A LOOK INTO THE TULSA PROGRAM

- Tulsa is in its 111th season of basketball and eighth season in the American Athletic Conference.
- Coach Frank Haith ranks third on the school's career coaching wins list behind Doug Wojcik (140) and Clarence Iba (137) with 129 wins.
- Heading into its eighth season as a member of the American Athletic Conference, Tulsa has the third most conference wins among league members with 74 victories, trailing only Cincinnati (90) and Houston (88) ... SMU is right behind Tulsa with 73 league wins in the past 7 years.
- Tulsa was picked to finish seventh in The American Athletic Conference preseason poll.
- Tulsa returns seven letterwinners and three starters from the team who went 11-12 and 7-9 in The American last season.
- Tulsa has eight newcomers, seven of whom are in their first season with the Golden Hurricane ... Jeriah Horne returns after a spending a year with the Colorado program ... Debuting newcomers are LaDavius Draine, Nikita Konstantynovskiy, Tim Dalger, Sam Griffin, Gavyn Elkamil, Anthony Pritchard and Sterling Gaston-Chapman.
- Tulsa moved to 70-41 all-time in season openers and 17-7 in openers at the Reynolds Center after beating Northwestern State 82-75.

SCOUTING THE RAMS

- Rhode Island comes in with a 3-0 record after beating Boston College 57-49 on Nov. 17 ... Although Boston College is also a participant in the Sunshine Slam, and a potential opponent for the Golden Hurricane, this game was not part of the event.
- In their first game of the Sunshine Slam, Rhode Island beat Bryant 83-64 at home on Nov. 12.
- The Mitchell brothers are a formidable duo for the Rams ... Makhi is the co-leader in scoring and averages a double-double with 11.3 points and 10.3 rebounds per game ... Makhel scores 9.7 points and grabs 5.7 rebounds ... Makhel is also second in the nation with 15 blocks, and second in averaging 5.0 blocks per game.
- As a team, the Rams defend the rim well ... They are second in the nation in blocks per game (11.7) and nine players have at least one block this season.

THE SERIES

- This is the third meeting between the two programs and Tulsa has won both previous matchups.
- This weekend's meeting comes exactly 21 years after the previous, where Tulsa beat the Rams 89-80 in the Donald W. Reynolds Center ... the first meeting was on Nov. 21, 1999, when the Golden Hurricane left Rhode Island with a 91-66 victory.

A WIN WOULD

- Improve Tulsa's record to 3-1 on the season.
- Move Tulsa to 3-0 all-time against Rhode Island.
- Book Tulsa's spot in the final of the Sunshine Slam, facing the winner of Utah and Boston College.

PLAYING IN THE SUNSHINE SLAM

- Tulsa will face two opponents while in Daytona Beach, Fla. for the tournament ... The winner of Saturday night's matchup will meet the winner of Boston College-Utah game in the championship of the Sunshine Slam ... The losers of the two games will meet in a consolation game earlier on Sunday.
- Tulsa lost the opener of the Sunshine Slam to Air Force at the Donald W. Reynolds Center on Nov. 13.
- The tournament is put on by the Gazelle Group, a sports marketing firm out of New Jersey.

LAST TIME OUT - TULSA 64, Oregon State 68

- Clutch defensive stops and strong free throw shooting helped the Hurricane hold off Oregon State in a close game at the Reynolds Center on Monday.
- Jeriah Horne recorded his first double-double of the season with 17 points and 10 rebounds, the 10th board sealing the win for Tulsa.
- It was a tightly-contested game throughout with 20 lead changes and nine ties .. Until seven minutes remaining in the game, neither team had a larger lead than four ... Tulsa eventually built a nine-point lead, but a 7-0 run from the Beavers made for a gutsy finish.

TULSA AT THE REYNOLDS CENTER

- After hosting the first TU men's basketball game on Dec. 29, 1998, the 2021-22 season will be the 24th for the Golden Hurricane at the Donald W. Reynolds Center.
- Tulsa has posted an overall record of 277-83 (.772) in its 20+ seasons, including 7-5 last season.
- Tulsa's 15 home wins in 2019-20 was the most for the Hurricane since 2009-10, when it claimed 16 home wins.
- Tulsa's 5 home losses last year were the most since a 10-5 home mark in the 2016-17 season.
- Tulsa has had 6 seasons in the 23 years of the Reynolds Center to have 15 or more wins at home.

