RECORD AGAINST THE OPPONENTS

- **OKLAHOMA** - Tulsa is 10-47 all-time against the Sooners and is seeking its first win in the series in a neutral venue.

- **OU** has a 13-game winning streak against the Golden Hurricane ... Tulsa's last win against the Sooners came on May 22, 2011 in Norman.

- **CHARLOTTE** - The Golden Hurricane has not lost against Charlotte, winning all six previous matchups ... this will be the first time the teams have met since 2014, when TU swept the 49ers at the Collins Family Softball Complex in TU's final season in C-USA ... Tulsa is 2-0 on the road against Charlotte.

A LOOK AT THIS WEEK'S GAMES

- **OKLAHOMA** - A perennial powerhouse, OU is in the midst of what the Sooners would consider a slump, going 3-3 in its last six games ... four losses is already tied for the most since 2021 ... the Sooners still top the Big XII standings and a series win against BYU over the weekend.

- The Sooners lead the nation in batting average (.379), and on-base percentage (.483) and rank in the top five for slugging (.692), runs per game (8.45) and home runs (85). They also get it done in the circle and defensively with a nation-leading 18 shutouts and a 1.65 ERA that ranks fourth, nationally.

- **CHARLOTTE** - Charlotte hosted Wichita State over the weekend and took the first two games of the series before narrowly dropping the finale.

- Arianna Rodi brings power to the 49ers offense, hitting a conference-leading 16 home runs through 41 games, which puts her ninth in the NCAA. She's not all power, though, hitting for average as well, slashing .364/.497/.822. Ella Chancy (.328) and Kiyah Garrett (.310) also hit above .300 this season.

- The 49ers have played an impressive schedule this season with three wins against ranked opponents in seven tries ... this includes a top-five victory over No. 4 Florida State to open the season.

TU TAKES TWO OF THREE FROM EAST CAROLINA

- The Golden Hurricane moved to 13-3 on the season at home with wins on Friday and Sunday against East Carolina ... Tulsa has won five of its six conference series this season and is in a three-way tie with North Texas and Charlotte for second in the conference.

- Game one was showcased fantastic pitching performances as each team only scored runs in the first inning ... Maura Moore got the start and Kylee Nash came on late to earn the save in a 2-1 win.

- Saturday's 5-2 loss snapped an 11-game win streak against ECU and eight game home winning streak.

- Tulsa bounced back on Sunday with seven runs in the fifth and sixth to walk-off ECU 10-2 in six innings ... Clair Skaggs and Imani Edwards homered in the win.

EDWARDS AND MOORE NAMED TO HONOR ROLL

- Shortstop Imani Edwards and pitcher Maura Moore were both named to The American Weekly Honor Roll for their performances last week.
- In two wins over East Carolina, Moore tossed 10.1 innings and allowed just three runs on eight hits with 18 strikeouts ... she held ECU to a .200 batting average and walked just three ... after a leadoff home run on Friday, Moore kept the Pirates off the board for the following 6.1 innings until Kylee Nash came on to close the game.
- Edwards hit .357 in four games with four runs scored and four driven in ... the senior shortstop added a double and a home run, stole a bag and led the defense with six assists.

TOPPING THE CONFERENCE CHARTS

- The Golden Hurricane has taken the conference lead in batting average, hitting .325 on the season ... the average also ranks 20th in the nation.
- Tulsa is third in doubles (71), leads the league in triples (19) and has fewer strikeouts (137) than any other team in the league ... Wichita State and FAU (154) have the second fewest in the conference.
- In the circle, the Hurricane has been the second-hardest team to get a hit off of, with the TU pitching staff holding opponents to .230 at the plate ... Tulsa has given up the fewest hits (227), and second-fewest runs (136) and earned runs (116).
- Individually, Tulsa has a few players showing up in the top-10 of conference stats ... MacKenzie Denson (.411) Imani Edwards (.403) are fourth and fifth in hitting ... Denson is also second in the conference with 58 hits while Edwards (54) is fourth ... Edwards is also second in triples (4), while Haley Morgan, Kennedy Cramer and Abby Jones all have three ... Morgan and Edwards are tied as the conference leader in steals (15), Jones (12) is fifth and Denson (11) sits tied for sixth..

TULSA LOVES EXTRA BASES

- Heading into the week, the Golden Hurricane ranks 14th nationally and third in the conference with 71 doubles.
- The Hurricane also sits third the nation in triples per game, hitting 0.46 three-baggers and 19 total this season.
- TU has two players who rank in the top 100 in the country for doubles in Clairra Skaggs, and Abby Jones ... Skaggs has collected 14, ranking 22nd nationally, while Jones (38th) has posted 13 doubles ... Celeste Wood (101st) sits just outside the top-100 with 11 doubles this year.
- Imani Edwards leads the team in triples, ripping four this season ... Haley Morgan, Abby Jones and Kennedy Cramer all have three.

