UALBANY FINISHES 2014 SEASON AT BUFFALO

UAlbany will conclude its 2014 campaign with a matchup against a fellow State University of New York team, heading west to play Buffalo on Saturday, November 29th at 1 p.m., with the match being featured on ESPN3.

UAlbany earned a trip to the America East title match last Saturday, falling to host New Hampshire in four to come into the match at 10-16 overall and 7-5 in the America East. Buffalo's two-match winning streak was snapped in the first round of the Mid-American Conference Tournament after a 3-0 defeat to Western Michigan, entering Saturday at 16-15 and 6-10 in the league.

The two programs will meet for the first time since 2008. UAlbany has won all three matches against Buffalo, last winning in three on September 5, 2008 in Albany.

MCCAULEY EARNS AMERICA EAST ELITE 18 AWARD

After setting the team to the America East title match, Mikala McCauley was honored with the league's Elite 18 Award for volleyball, given to the player with the highest GPA that played in the conference final match. McCauley stands with a 3.94 GPA in psychology and earned a place on the America East All-Academic Team.

2014 ALBANY GREAT DANES VOLLEYBALL

VIKTORIIA STROILO - AE DEFENSIVE SPECIALIST OF THE YEAR

For the third-consecutive year, Viktoriia Stroilo has earned America East Defensive Specialist of the Year honors. Including joining the 1,000-dig club this year, the senior has led the America East with 5.31 digs per set, 17th in Division I, including 13 matches with at least 20 digs.

THREE UALBANY PLAYERS EARN ALL-CONFERENCE

A trio of UAlbany players have been selected on the 2014 America East All-Conference Teams. Laini Leindecker earned First Team status, standing with 309 kills and 322 digs, each in the top ten of the league. Viktoriia Stroilo was selected as Second Team with 446 digs and 17 aces, as was Amanda Dolan, who hit .251 with 213 kills and 95 blocks.

In addition, Emily Lopes was selected to the America East All-Rookie Team, concluding the regular season with 209 digs and 10 aces. Stroilo and Mikala McCauley were selected to the All-Academic Team, with a 3.74 and 3.93 GPA respectively.

LAST TIME: UALBANY FALLS IN AE TITLE AT UNH

After defeating Binghamton 3-1 for a berth in the America East title match, UAlbany fell to tournament host New Hampshire in four sets on Saturday.

Amanda Dolan hit .263 in the match with 13 kills and four blocks. Laini Leindecker had a double-double with 16 kills and 11 digs, while Mikala McCauley got 41 assists and 19 digs.

UALBANY SWEEPS AMERICA EAST WEEKLY HONORS

For the first time since 2002, UAlbany swept the AE volleyball weekly awards for the period ending October 13th. Amanda Dolan earned Player of the Week, Mikala McCauley was selected as Setter of the Week and Emily Lopes was Rookie of the Week. It is the first time since 2012 that the feat was accomplished.

Dolan hit .426 with 31 kills on 61 attacks with only five attack errors, adding 14 blocks. McCauley had 95 assists and 23 digs, setting for a team that hit .204. Lopes tallied 34 digs and two aces in the back row.

TOP BLOCKING TEAM IN THE LEAGUE...

UAlbany sports the top statistical blocking team in the America East. The Great Danes average 2.20 blocks per set, the highest mark in the league. Amanda Dolan leads the team with 104 total blocks, including 24 of her own. Tatum Jungsten sports 31 solo blocks to total 81, while Sofia Furlong has 67 total blocks.

...AND FIRST IN DIGS IN THE LEAGUE

UAlbany is first in the conference and is 11th in NCAA DI in digs per set with 17.95, led by the best back row player in the America East in the last three years. Viktoriia Stroilo, the three-time reigning America East Defensive Player of the Year, averages 5.34 digs per set, 17th in the NCAA and first in the conference, totaling 491. Laini Leindecker, a six-rotation player, stands eighth in the league with 3.39 digs per set to total 349.

SCOUTING BUFFALO:

The Bulls will also play their final match of the year when they play UAlbany. Reed Sunahara serves at the helm of Buffalo for his first season.

Two Bulls earned All-MAC recognition this season: junior outside hitter Tahleia Bishop earned All-MAC First Team is hitting .229 with 376 kills, averaging 4.13 per set, with 12 aces and 245 digs, while middle blocker Cassie Shado was selected to the MAC All-Freshman Team, hitting .287 with 130 kills and 78 blocks. Junior outside hitter Megan Lipski has 261 kills, 26 aces and 311 digs, while junior middle Akeila Lain has 225 kills and 111 total blocks.

LAST TIME THEY MET:

Holding off a Buffalo comeback attempt in the third set, UAlbany swept the Bulls in three sets (25-17, 25-17, 26-24) in the Albany Classic in 2008.

UAlbany hit .307 in the match, compared to .076 of Buffalo. Kamisha Kellam hit .571 with nine kills, while Amanda Cowdrey hit .316 with nine kills and 14 digs. Valerie Sourbeer earned a team-high 12 kills.

