QUICK HITS

• Texas State dropped both games of the Louisiana Tech MTE. It is the first time the team has dropped two games in an in-season tournament since losing twice in the 2012 Great Alaska Shootout.

• Kaden Gumbs led the Bobcats in scoring in both games in Ruston, Louisiana. He scored 13 points against McNeese and followed with a season-high 15 points versus Southern Utah. The freshman guard also grabbed a season best 10 rebounds against the Thunderbirds to record his first career double-double.

• Brandon Love continued to show his shot blocking prowess at the LA Tech MTE. The junior recorded three blocks in both games to increase his season total to 19, which is the most in the Sun Belt Conference and tie for highest total in the nation.

• With his six blocks in the Pelican State, Love now has 57 blocks in his TXST career. He is now one shy of tying Tony Bishop for 10th on the program's career list.

• Texas State will play nine of its first 12 games on the road before beginning conference play and are currently 1-4 away from Strahan Arena. Last season saw the team play eight of 13 non-conference games on the road and post a 5-3 record in those contests.

• With the 10th win this season, the Bobcats will reach 1,400 wins as a program. They recorded the 1,300th win in team history on Nov. 21, 2018 in Portland, Oregon in a victory over Cal Poly by a score of 54-42.

STRAHAN ARENA

Press row for Texas State basketball games is located on the west side concourse level on the baseline. The media entrance to the arena is from the northeast corner of the Arena at Gate 4, and the northeast entrance is also used for Will Call pick up of credentials, also at Gate 4. Parking is located in the lost east of the Arena, across Charles Austin Drive.

MEDIA AND PHOTO CREDENTIALS

Credentials for Texas State home basketball games are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports information office, preferably in advance. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame packets including notes, statistics and game-day programs will be available prior to tip-off. Timeout, halftime, and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be distributed via email following the conclusions of the game. INTERVIEWS

Following a brief cooling off period, Texas State head coach Terrence Johnson and selected players will be available for interviews in the Strahan Arena media room. Texas State's locker room will remain closed at all times. Requests for selected players must be submitted to the Texas State Athletic Communications staff.

All other interviews with basketball players or staff members must be arranged through the Athletic Communications Office with at least 24 hours notice. Media should never contact a player or coach directly.

All-Time vs. UT Arlington

- UT Arlington leads the all-time series 41-38.
- Texas State has won the last two meetings and five of the last six contests.
- Last year saw the Bobcats win 71-65 at Dickies Arena in Fort Worth. Nighael Ceaser led the way with a double-double of 23 points and 11 rebounds.
- When playing in Arlington, TXST is 13-23 all-time.
- Last meeting on the road saw the Mavericks win 70-58 on Jan. 27, 2022.
- Bobcats' last win on the road was a 63-56 contest on Feb. 11, 2021.

Bobcats Against The WAC

- Texas State enters Saturday 191-189 all-time against current members of the Western Athletic Conference.
- Most contests have been against Stephen F. Austin (169) and UT Arlington (79) as former conference opponents other leagues.
- The most victories (67) and losses (102) are against the Lumberjacks.
- Bobcats have a winning record against Abilene Christian (41-18), Seattle (3-0), Tarleton State (21-3) and Utah Tech (1-0).

Rim Protector Love

- Brandon Love has been a menace around the basket for opposing teams.
- The junior forward has recorded 19 blocks so far this season which leads the Sun Belt and is tied for the most in the nation with Justice Ajogbor (Harvard) and Isaiah Cozart (Eastern Kentucky).
- He had a career-high five rejections at Oklahoma and is the first Bobcat to reach the mark since Nighael Ceaser also had five against Arkansas State on Feb. 9, 2023.
- Love followed the 5-block performance with four rejections against I-35 rival UTSA and three apiece in both games of the Louisiana Tech MTE.

Career Rejections

- Brandon Love enters Saturday's game at UT Arlington with 57 career blocks.
- He needs one more to tie Tony Bishop for 10th in program history.
- The program's all-time leader in rejections is Jeff Foster with 111.

Injury Bug

- The injury bug has continued to hit Texas State this season with four players missing a game so far this season.
- Since the start of the 2022-23 season, the Bobcats have played 41 games and had just one contest in which they had an entire healthy roster with that being on Dec. 10, 2022 versus UT Arlington.
- Last year saw the Bobcats have 10 players miss a game because of injury, second most in the nation behind IUPUI's 14 players.

