BLAZER BITES

- UAB is in its 40th season of basketball and owns a 608-556 (.522) overall record.
- Under head coach Randy Norton, UAB is 23-4 in non-conference home contests. The Blazers are currently 5-0 in home games this season.
- The Green and Gold will face Alabama State for the 24th time in program history and the first time since 2012 when UAB rattled off a 74-41 home victory.
- UAB is 50-8 against opponents from the SWAC, including a 2-0 mark this season with wins over Mississippi Valley State and Alabama A&M.
- The Blazers have been lights out from behind the arc this season, shooting 41.5 percent from behind the arc which leads Conference USA.
- UAB has been extremely unselfish this season as the Blazers lead the league in assists per game (17.4) and assist/turnover ratio (1.3).
- Bench play has been huge for the Blazers this season, as the reserves are outscoring opponents, 235-191.

RANDY NORTON

HEAD COACH • IOWA, 1986

- 72-61 overall record in five seasons
- Coached 11 All-Conference USA Team members, including two first-team selections in Karisma Chapman (2013-14) and Janae Smith (2014-15)
- Between 2015-2017, Norton has seen three players earn Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors, including Rachael Childress who was named the 2016-17 C-USA Freshman of the Year
- Responsible for two of UAB's four largest wins inside Bartow Arena (Miles, 106-48, 12/28/16 and Mississippi Valley State, 80-33, 12/05/15)
- Saw three players from his 2015-16 team continue their career in the professional ranks

2016-17

- The Blazers shot a UAB record 37.3 percent from the 3-point line
- UAB drained 218 3-pointers, the second most by a team in a single season in program history
- The Blazers connected on 187 3-pointers in league action, breaking the C-USA record for 3-pointers made by a team in a single season
- UAB's 37.3 percent from beyond the arc in league play marked fifth-highest percentage shot by a team in C-USA history
- The Blazers 58-point victory over Miles was the second largest win in program history
- Rachael Childress took home the 2017 Freshman of the Year award, just the fourth Blazer to earn the honor
- Two All-Freshman team members in Rachael Childress and Miyah Barnes
- Sophomore Deanna Kuzmanic earned the league's Spirit
 of Service Award, which aims to recognize the community
 service efforts of the league's student-athletes, based upon
 significant community service, good academic standing and
 participation in their elected sports
- Kuzmanic was one of just five players named to the league's all-academic team. In order to be eligible, student-athletes have to maintain a 3.2 GPA and be a valuable contributor to the team. Kuzmanic joins four other student-athletes

2015-16

- The Blazers held their opponents to the lowest rebound average in UAB history (32.7)
- UAB tallied 130 blocked shots, the third most by a team in program history
- The Blazers led C-USA in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 57.2 points per contest
- Chelsee Black and Brittany Winborne were named to the All-Conference USA Second Team
- Deanna Kuzmanic garnered C-USA All-Freshman Team honors
- The Blazers recorded a 3.39 cumulative team GPA, the highest team mark since 2006

2014-15

 Finished the season with an 18-13 record and 11-7 mark in league play

- UAB's 36.1 percent mark from long range ranks second for 3-point field goal percentage in program history
- The team drained 198 3-pointers, the fourth most by a team in program history
- The Blazers shot a combined 75.2 percent (361-of-480) from the free-throw line, the second highest percentage in program history
- Janae Smith earned a spot on the First-Team All-Conference USA squad

2013-14

- UAB shot 33.7 percent from deep, the sixth highest percentage in program history
- The Blazers swatted 141 shots, the most by a team in UAB history
- Karisma Chapman earned First-Team All-Conference USA honors after averaging 20.6 points per game including 16 double-doubles in her senior campaign

Prior to UAB

Norton spent three years as the Associate Head Coach at Missouri and seven years as an assistant at Illinois State under Robin Pingeton. In ten years as an assistant, Norton helped guide his teams to six post-season berths, including the 2005 and 2008 NCAA Tournament.

Playing Career

A 1986 graduate of the University of Iowa, Norton played both basketball and baseball for the Hawkeyes. On the hardwood, he was a guard on 1979 Big Ten Conference title team and the 1980 team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. On the diamond, Norton was a four-year letterwinner for the Hawkeyes. He spent three seasons in the Montreal Expos (now Washington Nationals) organization before moving into coaching.

Personal

An Iowa City, Iowa native, Norton and his wife Claire, have four children: Tom, Carly, Allie and Nick. Tom graduated from Truman State, Carly from St. Ambrose and Allie from Truman State, where all three played college basketball. Nick is a two-year starter at point guard for the UAB men's basketball team.

UAB NOTES

ALABAMA STATE

The Green and Gold will face Alabama A&M for the 24th time in program history and for the first time since 2012 which the Blazers won 74-41. UAB holds an 18-5 advantage in the all-time series.

UAB is 50-8 against opponents from the SWAC, including a 2-0 mark this season with wins over Mississippi Valley State and Alabama A&M.

HOLDIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

The Green and Gold has been lights out in Bartow Arena during its non-conference schedule as they are currently 5-0 at home this season in those games. UAB is 23-4 in non-conference home bouts under head coach Randy Norton.

BLAZERS ON TOP

UAB has racked up the points this season as it has outscored its opponents 749-600 through 10 games. The Blazers are first in Conference USA in scoring margin at +14.9 and rank second in scoring offense, averaging 74.9 points per game.

SWISHINGHAM

The Blazers have picked up right where they left off last season from behind the arc as they currently lead Conference USA in 3-point field goal percentage (.415). UAB's shooting percentage behind the arc the 21st-best in the NCAA this season.

SHARING IS CARING

UAB's offensive success is largely due to its ability to share the basketball. The Blazers lead the league in assists (17.4) as well as in assist/turnover ratio (1.3). UAB's assist/turnover ratio is the 24th best in the nation this year.

