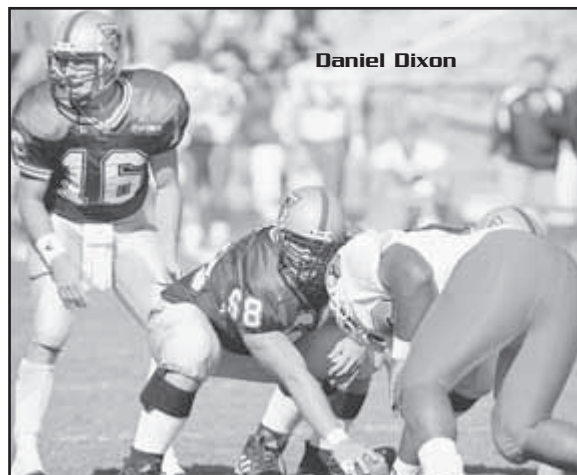

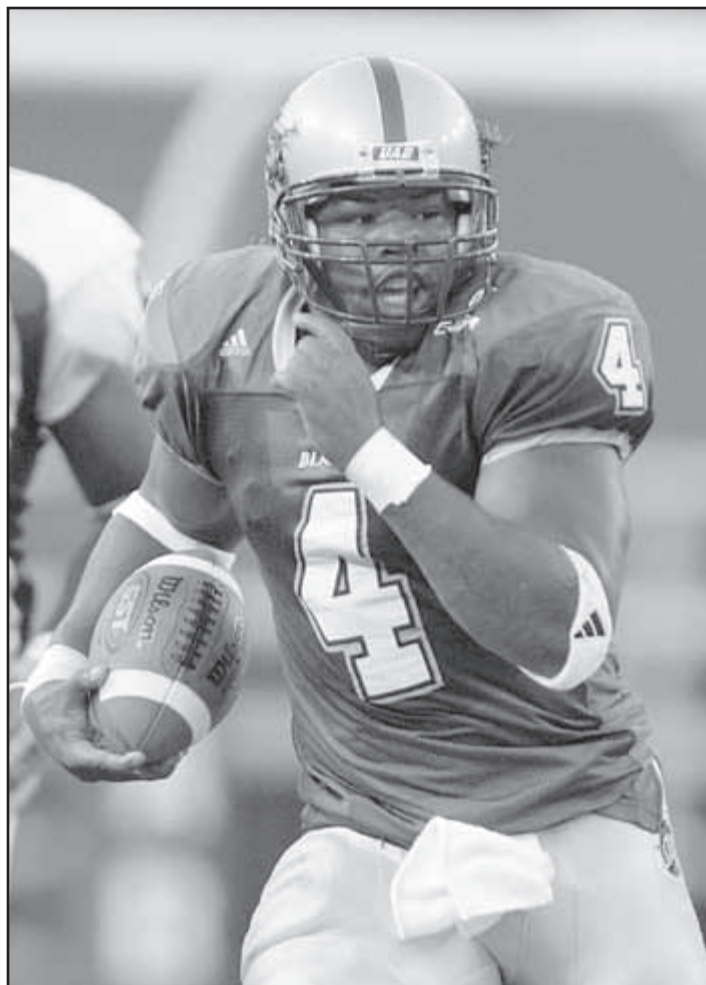

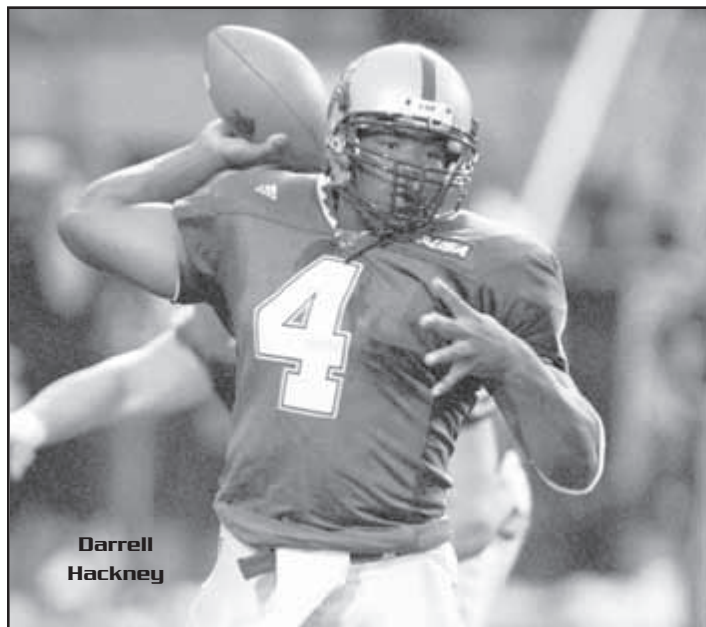

Homecoming Games

Homecomings have been quite a successful venture for the UAB program. As a participant, both as the visitor and the host, UAB is 18-11-1 in homecoming games. The mark is 12-3 at Legion Field, and 6-8-1 on the road.

Homecoming during football season at UAB had what was perhaps its best celebration in 1996 in what was also undoubtedly the Blazers' toughest homecoming contest to that point. The Blazers hosted the Ragin' Cajuns of Southwestern Louisiana, looking to avenge a 56-21 loss to USL a year earlier.

An offensive shootout saw the Blazers trail 29-28 entering the fourth quarter, and midway through the quarter, quarterback Rodney Hudson connected with Robert Davis on a 67-yard screen pass from deep in UAB's territory. Four plays later, Hudson connected with running back Keith Roland on a 13-yard pass for the go-ahead score; the two-point conversion made it, 36-29. After an interception by Omar Parker, a Jake Arians field goal clinched the victory, 39-29.

But the celebration of homecoming at UAB has not always been a football "tradition." Prior to the 1994 football season, the festivities of homecoming were conducted during the basketball season. It was not until the spring of 1994 that university administrators and athletic department officials agreed that the activities would be moved to football season.

The road streak includes a 35-35 tie at Hampden-Sydney in the inaugural season of Division III competition in 1991, as well as back-to-back road wins during the 1993 season at Mississippi Valley State (30-13) and Charleston Southern (48-20).

The most memorable of the "road" wins in homecoming games came in 2000, when the Blazers upset LSU 13-10 in Baton Rouge (Sept. 23), spoiling homecoming for the Tigers and a sellout crowd of 83,339.

