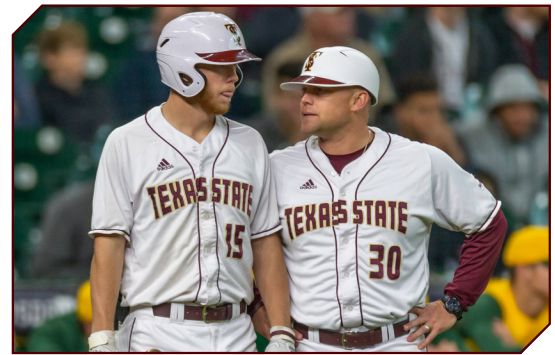

SCOUTING BAYLOR

- Baylor comes into the game with an 8-3 record.
- The Bears have won four straight. They defeated UT Rio Grande Valley (2-0) last week and followed by defeating Arkansas (3-2), LSU (6-4) and Missouri (4-2) in the Shriners College Classic at Minute Maid Park.
- Also have two victories over Nebraska and one each against Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Oral Roberts.
- Jared McKenzie leads Baylor with a .409 batting average, 18 hits, and three stolen bases. Has scored eight times, driven in four runs and hit three doubles.
- Kyle Nevin comes in hitting .381 with a triple and RBI.
- Nick Lofton, a preseason All-American, comes in batting .341 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and 11 RBI. Ricky Martinez (.300) has also hit four doubles and plated 11 runs.
- Both Mack Mueller (.297, 7 RBI) and Chase Wehsener (.162, 4 RBI) have hit a team-high four homers.
- Hambleton Oliver is scheduled to get the start on the rubber for the Bears. It will be the freshman right-handers second start of the season. He enters with a 1-0 record, 4.15 ERA and six strikeouts over 4.1 innings panning three contests.
- Luke Boyd has appeared in a team-high seven games and recorded five saves. He is 1-0 with 13 strikeouts in eight innings.
- Both Logan Freeman (1-0, 6 G) and Tyler Thomas (0-0, 5 G) have yet to allow a run this season.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. BEARS

- Baylor leads the all-time series 51-24 over Texas State.
- The Bears have won the last two meetings and four of the last five.
- Last win for the Bobcats was a 6-1 game on Apr. 2, 2018 in Waco.
- TXST is 17-33 all-time when playing at Baylor.

TXST AND THE BIG XII

- Texas State has faced eight of the nine current baseball playing members of the Big XII Conference. Only team yet to play is West Virginia.
- All-time against current Big XII members, the Bobcats are 64-146 (.305).
- The most games have been Baylor (75).
- TXST also has double-digit wins against TCU (13) and Texas (12).

TROUT ERA

- This season marks the first for Texas State under the leadership of Steven Trout.
- He took over after the retirement of Ty Harrington following 20 years leading the program.
- Trout is the fifth head coach in the program's Division I era.
- It will be Trout's seventh season with the Bobcats after serving the past two as the associate head coach. He held the title of assistant coach during the 2016 and 2017 seasons and was a volunteer assistant in 2009 and 2010.
- This is Trout's second head coaching jobs and first at the NCAA Division I level. He was the head coach at Texarkana College in 2012, the team's final season before all athletic programs were disbanded. Trout went 34-25 in his lone season with the Bulldogs.

FIRST-YEAR HEAD COACH

- Steven Trout is one of 38 head coaches in his first year at a program for the 2020 season.
- The Sun Belt Conference features three new head coaches in Matt Deggs (Louisiana), Brad Stromdahl (Georgia State) and Trout.
- Trout is one of four new head coaches for a Lone Star State program. Other Texas schools with new head coaches for 2020 are Incarnate Word (Ryan Shotzberger), Sam Houston State (Jay Sirianni) and UTSA (Patrick Hallmark).

YOUNGEST HEAD COACHES

- Steven Trout enters the 2020 season as 25th youngest head coach at the Division I level at the age of 35 years and 133 days old at the beginning of the 2020 season.

- He is the youngest head coach in the state of Texas and the Sun Belt Conference.

- The eight strikeouts matches his career-high.
- His first eight-strikeout performance was on Mar. 18, 2018 against Appalachian State in San Marcos.