For Buffalo, Kristin Bignell hit .688 with 11 kills and two blocks, while Lindsey Schlegel had 22 assists and four aces.

STROILO - CANDIDATE FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Viktoria Stroilo has been named as one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award in women's volleyball. CLASS stands for "Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School." Stroilo, a two-time America East Defensive Player of the Year, stands with a 3.74 GPA in biology.

VIKTORIA STROILO - 1,000-DIG CLUB

Two-time America East Defensive Player of the Year Viktoria Stroilo joined the 1,000-dig club. She earned 560 digs as a sophomore and 367 in her junior year, currently standing with 491 this season to total 1,418.

10 UAlbany players have over 1,000 digs, led by Laurie Gonzalez, who earned 2,044 from 2008-11. Currently, Stroilo is 4th all-time in digs in UAlbany history and third in the school's time in DI. Also ahead of Stroilo is Ashley DeNeal at 1,903 digs and Rafaela Nikas at 1,607 digs.

DOLAN, STROILO - AE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

After leading the team to the America East title match, Viktoria Stroilo and Amanda Dolan were selected to the America East All-Tournament Team.

Stroilo finished the tournament with 45 digs and seven assists, digging out at least 20 balls in each tournament match, while Amanda Dolan hit .323 in the playoffs, earning 25 kills and nine blocks, including double digit kills against both Binghamton and New Hampshire.

ENGSTROM APPROACHING TOP DI MARK AT UALBANY

At the helm of UAlbany, MJ Engstrom has amassed 121 victories, winning the America East regular season five times and taking the title three times. She has been named the America East Coach of the Year in 2009 and 2011. She is just 21 matches away from tying Kelly Sheffield, who has 142 wins at UAlbany, for most DI wins at the school. In her coaching career, Engstrom has taken three different schools, UAlbany, Nicholls State and Villanova, to the NCAA Tournament.

SAREEA FREEMAN JOINS UALBANY COACHING STAFF

Former AVCA All-American and professional volleyball player Sareea Freeman joins the UAlbany volleyball team for the 2014 season as an assistant coach. A former volleyball and basketball standout at Florida State, Freeman played for the Vasas Volleyball Professional Sports Club in Hungary. The 6-foot-4 middle blocker led Florida State to the NCAA Second Round in all four seasons from 2009-12, including a Final Four appearance in 2011.

She joins Brooke Stanley, the first assistant in her second season, and Traci Vandegrift, back for her second season as the graduate assistant manager.

GLOBETROTTING DANES

UAlbany sports four players from outside the United States from three different continents. Viktoriia Stroilo, a native of Ukraine, and Lara Temel, a newcomer from Turkey, hail from Europe. From New Zealand on the continent of Australia is Amy Hunter, and from St. Lucia in the North American Caribbean is Tyna William.

STROILO EARNS SUNY CHANCELLOR'S AWARD

Viktoriia Stroilo, the 2013 America East Volleyball Scholar-Athlete, received the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Division I volleyball, recognizing the top student-athletes for each sport in the State University of New York system. Stroilo has a 3.74 cumulative GPA in biology.

ALISSA GIBBS INDUCTED IN UALBANY HALL OF FAME

One of the top players around the turn of the century, Alissa Gibbs was inducted into the University at Albany Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 2013. A two-time All-conference player, Gibbs was the 2002-03 America East Scholar-Athlete of the Year and received the ECAC Merit Medal for being UAlbany's top female student-athlete in 2003.

2013 IN REVIEW

After a tough start in non-conference play, UAlbany rallied in America East competition. The Great Danes held first place in the middle of conference play, finishing 9-5 to tie for second place in the league and earn a berth in the America East Tournament. UAlbany fell in the semifinals to UMBC, ending the season at 9-19 overall. Viktoriia Stroilo earned America East Defensive Specialist of the Year, while Amanda Dolan was named America East Rookie of the Year.

HEAD COACH MJ ENGSTROM

MJ Engstrom enters her seventh season as head volleyball coach at the University at Albany in 2014.



Engstrom has posted an overall record of 111-70 and 62-10 in America East play over her first six seasons. Her record includes three America East titles and as many NCAA appearances as a head coach. She previously coached Villanova and Nicholls State to NCAA tournament berths.

In 2013, UAlbany finished tied for second place in the America East regular season with a team of eight freshmen and just three upperclassmen, going 9-5 in conference play and 9-19 overall. For the sixth season in a row, a Great Dane earned AE Defensive Player of the Year, with Viktoriia Stroilo leading the league in digs per set in conference matches. Amanda Dolan earned AE Rookie of the Year. Samantha Brostrom was placed on the All-Conference First Team, with Dolan and Stroilo going on the Second Team.

Engstrom, a native of St. Paul, Minn., is on the editorial board for the International Journal for Volleyball Research and is a member of the USA Volleyball Sports Medicine and Performance Commission. She was a student-athlete at the University of Minnesota and received a degree in psychology in 2000.
