### UALBANY REMATCHES AGAINST TRAVEL PARTNER BINGHAMTON

UALbany looks to get back on track on Friday, October 24th, hitting the road to take on its travel partner and in-state rival Binghamton at the West Gym in Vestal at 7 p.m.

UALbany fell in a five-set match at home against Binghamton to open conference play on September 26th. In DI play, the Great Danes are 21-10 overall vs. Binghamton.

UALbany fell to UMBC in five last Friday to snap a four-match winning streak, entering at 6-12 overall and 4-2 in-conference for second place. Binghamton beat UMBC in three on Sunday and is tied with UAlbany at 4-2 in the league and 6-16 overall.

### UALBANY SWEEPS AMERICA EAST WEEKLY HONORS

For the first time since '02, UAlbany has swept the America East volleyball weekly awards last week. Amanda Dolan earned Player of the Week, Mikala McCauley was selected as Setter of the Week and Emily Lopes was honored as Rookie of the Week. It is the first time since 2012 that the feat was accomplished.

Dolan hit .426 with 31 kills on 61 attacks with only five attack errors, adding 14 blocks. McCauley had 95 assists and 23 digs, setting for a team that hit .204. Lopes tallied 34 digs and two aces in the back row.

## 2014 ALBANY GREAT DANES VOLLEYBALL

### LAST TIME: UALBANY FALLS TO UMBC IN FIVE

Despite a 2-1 lead, UAlbany fell to UMBC in five sets on Friday to finish its three-match homestand, snapping its four-match winning streak.

Laini Leindecker earned her 11th double-double of the year with 13 kills and 26 digs. Viktoriia Stroilo earned a career-high 40 digs, while Mikala McCauley also had a double-double off 46 assists and 14 digs.

### YOUNG GUNS

UAlbany's outside hitter corps is made up of four sophomores, reflecting the youth of the team. Amanda Dolan, the reigning America East Rookie of the Year, leads the unit after hitting .268 with 189 kills and 91 blocks. Amy Hunter was one of the top players down the stretch, earning 177 kills. Laini Leindecker will serve as a team captain after tallying 51 kills and 153 digs last year, while Olivia Schonewise was one of the top reserves, finishing with 86 kills and 59 digs.

### TOP BLOCKING TEAM IN THE LEAGUE...

UAlbany sports the top statistical blocking team in the America East. The Great Danes average 2.22 blocks per set, the highest mark in the conference. Tatum Jungsten has 24 solo blocks, totaling 64 total blocks. Amanda Dolan leads the team with 70 total blocks, while Sofia Furlong stands with 50.

### ...AND FIRST IN DIGS IN THE LEAGUE

UAlbany is first in the conference in digs per set with 17.30, led by the best back row player in the America East in the last three years. Viktoriia Stroilo, the two-time reigning America East Defensive Player of the Year, averages 5.23 digs per set, 20th in the NCAA and first in the conference, totaling 324. Laini Leindecker, a six-rotation player, stands eighth in the league with 3.38 digs per set to total 247.

### VIKTORIIA STROILO - 1,000-DIG CLUB

Two-time America East Defensive Player of the Year Viktoriia Stroilo joined the 1,000-dig club. She earned 560 digs as a sophomore and 367 in her junior year, currently standing with 324 this season to total 1,251.

10 UAlbany players have over 1,000 digs, led by Laurie Gonzalez, who earned 2,044 from 2008-11. Currently, Stroilo is 6th all-time in digs in UAlbany history and third in the school's time in DI. She needs 133 digs to match 5th-place Jessica Volke's mark of 1,384 from 1989-92.

### STROILO - CANDIDATE FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Viktoriia Stroilo has been named as one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award in women's volleyball. CLASS stands for "Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School." Stroilo, a two-time America East Defensive Player of the Year, stands with a 3.74 GPA in biology, one of 15 of the 30 candidates with at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT:

Binghamton has won three of its last four matches and will play the fourth contest of a six-match homestand. Junior Megan Burgess ranks in the top-10 in the conference in hitting percentage at .231 and kills at 189. The Hovie sisters are on the outside: senior Kristin has 169 kills and 90 digs, while sophomore Allison stands with 172 kills, 19 aces and 156 digs. Senior Amanda Dettmann sets with 722 assists and 27 aces, while sophomore Bailey Walker is the libero with 328 digs and 27 aces.

## LAST TIME THEY MET:

UAlbany won set four to force a tiebreaker against Binghamton at home, but fell in five on September 26th to open America East play.

Laini Leindecker hit .263 with 19 kills and 12 digs, while Olivia Schonewise hit .255 with 16 kills and seven digs. For Binghamton, Allison Hovie hit .265 with 19 kills and 16 digs, while Bianca Anderson hit .320 with 13 kills.

