Quick Facts

- Tulsa is in its 110th season of basketball and 7th season in the American Athletic Conference.
- Coach Frank Haith is 3rd all-time in school history with 125 wins ... the record is 140 held by Doug Wojcik.
- Senior Brandon Rachal was selected to the Preseason American Athletic Conference all-league team, after being selected to the 2019-20 third team all-AAC team . . . Rachal averaged 12.1 points and 5.8 rebounds last season
- Tulsa has been picked to finish 6th in the preseason Coaches' poll after coming off of their first American Athetic Conference regular season championship.
- Tulsa is in its 7th year in the American Athletic Conference with the 3rd most conference wins among the league members in that time span with 73 victories, behind only Cincinnati (87) and Houston (83).

Jackson of All Trades

- In four seasons with the Tulsa Golden Hurricane, Darien Jackson has made a name for himself by doing a little of everything for TU from his defensive prowess to high-flying dunks on the offensive end.
- The senior guard is on the verge of setting a record at Tulsa that has been held for 55 years ... he has knocked down 67.9 percent (53-78)of his shots ... he would rank 1st all-time in single season field goal percentage passing Julian Hammond's record of 65.9% set during the 1965-66 season, if he attempts a total of 125 or more shots this season.
- Jackson is known for crashing the offensive boards ... at Wichita State the 6'3" guard pulled in 7 offensive rebounds to lead TU .. he leads the team in offensive rebounds with 32 averaging 1.9 per game
- The Kansas City, Kan. native has led the Hurricane in in steals 10 times and assists and rebounds 4 times.

The Game

- Tulsa will take on the Tulane Green Wave in a conference home matchup in the Reynolds Center Wednesday
 afternoon on ESPN+ ... it will be the third consecutive home game for the Hurricane.
- The game is the 18th contest for Tulsa (9-8) this season ... the Green Wave is 7-7 on the season losing their last contest 64-61 in a home conference game against the Cincinnati Bearcats on Feb. 7.

Scouting the Green Wave

- Tulane was picked to finish last in the preseason AAC Coaches Poll ... the Green Wave returned one of their starters
 from last season, when the team went 12-18 and 4-14 in conference play.
- Tulane added transfers Gabe Watson from Southern Miss, Kevin Cross from Nebraska, and Jaylen Forbes from Alabama ... the trio has appeared in a combined 126 games at the Division 1 level.
- The Green Wave returned starter Jordan Walker ... the junior guard last season averaged 7.9 points and 2.2 rebounds a game.
- The Green Wave opened their season with four straight wins with the largest margin coming at home against Southern Miss as Tulane picked up the 58-38 victory ... they have lost 7 of their last 9 conference game including their last two.
- Tulane is led in scoring by Forbes who is averaging 15.0 points, 4.9 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game ... Walker is averaging 13.4 points and 2.1 rebounds a game for the Green Wave.
- Tulane is led by Head Coach Ron Hunter, who has been at the helm of the Green Wave for the last 2 seasons ... he
 holds a 19-25 record at Tulane.

The Series

- This will be the 31st contest between the Golden Hurricane and the Green Wave ... Tulsa leads the series at 24-6 with TU winning the two meetings last season, at home, 62-57 and at Tulane 67-54.
- TU won the first-ever contest against the Green Wave in the ORU Mabee Center 102-85 on Dec. 13, 1980 in Nolan Richardson's first season as the head coach of the Hurricane ... TU would finish 26-7 during the 1980-81 season.
- This is the 16th time Tulsa has hosted Tulane in at home with the Hurricane holding an 14-1 advantage on the home court ... Tulsa has a road record of 8-4 against the Green Wave and a neutral site record of 2-1.

A Tulsa Win Would

- Give the Hurricane its 10th win of the season, moving Tulsa to 10-8, 7-6 AAC on the year.
- Move Tulsa's all-time record against Tulane to 25-6.
- Give TU its 8th straight win against the Green Wave after winning the two contests last season.

