UAB TRAVELS TO COASTAL CAROLINA FOR FIRST ROAD GAME OF 2018:

After a dominating 52-0 victory over Savannah State to open the season, the UAB football team travels to Coastal Carolina for its first road game of 2018. The matchup with Coastal Carolina is a rematch from last season when UAB and CCU met for the first time in program history. The Blazers edged Coastal Carolina 30-23 in that contest.

LIGHTS OUT DEFENSE:

The Blazer defense was lights out against Savannah State and did not surrender a point to the Tigers, marking the first shutout in 10 years for UAB. The Blazers only allowed one pass completion for 23 yards, and because of that, UAB ranks 1st nationally in pass efficiency defense, 9th in total defense, and was just one of four teams in the country to pitch a shutout along with Georgia, Georgia Tech and Air Force in Week 1.

BROWN PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF:

In only one half of work, sophomore running back Spencer Brown rushed for 102 yards on 18 carries against Savannah State, and in the process notched his seventh career 100-yard rushing performance. His seven career 100-yard rushing games moves him into a tie for fourth place on UAB's career list in that category, and he continues to inch closer to Jordan Howard's record of 12 career 100-yard rushing performances. Brown was a 2017 FWAA Freshman All-America honoree.

BALANCED OFFENSIVE ATTACK:

The UAB offense was clicking on all cylinders in the opener as the Blazers piled up 548 yards of total offense, which was the 27th time in school history UAB has had 500+ yards of total offense. The Blazers did it with a balanced air and ground attack by compiling 285 rushing yards and 263 passing yards. A.J. Erdely completed 22-of-28 passes for 228 yards and two touchdowns, while his top receiving target was Collin Lisa who had a career-high 10 catches for 93 yards and a TD. UAB had four rushing touchdowns as well, all coming from four different backs as Brown, James Noble III, Kingston Davis and Lucious Stanley all found the end zone.

WOOLBRIGHT AND HARRIS WITH INTs:

With UAB leading 7-0 midway through the second quarter, Chris Woolbright ignited a 21-point quarter with an interception which he returned 34 yards to the house to give the Blazers a 14-0 lead. It was his second career interception and his first career touchdown. UAB has now had an INT returned for a touchdown in each of its two season openers since the return as Anthony Rush also had a pick-six last year against Alabama A&M. On Savannah State's ensuing drive after the interception, cornerback Brontae Harris had an interception which UAB turned into a touchdown. It was also Harris' second career interception.

After a two-year hiatus from game action in which **Bill Clark** stayed loyal to UAB and rebuilt the program from scratch, the Blazers experienced unprecedented success in their 2017 return season and finished with a program record eight FBS wins.

Clark guided UAB to an 8-5 overall record and just its second bowl appearance in program history. The Blazers have now been bowl eligible five times in school history and both years under Clark. Other school records set in 2017 included going 6-2 in C-USA action and a perfect 6-0 mark at home for the first time ever.

Maybe most impressively, Clark helped galvanize an entire community throughout the two-year hiatus as the city of Birmingham contributed more than \$47 million to help reinstate the program. The loyalty was evident as UAB led Conference USA in attendance with an averaged of 26,375 fans per game in 2017.

Included in that was #theReturn against Alabama A&M on Sept. 2 in which a record crowd of 45,212 fans poured into Legion Field to witness the Blazers' 38-7 victory in its first game back in 1,007 days.

Clark and the Blazers proved the entire nation wrong in 2017 (ranked 130th out of 130 teams in preseason publications), and for his efforts he was a candidate for almost every national coaching award, and won the CBS Sports National Coach of the Year as well as Conference USA Coach of the Year.

On the field, he orchestrated one of UAB's most potent offenses in program history and a devastating ground game featuring true freshman Spencer Brown, who ran for 1,329 yards and 10 touchdowns. Brown slashed the UAB records books in his first season donning the Green and Gold as he broke program's single season rushing record by a freshman previously held by Jordan Howard and he is currently third in program history for overall single season rushing yards. His 10 rushing touchdowns is also seventh most in a single season.

Brown was named the Conference USA Freshman of the Year, a FWAA Freshman All-American and a Second Team All-Conference USA member for his efforts.

Clark also guided quarterback A.J. Erdely to record setting numbers as the junior tied a school record with 13 rushing touchdowns and threw for 2,331 yards and 16 touchdowns while completing 60.7 percent of his passes. His 29 total touchdowns were the second most in a single season at UAB.

The 2017 defense was led by a trio of seniors who became the backbone of the program, led by Darius Williams who was named First Team All-Conference USA and a First Team All-American by Pro Football Focus. He finished the regular season leading C-USA in passes defended (20), pass breakups (15) and interceptions (5).