RACHAEL "MONEY" CHILDRESS

Rachael Childress has proven why she was named to the C-USA Preseason Team as she is currently 11th in the league in scoring (13.9 ppg) and first in 3-point field goals made with 32 (3.2 per game) and third in 3-point field goal percentage (.471).

The sophomore also leads the team in double figure scoring games, recording at least 10 points in eight of the Blazers 10 games.

MIYAH BARNES: ASSIST MASTER

Miyah Barnes has been extremely efficient dishing out the basketball as she leads the team in assists with 48. Her 2.4 assist/turnover ratio is second in Conference USA to date.

KUZMANIC LEADING THE WAY

Deanna Kuzmanic has been a mainstay for the Blazers as she has started every game of her career (71). She also holds the best assist/turnover ration in Conference USA at 3.0.

At the Hilton Concord Classic, Kuzmanic set career highs in scoring in both games (22 - Indiana, 24 - UC-Santa Barbara). She

was named to the All-Tournament Team for her efforts.

EYES ON THE 1K CLUB

Deanna Kuzmanic is well on her way to becoming the Blazers' 28th member of the 1,000-point club. She currently has 777 career points and needs just 223 points to eclipse the 1,000-point mark.

CALL IN THE REINFORCEMENTS

UAB's has gotten dominant play off of its bench as the Blazers have outscored opponents 235-191 in that category. Imani Johnson has been the Blazers' top threat off the bench, scoring 82 of UAB's 235 bench points (.349 percent) through 10 games.

PADDING THE STATS

Eight Blazers have already set new career highs this season, including Childress (29), Kuzmanic (24), Thomas (22), Johnson (15), Rawls (15), Vendrell (11), Kerstein (6) and Roldan (6).

NOV-WIN-BER

The Blazers had a lot to be thankful for during the month of November, as the team went an impressive 4-1 (.800). It is the most wins for the Blazers in the month of November since they won four during the 2014-15 season.

EXHIBITION PLAY

UAB played in two exhibition games to open the 2017-18 season against Montevallo (Nov. 1) and Judson College

UAB NOTES

(Nov. 7). The Blazers' outscored their two opponents 239-71 while averaging 119.5 points per contest.

LIVE ACTION

While last year's team was one of the youngest in the nation with eight players having never played in a college game, this year is the complete opposite as nine of the Blazers' 13 available players saw game action last season. Of the four who did not play last season, Maya Garland is the only who has seen action for the Green and Gold in her career.

FRESH-MAN

Rachael Childress was dominant for the Blazers last season as she was named C-USA Freshman of the Year. Her efforts were well recieved as the now-sophmore was named to the Preseason All-Conference Team. Childress led the team with an average of 12.4 points per game in 31.7 minutes per game.

Childress was extremely effective behind the arc, breaking multiple conference and program records. She holds Conference USA's freshman record for 3-pointers made in a single season (95), which is also fifth overall in the record books. Her 95 made 3-pointers is good for second in school history and a UAB freshman record.

THE BIG THREE

Deanna Kuzmanic, Miyah Barnes and Rachael Childress were a force to be reckoned with for UAB last season. The trio was dominant as they accounted for 45 percent (906 pts.) of the teams scoring. Childress set numerous conference and program records en route to being named C-USA Freshman of the Year and being named to the C-USA All-Freshman Team

Barnes was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team after seeing action in 30 games, including 27 starts. Kuzmanic has also been a influential for the program as she was one of only two players to start in all 30 games last season, averaging 9.0 points in 34.1 minutes.

TEAM BREAKDOWN

UAB returns three of its starters from last season's squad in Deanna Kuzmanic, Miyah Barnes and Rachael Childress. The Blazers also welcome back letterwinners in Whytney Singleton, Angela Vendrell, Katelynn Thomas, T'erra Lewis, Kara Rawls, Maya Garland and Imani Johnson, while welcoming newcomers Talia Roldan, Lea Kerstein and University of Alabama transfer Trista Magee.

SCHEDULIN'

UAB's non-conference schedule includes 13 games featuring nine different conferences. The Blazers are set to face teams from the AAC, Big 10, Big South, Big West, MVC, SIAC, SoCon, Sun Belt and SWAC. The Blazers' league slate features an 18-game schedule with the games being played on a Thursday-Saturday schedule.

CONFERENCE USA TOURNAMENT

12 league teams will travel to the 2017 Conference USA Men's and Women's Basketball Championships, as the tournament will be held in Frisco, Texas at the Ford Center at The Star. It will be the first time in three seasons that the conference tournament will not be held in Birmingham.

BARTOW ARENA MEDIA ROOM

BARTOW ARENA



- Bartow Arena is in its 29th season as the home court for the women's basketball, men's basketball and volleyball teams.
- Bartow Arena has afforded the Blazers a solid home court advantage, as UAB posts a 264-149 (.638) record in the building.
- The arena was dedicated on December 3, 1988. The first win for the Blazers came on December 6, 1988, against Southern University, 66-64. The facility was renamed Bartow Arena on January 25, 1997.
- Bartow is a spacious 18,000-square feet floor space with lower level seats retracted, enough room for three full courts (basketball or volleyball).
- With a maximum capacity of 9,000, Bartow Arena has 6,500 permanent seats, and 2,000 retractable.
- Over the years, improvements have been made, such as a state-of-the-art video boards, administrative towers annex, a new locker room for football, a new paint scheme for both the permanent and portable floors, and major renovations to the Green and Gold room.
- Bartow Arena was the site of the 1991 Sun Belt Women's Tournament and the 1996 Conference USA Women's Championship. The Conference USA Tournament was held in Bartow Arena for three-straight years from 2015-17.


