OPENING TIPS

SCENE SETTER

- Texas State plays its 14th game of the season and third Sun Belt Conference tilt of 2016-17 slate on Sat., Jan. 7 against UTA.
- The Bobcats are 6-7 on the season and average 57.8 points and 18.8 forced turnovers per contest.
- Texas State has shot at least 50 percent from the floor in each of its last three games, posting a 51.2 percentage at North Texas, a 54.5 percentage against Coastal Carolina and an even 50.0 percent against Appalachian State.
- Texas State enters the game coming off a 66-64 last-second loss to Appalachian State last Saturday (Dec. 31). UTA is 2-0 on the season, most recently defeating Coastal Carolina 60-58 on New Year's Eve.

TXST VS. UTA

- Saturday marks the 69th meeting between Texas State and UTA with the Bobcats holding a 38-30 series advantage. Texas State is 6-4 against the Mavericks in the last 10 meetings, including a five-game win streak from Jan 2014 through March 2015.
- Last season UTA won both meetings -- 80-48 in San Marcos and 78-69 in Arlington.

GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE BOBCATS

- McKinley Bostad tied the game for the seventh time on a baseline layup with eight seconds remaining, but Appalachian State's Madi Story scored five ticks later to provide the Mountaineers a 66-64 win over Texas State Saturday afternoon inside Strahan Coliseum.
- Leading 64-62 with 12 seconds to play after a pair of missed Bobcat free throws, Appalachian State attempted to inbound the ball from the sideline; however, an offensive foul turned the ball over to Texas State. Head coach Zenarae Antoine called timeout to set up Bostad's game-tying score, but the Bobcats were unable to make a final stop and send the game to overtime.
- Appalachian State was led by Story's 14 points, while Ashley Bassett-Smith chipped in 13. Bria Carter and Joi Jones each finished with nine. The Mountaineers closed the game shooting 47.4 percent (27 of 57) from the floor and outscored the Bobcats 42-28 in the paint.
- Texas State was led by Ti'Aira Pitts' career-high tying 14 points. Pitts, who has scored in double-figures in each of the last four games, was 5 of 10 from the field, including 3 of 4 from 3-point range. McKinley Bostad scored nine, while Erin Peoples and Amber Jones each added eight. The Bobcats closed the day shooting an even 50.0 percent (24 of 48) and outscored App. State 23-16 off turnovers.

PITTS' SCORING STREAK

- Forward Ti'Aira Pitts has scored in double-figures in each of the Bobcats' last four games -- the first four double-digit efforts of her career. Over the four-game stretch she is averaging 12.3 points per game and is shooting 54.3 percent from the field and 44.4 percent from deep.
- She started the streak with 11 points against Sam Houston State (Dec. 19), then scored a career-high 14 points at North Texas (Dec. 22), had 10 against Coastal Carolina (Dec. 29) and added another 14 points against Appalachian State (Dec. 31).
- In her performance at North Texas, she went 5 of 8 from the field and a perfect 4 of 4 at the free-throw line. She scored four in the first half, six in the fourth quarter and four in the fourth quarter. Her four fourth-quarter points came by way of Texas State's only two fourth-quarter field goals.
- Her 14-point showing against the Mountaineers featured a career-best four 3-pointers as she shot 5 of 10 overall (3 of 4 from three) and added a free throw.
- Pitts is shooting an even 50.0 percent for the season, making 38 of 76 attempts. She is converting 54.7 percent (29 of 53) inside the arc and 39.1 percent (9 of 23) beyond the line.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Texas State's bench has showcased its scoring ability this season, averaging 26.8 points per game, including three 30-plus point performances and games of 43 and 50 points.
- Over the past four games the bench is averaging 32.0 points per game, while opponents' benches are managing a meager 6.8. During the four game span Toshua Leavitt is leading all bench personnel at 8.3 points per outing, while Kaitlin Walla, Amber Jones and Erin Peoples are each averaging greater than 7.0 point per game.
- The bench's most impressive performance came against Coastal Carolina on Dec. 29 as the Bobcat bench outscored the Chanticleer bench 50-3.

FILLING IT UP

- Texas State has made at least 50 percent of its field goal attempts in three consecutive games. The Bobcats started their three-game hot streak making 22 of 43 shots (51.2 percent) at North Texas, then shot a season-high 54.5 percent (30 of 55) against Coastal Carolina and an even 50 percent (24 of 48) against Appalachian State.
- During the stretch the Bobcats are also shooting 50 percent from three (27 of 54) as a team.
- McKinley Bostad has led the charge during the three games, making 9 of 11 (81.8 percent) from the floor and 6 of 7 (85.7 percent) from three. She is one of six Bobcats shooting north of 50 percent since Dec. 22.

BOBCATS IN THE SUN BELT RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 1 Texas State ranks in the top half of the Sun Belt Conference in eight of the league's 21 key statistical categories. The Bobcats' top statistical category is its 13.8 assist per game, which ranks third among member institutions.

