Fast Break Points

- Tulsa is in its 108th season of basketball and fifth season in the American Athletic Conference.
- TU will return home for a 7 p.m. matchup against UT Arlington on Tuesday, Nov. 27 at the Reynolds Center. The Hurricane will then play its first true road game of the campaign at Utah on Saturday, Dec. 1.
- Tulsa has won all three previous meetings against the Mavericks, including an 80-75 overtime win when the teams last met back on Dec. 17, 2011, in Tulsa.
- Sterling Taplin averaged 15.0 points and 4.5 assists in Tulsa's two games in Las Vegas last week and was named to the Continental Tire Las Vegas Holiday Invitational All-Tournament Team.
- Tulsa is coming off a 79-69 setback to Southern Illinois in the consolation game of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Holiday Invitational last Friday night. Martins Igbanu led the way with 15 points in the loss.
- · With 37 assists already this season, Sterling Taplin has moved to 12th place on the program's all-time charts with 312. Taplin needs seven more assists to move into the program's top 10.
- Martins Igbanu leads the team in scoring and rebouding at 14.3 points and 5.8 rebounds per game this season.
- The Hurricane return three starters and eight letterwinners from last year's team, which went 19-12 overall and 12-6 to finish fourth in The American.
- Tulsa will play 13 games in 2018-19 against opponents that participated in the postseason last year. Seven of those matchups will come at home, including back-to-back contests against Oklahoma State (Dec. 5) and K-State (Dec. 8).
- TU has notched 46 league wins since joining The American, which ranks third behind only Cincinnati (57) and SMU (51) during that span (2014-present).
- Tulsa was picked to finish ninth in The American Preseason Poll. TU has finished better than its preseason prediction in all four seasons under head coach Frank Haith.

The Game

- Tulsa will return home to the Reynolds Center for a 7 p.m. matchup on Tuesday, Nov. 27 against UT Arlington.
- The game can be seen on ESPN3, while fans in the Tulsa area can tune to Big Country 99.5 FM with Bruce Howard and former Hurricane player J.R. Rollo on the call. Live audio from the game also can be found by using the Tuneln app.

Scouting the Mavs

- UT Arlington was picked to finish 11th in the 12-team Sun Belt Conference as the team replaced all five starters and nine lettermen from last year's team, which went 21-13 overall and 10-8 to finish fourth in the league a season ago.
- The Mavericks are led by Brian Warren's 17.2 ppg. The 5-foot-9 guard is shooting 43.4-percent from the field and he also paces the team with 3.2 assists per contest.
- Edric Dennis (14.7 ppg) and David Azore (10.2 ppg) also average in double figures to help the Mavs average 70.5 ppg. The team is shooting 40.2-percent from the field and 24.8-percent behind the arc.
- Like Tulsa, UT Arlington has found a way to get to the free-throw line early in the season. The Mavs average 23 attempts per game and are shooting 76.2-percent from the charity stripe.
- The Mavs are led by first-year head coach Chris Ogden, who played at Texas from 1999-2003. Ogden was coached by current TU head coach Frank Haith, who was an assistant on the Longhorns' bench from 2001-04.

The Series

- Tuesday's matchup will be the fourth all-time meeting between Tulsa and UT Arlington. The Hurricane has won all three previous meetings by an average of 15 points.
- All three previous meetings have come in Tulsa. The first matchup came on Dec. 17, 1966, with Tulsa taking a 107-74 victory, while the last meeting took place on Dec. 17, 2011, as the Hurricane won 80-75 in overtime.

A Tulsa Win Would ...

- Improve Tulsa's record to 5-2 on the season.
- Improve Tulsa's all-time record against UT Arlington to 4-0.
- Give Tulsa its second win over a Sun Belt school in as many games this season.
- Improve Tulsa's all-time record against current Sun Belt members to 28-8.