Last Game Against the Green Wave

- Tulsa held off a surge by Tulane to capture a 62-57 win in front of 3,443 fans at the Donald W. Reynolds Center ...
 Martins Igbanu led the way with 17 points and 11 rebounds for his third double-double of the season.
- Tulsa improved its overall season record to 19-9 and 11-4 in the American Athletic Conference, while Tulane fell to 12-16 and 4-12.
- Jeriah Horne added 14 points and 6 rebounds for the Hurricane, while Lawson Korita had 12 points and 4 boards ... the Hurricane hit 49-percent of its field goals, while knocking down 50-percent of its 3-pointers, going 10-of-20 from behind the arc.
- Tulsa held the Green Wave to 39-percent shooting from the field and after a 10-8 deficit in the first half for paint scoring, the Hurricane ended the game out-scoring Tulane in the paint 22-16.
- The Green Wave took a one-point lead, 53-52, at the 4:53 mark and again with 3:23 left in the contest for a 55-54 lead ... Horne's trey at 3:05 on the clock put Tulsa back ahead by 2 points at 57-55 ... Igbanu's layup made it 59-55 with just 0:39 on the game clock.

- Elijah Joiner and Darien Jackson have been vital for the Hurricane this season.
- Joiner, Tulsa's senior point guard, has cracked the top-20 all-time in assists for the Hurricane with his 48 assists this season ... in his career he has 270 assists in 109 games and is number 20 all-time, trailing Pooh Williamson's 277.
- Jackson is a defensive minded guard, who is the heart of the Hurricane defense ... the senior has accumulated 92 steals in his career and is only 17 steals away from catching Michael Scott who is 20th all-time with 109.
- Jackson has also shown out offensively leading the AAC and TU in field goal percentage ... shooting at a 67.9% clip ... if he reaches 125 attempts and shoots above a 65.9 percentage he would rank 1st all-time on the FG percentage list ... as of now, Jackson has attempted 78 shots.

A Rich Tradition

- The month of February is Black History month, and the University of Tulsa Men's Basketball program has a rich tradition of hiring African-American Coaches..
- Nolan Richardson broke barriers at Tulsa in 1980, becoming the first African-American head coach in school history
 Richardson is 4th all-time in career wins at the helm of Tulsa with 119 victories in 5 seasons.
- Richardson was followed in 1991 as the Golden Hurricane hired Tubby Smith as head coach ... Smith spent four seasons with TU, leading Tulsa to a NCAA 'Sweet Sixteen' during the 1993-94 season.
- Now North Carolina assistant coach Steve Robinson led Tulsa to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances from 1995-97, while Danny Manning (38-29) and Frank Haith (125-83) have led the Hurricane the past 8 seasons.
- Former Tulsa point guard Alvin "Pooh" Williamson was interim coach during the 2004-05 season.

Too Little, Too Late...

- In the last 2 home games, Tulsa has dug itself a hole and ran out of time to garner the victory. The Hurricane trailed by as many as 17 points vs. SMU and 16 against UCF in the second half.
- Against SMU, the Hurricane trailed by 17 points with 6:21 remaining in the contest at 60-43 ... Tulsa went on a furious 20-5 run over the final 6:20 to slice its deficit to 2 points ... in the final 0:10, Tulsa had 2 field goal attempts and went just 1-of-3 from the free throw line at the 0:01 mark.
- A game later against UCF, the Knights had a 16-point lead, 50-34, at the 14:04 mark of the second half \dots the Hurricane cut its deficit to one point at 57-56 with 2:31 remaining in the game.
- During that stretch, Tulsa went on a 22-7 run, including a 17-3 stretch over an 8:14 time span, cutting the UCF lead from 54-39 at that point to 57-56.
- UCF converted on 13-of-28 three-pointers during the game, including the final one at the 1:14 mark to make the score 61-56.

Rachal in Conference Play

- The senior is averaging 14.3 points in conference play, grabbing 6.8 rebounds and dishing out 2.6 assists a game through 12 conference contests ... he is 9th in the AAC in scoring, 6th in rebounds and steals in AAC play.
- Rachal scored 17 of his 21 team-high points in the second half against ECU ... he recorded his 4th double-double of the season finishing with 21 points and 10 rebounds.
- At Temple, Rachal scored in double-digits for his 7th conference game with 12 points on 4-13 (30.8%) shooting.
- In the four games against Wichita State and Houston, Rachal averaged 15. 5 points, 7.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists .. he recorded his first double-double of the season at home against the Shockers with 17 points and 11 rebounds.
- The senior scored 25 points, shooting 8-11 (73%) from the field, 3-5 (60%) from three and 6-7 (86%) at the free throw line against Cincinnati ... Rachal had career-highs in rebounds (13) and blocks (3) in that game.
- On Jan. 4, 2021, Rachal was named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week after averaging 23.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 blocks against then No. 5 Houston and Cincinnati.