Tevin Crews more than tripled his production from his junior year in 2014 as he led the team in tackles with 102 and was second on the team in tackles for loss (12.0). Crews finished the regular season as the only player in Conference USA to rank in the top 10 in both tackles and tackles for loss.

Shaq Jones had 57 tackles and 13.0 TFL at the jack linebacker position and set the example for the team on and off the field. Along with his on-field production, Jones was named to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team and was a semifinalist for the inaugural Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year Award, both awarded for exceptional community service and humanitarian work.

Prior to the start of the 2017 season, the Blazers moved into their new state-of-the-art Football Operations Center which features coach's offices, meeting and film rooms, athletic training facilities, locker rooms, a weight room, a nutrition station and two full turf practice fields. One of those practice fields is a pioneering open-air covered pavilion made possible by Legacy Community Federal Credit Union.

Legacy Credit Union announced the largest-ever sponsorship with UAB, a 20-year, \$4.2

million naming right agreement for Legacy Pavilion, and in the process, became the official credit union of UAB.

In Clark's first season as head coach of the Blazers in 2014, he turned around a program that was 2-10 the year before into a team that finished 6-6 and earned bowl eligibility for the first time since 2004.

The Blazers had a school record 15 players earn All-Conference USA honors during the 2014 season, including three first team selections (RB Jordan Howard, DE Diaheem Watkins and KR J.J. Nelson). Nelson was also named the school's first Walter Camp First Team All-American.

The Blazers also experienced the country's second-highest increase in home attendance average, growing by more than 130 percent.

Prior to UAB, Clark was the head coach at Jacksonville State in 2013 and led the Gamecocks to an 11-4 record, their most victories since the 1992 campaign when JSU won the NCAA Division II National Championship. That number set an Ohio Valley Conference record and was also the most wins by a first-year head coach.

Jacksonville State earned an at-large berth in the FCS Playoffs and captured two victories -- including a second-round win over No. 6 McNeese State to reach the quarterfinals. The wins were the Gamecocks' first-ever in the NCAA Division I playoffs.

JSU concluded the 2013 season ranked No. 10 in the final FCS poll. The Gamecocks, who ranked sixth in the nation in FCS attendance, set 49 school records in 2013 and broke 13 OVC marks, as well as three NCAA records. JSU had two players earn All-America honors and nine selected for All-Ohio Valley Conference accolades.

Clark became Jacksonville State's head coach after five outstanding seasons at South Alabama as the Jaguars' defensive coordinator.

Clark's defense at USA finished second in the Sun Belt Conference in total defense in 2012 as the Jaguars completed their first full season of competition in the league. South Alabama posted the best record of any Division I FCS Independent in 2011 after winning the first 17 games in the program's history in 2009 and 2010.

During the 2010 season, South Alabama allowed only 13 points and 254.6 yards per game en route to a 10-0 record. In 2009, the Jags allowed only 5.9 points and 234 yards per game when the defense forced 25 sacks and forced 23 turnovers in only seven games.

Clark joined South Alabama in 2008 after spending nine years as head coach at Prattville (Ala.) High School where he led the Lions to national prominence. He won a pair of Class 6A State Championships as his last two teams won 30 straight games, while the 2007 squad was ranked No. 2 in USA Today's national high school poll.

Following his final season at Prattville High School, he was named the Alabama High School Athletic Association Coach of the Year and was also selected as the Schutt Southeast Regional Coach of the Year.

He first led the Lions to the Class 6A state playoffs in 2000, his second season guiding the program. Clark earned his first postseason victory a year later, helping Prattville advance to the quarterfinals before falling to the eventual state champion, which is where the Lions' season would end each of the next two falls.

Prattville made its first state championship game appearance under Clark in 2004, with the team allowing three touchdowns in four postseason contests, including a pair of shutouts. The Lions advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2005 playoffs before dropping a two-point decision.

Clark posted a 107-11 (90.7 percent) overall record during his tenure, suffering his last regular-season loss during the second week of the 2002 season.

Clark served on the staff of the Alabama-Mississippi All-Star Classic three times, including as head coach in the summer of 2007. He also served as head coach in the 2004 North-South All-Star Game. Clark began his coaching career as an assistant at Piedmont High School (1990-91) and also has coaching stints at Tuscaloosa County High School (1992-94), Coffee County (Ga.) High School (1995-96) and Dothan High School (1997-98).

He graduated from Jacksonville State in 1990 with a degree in physical education. Clark and his wife, Jennifer, have two children: daughter, Katie and son Jacob. His son Jacob appeared in all 13 games on special teams for the Blazers in 2017.