Last Time Out

- Southern Illinois shot 65.2-percent in the second half and went on a 15-0 run on its way to a 79-69 win last Friday night in the consolation game of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Holiday Invitational at Orleans Arena.
- Martins Igbanu led the way for the Golden Hurricane with 15 points and he was joined in double-figures by Curran Scott (11 points) and Elijah Joiner (10 points).
- TU was limited to 39.3-percent shooting over the final 20 minutes and 43.1-percent for the game.
- The Hurricane led by as much as five points in the first half and took a 51-46 advantage with 11:12 to play on Jeriah Horne's 3-pointer. However, the Salukis countered with their 15-0 run to take the lead for good.

Haith Enters Fifth Season at TU

- Head coach Frank Haith is in his fifth season at Tulsa, where he has compiled an 81-54 record and led the Golden Hurricane to a pair of postseason appearances during his tenure. Overall, he has an on-court record of 286-183 (.610) in his 15th season.
- Haith's 81 wins on the TU bench rank seventh in program history as he passed former Golden Hurricane coaches Bill Self (74), Tubby Smith (74), Francis Schmidt (73), Chet Benefiel (65) and John Phillips (61) on the charts last season.
- Haith's 19.3 wins per season at TU rank fifth among those who coached more than one season for the Hurricane.

Haith in Exclusive Coaching Company

- Head coach Frank Haith is the one of just two active Division I head coaches to take teams in four of the Power 6 conferences to the NCAA Tournament (Houston's Kelvin Sampson is the other). Haith guided Tulsa (The American) to the Big Dance in 2015, Missouri (SEC) in 2013, Missouri (Big 12) in 2012 and Miami (ACC) in 2008.
- In addition, Haith is one of just 24 active coaches that have taken at least three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.
- Haith and the Hurricane will face two other members of that list this season, when the team takes on Bruce Weber and Kansas State (Dec. 8) before two matchups with Sampson and Houston (Jan. 2 and Jan. 27).

The Schedule

- Tulsa will play 13 games in 2018-19 against opponents that participated in the postseason last season. Seven of those matchups will come at home, including back-to-back contests against Oklahoma State (Dec. 5) and Kansas State (Dec. 8).
- TU also will have six games against teams that open the season ranked or receiving votes in the AP Top 25. The first comes against preseason No. 6 Nevada (Nov. 22) on a neutral floor in Las Vegas. The Hurricane will host No. 12 Kansas State, while it will have matchups against UCF (Jan. 19) and Cincinnati (Jan. 10, Jan. 24), who each received votes to start the year.

Taplin Leads the Way

- Senior point guard Sterling Taplin has developed into one of the top point guards in The American and he was named preseason second-team all-conference in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- The East Amherst, N.Y., native is the team's leading returning scorer after he registered a career-best 11.8 ppg last season. He also set career bests with 3.7 rpg and 4.4 apg, which also ranked fourth in The American.
- Taplin's 11.8 ppg last season ranks 11th among returners in The American. In all, he set career highs last season in field goals (127), 3-pointers (38), points (354), rebounds (112) and assists (132).
- In addition, he has climbed to No. 12 on the program's career-assists charts with 312.

Tulsa's Success in The American

- Since joining the American Athletic Conference prior to the 2014-15 season, the Golden Hurricane has posted 46 league wins, which ranks third in the circuit during that time.
- Only Cincinnati (57 wins) and SMU (51 wins) have earned more victories than Tulsa's 46.
- TU has finished better than its preseason prediction in each of Haith's four seasons. Tulsa is the first program in The American history to finish better than its preseason prediction in four consecutive seasons. The Golden Hurricane was picked to finish ninth in the conference prior to the 2018-19 season.

Home Cookin'

- After hosting the first TU men's basketball game on Dec. 29, 1998, the Golden Hurricane is in its 21st season in the Donald W. Reynolds Center this year.
- Tulsa has posted an overall record of 243-72 (.771) in its 20+ seasons, including a 4-0 mark this season.
- The building has seen 42 sellouts and 1,869,955 fans have witnessed Tulsa basketball at the Reynolds Center.
- The Hurricane has won 19 of its last 21 games in the Reynolds Center, including nine straight victories.