Joiner's Leadership

- Elijah Joiner is the most seasoned Hurricane having played in 109 games with 41 starts over four seasons for Tulsa. ... he is second in scoring and rebounds for TU, averaging 10.2 points and 4.6 rebounds ... he leads the team in assists with 3.5 a game for the Hurricane.
- The guard is 11th in the AAC in assists, 12th in field goal percentage and is 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Against Memphis, Joiner tied his season-high in scoring with 14 points, putting in 12 points in the second half
- The Chicago native has led the team in rebounds three times and assists 10 times this season.
- He was named to the American Athletic Conference week one honor roll on Jan. 11 after averaging 12.5 points and 4 rebounds in games against Wichita State and Memphis.

The Emergence of Idowu

- Rey Idowu is in his first season with the Golden Hurricane ... the forward transferred to TU after two seasons at Illinois State where he averaged 3.6 points and 2.9 rebounds.
- This season the 6'9" big man has come on strong for Tulsa ... he is third in scoring and rebounds for TU, averaging 8.4 points and 4.2 rebounds coming off of the bench in the first 14 games ... has started the last 3 contests.
- Idowu was named to the AAC Weekly Honor roll after averaging 18 points and 6 rebounds against Temple and ECU.
- Idowu, in his first start as a Hurricane, score 16 points and grabbed 8 rebounds against ECU ... he played a career-high 32 minutes against the Pirates.
- At Temple, the forward scored a career-high 20 points on 7-11 (64%) shooting from the field and 6-8 (75%) from the free throw line.
- Idowu had 16 points against Cincinnati ... he shot 7-8 (87.5%) from the field and 2-4 (50%) from the free throw line, while grabbing 4 rebounds.

About TU

- Tulsa has an 11:1 student-faculty ratio
- The average class size is 21
- 1 in 10 is the ratio of National Merit Scholars in the undergraduate student body, and is also the ratio of student-athletes among the student-population
- 30 is the average ACT score of incoming freshmen
- 1,019,940 is the amount of square feet added to the campus in the last decade
- 76-percent of Tulsa students graduated in the top-10 percent of their high school class (based on the 2015 freshman class)

Why Golden Hurricane?

Enter the name Howard Acher as the Tulsa head football coach in 1922. When he took over the position, Acher saw great potential in his team and wanted to publicize it by creating a new identity with a new nickname. Sports writers and others had called the school by any number of names from the Presbyterians to the Orange and Black, to the Kendallites.

After an opening day win against a strong Texas Christian University team in 1922, Acher put his mind to work. The press had claimed that the Kendall football team blew through its opponents like a tornado. So, it figured that Tornadoes would be the nickname with "golden" added to identify the color of the uniforms. However, it was later found that Georgia Tech had claimed that name, so from tornado it was evolved meteorologically to a hurricane. Thus the squad voted, and the name "Golden Hurricane" became the new team moniker with the gold added because of the jersey color.

Earning Degrees

Frank Haith has made achievement in the classroom as much of a priority as success on the basketball court over his nearly 16 years as a head coach. Since arriving at Tulsa, 21 of the program's 23 seniors (91-percent) have graduated, including Martins Igbanu and Lawson Korita from last year's team.

Additionally, Tulsa has had at least two student-athletes recognized on the American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team in each of Haith's five seasons.

Last year, Tulsa senior Martins Igbanu was named an American Athletic Conference Scholar Athlete of the year. He joins Shaquille Harrison (2015-16) as the only Hurricane to earn the award.

American Athletic Conference Player of the Week

BRANDON RACHAL was named the AAC Player of the Week on Jan. 4.

