST TIME OUT**

Tulsa fell at Wichita State, 80-53, on Wednesday in Wichita . . . senior guard Pat Birt led the Golden Hurricane with 17 points, three 3-pointers and four assists . . . junior guard Corey Henderson Jr. tallied nine points and junior forward Junior Etou grabbed nine rebounds . . . Wichita State held a 52-30 advantage on the boards and shot 43 percent from the field, while TU shot 33 percent on field goals . . . Wichita State ed 21-10 with 11:38 to play in the first half . . . Will Magnay and Lawson Korita made consecutive baskets to spark a 10-2 Tulsa run to cut the deficit to 23-20 with 7:34 remaining in the first half . . . WSU used a 14-0 run to extend its lead to 37-20, but Tulsa cut it to 37-27, and WSU led 44-30 at the half . . . in the second half, TU cut it to 55-43 with 11:58 to play on an Edogi layup, but the Shockers went on a 16-0 run to take a 71-43 lead, and won, 80-53.

**FRANK HAITH IN THIRD SEASON AT TULSA**

Frank Haith is in his third year as head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa, where he has compiled a 43-25 record . . . he has 30 years of collegiate coaching experience, and is in his 13th year as a head coach . . . he has averaged 20.6 wins in his 12 seasons as head coach, while compiling an overall 248-154 on-court record for a .617 winning percentage . . . 10 of his 12 teams have advanced to postseason competition.

In his first season at TU in 2014-15, Haith led the Golden Hurricane to a 23-11 record and an appearance in the second round of the NIT. TU finished second in the American Athletic Conference with a 14-4 record, and advanced to the semifinals of conference tournament. TU won 12 straight games during the season, and started conference play 10-0 – its best league start since 1968-69. The Hurricane won 20 games for the 22nd time in program history, and advanced to the postseason for the 28th time. TU also held 17 opponents below a .400 field goal percentage and collected eight road victories.

In his second season, TU won 20 games and reached the NCAA Tournament for the 16th time in program history, and the fourth time in Haith's head coaching career. The Hurricane tied for third in The American, and two players earned all-conference honors.

**TULSA IN 19TH YEAR AT THE REYNOLDS CENTER**

The 2016-17 campaign is the 19th for the Tulsa Golden Hurricane in the Donald W. Reynolds Center . . . the Hurricane has posted an overall 216-66 record in their home arena for a .766 winning percentage . . . Tulsa won its 100th game at the Reynolds Center on January 27, 2007 with a 70-66 win over SMU . . . TU won its 200th game at the Reynolds Center on Jan. 13, 2015 with a 66-58 victory over UConn . . . Tulsa completed the 2006-07 season with a 15-3 home mark, 2007-08 with an 18-2 record, 2008-09 with a 15-2 mark, 2009-10 with a 16-2 mark, 2010-11 with a 12-3 record, 2011-12 with a 10-5 record, 2012-13 with a 9-5 mark, 2013-14 with an 11-3 mark, 2014-15 with a 13-4 record, and 2015-16 with a 12-3 mark . . . in Tulsa's 216 wins, 141 have been by double digits . . . Tulsa has a 99-28 non-conference record for a .779 winning percentage . . . Tulsa has won 131 of its last 161 home games at the Reynolds Center . . . the Hurricane had a 28-game home-court non-conference winning streak snapped on December 30, 2008 against BYU . . . the loss also snapped an overall 18-game home winning streak . . . Tulsa won 23 straight home games from the 2008-09 season beginning with a 69-50 win over Marshall on Jan. 17th, until 2010, but the streak was snapped with a 93-86 loss against Memphis on Feb. 13, 2010.

**HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 50 PERCENT SHOOTING**

Tulsa has held 55 of 68 opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field in two seasons under head coach Frank Haith, including 27 under 40 percent from the field . . . the Hurricane has prevented its opponent from reaching 50 points nine times under Haith.

## HEAD COACH FRANK HAITH

### THIRD SEASON

### ELON '88

Frank Haith is in his third year as head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa.

He carries 30 years of collegiate coaching experience and 19 years of advancing to postseason competition. He has averaged 20.7 wins in his 12 full seasons as head coach, while compiling an overall 248-153 on-court record for a .618 winning percentage, including a 43-24 record at Tulsa. Ten of his 12 teams have advanced to postseason competition.