THE SENIORS

- Tulsa has five seniors on this year's teams – forwards Rey Idowu and Jeriah Horne, and guards Darien Jackson, LaDavius Draine and Curtis Haywood II
- This is Jackson's fifth season to wear the the Tulsa colors ... He's appeared in 99 games and started in 19 games in his career.
- Horne returns to Tulsa after spending a season in the Pac-12 with Colorado ... He averaged 10.8 points and 5.8 rebounds in his lone season in Colorado, helping them to an NCAA appearance.
- Haywood II and Idowu are each in their second season donning a Tulsa uniform ... Haywood played in 23 games for the Hurricane last season, garnering 17 starts and averaging 5.3 points and 3.6 rebounds. He has dished out 44 assists ... Idowu also played in each of the 23 games and scored 7.9 per game while shooting 52.5 percent from the field.
- Grad transfer LaDavius Draine is the other incoming senior after spending a productive four seasons at Southern Miss. ... He is part of their 1,000 point club, scoring 1,133 in his career

JACKSON REACHES THE CENTURY MARK

- Darien Jackson made his 100th appearance for the Golden Hurricane against Air Force ... In his time with the University of Tulsa, Jackson has scored 549 points, pulled down 252 rebounds and dished out 148 assists.
- He is 25 games away from surpassing assistant coach Shea Seals (1993-97) for 21st in program history for career games played... It would also tie him for 20th with Jarius Glenn (2001-2005).

MOVING UP CAREER LISTS

- Graduate student Darien Jackson has been a vital member of the Golden Hurricane teams in his five seasons.
- Jackson, a defensive-minded guard, is was the heart of the Hurricane defense ... the senior has accumulated 105 steals in his career and is 4 steals away from catching Michael Scott for 20th place (109) on the career list.

Recapping the 2020-21 Season

- With no exhibition season, Tulsa began the season with a Big 12 and SEC opponent, falling to TCU by 5 and South Carolina by 11, in Kansas City, Mo.
- Tulsa had 2 early non-league games (Arkansas & ORU) canceled due to COVID on the Tulsa team ... through the AAC schedule, 5 games were postponed or canceled due to COVID-related issues at those schools ... 2 of those were rescheduled and played ... Tulsa played ECU, USF, SMU and Tulane only once
- The Hurricane team began AAC play with a 4-1 record, including a home win over #5 Houston (65-64) and road wins at Memphis, Cincinnati and USF ... Tulsa had a 1-5 record in its last 6 AAC games, including a 1-4 mark at home.
- Tulsa had a 6-game winning streak to take a 7-3 record on Jan. 6, before finishing 4-8 the rest of the way.
- Tulsa secured the No. 7-seed in the 2021 AAC Basketball Championship, falling in the first round to No. 10-seed Tulane 77-70.

JACKSON OF ALL TRADES

- In five seasons with the Tulsa Golden Hurricane, Darien Jackson has made a name for himself by doing a little of everything for TU from his defensive prowess to high-flying dunks on the offensive end.
- The graduate student guard flirted with a single-season school record in 2020-21 that was established 55 years ago, but did not reach the 16 field goal attempts needed to break the record.
- Jackson knocked down 64.0 percent (73-of-114) of his field goals this year.
- If he had reached 125 field goal attempts and moved his percentage above 66-percent he would have set the record for the school's best single-season field goal percentage ... Julian Hammond holds the record of 65.9% set during the 1965-66 season ... Jackson currently attempted 114 field goals.
- Jackson was Tulsa's leading offensive rebounder with 1.78 per game (41) ... he was also second on the team in assists (56) and steals (30)
- He had season-highs of 7 offensive rebounds at Wichita State, 7 assists vs. Northeastern State and 3 steals in three different games.

THE EMERGENCE OF IDOWU

- Rey Idowu played in his first season with the Golden Hurricane during the 2020-21 season ... the forward transferred to TU after two seasons at Illinois State where he averaged 3.6 points and 2.9 rebounds.
- The 6'9" big man ranked third on the team in scoring and rebounds, averaging 7.9 points and 3.8 rebounds ... he came off the bench in the first 14 games and started 8 of the last 9 contests.
- Idowu was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll after averaging 18 points and 6 rebounds against Temple and ECU.
- In his first start as a Hurricane, Idowu scored 16 points and grabbed 8 rebounds against ECU (1/30) in a career-high 32 minutes.
- At Temple (1/26), the forward scored a career-high 20 points on 7-of-11 (64%) shooting from the field and 6-of-8 (75%) from the free throw line.
- Idowu had 16 points against Cincinnati (1/2) ... he shot 7-8 (87.5%) from the field and 2-4 (50%) from the free throw line, while grabbing 4 rebounds.

LEADING THE AAC

- Tulsa's Darien Jackson ranked first in the American Athletic Conference for field goal percentage in 2020-21, a ranking he held for nearly the entire season.
- The 6'3" Jackson knocked down 64.0 percent of his shots, nailing 73-of-114 field goals.
- Rey Idowu and Elijah Joiner also ranked in the top-10 in the AAC in shooting percentage, as Idowu was 6th (.525) and Joiner was 10th (.456).