Earning Degrees

- Frank Haith has made achievement in the classroom as much of a priority as success on the basketball court over his nearly 15 years as a head coach.
- During head coaching tenures at Miami, Missouri and Tulsa, 54 of the 58 (93.1-percent) seniors that have come through his programs have earned a degree.
- Since arriving at Tulsa, 14 of the program's 15 seniors (93.3-percent) have graduated, including Corey Haith, Corey Henderson Jr., Jaleel Wheeler and Junior Etou from last year's team.
- Additionally, Tulsa has had at least two student-athletes recognized on the American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team in each of Haith's four seasons. Last year, both Alex Foree and Curran Scott made the team, which honors student-athletes with at least a 3.0 GPA.

Dialing Long Distance

- Tulsa lit it up from behind the arc last season and totaled 247 3-pointers, which was the program's highest output since the 2007-08 campaign.
- Along with the most 3-pointers made in the Frank Haith era, TU also posted its best 3-point shooting percentage at .348. That mark was the best for the Hurricane since the 2011-12 team connected at a .384 clip.
- After hitting 188 treys in 2014-15, which was TU's first under Haith, the squad has seen an increase in 3-pointers made each season (2014-15/188; 2015-16/219; 2016-17/234; 2017-18/247).
- The Hurricane will be without its top two 3-point shooters from a season ago after the graduations of Corey Henderson Jr. (73) and Junior Etou (42).

Why Golden Hurricane?

Enter the name Howard Acher as the Tulsa head football coach in 1922. When he took over the position, Acher saw great potential in his team and wanted to publicize it by creating a new identity with a new nickname. Sports writers and others had called the school by any number of names from the Presbyterians to the Orange and Black, to the Kendallites.

After an opening day win against a strong Texas Christian University team in 1922, Acher put his mind to work. The press had claimed that the Kendall football team blew through its opponents like a tornado. So, it figured that Tornadoes would be the nickname with "golden" added to identify the color of the uniforms. However, it was later found that Georgia Tech had claimed that name, so from tornado it was evolved meteorologically to a hurricane. Thus the squad voted, and the name "Golden Hurricane" became the new team moniker with the gold added because of the jersey color.

Look Who's Back

- Tulsa returns eight letterwinners, including three starters, from last year's team, which went 19-12 and finished fourth in The American with a 12-6 league mark.
- Returning starters include senior point guard Sterling Taplin (30 starts), junior forward Martins Igbanu (23) and junior guard Lawson Korita (17).
- Other returners include senior guard/forward DaQuan Jeffries, senior forward Alex Foree, junior guard Curran Scott and sophomore guards Elijah Joiner and Darien Jackson.
- In all, Tulsa returns 56.3-percent of its scoring, 56.7-percent of its minutes, 48.9-percent of its rebounding, 69.5-percent of its assists and 59.7-percent of its steals.

Roster Experience

- Despite having seven newcomers on the roster for 2018-19, Tulsa features 11 players with Division I experience.
- Those 11 players have totaled 18 years of Division I experience, led by three years from senior Sterling Taplin.
- Even with the influx of newcomers, Tulsa is one of just seven Division I programs without a scholarship freshman on the roster. TU's only freshman is walk-on George Christopolous, who is redshirting this season.
- Counting walk-ons, TU is one of just seven Division I programs to have one or fewer total freshmen on their roster.

New Faces

- Along with the eight returning letterwinners, Tulsa has seven newcomers in addition to Jeriah Horne, who sat out the 2017-18 season after transferring from Nebraska.
- The newcomers eligible to make their debut for the Hurricane this season are Chris Barnes, Zeke Moore, Peter Hewitt, Jeriah Horne, Simon Falokun and walk-on Lindsay Deline Jr. Reggie Jones will sit out the 2018-19 campaign after transferring from Western Michigan and walk-on George Christopoulos will redshirt, as well.
- Of the six eligible to make their debut for TU, three student-athletes have Division I experience (Chris Barnes/UTEP, Jeriah Horne/Nebraska, Zeke Moore/Saint Louis), while Peter Hewitt redshirted at UC Davis in 2016-17.
- TU newcomers have totaled 103 points (20.6 ppq) so far this season, led by 38 points (6.3 ppq) from Jeriah Horne.