• Rachal averaged 23.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 blocks in games against No. 5-ranked Houston and Cincinnati. He shot 14-20 (70.0%) from the field, 5-8 (62.5%) from three and 14-15 (93.3%) at the free throw line.

Remembering Steve

A longtime member of the Tulsa basketball table crew, scorer Steve DeVivo passed away Thursday, Jan. 28, 2021. For the Women's and Men's basketball games, his seat at the scorer's table will be left vacant in his memory. Steve worked as a member the Golden Hurricane table crew for both TU football and basketball for over 20 years.

Steve will be greatly missed.

The Hurricane in the Rankings

- As of Feb. 8, 2021, the Golden Hurricane is 103rd in the NET Rankings ... the ranking is 5th in the American Athletic Conference trailing Houston who is ranked 5th, SMU at 59, Memphis at 61 and Wichita State at 76.
- The Hurricane received 5 votes in the AP Top-25 poll on Jan. 11 after a 7-3 start to the season.
- Tulsa has played in 11 Quad 1 and Quad 2 matchups this season ... TU has a 6-5 record in those games including two Quad 1 victories against Houston, ranked No. 5 at the time and on the road at Memphis.
- This season the American Athletic Conference has been a strong conference with the lowest ranked NET team being higher than the lowest in the Big Ten, Big East, SEC, and Pac 12.

1 and 6 in the AAC

- Tulsa's Darien Jackson and Rey Idowu are ranked 1-and-6 in The American for field goal percentage.
- The 6'3" Jackson has knocked down 67.9 percent of his shots, nailing 53-of-78 field goals.
- Idowu, a 6'9" newcomer to the Tulsa roster this year, has converted 58-of-109 field goals for a field goal percentage of .532.
- Senior Elijah Joiner also ranks among the league's top-15 for field goal percentage ... Joiner is 12th at 46.0-percent (52-of-113).

Rachal Named Naismith Player of the Week

- Brandon Rachal was named Jersey Mikes Naismith Trophy Player of the Week and American Athletic Conference Player of the Week, averaging 23.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 blocks against No. 5-ranked Houston and Cincinnati.
- The senior combined to shoot 67-percent from the field, knocking down 14-of-21 field goals, 63-percent (5-8) from three and also converted 93-percent (14-15) from the free throw line.
- Rachal scored 22 points and grabbed 8 rebounds against the No. 5-ranked Cougars, making two free throws with 0.1 seconds left to give the Hurricane a 65-64 victory.
- Against the Cincinnati Bearcats, Rachal notched his third double-double of the season scoring 25 points and pulling in a career-high 13 rebounds ... with 12.0 seconds left, he made two free throws to give Tulsa a 70-66 win.

THE HURRICANE AT HOME VS. THE ROAD

- Tulsa this season has a 8.2+ margin in points per game this season at home compared to on the road.
- Tulsa has scored 71.5 points (572) in 8 games at the Reynolds Center, while scoring 63.3 points (443) in 7 true road games ... the Hurricane averaged 61.5 points (123) in its 2 neutral site games this season.
- The Hurricane shot has 46.4% (209-450) from the field at the Reynolds Center as compared to 41.2% (154-372) on the road . . . 32.6% (58-178) to 28.1% (41-146) from 3-point range . . . Tulsa's free throw shooting has been better on the road -72.3% (94-130) to 64.4% (96-149).

The 6-Game Winning Streak

- Tulsa won 6 consecutive games from Dec. 18 to Jan. 6, including 3 American Athletic Conference games which included a 65-64 win over No.5-ranked Houston ... the streak was snapped in a loss to Wichita State on Jan. 13.
- During Tulsa's 6-game winning streak, the Hurricane outscored the opposition 17.7 points, 72.7 to 55.0.
- Tulsa shot 47-percent from the field, while holding the opposition to 32 percent.
- The Hurricane also knocked down 35-percent of its 3-pointers compared to 23-percent for the opponents.
- Tulsa dished out an average of 16.5 assists (99) during the 6 games, while forcing the opposition into 15 turnovers.
- It's the second straight year that Tulsa has had a 6-game winning streak . . . last year Tulsa had two 6-game winning streaks during the season.