UAB's defense stifled the Tigers for most of the game, Daniel Dixon

came off the bench to toss a 24-yard touchdown pass to Leron Little, and Rhett Gallego connected on two field goals, the last a 32-yarder on the game's final play to clinch the win.

The Blazers also won their own homecoming game in 2000, holding off a very tough Middle Tennessee team at Legion Field (Oct. 21) behind 102 rushing yards from Jegil Dugger and 153 passing yards and a touchdown pass from Jeff Aaron.

UAB spoiled another SEC homecoming in 2004 when the Blazers traveled to Starkville, Miss. to knock off Mississippi State, 27-13.

UAB saw its five-game Homecoming game win streak at Legion Field come to an end in 2006 as SMU edged the Blazers, 28-27. UAB has since won its last two Homecoming contests at Legion Field, and seven of eight overall. Last year, UAB defeated Tulane, 26-21. The Blazers defeated Tulane in the 2001 homecoming contest and then won over Houston in 2002.

The Blazers have captured victories in their last three homecoming games. They defeated in-state foe Troy, 21-3, in 2006, downed Tulane, 26-21, in 2007, and last season edged Marshall by a 23-21 score.

Legion Field

Historic Legion Field has been the site of many a classic grid-iron confrontation in its 70 years of existence. The first game on November 19, 1927, a “local” battle that saw Howard (now Samford) defeat Birmingham-Southern 9-0; since that time, the stadium has played host to hundreds of high school, college and professional football contests.

The stadium was constructed in 1926 with an original capacity of 21,000; the cost of the original construction was \$439,000. The stadium was named in 1927 in honor of the American Legion and stands as a memorial to those who gave their lives in the service of this country.