Exhibition Excellence

- Tulsa improved to 67-2 all-time in exhibition games with a 95-60 win over Division II Northeastern State on Nov. 2 in the Reynolds Center. It also marked the 38th straight exhibition victory for the Golden Hurricane.
- Curran Scott scored 16 points off the bench to lead a balanced scoring effort that saw nine Tulsa players tally at least eight points.
- Newcomer Simon Falokun was the only other player in double-figures with 14 points on 4-of-4 shooting and a 6-for-6 effort from the free-throw line. Falokun also had six rebounds and a pair of blocks.
- The Hurricane jumped out to a 30-5 lead and led by as much as 40 points midway through the second half.

Tulsa Signs Isaiah Hill to NLI

- Isaiah Hill, a 6-foot point guard from Bakersfield, Calif. (Liberty HS), signed a National Letter of Intent on Nov. 14, the first day of the early signing period, to join The University of Tulsa men's basketball program for the 2019-20 season.
- Hill is the highest-rated high school recruit in TU history, according to 247sports.com, which lists Hill as a three-star prospect and the No. 25 point guard recruit in the nation.
- He averaged 22 points, eight rebounds and six assists per game as a junior en route to first-team All-Area honors from the *Bakersfield Californian*.
- Hill played AAU ball for the Compton Magic, which is the same program that current TU guard Chris Barnes came out of.
- In addition, Hill was the starting quarterback for the Liberty HS football team as a sophomore and junior. He did not play as a senior to focus on his basketball career.

Frank Haith is in his fifth year as head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa.

Haith was named the program's 30th head coach on April 18, 2014. He carries more than 30 years of collegiate coaching experience and 19 years of advancing to postseason competition. His teams have averaged 20.1 wins in his 13 seasons as head coach, while compiling an overall 264-181 record (282-181 on-court mark) for a .593 winning percentage, including a 77-52 (.597) record at Tulsa. Ten of his 14 teams have advanced to postseason competition.

In his first season at TU in 2014-15, Haith led the Golden Hurricane to a 23-11 record and an appearance in the second round of the postseason NIT. The Hurricane, which was picked to finish fifth in its first season of competition in the American Athletic Conference, finished second in the league with a 14-4 record and advanced to the semifinals of the AAC Tournament. TU boasted a 12-game winning streak during the season, which included a 10-0 start to conference play — its best league start since 1968-69.

In just his second season, TU reached the NCAA Tournament for the 16th time in program history, and the fourth time in Haith's head coaching career. The Hurricane tied for third in The American, and for the second straight year, James Woodard and Shaquille Harrison earned all-conference honors.

Last season, Haith guided the Hurricane to 19 wins and a fourthplace finish in The American with a 12-6 conference mark. It was the fourth straight season that TU outperformed its preseason prediction. Junior Etou led the team in scoring and rebounding for the second consecutive campaign and earned all-conference accolades as the squad closed the campaign with eight wins over its final 10 games.

In all, Haith's Tulsa teams have compiled 20 wins, and advanced to the postseason in two of his first four seasons, while players have collected five all-conference honors. Additionally, Tulsa has notched 46 league wins under Haith (2014-present), which ranks third in the conference during that span.

Haith was the 2012 Associated Press and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Coach of the Year, while he also was a National Coach of the Year finalist in 2005. Before coming to Tulsa, he spent the previous 10 seasons as a head coach, including seven seasons at Miami (Fla.), followed by a three-year stint at Missouri.

Haith has transitioned all three programs into new conferences, moving Miami from the Big East Conference to the Atlantic Coast Conference and Missouri from the Big 12 Conference into the Southeastern Conference. Tulsa transitioned into the American Athletic Conference from Conference USA on July 1, 2014.

In his three seasons at Missouri, Haith's teams posted a 76-28 record and advanced to the postseason in all three campaigns with a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2012-13) along with a spot in the 2014 National Invitational Tournament. Haith became the fastest Mizzou head coach to post 50 wins and he was the winningest coach at Missouri through two seasons with a 53-16 record (.768).