In his first season at TU in 2014-15, Haith led the Golden Hurricane to a 23-11 record and an appearance in the second round of the postseason NIT. Picked fifth in its first season of competition in the American Athletic Conference, TU finished second in the league with a 14-4 record, and advanced to the semifinals of The American Conference Championship. TU boasted a 12-game winning streak during the season, which included a 10-0 start to conference play – its best league start since 1968-69. The Hurricane won 20 games for the 22nd time in program history, and advanced to the postseason for the 28th time. TU also held 17 opponents below a .400 field goal percentage and collected eight road victories.

In his second season, TU reached the NCAA Tournament for the 16th time in program history, and the fourth time in Haith's head coaching career. The Hurricane tied for third in The American, and two players earned all-conference honors.

Haith, 51, was the 2012 Associated Press and USBWA National Coach of the Year, and was a National Coach of the Year finalist in 2005. He spent the previous 10 seasons as a head coach at Miami and Missouri. Haith has averaged 20.7 wins in his 11 years as a head coach, while compiling an overall 205-129 record for a .614 winning percentage and eight postseason tournament appearances entering his tenure at Tulsa.

His first seven seasons were spent at the University of Miami and the following three years at the University of Missouri, where he won a remarkable 76 games.

He has transitioned all three programs into new conferences, moving Miami from the Big East Conference to the ACC and Missouri from the Big 12 Conference into the SEC.

In his three seasons at Missouri, Haith's teams posted a 76-28 record, while advancing in consecutive seasons to the NCAA Tournament and moving to second round action in the postseason NIT in 2014. Haith became the fastest Mizzou head coach to post 50 wins and was the winningest coach at Missouri through two seasons with a 53-16 record for a .768 winning percentage. During Haith's tenure, Missouri posted a 10-7 record against top-25 teams, including a 5-5 mark vs. schools ranked among the top-10 nationally.

In his first of seven seasons at Miami, Haith guided the Canes to seven ACC victories and postseason play in 2004-05, and he was named a Naismith National Coach of the Year finalist and NABC District 6 Coach of the Year in 2005. Haith earned his degree from Elon University in 1988.

## THE 2016-17 GOLDEN HURRICANE

Tulsa returns five players from its roster last season, including just three who have seen game action at TU, and welcomed 10 newcomers to the team . . . 6'5" senior guard Pat Birt averaged 12.0 points per game and led the team with 78 3-pointers last year . . . 6'1" sophomore guard Sterling Taplin averaged 2.6 points per game, 6'8" junior forward TK Edogi is back on the court after redshirt season, and 5'11" senior guard Corey Haith looks to contribute in games after battling injuries last year . . . 6'8" junior forward Junior Etou is a potential impact player in the post coming off his redshirt season in 2015-16 after transferring from Rutgers.

Junior guards Corey Henderson Jr. and Jaleel Wheeler (both 6'4") transferred to TU from Blinn College and Kilgore College, respectively . . . Henderson spent his first season at Wichita State, and Wheeler was a NJCAA All-America honorable mention last year . . . 6'9" sophomore forward Geno Artison came to TU from the College of Southern Idaho . . . 6'5" sophomore guard Alex Foree joined the team after serving as a team manager last year, while Curran Scott will sit out this season after transferring from Charlotte.

Freshman guards Travis Atson, Joseph Battle and Lawson Korita pair with forwards Martins Igbanu and Will Magnay in the freshman class . . . Atson is a 6'5" guard from Brooklyn, N.Y., Battle is a 6'3" guard from Abbeville, S.C., Korita is a 6'5" guard from Little Rock, Ark., Igbanu is a 6'8" forward, who is a native of Lagos, Nigeria, and attended high school in Marietta, Ga., and Magnay is a 6'10" forward from Brisbane, Australia.

## THE SCHEDULE

Tulsa will play 12 non-conference games, with six of those at home, including in-state rival Oklahoma State, Pac-12 member Oregon State and former Missouri Valley Conference rival Illinois State . . . the six non-home games include road games at intracity rival Oral Roberts, and at Wichita State and Little Rock, both of which played in the NCAA Tournament last season . . . TU will play in the Diamond Head Classic in Honolulu, Hawai'i to conclude non-conference play, facing Stephen F. Austin in the first round, and either San Diego State or Southern Miss in the second round . . . the league schedule, which features nine home games and nine road contests, begins Dec. 31 against UConn at the Reynolds Center . . . the Hurricane will face UConn only at home and Temple only on the road, while playing home-and-away contests against SMU, Cincinnati, Houston, Memphis, East Carolina, Tulane, UCF and USF.