The stadium grew significantly over the years, growing to a capacity of 83,091. At that time, the expansion moved the stadium to 10th among the then-112 Division I football stadiums in the country.

After having an artificial playing surface for 25 years, the stadium was returned to grass in time for the 1995 season; Legion Field was the site for first-round soccer games during the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta.

A new, state-of-the-art Sure Turf surface was added prior to the 2006 season.

The stadium has seen its share of famous players and coaches throughout the years. Among the players who have competed here are Johnny Unitas, Doak Walker, Bobby Layne, Dick Butkus, Sammy Baugh, and Vincent “Bo” Jackson.

The coaching list includes such greats as Tom Landry, Bob Neyland, Bobby Bowden, Wallace Wade, Tom Osborne, Wally Butts, John McKay, Hank Stram, Jack Pardee, Bobby Dodd, Ralph



“Shug” Jordan, Pat Dye, Paul “Bear” Bryant, Vince Dooley and Joe Paterno.

In addition to its numerous high school and collegiate contests, Legion Field has served as the home of the Birmingham Americans and Birmingham Vulcans of the World Football League, the Birmingham Stallions of the United States Football League, the Birmingham Fire of the World League of American Football, the Birmingham Barracudas of the Canadian Football League, and the Birmingham Bolts of the XFL.

UAB has posted an overall record of **61-35-1** at Legion Field during the past 18 seasons, winning just shy of 70 percent of its contests in the stadium. The Blazers were 2-2-1 at home in their inaugural season of Division III competition in 1991; the first home victory

was a 9-7 triumph over Hastings on Nov. 9, 1991.

In 1992, UAB won all five of its home contests and extended its home winning streak to seven games. That streak was ended, however, in the season-opener of the 1993 campaign - the Blazers’ first year of competition in Division I-AA - as the nationally-ranked Troy State Trojans defeated the Blazers 37-3 before a crowd of 14,207 on Labor Day afternoon (Sept. 6, 1993). However, working on just four days rest, the Blazers came back five days later and earned their first I-AA victory with a 52-14 decision over Morehead State.

UAB was 5-1 at Legion Field in 1993, a record that included an unusual “road” appearance in the stadium as the Blazers were the visitors in a city showdown with Miles College, which UAB won, 31-6.

The Blazers were 3-2 at Legion Field in 1998, and 3-2 again in 1999, a mark that included a win over Houston in UAB’s first-ever Conference USA game (Sept. 25, 1999) and a stunning 36-17 upset of No. 17-ranked East Carolina on Nov. 6, 1999.

The Blazers finished with a 4-1 mark in 2004. UAB have compiled 2-3 home records the two last seasons after a 3-3 mark in 2006.

Awards were presented by the Associated Press, The Sports Network, a national wire service that conducts weekly I-AA national rankings and The Football Gazette.



Josh Evans, DT
1993, 1994

Josh Evans was a four-year letterwinner and start for the Blazers' defensive line. He was one of 16 players to play on each of the first four teams in the program's brief history.

Evans earned honorable-mention All-America honors from *The Sports Network* in 1993 and 1994.

As a senior in 1994, Evans posted 72 tackles with five sacks and 13 tackles for losses.

A consistent performer during his career, Evans ranks among the top five career leaders in tackles at UAB. Evans spent nearly 10 seasons in the NFL with various organizations before retiring in 2005.



Derrick Ingram, WR
1993, 1994

Derrick Ingram was a four-year letterwinner who proved to be one of the nation's top receivers in his senior season.

Ingram earned first-team All-America honors from the Associated Press in 1994 and was a second-team selection by The Sports Network. In '93, he was a second-team AP and honorable mention Sports Network honoree.

In 1994, Ingram posted 83 receptions for 1,457 yards and 13 touchdowns; his 1,457 yards rank as the third-best single-season performance in I-AA history, eclipsing the mark of 1,450 by Jerry Rice during his junior season.

He completed his career with 207 receptions for 3,379 yards and 28 touchdowns.