WALK-OFF VICTORIES

- Texas State recorded its first walk-off win of the season in the second game of the series against Lamar. John Wuthrich hit a game-winning single to give the Bobcats a 4-3 win.
- The last eight games that the Bobcats have been involved in that ended on a walk-off have gone in their favor.
- Last season saw TXST have a 7-0 record in games that ended with a walk-off hit. Those came against Arkansas State, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, Rice, Texas, Troy and ULM.
- Games against the Red Wolves, Owls and Trojans ended in in extra innings.
- The victories against the Eagles, Panthers and Warhawks were run-rule walk-offs in the series finale.
- Last time TXST was on the wrong end of a walk-off was May 1, 2018 at #18 Texas. The Longhorns rallied for five runs in the ninth for an 11-10 victory.

HOLLIS’ NEAR CYCLE

- Will Hollis had a career day at the plate in the second game of the series against lamar. The junior outfielder went 5-for-5 at the plate.
- He recorded three singles, a triple and a home run on the day to fall a double short of hitting for the cycle.
- No Bobcat has ever hit for the cycle since the program was restarted in 1985.

SUNDGREN DEBUT PERFORMANCE

- Trevis Sundgren had an outstanding debut in a Texas State uniform in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday, Feb. 15.
- The junior right-hander threw seven shutout innings with six strikeouts and allowed just two hits and no free passes. He was also perfect through the first four innings.

OPENING DAY

- The 2020 season will be the 36th in the history of Texas State baseball.
- The Bobcats won the season opener 4-3 over Stony Brook to improve to 21-15 all-time in opening day games.

HOME OPENERS

- Texas State began the season at home for the 10th consecutive year.
- Last time the Bobcats did not open the year in San Marcos was in 2010 with a three-game series at Houston.
- Texas State now sports a 21-15 record all-time in home openers.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Texas State is now 231-118-1 (.661d) all-time at Bobcat Ballpark since it opened in 2009 after winning three of four from Stony Brook.
- Last season saw the Bobcats go 19-8 in the friendly confines with an 11-4 mark against Sun Belt Conference opponents.
- TXST has recorded seven seasons of 20 or more victories at home. The last such 20-win campaign came in 2018 in which the team won 20 games.

BOBCATS ON ESPN NETWORKS

- Texas State are scheduled to see 19 of its games set for an ESPN platform this season. It will be the most games broadcast in program history.
- 13 home games will be broadcast on ESPN+.

- For the second time in program history, Texas State saw all three of its weekend starters be selected in the MLB Draft.
- The Bobcats were one of four teams to see all three weekend starters selected along with Duke, Georgetown and Indiana.
- Illinois State, St. John’s and West Virginia also had three starting pitchers drafted but one on each staff wasn’t a full-time starter, made some appearances out of the bullpen and/or made midweek starts.

FEWEST PITCHING STARTS RETURNING

- Entering the 2020 season, Texas State is one of 15 teams that will be returning 25% or less of its starts from 2019.
- The Bobcats are tied with TCU and Utah Valley for the 10th fewest returning starts. TXST is tied for the 11th fewest starts percentage wise with Utah Valley.
- Texas State’s 11 starts are tied for the second fewest in the Lone Star state with TCU. Only team with fewer is UT Rio Grande Valley (2) while Rice and Sam Houston State return 13 apiece.

PROCATS

- Heading into the 2020 season, three former Texas State players are in a Major League organization.
- Three Bobcats are playing in the major leagues with Paul Goldschmidt playing for St. Louis and both Kyle Finnegan and Austen Williams with the defending world champions Washington Nationals.
- Donnie Hart will also have an opportunity to make a major league squad after signing a minor league deal with the Oakland Athletics that includes an invite to spring training.
- Also in the Nationals organization is Jaylen Hubbard. Hunter McMahon was also in the defending World Series champions organization until he was traded to the Minnesota Twins in late January.
- Other organizations with former Bobcats are Arizona, Boston, Chicago (AL), Detroit, Miami, Philadelphia, Tampa Bay and Toronto.
- Two former Texas State players (Louis Head & Carson Smith) are free agents after being under contract with a MLB organization in 2019.

BOBCAT BALLPARK ATTENDANCE

- Since joining the Sun Belt Conference, Texas State has ranked in the top three of attendance four of the six years and in the top six all six seasons.
- Last season saw the Bobcat see 33,537 attend a game for an average of 1,242 fans, the sixth highest in the Sun Belt.
- That mark included a Bobcat Ballpark record 3,119 on Apr. 23, 2019 against Texas. It broke the previous mark of 3,017 on Mar. 21, 2017, which also saw the Bobcats take on the Longhorns.
- Those are the only two game that 3,000-plus fans attended at Bobcat Ballpark.
- Since the opening of the stadium in 2009, there have been 20 games with an attendance of 2,000 or more.

