The University at Albany baseball team hopes history will repeat itself this week when the squad heads to Lowell, Mass. for the four-team, double-elimination style America East Conference Tournament, which runs May 22-24 at LeLacheur Park. The No. 3 seeded Great Danes will face the No. 2 seeded Binghamton Bearcats in the first round Wednesday at 8:00 p.m., following the clash between No. 1 Maine and No. 4 Stony Brook. UAlbany will be making its eighth appearance in the tournament having won the title once before – 2007 – which was also the last time the Great Danes were seeded third.

NOTES



BEARCAT BATTLE

Quite familiar with one another, Binghamton and UAlbany come off last weekend's three-game series in which Binghamton won 2-of-3 at UAlbany's Varsity Field. UAlbany has played the Bearcats eight times in conference tournament history, leading the series with a 5-3 record. In first round games, they have met twice with an even 1-1 record, including Binghamton's 2-1 win in last year's tournament at Stony Brook.

SCOUTING THE GREAT DANES (23-23-1, 16-14 America East)

The Great Danes come off a 1-2 weekend against Binghamton, in which the Bearcats edged UAlbany, 3-2 in extras (9 inn.) in game one. The Danes rallied to win game two, 5-4, before falling 10-3 in Sunday's Senior Day rubber match. With an arsenal of bats in the lineup, UAlbany ranks second in the league with a collective .278 batting average, as well as hitting .288 against conference opponents. Junior Josh Nethaway (.324), senior Nolan Gaige (.315), and senior Greg Muller (.311) lead the way. Defensively, the Great Danes own a .970 fielding percentage and a collective 5.03 ERA.

THE UALBANY COACH: Jon Mueller (14th season, Eckerd College '92)

Jon Mueller is in his 14th season as the head coach of the University at Albany baseball program. The Stillwater, N.Y. native has had proven success as both a player and coach throughout his career. Mueller ranks first among UAlbany's career leaders with 302 coaching victories, and was named the America East Coach of the Year in 2004. He also led the Danes to the program's first America East Conference tournament championship title and NCAA appearance in 2007. Mueller has produced dozens of all-conference standouts and has had six players selected in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft under his direction, including one in each of the past two seasons.

SCOUTING THE BEARCATS (27-22, 16-13 America East)

Taking 2-of-3 against UAlbany in the regular season finale, Binghamton clinched second place in the standings. The Bearcats boast the best fielding percentage in the league -- .974 -- while the pitching staff owns a 3.85 ERA, good for second behind Maine. Offensively, Binghamton is batting a collective .263 average led by sophomore Jake Thomas, who owns the conference's best average (.374) and junior Daniel Nevares (.325).

THE BEARCAT COACH: Tim Sinicki (21st season, Western Carolina '88)

Tim Sinicki has been named the America East Coach of the Year four times in the last eight seasons (2005, 2007, 2009, 2010), leading Binghamton to four straight regular season conference titles from 2007-10. Sinicki began his collegiate playing career as a freshman all-conference pitcher at Binghamton in 1985. One year later, he was named to the All-Region III team while pitching at nearby Broome Community College, where he was tabbed by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the Major League Baseball amateur draft. He finished his playing career at Western Carolina University in Cullowhee, N.C., where the Catamounts captured back-to-back Southern Conference titles and competed in the NCAA Division I Championship both seasons. In his 21st season at the helm, Sinicki owns a 458-465-6 all-time record.

2013 AMERICA EAST TOURNAMENT

Announced by the league office March 6th, the America East Conference will take its 2013 baseball championship to LeLacheur Park in Lowell, Mass., home of Boston Red Sox Single A affiliate Lowell Spinners. The state of the art facility was tabbed to host the entire championship, marking the first time it has been held at a predetermined minor-league facility since 2001.

UALBANY IN THE AMERICA EAST TOURNAMENT

The Great Danes will compete in the America East Tournament for the fifth straight season and eighth time since 2004. UAlbany has won the tournament once -- as the No. 3 seed in 2007. The Great Danes advanced to the NCAA Regional in Fayetteville, Ark. where faced Arkansas (9-0, L) and Creighton (21-11, L). UAlbany has been seeded third twice before, owning a 4-2 record.

SENIOR DAY

Prior to UAlbany's final home game and series finale versus Binghamton last Saturday, the Great Danes honored the squad's eight seniors -- Luke Burns, Austin Chase, Brian Gauthier, Kasceim Graham, Nolan Gaige, Greg Muller, Jeff Welsh, and Derek Zielinski. As a class, the seniors have led UAlbany to an appearance every year in the America East Conference Tournament, including three runner-up finishes, as well as a 67-55 overall conference record.