GAME NOTES

BREAKING 70

- For the first time this season, Texas State broke the 70-point threshold in its conference-opening win over Coastal Carolina (Dec. 29). The Bobcats, who's previous season-best was 69 points, scored 83 against the Chanticleers. It marked the latest into a season a Texas State team took to breach 70 points since the 1997-98 team took until Jan. 15, 1998 to score more than 70 points (80-56 win at Nicholls State).
- Texas State produced its season-high 83 points as Kaitlin Walla led four in double-figures with her 17 points, marking the first time this season four Bobcats scored 10-plus in the same game. The Bobcats counted a season-best 13 3-pointers (one shy of the team single game record), shot a season-best 54.5 percent overall (30 of 55) and outscored the Chants 50-3 in bench points.

WALLA BREAKS THROUGH

- Mired in a shooting slump that lasted the first 11 games of the season, Kaitlin Walla produced a breakout performance in the Sun Belt Conference season-opener against Coastal Carolina (Dec. 29). The junior scored a season-high 17 points in her 25 minutes off the bench. She went 6 of 10 from the field, including 3 of 5 from 3-point range, and 2 of 2 at the free-throw line. In addition to her scoring, Walla also dished out a season-best four assists and grabbed three offensive rebounds.
- The junior backed up her breakout performance with six points on a pair of 3-pointers along with five rebounds and three assists against Appalachian State (Dec. 31).

PEOPLES MAKES SEASON DEBUT

- Redshirt senior Erin Peoples made her 2016-17 season debut on Dec. 22 at North Texas. Peoples played 12 minutes off the bench, scoring four points and registering a steal (first basket came by way of steal and fastbreak layup).
- Peoples, a preseason All-Sun Belt selection, suffered a knee injury in August 2015 that forced her to medically redshirt last season and miss the first 10 games of the current campaign. Her minutes at North Texas were her first of game action since March 18, 2015 -- a span of 646 days.

- Through her first three game back on the court, Peoples is averaging 6.7 points and 3.7 rebounds per outing, while shooting 50.0 percent from the field. She has also totaled five assists and three steals.

QUICK HANDS

- Texas State forced a season-best 27 turnovers at UTSA (Dec. 1). The Bobcats where led in the contest by Taeler Deer's career-best five steals.
- At Baylor (Dec. 6) the Bobcats turned the Lady Bears over 18 times – four more than Baylor's season average of 13.9.
- The Bobcats forced 23 St. Edward's (Dec. 10) turnovers with 14 coming by way of clean steals and registered 16 forced turnover at Prairie View A&M (Dec. 16), including nine via steals.
- Texas State continued its December defensive pressure against Sam Houston State (Dec. 19) and North Texas (Dec. 22), turning their opposition over 21 and 22 times, respectively.
- For the month of December the Bobcats forced 155 total turnovers, equating to 19.4 per game.

FINDING THE RIGHT MIX

- Texas State has used seven different starting lineups this season with only Ti'Aira Pitts starting each game.
- Eight of Texas State's 14 active players have saw action in at least 12 games and an additional two seeing time in at least 10 contests.

SCORING IN THE PAINT

- Post players Amber Jones and Ti'Aira Pitts are making the most of their touches in the paint. Jones, a redshirt junior forward, is shooting 59.6 percent from the field, knocking down 31 of 52 attempts. Pitts, a junior, is making 50.0 percent of her attempts (38 of 76) from the floor. However, Pitts has attempted 23 3-pointers, making nine for a 39.1 percentage from deep. When those triples are subtracted from her overall numbers, Pitts is shooting 29 of 53 (54.7 percent) from inside the arc.
- As a team the Bobcats are averaging 24.2 points in the paint per game with a season high of 36 in the win over Sam Houston State (Dec. 19).

APPALACHIAN STATE UPENDS BOBCATS ON FINAL SHOT

SAN MARCOS, Texas - McKinley Bostad tied the game for the seventh time on a baseline layup with eight seconds remaining, but Appalachian State's Madi Story scored five ticks later to provide the Mountaineers a 66-64 win over Texas State Saturday afternoon inside Strahan Coliseum.

Leading 64-62 with 12 seconds to play after a pair of missed Bobcat free throws, Appalachian State attempted to inbound the ball from the sideline; however, an offensive foul turned the ball over to Texas State. Head coach Zenarae Antoine called timeout to set up Bostad's game-tying score, but the Bobcats were unable to make a final stop and send the game to overtime.

Appalachian State (6-7, 1-1 Sun Belt) was led by Story's 14 points, while Ashley Bassett-Smith chipped in 13. Bria Carter and Joi Jones each finished with nine. The Mountaineers closed the game shooting 47.4 percent (27 of 57) from the floor and outscored the Bobcats 42-28 in the paint.

Texas State (6-7, 1-1 Sun Belt) was led by Ti'Aira Pitts' career-high tying 14 points. Pitts, who has scored in double-figures in each of the last four games, was 5 of 10 from the field, including 3 of 4 from 3-point range. McKinley Bostad scored nine, while Erin Peoples and Amber Jones each added eight. The Bobcats closed the day shooting an even 50.0 percent (24 of 48) and outscored App. State 23-16 off turnovers.