John Whitcomb, QB
1993, 1994

John Whitcomb left Southern Mississippi, where he backed up current Green Bay Packer starter Brett Favre, and transferred to UAB where he started four games in 1992 and all 22 during the '93 and '94 seasons.

The strong-armed quarterback quickly made his mark on the program, throwing for 3,012 yards and 21 touchdowns as a junior, earning honorable mention All-America honors from The Sports Network.

As a senior, the Chipley, Fla., native threw for 3,031 yards and 22 touchdowns and finished his UAB career with 560 completions for 7,420 yards and 53 touchdowns.

Cedrick Buchannon spent three years "in the shadow" of fellow All-American Derrick Ingram but made the most of his fourth and final season with the Blazers in 1995.

Buchannon is UAB's all-time leader in kickoff and punt returns, and he ranks second among all-time leaders in receiving.

Indeed, it was his special-teams play that earned him Honorable-Mention All-America honors from The Football Gazette in his senior season. Buchannon ranked among the national leaders in kickoff and punt returns; he had 14 kickoff returns for 335 yards, and he returned 23 punts for 312 yards and two touchdowns.



Kerry Frazier, LB
1995

Kerry Frazier wasted no time in making an impact on the UAB program.

Frazier started all 11 games in 1995 at middle linebacker with 91 tackles, including 65 solos; he posted four quarterback sacks (second-most on team) and six total tackles for losses. He also had an interception and a fumble recovery in a campaign that earned him honorable mention All-America honors from The Football Gazette.



Robert Leslie, DE
1995

Robert Leslie got better and better during his career at UAB, and in his senior season he was one of the top defensive ends in the nation.

Leslie posted a career-high 81 tackles (third-best on the team) in his senior season; he set a single-season record with 13 quarterback sacks and tied a team mark with 16 total tackles for losses. Those numbers earned the three-year letterwinner second team All-America honors from The Football Gazette.

The three-year starter finished his career with 224 tackles, 20 sacks and 28 total tackles for losses.



Johnny Rea, C
1997

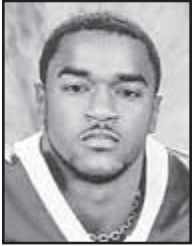
Johnny Rea was a four-year starter and letterwinner on the offensive line during his collegiate career at UAB (1994-97) and also established himself as one of the finest all-around student-athletes in the history of UAB athletics.

Rea came to UAB on an academic scholarship and walked on; a year later, he was on athletic aid.

The Pell City, Ala., native posted a 4.0 GPA for his undergraduate career, earned him Presidential Honors (a 4.0 GPA) in each of his full-time quarters as well as first-team Academic All-America honors. in 1997-98.

Rodregis Brooks, CB
1999

Rodregis Brooks was lucky to even be playing at the beginning of the 1999 season. The junior cornerback had suffered a torn groin muscle in 1998 pre-season practice and had to sit out the year as a medical redshirt. Brooks came back, tying for the national lead in interceptions with nine, and leading the nation in punt return yardage for much of the year. Brooks received first-team All-Conference USA honors and was named C-USA Special Teams Player of The Year. In addition, he earned second team All-America honors from the Associated Press, becoming the first Blazer All-American of the I-A era.



Bryan Thomas, DE
2001

Bryan Thomas' dedication and hard work paid dividends in April, 2002 when he was selected No. 22 in the NFL draft by the New York Jets.

Thomas became the first UAB player in history to be taken in the NFL's opening round. Thomas was the anchor of the Blazers' "Steel Shield" which led



Roddy White, WR
2001-04

Roddy White was a three-year letterwinner for the Blazers at wide receiver and while he had productive seasons as a sophomore and junior, it was in 2004 as a senior when White emerged as one of the best at his position in the country. White caught 71 passes as a senior for an NCAA-leading and Conference USA record 1,452 yards. He also was on the receiving end of 14 touchdowns, also a league record. White, who was chosen in the first round of the 2005 NFL draft by the Atlanta Falcons, earned All-America honors by several agencies, including Associated Press.