## LAST YEAR IN THE AMERICA EAST:

In 2013, after a 2-2 start, the Great Danes won three-consecutive matches at home against Stony Brook, UMass Lowell and UNH to tie for first place at 5-2. Following a defeat at Binghamton, UAlbany swept Stony Brook on the road to go to 6-3. In the final match of the year, UAlbany swept UMass Lowell to finish at 9-5, tying for second place in the league.

After earning three-seed in the America East Tournament, UAlbany played UMBC in the first round of the tournament, falling in three sets.

## CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'

Three players have come across the country from the Golden State to suit up for the Purple and Gold. Two California players lock down the middle, with senior Sofia Furlong and junior team captain Tatum Jungsten, while freshman Emily Lopes plays as a setter.

## GLOBETROTTING DANES

UAlbany sports four players from outside the United States from three different continents. Viktoria Stroilo, a native of Ukraine, and Lara Temel, a newcomer from Turkey, hail from Europe. From New Zealand on the continent of Australia is Amy Hunter, and from St. Lucia in the North American Caribbean is Tyna William.

## GREAT DANES PICKED #4 IN AE PRESEASON POLL

After finishing tied for second in the conference last season, UAlbany was predicted to finish fourth in the America East pre-season coaches poll with 21 points.

UMBC, the league runner-up in 2013, is predicted to finish first with 33 points, including three first-place votes. UNH is predicted to finish second, while Stony Brook is at third in the poll.

### ENGSTROM APPROACHING TOP DI MARK AT UALBANY

At the helm of UAlbany, MJ Engstrom has amassed 117 victories, winning the America East regular season five times and taking the title three times. She has been named the America East Coach of the Year in 2009 and 2011. She is just 25 matches away from tying Kelly Sheffield, who has 142 wins at UAlbany, for most DI wins at the school. In her coaching career, Engstrom has taken three different schools, UAlbany, Nicholls State and Villanova, to the NCAA Tournament.

### SAREEA FREEMAN JOINS UALBANY COACHING STAFF

Former AVCA All-American and professional volleyball player Sareea Freeman joins the UAlbany volleyball team for the 2014 season as an assistant coach. A former volleyball and basketball standout at Florida State, Freeman played for the Vasas Volleyball Professional Sports Club in Hungary. The 6-foot-4 middle blocker led Florida State to the NCAA Second Round in all four seasons from 2009-12, including a Final Four appearance in 2011.

She joins Brooke Stanley, the first assistant in her second season, and Traci Vandegrift, back for her second season as the graduate assistant manager.

### ALISSA GIBBS INDUCTED IN UALBANY HALL OF FAME

One of the top players around the turn of the century, Alissa Gibbs was inducted into the University at Albany Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 2013. She currently ranks third all-time in UAlbany volleyball history with 1,376 kills. She also stands fifth all-time with 166 service aces, sixth with 3.72 kills per set and 10th with 992 digs. A two-time All-conference player, Gibbs was the 2002-03 America East Scholar-Athlete of the Year and received the ECAC Merit Medal for being UAlbany's top female student-athlete in 2003.

### 2013 IN REVIEW

After a tough start in non-conference play, UAlbany rallied in America East competition. The Great Danes held first place in the middle of conference play, finishing 9-5 to tie for second place in the league and earn a berth in the America East Tournament. UAlbany fell in the semifinals to UMBC, ending the season at 9-19 overall. Viktoriia Stroilo earned America East Defensive Specialist of the Year, while Amanda Dolan was named America East Rookie of the Year. Samantha Brostrom got First Team All-Conference, while Dolan and Stroilo got Second Team. Mikala McCauley was selected to the All-Rookie Team along with Dolan.

### STROILO EARNS SUNY CHANCELLOR'S AWARD

Viktoriia Stroilo, the 2013 America East Volleyball Scholar-Athlete, received the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Division I volleyball, recognizing the top student-athletes for each sport in the State University of New York system. Stroilo has a 3.74 cumulative GPA in biology.

### HEAD COACH MJ ENGSTROM

MJ Engstrom enters her seventh season as head volleyball coach at the University at Albany in 2014.



Engstrom has posted an overall record of 111-70 and 62-10 in America East play over her first six seasons. Her record includes three America East titles and as many NCAA appearances as a head coach. She previously coached Villanova and Nicholls State to NCAA tournament berths.

In 2013, UAlbany finished tied for second place in the America East regular season with a team of eight freshmen and just three upperclassmen, going 9-5 in conference play and 9-19 overall. For the sixth season in a row, a Great Dane earned AE Defensive Player of the Year, with Viktoriia Stroilo leading the league in digs per set in conference matches. Amanda Dolan earned AE Rookie of the Year. Samantha Brostrom was placed on the All-Conference First Team, with Dolan and Stroilo going on the Second Team.

Engstrom, a native of St. Paul, Minn., is on the editorial board for the International Journal for Volleyball Research and is a member of the USA Volleyball Sports Medicine and Performance Commission. She was a student-athlete at the University of Minnesota and received a degree in psychology in 2000.