Sooner State Struggles

- Texas State limited success in the state of Oklahoma continued on Tuesday with a 39-point setback.
- Overall, the Bobcats remain at having just one win in the state in program history.
- That victory came on Nov. 30, 1976 at Cameron by a score of 82-71.
- All-time, the Bobcats are 1-16 in the Sooner State.

MAC/SBC Challenge

- Texas State was one of five Sun Belt Conference teams to win a game in the MAC/SBC Challenge.
- A 10-point victory over Miami (OH) started off the Saturday slate.
- It was the Bobcats' first-ever road win over a MAC program and just the second overall.
- TXST and the rest of the Sun Belt teams competing in the challenge will host a MAC program on Feb. 10.

Power 5 Victory Drought Snapped

- On Nov. 21, 2022, Texas State ended its victory drought over a Power 5 conference program with a 59-55 win at California.
- It had been nearly 24 years to the day of the last P5 win, which came on Nov. 24, 1998 at Baylor by a 70-62 score. Assistant coach Donte Mathis was the point guard on that squad.
- The win over the Bears was the 14th for the Bobcats over a P5 opponent with the most being against Texas (5).
- Other wins over P5 teams were against Baylor (3), Miami (1), Texas A&M (3) and Texas Tech (1).
- This season, TXST has two remaining games against P5 program in in Houston (Dec. 21) and Texas (Nov. 30).

Boardfest

- Monday night saw Texas State grab 53 rebounds against Little Rock.
- It was the highest rebound total in a game since also having 53 against LeTourneau on Nov. 24, 2021.
- The last time the Bobcats surpassed 50 boards against a Division I opponent was on Feb. 28, 2020 in a triple overtime contest at UT Arlington.

- In his fourth season leading the Texas State program, Terrence Johnson has won 57 games.
- His total is the 10th most in program history.
- The Bobcats' win at Miami (OH) broke a tie with Harry Larrabee (1986-91).
- Next on the list is Joe B. Cheaney (1935-40, 43) at 60 victories.
- Only three coaches have reached triple-digit wins in Milton Jowers (287; 1946-61), Vernon McDonald (226; 1961-77) and Danny Kaspar (119; 2013-20).

Road Warriors

- Texas State will be on the road a lot in non-conference play with nine of the 12 games taking place away from Strahan Arena.
- Bobcats are 1-4 in the road games after dropping both games in Ruston, Louisiana.
- Seven of the nine contests are true road games while the other two are neutral site games in Ruston, Louisiana as part of the Louisiana Tech MTE.
- Last season saw the Bobcats play seven of their first games on the road and didn't play their home opener in 2021-22 until the sixth game of the campaign.

Road Dubs

- The Bobcats won 12 games away from Strahan Arena last season that included three straight in the Sun Belt Tournament.
- Seven of the victories were in true road contests while the other five were at neutral sites.
- The 12 road victories were tied for the most in the Sun Belt Conference with Louisiana.
- It is the third time since joining the Sun Belt that Texas State has won 10 more games away from San Marcos. The other two times were in 2018-19 (13) and 2020-21 (10).

- Texas State is 351-202 (.635) all-time when playing in Strahan Arena at the University Events Center.
- This season, the Bobcats are 1-0 after defeating I-35 rival UTSA and are now 25-12 under Terrence Johnson.
- Last year saw the Bobcats go 4-10 at home.
- TXST won its 350th game in Strahan Arena against Arkansas State on Feb. 9, 2023.

Legacy Bobcat

- Davion Sykes is in his second year in a Texas State uniform.
- The sophomore is the son of David Sykes, who played in San Marcos from the 1999-00 season to 2002-03 campaign.
- David Sykes is the Bobcats' all-time leader in steals and ranks third in assists and 10th in minutes played (2,609).
- The elder Sykes also has three of the top 10 single-season steal campaigns including the record of 65 set in 2002-03. He was also named to the 2001 All-Southland Conference Third Team.
- As a freshman, Davion averaged 3.5 ppg and 2.4 rpg in 34 contests that included five starts.

Playing Defense

- A team that prides itself on defense, Texas State has been among the defensive leaders in the Sun Belt over the past nine seasons.
- In that time, the Bobcats have finished in the top 50 in the nation in scoring defense eight consecutive years until last season.
- The 2022-23 team ended up 73rd in the nation surrendering 66.7 ppg.