About TU

- Tulsa has an 11:1 student-faculty ratio
- The average class size is 21
- 1 in 10 is the ratio of National Merit Scholars in the undergraduate student body, and is also the ratio of student-athletes among the student-population
- 30 is the average ACT score of incoming freshmen

Why Golden Hurricane?

Enter the name Howard Acher as the Tulsa head football coach in 1922. When he took over the position, Acher saw great potential in his team and wanted to publicize it by creating a new identity with a new nickname. Sports writers and others had called the school by any number of names from the Presbyterians to the Orange and Black, to the Kendallites.

After an opening day win against a strong Texas Christian University team in 1922, Acher put his mind to work. The press had claimed that the Kendall football team blew through its opponents like a tornado. So, it figured that Tornadoes would be the nickname with "golden" added to identify the color of the uniforms. However, it was later found that Georgia Tech had claimed that name, so from tornado it was evolved meteorologically to a hurricane. Thus the squad voted, and the name "Golden Hurricane" became the new team moniker with the gold added because of the jersey color.

100 Darien Jackson made his 100th appearance for the Golden Hurricane against Air Force ... In his time with the University of Tulsa, Jackson has scored 555 points, pulled down 255 rebounds and dished out 148 assists.

28 Jeriah Horne scored 28 points in his return to the University of Tulsa ... He finished 8-12 from the field, 4-6 from three and was a perfect 8-8 from the line.

7 The number of returning letterwinners from the 2020-21 season ... three of the returners were starters.

8 The number of players Tulsa lost from last season, and also the amount the Hurricane welcomes this season.

5 Five of this season's newcomers bring collegiate experience with them ... Jeriah Horne is familiar to all Tulsa fans after spending two seasons with the program before transferring after graduation ... LaDavius Draine joins the program after four years at Southern Miss ... Sam Griffin already has experience in Tulsa, as he's faced the Golden Hurricane on two occasions with his former school, UT Arlington ... Tim Dalger and Nikita Konstantynovskyi both played at junior colleges before joining TU.

41 Jeriah Horne returns to the University of Tulsa this season ... Horne spent a season with Colorado where he was the second leading scorer and helped the Buffaloes to a second-round NCAA appearance.

1133 LaDavius Draine scored 1,133 points in his four seasons at Southern Miss ... He ended his career there ranked second with 220 three-pointers ... The sharpshooter has 38 games with at least three three-pointers.

74 Tulsa has won 74 American Athletic Conference contests since joining the league in 2014 ... the 74 wins is third most trailing only Cincinnati and Houston.

128 Head Coach Frank Haith is third all-time for coaching wins with 128 wins while at the helm of the Golden Hurricane ... Haith trails only Clarence Iba (137) and Doug Wojcik (140) in all-time wins.

Frank Haith is in his eighth year as head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa.

Haith helped the Hurricane navigate a difficult, covid-altered 2020-21 season that included a historic win over the No. 5 Houston Cougars, the third top-five win in program history. Tulsa also swept the eventual NIT-Champion Memphis Tigers and earned its first win on the road against Cincinnati in more than 40 years.

Haith was named the program's 30th head coach on April 18, 2014. He carries more than 30 years of collegiate coaching experience and 19 years of advancing to postseason competition. His teams have averaged over 20 wins in his 16 seasons as head coach, while compiling an on-court mark of 333-218 for a .604 winning percentage, including a 129-89 (.592) record at Tulsa. Ten of his 17 teams have advanced to postseason competition.

In his first season at TU in 2014-15, Haith led the Golden Hurricane to a 23-11 record and an appearance in the second round of the postseason NIT. The Hurricane, which was picked to finish fifth in its first season of competition in the American Athletic Conference, finished second in the league with a 14-4 record and advanced to the semifinals of the AAC Tournament. TU boasted a 12-game winning streak during the season, which included a 10-0 start to conference play — its best league start since 1968-69.

In 2018-19, Haith guided the Hurricane to 18 wins and TU outperformed its preseason prediction for the fifth-straight season. DaQuan Jeffries led the team in scoring and earned all-conference recognition before capping his career at TU by winning the College Slam Dunk title at the Final Four in Minneapolis. The Golden Hurricane posted 14 victories at home during the campaign, including wins over Oklahoma State and nationally-ranked Kansas State, which was its most in the Reynolds Center since the 2009-10 season.

In the 19-20 season, Haith was named the 2020 American Athletic Conference (AAC) and National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 24 Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Hurricane to a share of the AAC regular season title with a 13-5 league mark and an overall 21-10 record.

In all, Haith's Tulsa teams have compiled 20 wins and advanced to the postseason in two of his five seasons, while players have collected six all-conference honors. Additionally, Tulsa has notched 74 league wins under Haith (2014-present), which ranks third in the conference during that span.