MOORE TOSSES NO-NO

- Maura Moore tossed her third no-hitter as a Golden Hurricane and first of Tulsa's season in a 9-0 five-inning win to open conference play against the Memphis Tigers on March 8.
- She struck out six batters while keeping the Tigers offense off-balance and hitless.
- Haley Morgan was named to the honor roll after hitting .500 with six RBI, three runs, a pair of walks and two steals.

HEAD COACH CRISSY STRIMPLE



Crissy Strimple is in her fifth season as head softball coach at The University of Tulsa and her 19th year coaching with the Golden Hurricane program.

The Oklahoma native spent two seasons (2002-03) as a Hurricane infielder, four years (2008-11) as an assistant coach and eight years (2012-19) as associate head coach before serving the past four seasons (2020-23) as head coach.

Strimple has been in the Tulsa dugout for a total 634 wins, including an 82-45 record as a player. In her coaching tenure, she has been a part of 552 wins, 10 NCAA tournament appearances, six postseason conference championships, including three each in Conference USA and the American Athletic

Conference. The Hurricane has also made the conference championship game three more times with Strimple on the coaching staff, including last year's American Athletic Conference Championship.

Tulsa advanced to the 2023 AAC Championship Game after defeating No. 20-ranked Wichita State in the semifinals, 2-1.

Strimple took over the reins as head coach on June 12, 2019, when John Bargfeldt announced his retirement from head coaching following 14 years at the helm. Strimple stepped into the top role after 14 seasons in the Tulsa dugout as a player and coach.

In her first four years, Strimple's teams have compiled an 81-85-1 record with five wins against top-25 teams while facing a schedule in that time span that has included eight games against College World Series participants.

Strimple's first season was interrupted by the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020. The Hurricane had the second-best start in program history at 7-0, trailing only an 8-0 start in 2002, and finished with a 13-11 record in 2020. Three of Tulsa's setbacks came against top-20 ranked teams while nine were by no more than two runs, including six one-run losses.

In 2021, Strimple guided the Hurricane women to a 25-16 record and a 15-8 mark in The American. Tulsa constructed a season-best eight-game winning streak and downed the 22nd-ranked UCF Knights in three of four matchups. The 2022 team faced a schedule with nine games against top-25 teams and three CWS finalists, including national champion Oklahoma.

During her coaching tenure, Tulsa has had 71 all-conference selections, 32 NFCA all-region recipients and six NFCA All-Americans. Twelve of those all-league recipients have come in the last three seasons under Strimple's leadership.

As associate head coach (2012-19), Strimple mentored the Tulsa infielders and served as the recruiting coordinator. Her infielders produced six NFCA All-Region selections, 23 all-conference awards and one All-America honor. Strimple was instrumental in the development of Jill Barrett, who claimed three all-conference honors and closed her career as the 2014 Conference USA Player of the Year and a second-team All-American.

After returning to the program in 2008, Strimple coached an infield defense that contributed to two record-setting seasons for fielding percentage and one for fewest errors. The 2010 squad committed a program-low 36 errors, and the 2010 and 2011 teams fielded at a .975 clip, matching the 2005 team for best fielding percentage. The 2017 team nearly matched that mark with a .974 fielding percentage. In that time, the Hurricane offense set eight separate single-season school records, including for batting average, hits, runs, RBI, home runs, slugging percentage and on-base percentage.

Before returning to her alma mater, Strimple spent the 2007 season as an assistant coach at Central Arkansas, where she was responsible for coordination of the Lady Bears' recruiting efforts and academic progress. She also worked heavily with UCA's defensive schemes.

Previously, Strimple was the director of softball operations at Arkansas for two seasons (2005-06). Her duties included team travel, equipment, field maintenance and general management of the softball office.

Strimple played third base for TU during the 2002 and 2003 seasons, following a two-year career at Northeastern Oklahoma A&M. She led the Hurricane with 10 home runs as a senior and was the team's Offensive Player of the Year in each of her two seasons. Defensively, she established the top two single season assist totals in school history.

At NEO A&M, Strimple became the first freshman in school history to earn first-team NJCAA Region II and All-America honors while starting at shortstop. She was inducted into the NEO Athletic Hall of Fame in 2014.

Strimple graduated from Tulsa in 2003 with a degree in exercise & sports science before earning her master's degree in education with an emphasis on sports administration in 2006 from Arkansas.