Taking Down Cincinnati on their Court

- Brandon Rachal scored 25 points and grabbed 13 rebounds to lead the Golden Hurricane to a 70-66 victory over the Cincinnati Bearcats at the Fifth Third Arena.
- Rachal, for the second straight game, knocked down two free throws in the last seconds of the game to beat the Bearcats on the road for the first time since 1967.
- Rey Idowu tied his career-high in points with 16, shooting 7-8 (88%) from the field while grabbing 4 rebounds ... Darien Jackson had 8 points and 3 rebounds and Keyshawn Embery-Simpson had 8 points and 2 assists.
- TU never trailed in the game, leading the contest for 38:22 of the game. Tulsa's largest lead of the game at 12

came at 23-11 in the first half.

• In the game, TU shot 57-percent (25-44) from the field, 28-percent (5-18) from three and 79-percent (15-19) from the free throw line, while Cincinnati shot 34-percent (21-61) from the field, 32-percent (6-19) from three and 67-percent (18-27) from the line.

Being Big in the Paint

- Tulsa has scored 48.5 percent of its points in the paint through 17 games ... the Hurricane has scored 552 of its 1,138 total points in the paint area.
- The Golden Hurricane has a 12.4 margin in the paint over its opponents, 33.5 per game (552) for Tulsa to 21.1 for the opposition (358).
- The Golden Hurricane has 6 games with a double-digit margin of points in the paint ... Tulsa outscored USF 30-18 (12), Southwestern Christian 56-12 (44), TCU 38-18 (20), UT Arlington 48-24 (24), Temple (10) and ECU (16) in the paint.
- Tulsa has used its two bigs to bang down low with Emmanuel Ugboh and Rey Idowu combining for 164 points in the paint ... Hurricane guards have attacked the rim making 194 baskets (388 points) inside the paint.

2nd Half Outbursts

- The Golden Hurricane grow stronger as games go on outscoring opponents in the second half in 12-of-17 contests this season ... in five games Tulsa has outscored an opponent by 10 or more points SWC (28), UTA (12), Wichita State (10), Memphis (15) and Temple (10) in the second half.
- Tulsa has a 5.4 + margin in the second half ... TU is averaging 36.4 points per game (619 points) in the second half, while opponents are averaging 31.0 points per game (527 points).
- The Hurricane outscored Southwestern Christian 52-24 in the second half on Dec. 23 ... the 28-point margin was the largest of the season.
- TU used a 18-5 run to end the second half against Memphis in the fist meeting ... the Hurricane outscored the Tigers 37-22 after being outscored 27-19 in the first ... Darien Jackson (9 points) and Elijah Joiner (5 points) scored all their points in the 2nd.
- In the 12 conference games, the Hurricane has a 4.3 scoring margin in the second half, outscoring opponents 35.6 per game (427 points) to 31.3 (375 points).

Rachal Dominating for the Hurricane

- Senior Brandon Rachal averages 14.6 points, 6.7 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.8 blocks per game through the first 16 contests.
- He was named to the American Athletic Conference week one honor roll after averaging 16.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.5 blocks in games against TCU and South Carolina.
- Rachal is the only Hurricane to have recorded a double-double this season ... he has four on the season ... he put in 17 points, 11 rebounds against Wichita State and 14 points and 10 rebounds against Southwestern Christian, 25 points and 13 rebounds at Cincinnati and 21 points and 10 boards at ECU.

Team Effort on the Boards

- Through the first 17 games of the season rebounding has been a team effort as the Hurricane use a guard centric lineup.
- Tulsa is averaging 34.6 rebounds a game pulling in 156 offensive and 432 defensive rebounds in 17 games.
- All six of Tulsa's guards who are under 6'6" have combined to average 17.1 rebounds a game which is 49.3-percent of the Hurricane's rebounds ... point guard Elijah Joiner is 2nd on the team in rebounds with 4.6 per game.
- Guards have led the Hurricane in rebounding 8 out of the 17 games this season ... against South Carolina and USF Joiner led the team with 7 boards and against Memphis he had 5, while Darien Jackson led the way against UTA and Wichita State with 9 ... Curtis Haywood II led TU in rebounds at Houston with 5.
- The duo of Brandon Rachal and Rey Idowu combine for 10.9 rebounds a game ... Rachal has led the team in rebounds 7 times TCU (8), WSU (11), Memphis (7), SWC (10), Houston (7), Cincinnati (13), ECU (10) and UCF (8).