DEFENDING SUN BELT REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONS

- Texas State claimed the 2019 Sun Belt Conference regular season championship with a doubleheader sweep of UT Arlington to conclude the regular season.
- The Bobcats defeated the Mavericks 10-9 in the first game of the twin-bill to claim at least a share of the regular season title and the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. TXST followed with a 13-11 victory to win the regular season crown outright.
- It was Texas State's first regular season championship as a member of the Sun Belt and first regular season crown since 2011.

SERIES SWEEPS

- The 2019 season saw Texas State record three series sweeps during Sun Belt Conference play.
- The Bobcats won all three games against Arkansas State, Louisiana and ULM.
- Sweeps against the Red Wolves and Warhawks were at home while the Ragin' Cajuns sweep was on the road. The sweep of UL was the first on the road since Apr. 13-14, 2018 at Georgia State.
- It was the third time TXST had recorded three conference series sweeps in a season since joining the Sun Belt with the other two being in 2018 and 2014.

SUN BELT PRESEASON POLL

- Texas State was picked to finish third in the West Division of the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll. The Bobcats totaled 55 points with three first-place votes to finish behind UT Arlington (58 pts; 3 1st) and Louisiana (57 pts; 5 1st).
- Little Rock came in third in the division with 39 points and picked up a lone first-place vote.
- Rounding out the West Division poll was ULM (25 pts) and Arkansas State (18 pts).
- TXST's point total was the fifth most in the conference behind South Alabama (62 pts), Coastal Carolina (61 pts), the Mavericks and Ragin' Cajuns.

HOLLIS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SUN BELT

- Senior outfielder Will Hollis was selected to the All-Sun Belt Conference Preseason Team at designated hitter.
- Last year saw him hit .320 with a team-high 47 RBI, 42 walks and 20 doubles. He also hit six home runs and scored 37 runs.
- Hollis was the lone selection for the Bobcats. South Alabama had the most with three including the Preseason Player of the Year (Ethan Wilson) and Pitcher of the Year (Drake Nightengale).

- In the preseason poll, Texas State was listed as one of the teams receiving votes in the Collegiate Baseball News Top 40 poll.
- The Bobcats were one of four Sun Belt Conference teams recognized in the poll. South Alabama is ranked 23rd and Louisiana is right behind the Jaguars at No. 24. Also receiving votes with the Bobcats was Coastal Carolina.

BLAKLEY RETURNS

- With the promotion of Steven Trout to head coach, that left an opening on the coaching staff that was filled with the hiring of Josh Blakley as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.
- Blakley comes from UT Rio Grande Valley where he was an assistant coach and the recruiting coordinator, where he helped them win a share of the 2019 WAC regular season title.
- This is his second run with Texas State as he served as a volunteer assistant during the 2018 season.

INEXPERIENCED PITCHING STAFF

- After having a very experience pitching staff in 2019, the 2020 Texas State pitching staff will be much more inexperienced.
- The Bobcats return just 126 innings (25.3%) of 498.1 innings thrown last season.
- Only starter back from last season is senior right-hander Garrett Herrmann, who made 10 of the team's 11 midweek starts.
- Others on the staff that have started games on the mound are Wes Engle (22 GS) and Zachary Leigh (10 GS).
- Out of the bullpen, the team returns Matthew Charles, Reece Gould, Brent Hebert, Matthew Nicholas and Dontate Woodard. They combined to toss 46.2 innings and strikeout 36.

RETURNING OFFENSE

- Texas State returns four starters from the battery in Will Hollis, Dalton Shuffield, Jaxon Williams and John Wuthrich. All of them hit .311 or better last season.
- Five other Bobctas are back that recorded an at-bat in 2019.
- The group of nine represented 40.0% of the team's hits led by Shuffield's 72.
- The returners accounted for 51.9% of last year's RBI total and 52.5% of the runs scored.

NEWCOMERS

- Texas State welcomes 14 newcomers to the program.

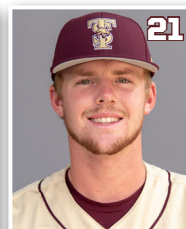