SBC Preseason Poll

- Texas State was picked to finish 10th in the 14-team Sun Belt Conference by the league's head coaches.
- The Bobcats garnered 72 points to finish ahead of Georgia State (69), Coastal Carolina (59), Georgia Southern (42) and ULM (32).
- Coming in just ahead of TXST was Arkansas State (84) and Troy (91).
- Favored to win the league was James Madison, which picked up 176 points and seven first-place votes.
- Also earning at least one first-place selection was App State (2), Louisiana (2), Old Dominion (1) and South Alabama (2).
- No Texas State player was chosen to any of the three preseason all-conference teams for the first time since the 2020-21 season.

Fourth Season as Head Coach
Ninth Season at Texas State
Southern, 2001

Head coach Terrence Johnson ("TJ") is in his fourth season at Texas State and has taken the program to a level it has not seen in its Division I era in his first two years as the head coach.

Johnson, who has been on the Texas State coaching staff since the 2015-16 season, led the Bobcats to back-to-back Sun Belt regular season conference championships, the program's first ever trip to the NIT, and 39 total wins in his first two seasons as the head coach.

The two-time Sun Belt Coach of the Year and NABC District 23 Coach of the Year is the first coach in program history to lead the Bobcats to back-to-back conference championships. He is also the fastest Texas State coach to 39 career wins in more than 40 years.

In 2021-22, Johnson led the Bobcats to the NIT after winning the second Sun Belt regular season title in as many seasons. Texas State was 12-3 in conference (finished 21-8 overall) and put together two different winning streaks of eight or more games.

Johnson took over the program shortly before the 2020-21 campaign and ascended from interim head coach to head coach after guiding the program to a conference title in his first season. The program's 2021 Sun Belt regular season championship was the first in program history and the team's first conference championship since 1999 when it won the Southland Conference title.

The Bobcats won 18 games his first season, which were the most victories by a first-year Texas State head coach in the program's Division I history and second-most all-time behind Dan Wall's 20 wins in 1977-78. He also became the third coach in Texas State history to win conference coach of the year honors, joining Jim Wooldridge (1994, Southland) and Mike Miller (1997, Southland).

In two seasons, Johnson has seen a pair of Bobcats earn four total All-Sun Belt honors. Caleb Asberry was named first team in 2021-22, a year after earning third team, and Mason Harrell picked up first and second team honors in 2020-21 and 2021-22, respectively.

As an assistant with the Bobcats, Johnson played an instrumental role in the development of guard Nijal Pearson, who left the program as the all-time leading scorer (2,122 points), the first All-American since the Bobcats transitioned to NCAA Division I, and the program's first Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year and the first league MVP for Texas State since 1999 (Donte Mathis, Southland Conference).

Johnson arrived in San Marcos after teaching middle school and serving as an AAU coach as recent as 2015.

Johnson has worked with some standout players during his career, most notably Langston Galloway (Phoenix Suns) who played collegiately at St. Joseph's. He went on to be selected by the New York Knicks and was named to the NBA All-Rookie Second Team for the 2014-15 season.

Johnson was regarded as one of the most notable AAU coaches in the southern region as his relationships and strong ties stretch from Texas to Florida. He founded Hollis Price Elite AAU and was the head coach from 2006 to 2010. During that time, his team won the 2008 Louisiana State Championship.

Most notably, Johnson was the head coach of Texas PRO 17-U where he coached standout players like McDonald's All-American and NBA player Jarret Allen (Texas), Galen "G" Robinson (Houston), Alex Hobbs (Boise State), Jarrey Foster (SMU), and Bobcats Marlin Davis and Pearson.

Johnson's first collegiate coaching experience was at Samford, where he served as an assistant from 2010 to 2013.

Born in New Orleans, La., Johnson grew up in Sebastopol, La., located in St. Bernard Parish. His father was a teacher and basketball coach – the first Black head boy's basketball coach in St. Bernard Parish.

Johnson eventually taught and was an assistant basketball coach at the same school as his father in 2003. Over the course of his career, Johnson has worked as a high school and middle school teacher in Houston and Louisiana.

After graduating from high school, Johnson attended Southern University in Baton Rouge, La., where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in microbiology. While at Southern, he intended to play basketball for legendary coach Ben Jobe, but Jobe retired before his freshman year and he ended up never playing for the team. He later went on to receive a master's in education administration from Prairie View A&M University in 2011.