Tulsa at the Reynolds Center

- After hosting the first TU men's basketball game on Dec. 29, 1998, the 2020-21 season is the 23rd for the Golden Hurricane at the Donald W. Reynolds Center.
- \cdot Tulsa has posted an overall record of 273-80 (.771) in its 20+ seasons, including 5-3 this year and 15-2 last

- Former Golden Hurricane DaQuan Jeffries signed a two-year contract with the Sacramento Kings during the 2020-21 NBA offseason.
- Jeffries played last season with the Kings on a two-way deal averaging 3.8 points in 13 games last season.
- Jeffries signed with the Kings after signing as an undrafted free agent with the Orlando Magic
- Former Tulsa guard Shaquille Harrison signed a one-year deal with the Utah Jazz during the 2020-21 NBA offseason.
- Harrison has spent the last two seasons with the Chicago Bulls averaging 5.9 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- Harrison was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Phoenix Suns in 2016.

Last Season at a Glance

- Tulsa shared the American Athletic Conference regular season title with Cincinnati and Houston.
- Tulsa has now won or shared 11 league titles in school history with 10 coming in the last 36 seasons.
- It was the first AAC title for Tulsa in its 6 years as a league member ... Tulsa also placed among the top-4 in the AAC regular season in 4 seasons, including 2nd in 2014-15, 3rd in 2015-16 and 4th place in 2017-18.
- Tulsa has now won a league championship in 4 leagues Missouri Valley (6), Western Athletic (3), Conference USA (1) and the American Athletic (1).
- Coach Haith captured his 100th win as Tulsa's head coach with the Hurricane's 78-47 victory on Wednesday, Nov. 27 against South Carolina State ... he coached his 500th career game vs. SE Louisiana earlier this year on Nov. 20.

• Tulsa has had 6 seasons in the 22 years of the Reynolds Center to have 15 or more wins at home.

Started Strong on the Road

- The Golden Hurricane started the season 3-0 on the road ... Tulsa defeated three American Athletic Conference opponents on the road, beating Memphis 56-49, Cincinnati 70-66 and USF 61-51, before losing at Wichita State.
- The 3-0 start was the second longest AAC road winning streak for the Hurricane ... Tulsa started the
 conference road slate in 2014-15 with a 6-0 record.
- The 3-0 road record was the best overall start in school history since the 2001-02 season where the Hurricane opened the season with wins at Oral Roberts, Wichita State and Texas A&M.
- Against Memphis, TU used a 18-5 run to close out the game and capture the win ... in both the Cincinnati and USF games the Hurricane never trailed ... Tulsa during the stretch outscored opponents 62.3 to 55.3 on the road.

Richie Breaks Out

- Junior Austin Richie is in his first season with the Golden Hurricane after spending last season with Triton College ... Richie was a NJCAA Third-Team All-American in 2019-20 ... he spent the 2018-19 season at Northern Illinois
- After averaging 4.3 points on 6-18 (33%) from the field and 4-12 (33%) from three over the four game stretch from Wichita State (1/13) to Temple (1/26), Richie sored 14 points on 4-11 (36%) shooting from the field and 4-9 (44%) from three at ECU on Jan. 30.
- The Hurricane is 6-1 when Richie makes two or more threes in a game.
- Richie sparked a 14-3 run to begin the second half against USF ... scored 10 of his 13 points during the run.
- Richie shot 50-percent (4-8) from the field and 57-percent (4-7) from 3-point range ... he made his first two free throw attempts of the season against Memphis.
- After wins against Memphis and Southwestern Christian, he was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll on Dec. 23.

A Game of Firsts for Tulsa

- Tulsa, in its first game in the Reynolds Center during the 2020-21 season, defeated UT Arlington to capture its first win of the season.
- The Hurricane played every active player giving Ryan Gendron, Christian Shumate, Ari Seals, Peyton Urbancic and Bradley Alcime their first minutes of action in their career.
- Junior transfers Curtis Haywood II and Austin Richie both scored their first baskets wearing a Tulsa uniform ... Haywood II scored 8 in the game, while Richie added in 5 points.
- For the first time since opening in the 1999-00 season, the Reynolds Center hosted a game without fans.