TULSA COMEBACK COMES UP JUST SHORT AT #5 OKLAHOMA STATE

- The Hurricane got the tying run in scoring position but could not find a way to get her home as Tulsa fell 3-2 to the 5th-ranked Cowgirls on Wednesday in Stillwater.
- The game came to an anti-climatic ending on a runner left early call that stifled Tulsa's opportunity to tie the game ... TU trailed 3-1 entering the final ending before a two-out home run from Haley Morgan gave the Hurricane some life ... Kailyn Bearpaw singled and Abby Jones walked before the game-ending call.
- OSU's only three runs came in the bottom of the third.

HURRICANE TAKE SERIES IN WICHITA

- Tulsa took Friday's opener and Sunday's finale against Wichita State to secure its first series win on the road against the Shockers since 2018.
- The Hurricane scored three in the seventh in a 5-4 win on Friday ... Wichita State bounced back with an 11-3 win in five innings on Saturday ... TU closed the series with four home runs and 14 hits in a 14-5 win on Sunday to clinch the series.
- Maci Cole hit the first home run with a 3-run blast ... Claira Skaggs collected the second with a two-run homer that stayed just inside the foul pole in right ... Kailyn Bearpaw went deep more than halfway up the flagpole for a solo shot ... Abby Jones completed the home run cycle in fashion with a grand slam in the seventh just over the fence in right.

TULSA RACES PAST BEARS

- The Golden Hurricane offense exploded for 14 hits and 13 runs in five innings as Tulsa took down Missouri State 13-2 in a five-inning game at the Collins Family Softball Complex on Wednesday.
- Junior Alexa Hopkins (1-3) picked up her first win of the season after throwing three innings of two-hit, one run ball ... her only allowed run came on a leadoff home run in the first.
- Kailyn Bearpaw smashed a three-run home run and finished the game with four RBI ... third baseman Claira Skaggs hit a two-run home run and drove in three ... Haley Morgan doubled twice, scored twice and drove in a run.
- Junior Danielle Burns collected her first collegiate hit with a two-out single that scored a pair of runs.

BRINGING OUT THE BROOMS AT HOME

- Tulsa got its first conference sweep at home against UAB, taking down the Blazers 6-5, 3-1 and 5-3 in a Thursday, Friday, Saturday series.
- Kylee Nash picked up a pair of wins, including in the opener where Tulsa seemed down and out before a wild seventh inning saw Tulsa score four times to win ... Maci Cole's double with two outs and the bases loaded scored three runs to help TU win.
- Imani Edwards homered and tripled in the series ... she batted .600 over the three games with a 1.000 slugging percentage, earning The American Player of the Week honors.

OFFENSE STRUGGLES IN TEXAS

- The Golden Hurricane could not get things going in Denton, Texas last weekend, getting swept by North Texas ... all three losses were in walk-off fashion by one run.
- TU lost 1-0 on Friday and Saturday, and 3-2 on Sunday ... both 1-0 games were decided by solo home runs in the bottom of the eighth and seventh, respectively.
- Anneca Anderson allowed just one hit in Saturday's loss, and it was the game-winner ... she has allowed just one run and two hits in her last 14.0 innings.
- Maura Moore also allowed one run thanks to a homer ... thanks to her earlier win over Oklahoma State, she finished the week with 13.1 innings, eight strikeouts and just one run.

GOLDEN HURRICANE STUNS #4/6 OKLAHOMA STATE IN FRONT OF SELLOUT CROWD

- With a packed Collins Family Softball Complex in attendance, the University of Tulsa shutout the highly-ranked Oklahoma State Cowgirls 3-0 on Tuesday afternoon.
- It was the first top-10 win for TU since knocking off #6 Texas on the road in 2013, and highest-ranked win since 2009.
- Maura Moore allowed just four hits and walked three batters while striking

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- The Golden Hurricane brings an experienced roster into the 2024 season with 18 returners from last season's team.
- TU returns 100 percent of its pitching from last season ... Maura Moore finished with a 15-13 record and a 2.90 ERA with a team-best 113 strikeouts ... Moore tossed a pair of no-hitters. Kylee Nash picked up 10 wins on a 4.91 ERA ... Nash held opponents to a .232 batting average and struck out 87 batters ... Nash also got it done on the other side of the plate, batting .317 with four doubles and 10 RBIs ... her contributions on both sides of the field earned Nash a second team all-conference selection.
- First Team All-Conference selections Imani Edwards and Haley Morgan highlight returning field players, where the Hurricane return all but one starter ... Morgan paced Tulsa with a .392 batting average .621 slugging percentage and .453 on-base percentage ... the star center fielder added 32 RBI, eight doubles, three triples and a team-best seven home runs ... Edwards, the TU shortstop, hit .369 last season and drove in 21 runs ...