Haith was the 2012 Associated Press and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Coach of the Year, while he also was a National Coach of the Year finalist in 2005. Before coming to Tulsa, he spent the previous 10 seasons as a head coach, including 7 seasons at Miami (Fla.), followed by a 3-year stint at Missouri.

Haith has transitioned all three programs into new conferences, moving Miami from the Big East Conference to the Atlantic Coast Conference and Missouri from the Big 12 Conference into the Southeastern Conference. Tulsa transitioned into the American Athletic Conference from Conference USA on July 1, 2014.

In his three seasons at Missouri, Haith's teams posted a 76-28 record and advanced to the postseason in all three campaigns with a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2012-13) along with a spot in the 2014 National Invitational Tournament. Haith became the fastest Mizzou head coach to post 50 wins and he was the winningest coach at Missouri through two seasons with a 53-16 record (.768).

His first team at Missouri was picked to finish fourth in the Big 12 preseason poll but went on to a school-record 30 wins and the Big 12 Tournament crown before earning a No. 2 seed in the 2012 NCAA Tournament. The Tigers' 14 league wins also were a program record before winning their second-ever Big 12 Tournament title.

Following the historic season, Haith received recognition in the form of numerous coaching accolades, highlighted by the prestigious Henry Iba National Coach of the Year and Associated Press National Coach of the Year honors. He also was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and was the USBWA District VI Coach of the Year. As a first-year coach, Haith guided his team to more regular-season wins than any other Mizzou coach before him, and he became the first Tiger head coach since 1920-21 to win his first 14 games.

Missouri was the lone college basketball program in the 2012-13 season to advance to NCAA Tournament play with just one returning starter. Prior to Missouri's NCAA Tournament run that year, the Tigers enjoyed their second undefeated season in Mizzou Arena history, going 17-0 at home with wins over a pair of nationally-ranked opponents, including No. 5 Florida.

During Haith's tenure, Missouri posted a 10-8 record against top-25 teams, including five wins versus schools ranked among the top-10 nationally.

In his first of seven seasons at Miami, Haith guided the Canes to seven ACC victories (despite being picked last) and qualified for postseason play in 2004-05. He was named a Naismith National Coach of the Year finalist and National Association of Basketball Coaches District 6 Coach of the Year in 2005.

Miami returned to postseason play in 2006 as the Hurricanes won 18 games and advanced to the quarterfinals of the NIT, recording the program's first postseason victories since 2000. Over his final four seasons, Haith's Miami squads averaged 21 wins per season, with four consecutive postseason trips, while three of the school's six all-time 20-win ledgers came under Haith. His Miami teams won six total games in the NCAA and NIT, including a memorable run to the second round of the Big Dance in 2008. The Canes went 23-11 in Haith's fourth season, just one win shy of the school record and he was named a finalist for ACC Coach of the Year and Skip Prosser Man of the Year honors.

During his time as a head coach, Haith's players were visible in the community, while he also saw an incredible 31-of-33 seniors walk across the stage to receive a diploma.

Haith paid his own way through Elon and graduated in 1988, while beginning his coaching career as a student assistant coach at the school in 1986. Haith helped the Phoenix twice win 20 games and he earned the opportunity to coach at Wake Forest in the 1989-90 season as a graduate assistant.

His first full-time coaching position on the Division I level came at UNC-Wilmington from 1990-92, and he then went on to a three-year stint at Texas A&M from 1992-95, in which he helped the Aggies reach postseason play in 1994.

A remarkable 21-win campaign during his lone season at Penn State (1995-96) allowed the Nittany Lions to reach the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 31 years, and he returned to Texas A&M and the Big 12 Conference for one season as the Aggies' Associate Head Coach in 1996-97. He then returned to Wake Forest for the 1997-98 season. The Demon Deacons reached postseason play each of his four years in Winston-Salem, including an NIT Championship in 2000 and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2001.

Haith parlayed that success at Wake Forest into an opportunity at Texas. Under Rick Barnes, Haith was, at the time, a part of the winningest three-year stretch in Texas Basketball history. The Longhorns averaged better than 24 wins per season and never failed to reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Longhorns advanced to the Final Four in 2003 and Haith worked magic on the recruiting trail, ushering four McDonald's All-Americans to Austin, including Brad Buckman (2002), LaMarcus Aldridge (2004), Daniel Gibson (2004) and Michael Williams (2004). Texas' 2004 recruiting class was rated No. 2 nationally by Rivals.com, while Aldridge became the No. 2 overall draft pick by the Chicago Bulls in the 2006 NBA Draft.

Born in Queens, N.Y., Haith spent most of his childhood growing up in Burlington, N.C. He is one of 11 siblings. Haith and his wife Pam have two children: Corey, and Brianna.