Freshman Frenzy

- In the 102-45 win against Southwestern Christian all 5 Hurricane freshmen played with 4 scoring for TU ... the freshmen combined to score 33-percent (34 of 102) of Tulsa's points.
- Keshawn Williams led the Hurricane in scoring with a career-high 20 points ... he also led the team with a
 career-high 9 assists while also grabbing 6 rebounds.
- Guard Peyton Urbancic and forward Bradley Alcime both scored their first points as a Hurricane ... Urbancic had 9 points on 2-4 shooting and Alcime had 5 points going 2-2 from the field.
- Christian Shumate saw action in his third game scoring two points and pulling down a rebound ... Ari Seals saw two minutes of action recording his first career assist.

Leading by Example

- In the season opening weekend against TCU and South Carolina, the four seniors Brandon Rachal, Elijah Joiner, Darien Jackson and Emmanuel Ugboh averaged 36 points and 16.5 rebounds.
- The group led the team in points (Rachal-19), rebounds (Rachal-8), assists (Joiner-5), Steals (Joiner-3) and blocks (Rachal-2) against TCU.
- For the second consecutive game against South Carolina, Rachal (14) led in points ... Joiner (7) led in rebounds and Jackson in steals (3) and assists (4).

Frank Haith is in his seventh year as head basketball coach at The University of Tulsa.

Haith was named the 2020 American Athletic Conference (AAC) and National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 24 Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Hurricane to a share of the AAC regular season title with a 13-5 league mark and an overall 21-10 record. En route to its 21-win total, Tulsa claimed victories over 20th-ranked Memphis, by 40 points, and had a three-point win over No. 23 Wichita State.

Haith was named the program's 30th head coach on April 18, 2014. He carries more than 30 years of collegiate coaching experience and 19 years of advancing to postseason competition. His teams have averaged over 20 wins in his 16 seasons as head coach, while compiling an on-court mark of 330-213 for a .608 winning percentage, including a 125-84 (.598) record at Tulsa. Ten of his 14 teams have advanced to postseason competition.

In his first season at TU in 2014-15, Haith led the Golden Hurricane to a 23-11 record and an appearance in the second round of the postseason NIT. The Hurricane, which was picked to finish fifth in its first season of competition in the American Athletic Conference, finished second in the league with a 14-4 record and advanced to the semifinals of the AAC Tournament. TU boasted a 12-game winning streak during the season, which included a 10-0 start to conference play — its best league start since 1968-69.

In 2018-19, Haith guided the Hurricane to 18 wins and TU outperformed its preseason prediction for the fifth-straight season. DaQuan Jeffries led the team in scoring and earned all-conference recognition before capping his career at TU by winning the College Slam Dunk title at the Final Four in Minneapolis. The Golden Hurricane posted 14 victories at home during the campaign, including wins over Oklahoma State and nationally-ranked Kansas State, which was its most in the Reynolds Center since the 2009-10 season.

In all, Haith's Tulsa teams have compiled 20 wins, and advanced to the postseason in two of his five seasons, while players have collected six all-conference honors. Additionally, Tulsa has notched 54 league wins under Haith (2014-present), which ranks fifth in the conference during that span.

Haith was the 2012 Associated Press and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Coach of the Year, while he also was a National Coach of the Year finalist in 2005. Before coming to Tulsa, he spent the previous 10 seasons as a head coach, including 7 seasons at Miami (Fla.), followed by a 3-year stint at Missouri.

Haith has transitioned all three programs into new conferences, moving Miami from the Big East Conference to the Atlantic Coast Conference and Missouri from the Big 12 Conference into the Southeastern Conference. Tulsa transitioned into the American Athletic Conference from Conference USA on July 1, 2014.

In his three seasons at Missouri, Haith's teams posted a 76-28 record and advanced to the postseason in all three campaigns with a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2012-13) along with a spot in the 2014 National Invitational Tournament. Haith became the fastest Mizzou head coach to post 50 wins and he was the winningest coach at Missouri through two seasons with a 53-16 record (.768).

