Matilda Mossman Western Kentucky, 1979 Head Coach 10th Season

Matilda Mossman is in her 10th season at The University of Tulsa after being appointed as the head women's basketball coach on March 22, 2011. Mossman took over a five-win team and in just her second year won a conference championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

The 17-year collegiate head coaching veteran has transitioned the program from Conference USA to the American Athletic Conference.

In her first season at the helm of the program (2011-12), the Golden Hurricane posted 13 wins, and finished league play with an 8-8 record and a sixth-place finish. However, a year later, the program took another big step forward as the Hurricane captured the 2013 Conference USA tournament title, advanced to the NCAA Tournament and posted the first non-losing record (17-17) since 2006.

Mossman led Tulsa to an 18-14 mark in 2014-15, the school's first winning season since 2006. Tulsa advanced to the WNIT Second Round during that season.

During her tenure, Mossman has coached two-time all-Conference USA performer Taleya Mayberry, and helped Kelsee Grovey earn C-USA All-Freshman team accolades, as well as Mayberry, Grovey and Tiffani Couisnard receive C-USA All-Tournament team recognition in 2013. She also coached Ashley Clark to all-C-USA second team accolades as a sophomore, second team all-conference accolades and Sixth Man of the Year recognition as a junior in the American Athletic Conference, and third-team all-conference accolades as a senior; and Crystal Polk to third-team all-American Athletic Conference accolades in 2018-19.

In 18 years as a collegiate head coach, Mossman has registered an overall 262-255 record. She had a 67-27 mark at Arkansas (1981-84), an 80-66 mark at Kansas State (1984-89), and a 115-162 record in 10 seasons at Tulsa. She also coached on the high school level for nine seasons. In 23 years as a head coach, Mossman has compiled a 453-308 record for a .594 winning percentage.

She has two sons, Scott and Matt.

Facing UCF

- This is the 20th time that Tulsa and UCF will meet on the women's basketball court
- The Knights own a 12-7 lead in the all-time series, including a five-game winning streak
- The Knights are off to a 3-1 start this season, including a 66-62 win on Tuesday at Tulane in their only conference game
- Courtajia Sanders (12.3) and Diamond Battles (11.5) both average double-digit points for the Knights
- Destiny Thomas has a team-best 5.7 rebounds per game, Alisha Lewis has 17 assists, Sanders has 11 steals, and Thomas and Brittney Smith each have four blocks

In the Last Game

- Four players scored in double figures to lead Tulsa to a 69-62 win over Oklahoma State, including a team-best 16 points by freshman Wyvette Mayberry.
 Senior Rebecca Lescay added 15, junior-transfer Maya Mayberry scored 13 and junior Elin Hrafnkelsdottir added 10.
- This was TU's first win over a Big 12 opponent since topping the Cowgirls in 2005.

Wyvette Mayberry Named The American Freshman of the Week

- Wyvette Mayberry was named the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week on December 14.
- Mayberry made her collegiate debut a memorable one. She tallied a teamleading 16 points in just 11:25 off the clock against Oklahoma State.
- This was TU's first and only other Freshman of the Week honor since the 2016-17 season when Kendrian Elliott, Alexis Gaulden and Shug Dickson each earned the honor twice.

- Assistant Coach Taleya Mayberry played at Tulsa from 2009-13, and returned to her alma mater and joined the coaching ranks prior to the 2018-19 campaign
- This season, she is coaching two of her younger sisters, Maya, who is a juniortransfer from crosstown rival Oral Roberts, and Wyvette, who is a freshman this season

Destiny Johnson Hit her Stride After in February Last Season

- Destiny Johnson hit her stride in the last two months of the 2019-20
- She averaged 2.1 points per game leading up to the Memphis game (2-1-20),
 and then averaged 10.3 ppg in February and March
- Johnson tallied eight points against both Memphis and Cincinnati, 10 points against both Wichita State and Tulane, 15 points against UCF, 16 points against SMU, and 23 points against Houston.
- Johnson also had one steal in the first three months of the season, and had 12 in the final nine games; and similarly had 12 of her 13 assists in the final nine games of the year.

Back-to-Back-to-Back

- Desiree Lewis had back-to-back-to-back double-doubles during the 2018-19 season, making her the fifth player in school history to reach this milestone

- The 2020-21 predicted order of finish is USF, UCF, Tulane, Cincinnati, Temple, Wichita State, Houston, Memphis, ECU, SMU and Tulsa

Tulsa in The American Championship

A Hurricane in Tulsa?

The Origination of The University of Tulsa nickname - Golden Hurricane - was created in 1922. A new football coach, Howard Archer came to town and inherited a slew of nicknames dating back to 1895. In the past, Tulsa had been named "Kendallites," "Presbyterians," "Tigers," "Orange and Black," "Tulsans," and of course, "Yellow Jackets." The team started working out in the fall with a new nickname "Yellow Jackets" which was apparently due to the fact that the team was wearing new black and yellow uniforms. The team opened the season and it was apparent that Tulsa was going to have a great year, and trying to seize some publicity for his team, Archer wanted to find a new nickname quickly. After a remark was made in practice one day about "roaring through opponents," and because of their new jersey colors, he thought of "Golden Tornadoes." But a check showed that Georgia Tech already had chosen that tag in 1917. From the tornado, he evolved meteorologically to the hurricane. A few days before the team left for a game against Texas A&M, Archer asked the squad to vote on the name, and thus "Golden Hurricane" was born.