STREAKING TRACY

Sophomore third baseman Joey Tracy entered last weekend with a 15-game hitting streak, marking UAlbany's longest streak since 2008 when Ryan Gugel and Brendan Rawland both hit in 15 consecutive games. Unfortunately, it was snapped in the first clash with Binghamton. The longest hitting streak in UAlbany's Division I history is 18 games, set by Kirt Zimmewicz in 2004. During the streak, Tracy raised his batting average 174 points. He currently owns a .250 average on the season and .322 against conference foes. While Tracy's hitting streak was snapped, his on-base streak continues at 17. In addition to Tracy, Nolan Gaige has reached successfully in 25 straight games and Greg Muller 19.

TRIPLE THREAT

Senior Nolan Gaige currently ranks 11th among NCAA Division I players for triples per game this spring. Gaige, who is UAlbany's all-time career leader in three-baggers (17) has ripped a league-high six triples this season (0.13/game).

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UAlbany's active career doubles leader redshirt junior Josh Nethaway has belted 43 in his three-year tenure, ranking third all-time in program history. With 17 this season, Nethaway is tied for third all-time in a single season. Against America East opponents this spring, the Fonda, N.Y. native has ripped 13 two-baggers, leading the league.

GAIGE'S RECORD-BREAKING HITS

With two hits against Manhattan on April 24th, senior Nolan Gaige became the University at Albany baseball program's all-time hits leader, now totaling 247 in his four-year career. Gaige passed Michael Oliva (229: 1997-01) in the archives with his first hit of the night -- a leadoff double in the top of the first. In addition, Gaige is UAlbany's all-time triples leader with 17 in his career, ranks second for runs scored (163), and is tied for sixth for doubles (35).

AT-BATS KING

Nolan Gaige is UAlbany's all-time leader for at-bats. Playing and starting in 204 games in his career (2nd all-time), Gaige -- a mainstay in the leadoff spot -- has recorded 794 career at-bats.

BALL MAGNET

Senior Greg Muller has been hit by a pitch 16 times this season, which leads the conference and ranks 34th in the nation, getting beamed 0.34 times per game. When Muller is not taking one for the team, the senior is driving in runs, as he leads the squad and ranks second in the America East with 38 RBI.

STINAR'S FINE START

Freshman Ryan Stinar made his fourth career start on the mound last Friday after proving to be one of the top closers in the conference. Making 14 appearances, including 10 in relief, Stinar has logged a team-high five saves, which also ranks second in the America East. In his first career start on March 24th, Stinar led UAlbany to a 5-2 victory over UMBC, which also captured the series for the Great Danes. Stinar went six strong innings, yielding no earned runs, four hits (all singles), while striking out three. Since then, the

rookie also started vs. Maine (3/31) and Stony Brook (4/7), and Binghamton (5/17) but went without a decision in all. Stinar is 1-0 on the season with a 3.71 ERA.

WINNING IS CONTAGIOUS

UAlbany athletic teams have won a school-record nine conference championships this academic year, and baseball will look to join the club this week. Championships were already won in football, field hockey, men's basketball, women's basketball, men's indoor track & field, women's indoor track & field, men's outdoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field, and men's lacrosse. The Great Danes have now captured 66 conference championships and have made 27 NCAA Tournament appearances since going Division I.

EARLY START SUCCESS

When UAlbany scores first, the Great Danes own a 17-8-1 record this spring. On the contrary, when UAlbany's opponent gains the initial lead, UAlbany is 6-15.

MR. 300

Head coach Jon Mueller earned his 300th career coaching victory May 4th at Varsity Field, as the Great Danes split the conference twinbill with the University of Maine. While the Black Bears won game one, 8-6, UAlbany rallied to triumph, 4-3, in the nightcap. Mueller is in his 14th season at the helm and ranks first in UAlbany baseball coaching victories with a 302-406-5 record.

HOT BATS VS. THE HAWKS

In UAlbany's second series with Hartford on April 20th and 21st, the Danes totaled 38 runs, 33 RBI, and 48 hits, including nine doubles, a triple, and two home runs across three games. The Great Danes also batted .397 as a squad with a .537 slugging percentage. Their 23 runs scored in the seven-inning game are the most by any conference team this season.

DRAW!

UAlbany's 6-6 tie with Marist marked the program's 12th in 54 seasons and the fifth tie in the Jon Mueller era. The scheduled seven-inning contest went nine full frames before being called on account of darkness.