His first team at Missouri was picked to finish fourth in the Big 12 preseason poll but went on to a school-record 30 wins and the Big 12 Tournament crown before earning a No. 2 seed in the 2012 NCAA Tournament. The Tigers' 14 league wins also were a program record before winning their second-ever Big 12 Tournament title.

Following the historic season, Haith received recognition in the form of numerous coaching accolades, highlighted by the prestigious Henry Iba National Coach of the Year and Associated Press National

Coach of the Year honors. He also was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and was the USBWA District VI Coach of the Year. As a first-year coach, Haith guided his team to more regular-season wins than any other Mizzou coach before him, and he became the first Tiger head coach since 1920-21 to win his first 14 games.

The Tigers followed that up with a 23-11 record and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2012-13 before a 23-12 mark in Haith's final season

Missouri was the lone college basketball program in the 2012-13 season to advance to NCAA Tournament play with just one returning starter. Prior to Missouri's NCAA Tournament run that year, the Tigers enjoyed their second undefeated season in Mizzou Arena history, going 17-0 at home with wins over a pair of nationally-ranked opponents, including No. 5 Florida.

During Haith's tenure, Missouri posted a 10-8 record against top-25 teams, including five wins versus schools ranked among the top-10 nationally.

In his first of seven seasons at Miami, Haith guided the `Canes to seven ACC victories (despite being picked last) and qualified for postseason play in 2004-05. He was named a Naismith National Coach of the Year finalist and National Association of Basketball Coaches District 6 Coach of the Year in 2005.

Miami returned to postseason play in 2006 as the Hurricanes won 18 games and advanced to the quarterfinals of the NIT, recording the program's first postseason victories since 2000. Over his final four seasons, Haith's Miami squads averaged 21 wins per season, with four consecutive postseason trips, while three of the school's six all-time 20-win ledgers came under Haith. His Miami teams won six total games in the NCAA and NIT, including a memorable run to the second round of the Big Dance in 2008. The 'Canes went 23-11 in Haith's fourth season, just one win shy of the school record and he was named a finalist for ACC Coach of the Year and Skip Prosser Man of the Year honors.

During his time as a head coach, Haith's players were visible in the community, while he also saw an incredible 31-of-33 seniors walk across the stage to receive a diploma.

Haith paid his own way through Elon and graduated in 1988, while beginning his coaching career as a student assistant coach at the school in 1986. Haith helped the Phoenix twice win 20 games and he earned the opportunity to coach at Wake Forest in the 1989-90 season as a graduate assistant.

His first full-time coaching position on the Division I level came at UNC-Wilmington from 1990-92, and he then went on to a three-year stint at Texas A&M from 1992-95, in which he helped the Aggies reach postseason play in 1994.

A remarkable 21-win campaign during his lone season at Penn State (1995-96) allowed the Nittany Lions to reach the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 31 years, and he returned to Texas A&M and the Big 12 Conference for one season as the Aggies' Associate Head Coach in 1996-97. He then returned to Wake Forest for the 1997-98 season. The Demon Deacons reached postseason play each of his four years in Winston-Salem, including an NIT Championship in 2000 and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2001.

Haith parlayed that success at Wake Forest into an opportunity at Texas. Under Rick Barnes, Haith was, at the time, a part of the winningest three-year stretch in Texas Basketball history. The Longhorns averaged better than 24 wins per season and never failed to reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Longhorns advanced to the Final Four in 2003 and Haith worked magic on the recruiting trail, ushering four McDonald's All-Americans to Austin, including Brad Buckman (2002), LaMarcus Aldridge (2004), Daniel Gibson (2004) and Michael Williams (2004). Texas' 2004 recruiting leass was rated No. 2 nationally by Rivals.com, while Aldridge became the No. 2 overall draft pick by the Chicago Bulls in the 2006 NBA Draft.

Born in Queens, N.Y., Haith spent most of his childhood growing up in Burlington, N.C. He is one of 11 siblings. Haith and his wife Pam have two children: Corey, and Brianna.