His first team at Missouri was picked to finish fourth in the Big 12 preseason poll but went on to record a school-record 30 victories and claim the Big 12 Tournament crown before it earned a No. 2 seed in the 2012 NCAA Tournament. The Tigers' 14 league wins also were a program record before winning their second-ever Big 12 Tournament title.

Following the historic season, Haith received recognition in the form of numerous coaching accolades, highlighted by the prestigious Henry Iba National Coach of the Year and Associated Press National

Coach of the Year honors. He also was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and was the USBWA District VI Coach of the Year. As a first-year coach, Haith guided his team to more regular-season wins than any other Mizzou coach before him, and he became the first Tiger head coach since 1920-21 to win his first 14 games.

The Tigers followed that up with a 23-11 record and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2012-13 before a 23-12 mark in Haith's final season.

Missouri was the lone college basketball program in the 2012-13 season to advance to NCAA Tournament play with just one returning starter. Prior to Missouri's NCAA Tournament run that year, the Tigers enjoyed their second undefeated season in Mizzou Arena history, going 17-0 at home with wins over a pair of nationally-ranked opponents, including No. 5 Florida.

During Haith's tenure, Missouri posted a 10-8 record against top-25 teams, including five wins versus schools ranked among the top-10 nationally.

In his first of seven seasons at Miami, Haith guided the `Canes to seven ACC victories (despite being picked last) and qualified for postseason play in 2004-05. He was named a Naismith National Coach of the Year finalist and National Association of Basketball Coaches District 6 Coach of the Year in 2005.

Miami returned to postseason play in 2006 as the Hurricanes won 18 games and advanced to the quarterfinals of the NIT, recording the program's first postseason victories since 2000. Over his final four seasons, Haith's Miami squads averaged 21 wins per season, with four consecutive postseason trips, while three of the school's six all-time 20-win ledgers came under Haith. His Miami teams won six total games in the NCAA and NIT, including a memorable run to the second round of the Big Dance in 2008. The 'Canes went 23–11 in Haith's fourth season, just one win shy of the school record and he was named a finalist for ACC Coach of the Year and Skip Prosser Man of the Year honors.

During his time as a head coach, Haith's players were visible in the community, while he also saw an incredible 31-of-33 seniors walk across the stage to receive a diploma.

Haith paid his own way through Elon and graduated in 1988, while beginning his coaching career as a student assistant coach at the school in 1986. Haith helped the Phoenix twice win 20 games and he earned the opportunity to coach at Wake Forest in the 1989-90 season as a graduate assistant.

His first full-time coaching position on the Division I level came at UNC-Wilmington from 1990-92, and he then went on to a three-year stint at Texas A&M from 1992-95, in which he helped the Aggies reach postseason play in 1994.

A remarkable 21-win campaign during his lone season at Penn State (1995-96) allowed the Nittany Lions to reach the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 31 years, and he returned to Texas A&M and the Big 12 Conference for one season as the Aggies' Associate Head Coach in 1996-97. He then returned to Wake Forest for the 1997-98 season. The Demon Deacons reached postseason play each of his four years in Winston-Salem, including an NIT Championship in 2000 and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2001.

Haith parlayed that success at Wake Forest into an opportunity at Texas. Under Rick Barnes, Haith was, at the time, a part of the winningest three-year stretch in Texas Basketball history. The Longhorns averaged better than 24 wins per season and never failed to reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Longhorns advanced to the Final Four in 2003 and Haith worked magic on the recruiting trail, ushering four McDonald's All-Americans to Austin, including Brad Buckman (2002), LaMarcus Aldridge (2004), Daniel Gibson (2004) and Michael Williams (2004). Texas' 2004 recruiting class was rated No. 2 nationally by Rivals.com, while Aldridge became the No. 2 overall draft pick by the Chicago Bulls in the 2006 NBA Draft.

Born in Queens, N.Y., Haith spent most of his childhood growing up in Burlington, N.C. He is one of 11 siblings. Haith and his wife Pam have two children: Corey, and Brianna.