HONORABLE MENTION CBI TEAM OF THE WEEK

After sweeping Stony Brook -- the reigning America East Conference champions, Coral Gables Regional Champions, Baton Rouge Super Regional Champions, and 2012 College World Series participants -- UAlbany was recognized as an honorable mention College-BaseballInsider.com Louisville Slugger Team of the Week on April 9th. UAlbany captured all three victories in an important America East Conference series against Stony Brook. In game one, the Great Danes triumphed, 5-4, in walk-off style in the bottom of the seventh. Despite trailing 4-0, UAlbany tied the ballgame with a four-run sixth inning. In the seventh, senior Greg Muller led off with a single, moved to second on a wild pitch, and pinch runner Adam Mund scored on freshman Evan Harasta's game-ending single down the left field line. Reliever Austin Chase (2-3) came out of the pen to toss the final four frames and earned the victory. Holding Stony Brook without a hit until the sixth, Chase limited the Seawolves to just one run and two hits, while striking out two in his outing. In the doubleheader's nightcap, UAlbany jumped out to a 6-0 head start and held on to win 9-6. On the mound for UAlbany, Kasceim Graham earned the win, tossing six and a third innings, holding SBU to two runs and five hits, while striking out six. With the tying run at the plate, closer Derek Zielinski earned the save after striking out the final two batters of the victory. In the series finale, the Great Danes captured another one-run win, 4-3, securing the sweep. UAlbany scored all four runs in the fourth inning. Coming out of



the pen for three and two-thirds frames, junior Kevin Archbold recorded his first career win, holding the Seawolves to just two hits and two runs (none earned), while tying his career-high with six strikeouts. Redshirt sophomore Stephen Carey earned the save, limiting Stony Brook to one hit, while striking out one in the final two scoreless innings.

CHASE NAMED AMERICA EAST PITCHER OF THE WEEK (5/6)

Senior Austin Chase was named the America East Pitcher of the Week, announced by the league office May 6th. The honor marked the second of Chase's career. The East Greenbush, N.Y. native threw his second-consecutive complete game, leading UAlbany to its only win of the series against Maine. Chase held the Black Bears to just three runs and scattered three hits, while striking out three in nine full frames. With just a one-run cushion, Chase put the game away for the Great Danes with six straight outs in the final two innings, setting the Black Bears down in order. The win extended the right-hander's streak to five straight victories in as many outings on the mound.

NETHAWAY HONORED BY AMERICA EAST AGAIN (4/22)

For the second time this season, junior Josh Nethaway was named the America East Player of the Week, announced by the league office April 22nd. Batting .500 (10-for-20) with a .750 slugging percentage, Nethaway led UAlbany to a 3-1 week, including a series win over Hartford. With one out in the bottom of the 12th inning, Nethaway played hero with his fourth hit of the game -- a walk-off game-winning double -- leading the Danes to a 10-9 victory over the Hawks in Sunday's rubber match. In their 23-8 game one win against Hartford, Nethaway finished a triple shy of the cycle as he went 3-for-4 with two runs batted in and two runs scored. The Fonda, N.Y. native pounded out a double, home run, and single in his first three at-bats. Nethaway also recorded multiple hits in UAlbany's 8-6 win over St. John's University -- the reigning BIG EAST champion and 2012 Super Regional participant.

NETHAWAY NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK (4/8)

Leading UAlbany to a 3-0 series sweep over conference foe Stony Brook, junior Josh Nethaway was named the America East Player of the Week, announced by the league office Monday, April 8th. Nethaway led UAlbany with a team-best .455 batting average and .727 slugging percentage, logging a home run, three RBI, and four runs scored. The Fonda, N.Y. native crossed the plate and lined at least one hit in each game, including a pair of multi-hit performances. Facing a 4-0 deficit in game one, Nethaway capped the Danes' sixth inning rally with a game-tying two-run home run with two outs. Nethaway recorded two hits in each of the final two games, including driving in the game-tying run in the series finale, as well as scoring what would become the game-winning run.

GAIGE EARNS AMERICA EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS (3/25)

Senior outfielder Nolan Gaige was selected as the America East Player of the Week, announced by the conference office Monday, March 25th. Gaige (East Greenbush, N.Y.) led UAlbany to a series victory over conference foe UMBC, batting .500 with a conference-best five RBI, three triples, three runs scored, and stole one base in one attempt. With his first triple of the weekend, Gaige became the program's all-time leader, belting 14 in his career. His seven hits in the series also moved Gaige into fourth place all-time at Albany with 210 career hits. Going 3-for-5 with two triples, three runs batted in and two runs scored in game two, Gaige led the Great Danes to a 13-1 victory and also played a key role in UAlbany's 5-2 rubber match win, scoring a run. Gaige had hits in all three games, including a pair of three-hit performances.