500+ Yards of Total Offense

The Blazers had 548 yards of total offense against Savannah State, which was the 27th time in program history the Blazers have compiled over 500 yards of total offense. It was the first time UAB had over 500 yards of offense since Week 2 of the 2017 season when they had 504 at Ball State. The Blazers are 16-11 overall when compiling over 500 yards of total offense.

LISA LEADING C-USA IN CATCHES

Senior Collin Lisa had a career-high 10 catches against Savannah State and caught all 10 targets that came his way. His 10 catches were the most by any player in Conference USA and he was only one of eight players nation wide to have at least 10 catches in Week 1.

RED ZONE EFFICIENCY

The Blazers made seven trips to the red zone against Savannah State and converted all seven trips into points, including six touchdowns. UAB finished 24th nationally in red zone offense in 2017 and is off to a tremendous start this season.

THIRD DOWN SUCCESS

UAB was 8-of-12 on third down against Savannah State, while one of the failed conversions was taking a knee in victory formation. The Blazers were 18th nationally in this statistic a year ago and their success on opening night currently ranks them seventh overall.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

BLAZERS SHUT OUT SAVANNAH STATE

The UAB defense dominated Savannah State en route to a 52-0 victory. It was the Blazers' first shutout in 10 years dating back to a 15-0 victory at UCF on Nov. 29, 2008, and just their sixth since becoming Division I members in 1995.

NO FLY ZONE

UAB held Savannah State to just one completion for the entire game as the Tigers finished 1-of-17 for 23 yards. The Blazers now find themselves leading the nation in pass defense efficiency, along with being third in passing yards allowed and ninth in total defense.

UAB also picked off the Tigers twice on Thursday. The Blazers were ball hawks last season and finished with 14 interceptions and picked up right where they left off. Chris Woolbright returned his interception 34 yards for a touchdown as well.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The UAB football team notched its second largest margin of victory in program history on Thursday night as the Blazers defeated Savannah State 52-0 at Legion Field in front of 27,124 fans.

The Blazer defense held the Tigers to 178 yards of total offense and just 23 yards through the air en route to its first shutout since Nov. 29, 2008, against UCF. The 23 yards passing are the second fewest given up by UAB since allowing 10 yards through the air against WKU on Oct. 5, 1996.

“These were our fans here, and really, a great job as they always do,” said head coach Bill Clark. “We’ve got a big road game next week and then we’ll be playing Tulane at 12 p.m. the week after next, which is a really great opponent. Hopefully they’ll come out and support us again. We’re very appreciative of them.”

Sophomore running back Spencer Brown tallied his seventh career 100-yard rushing performance which moved him into fourth place on UAB’s career 100-yard rushing list. He finished with 102 yards on 18 carries.

Senior wide receiver Collin Lisa had a career night with 10 catches for 93 yards and a touchdown, while quarterback A.J. Erdely threw for 228 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, linebacker Kristopher Moll had a team-high five tackles, while Jamell Garcia-Williams had four tackles, two TFL and a sack. Chris Woolbright and Brontae Harris each had interceptions, while Woolbright returned his to the house for a touchdown.

HOW IT HAPPENED:

UAB marched down the field on its opening drive as Spencer Brown picked up 41 yards on five carries, and finished off the drive with a three-yard touchdown run. The Blazer offense had 123 yards on 22 plays in the opening quarter.

The defense sparked the offense as two second quarter interceptions turned into points for the Blazers. With Savannah State backed up in its own end, Woolbright recorded his second career interception and returned it 34 yards for a touchdown, giving UAB a 14-0 lead.

Brontae Harris snagged his second career INT on the ensuing drive to set up the offense with excellent field position on the Savannah State 43-yard line. From there, the Blazers needed five plays to find the end zone, capped with A.J. Erdely finding Andre Wilson in the corner of the end zone for six, giving UAB a 21-0 lead with 4:55 left in the second.

After forcing a Savannah State three and out, the Green and Gold went to work with a 6-play, 62-yard drive that culminated with Kingston Davis punching it in from one yard out as UAB went up 28-0 at the half.

The Blazer offense put on the steam as they took their opening drive of the second half 75 yards, finishing it off with Erdely connecting with Lisa in the end zone to put UAB up 35-0. UAB tacked on three more points before the end of the third with Nick Vogel adding a 23-yard field goal, putting the Blazers up 38-0.

UAB put up two more touchdowns in the fourth quarter as Lucious Stanley and James Noble III scored on the ground after drives of seven and eight plays, respectively. The 52-0 final score is the second largest margin of victory in school history.

UP NEXT:

UAB will hit the road next week to play Coastal Carolina in Conway, S.C. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. CT on Sept. 8.

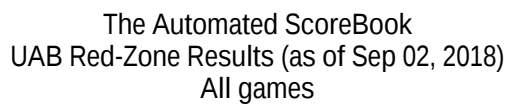