MOUND-BREAKING RECORDS

The combined 15 strikeouts by the UAlbany pitching staff at NYIT (3/11) tied the program's Division I era record for K's in a game. The last time the Great Danes totaled 15 strikeouts was on May 7, 2005 in a 13-inning contest at Hartford. UAlbany used five hurlers in the 11-9 extra-inning victory. March 11th's feat at NYIT marked a DI record for nine-inning games. Kasceim Graham (10), Cameron Sorgie (4) and closer Ryan Stinar (1) combined for 15 strikeouts in game one, while Derek Zielinski (7) and Austin Chase (6) recorded 13 strikeouts in the combined shutout against NYIT, totaling 28 K's in the twin bill.

RACKING UP THE MILES

At this point in the season, UAlbany is in prime bus-riding shape after traveling over 10 hours south (one way) for three consecutive series. The Great Danes traveled 1,290 mile roundtrip to Cary, N.C. for the Ron Fraser Classic. UAlbany played two games against Canisius (2/15) before the remaining two days of the tournament were cancelled due to snow. The following weekend, the Great Danes totaled 1,734 miles to and from South Carolina to play a three-games series against the Gamecocks (2/23-24). UAlbany made one last trip below the Mason-Dixon Line to Greensboro, N.C. (1,370 miles), facing UNCG March 1-3. In the first three weekends of the 2013 season, UAlbany totaled nearly 4,400 miles of bus travel. The Great Danes played the first eight weeks on the road before finally playing at home against Stony Brook on April 6th.

2012 UALBANY SEASON SUMMARY (22-32-1, 16-8 America East)

In 2012, UAlbany earned the No. 2 seed in the America East Championship, recording the highest total league wins in the program's Division I history with a 16-8 record. Seven earned all-conference honors, highlighted by first-teamers Mike Tirri and Nolan Gaige, as Gaige finished the season ranked third in the nation for triples (9). In addition, left-handed pitcher Sean Lucas was chosen in the 25th round of the Major League Baseball Draft by the Cincinnati Reds, marking the highest draft choice from the UAlbany program since 2002, and the eighth player in UAlbany history to be selected. Lucas is currently on the Dayton Dragons' roster – Cincinnati's Class A Affiliate.

CAPTAINS

D.J. Hoagboon, Josh Nethaway, Greg Muller, and Jeff Welsh were named team captains for the 2013 baseball season. Hoagboon, a junior from Mayfield, N.Y., is the Great Danes' top returning hitter, batting .318 overall and .392 in conference play in 2012. The second team All-America East outfielder recorded a .398 on-base percentage and .411 slugging percentage, including seven doubles, two triples, and a home run. Nethaway, a redshirt junior, finished second on the squad a year ago with a .313 batting average. The Fonda, N.Y. native was also a second team all-conference selection and All-Academic honoree, logging 12 doubles, a triple and two home runs, while scoring 27 runs and driving in 30. Muller, a native of Massapequa, N.Y., recorded a .301 batting average in 2012 with a .400 on-base percentage. The senior lined five doubles, knocked in 13 runs, and scored 16. Muller is one of the team's most trusted defenders, logging a .993 fielding percentage with 247 putouts and 20 assists last season. Welsh, a redshirt senior from West Haverstraw, N.Y., batted .284 a season ago with a .474 slugging percentage, including three home runs, three triples, and three doubles. He also knocked home 16 runs, while scoring 17 in 2012.

PROJECTED STARTING PITCHER SUMMARIES

GAME 1: Kasceim Graham, a native of Brooklyn, N.Y., is also in his fourth season with the Great Danes. Kasceim has been a key piece of the UAlbany pitching staff, as he ranks third all-time with 258 and a third innings pitched in his career. Making 50 appearances on the mound, Kasceim has totaled 14 wins, a 4.74 ERA, a save, and 152 strikeouts in four seasons and was named to the 2011 America East all-tournament team. This season, he leads the Great Danes with a 7-4 record and 3.93 earned run average in 12 starts, including a two-hit complete-game shutout over UMBC.

GAME 2: Austin Chase, a native of East Greenbush, N.Y., is in his fifth season with the Great Danes, serving as a key member of the UAlbany pitching staff throughout his career. Austin has made 50 appearances on the mound, including 30 starts, accruing a 13-12 overall record and 5.40 earned run average, as well as recording 118 strikeouts and three saves. He has been named the America East Pitcher of the Week twice in his career, including once this season after a complete-game versus Maine, and was a second-team all-conference pick in 2012. This spring, Austin boasts a 6-4 record and 3.97 ERA with 54 strikeouts and three complete games.
