UALBANY RETURNS HOME TO TAKE ON NORTHEASTERN

UAlbany is back after a six-game road trip and will play its final non-conference home game of the season, playing Northeastern at the SEFCU Arena on Sunday, December 28 at 2 p.m.

The Great Danes returned from California with a pair of wins, capped by a 71-49 victory over Cal State Fullerton last Sunday, to enter this contest at 7-4. Northeastern fell on a buzzer beater at home on Monday to New Hampshire 63-62 to drop its fifth-straight and stand at 2-6.

UAlbany and Northeastern formerly are America East rivals, with the latter leaving for the CAA in 2005. The two met for the first time since the conference switch in Boston on January 4, 2014, with UAlbany winning 75-66. With that win, UAlbany leads the all-time series 5-4, taking the last four games.

COACH ABE EARNS 100TH VICTORY WITH UALBANY

UAlbany head coach **Katie Abrahamson-Henderson**, who has a 73.2% winning percentage at the helm of UAlbany, earned her 100th victory with the Great Danes with the 62-36 win at Pepperdine on December 19, 2014. She stands with a 101-37 record with the program.

With UAlbany joining the Division I ranks in 1999, Coach Abe is the all-time leader in wins in the program's DI history.

UALBANY - UNANIMOUS PICK TO FINISH FIRST IN AMERICA EAST

For the third-consecutive year, UAlbany has been predicted to finish first in the America East in the preseason coaches poll. It is the second-straight year that UAlbany has been a unanimous selection to win the league, receiving all eight possible first place votes for a maximum 64 points.

Last season's runner-up Stony Brook placed second in the poll with 51 points. UNH, which received the other first-place vote, and Hartford tied for third with 46 points. Maine, UMBC, UMass Lowell, Vermont (tied with the previous in the poll) and Binghamton fill out the rest of the coaches poll.

DEFENSE!

UAlbany currently ranks 26th in Division I in scoring defense, allowing 54.9 points per game, allowing 50 points or less against St. Francis, Colgate, Pepperdine and Cal St. Fullerton. As a team, the Great Danes average 9.6 steals per game and have a 9.1 rebounding margin.

SHEREESHA RICHARDS - WNIT ALL-TOURNAMENT

Earning double digit points in all three games UAlbany played, **Shereesha Richards** was named to the Preseason WNIT All-Tournament Team. She earned 27 points and 14 rebounds in the win over Penn State, following with 21 points against Western Kentucky. She started the run with 10 points vs. St. Francis Brooklyn.

SHEREESHA RICHARDS - 1,000-POINT CLUB

With 27 points against Penn State, Shereesha Richards joined the 1,000-point club, standing with 1,166 in her UAlbany career. She has averaged 15.6 points a game in her career, the highest scoring average in program history.

Richards ranks 6th all-time in UAlbany history, and 3rd all time in UAlbany DI history, in scoring. Ebone Henry is UAlbany's all-time points leader, scoring 1,642 from 2009-13. Richards is 22 points from tying for 5th all-time with Liz Tucker, who scored 1,188 points from 1997-01.

Sarah Royals is also approaching the 1,000-point mark. The senior point guard stands with 777 points, averaging 7.2 a game in her career.

UALBANY STANDS AT #12 IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Following a 2-0 trip to California, UAlbany held its ranking at #12 in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 poll on December 23rd.

The Great Danes picked up 353 points in the poll, released every Tuesday. The team is the only ranked team from the America East and is the only mid-major in the poll in the state of New York.

UA DI ASSISTS LEADER ROYALS GOES FOR PROGRAM RECORD

Sarah Royals became UAlbany's Division I assists leader last year, tallying 157 assists, ranking #1 in the America East with that mark. She now stands with 354 assists in her collegiate career. To date, she is 4th all-time in UAlbany women's basketball history in assists. She needs 21 assists to match the program record.

Currently the record is held by Samantha Ginsberg, who notched 375 assists from 1993 to 1997.

Royals is two assists away from tying for third all-time in UAlbany history with Liz Tucker, who had 356 assists from 1988 to 1992.

RICHARDS ADDING TO UALBANY RECORDS

During her sophomore season, **Shereesha Richards** set a number of program records that she can add to in her future years.

Including 16 times last season, Richards has the UAlbany record for most 20+ point games with 23 total, including four this year. She also earned the record for most double-doubles in a season, combining for 17 in her career.

She has a chance to match another record for most 30+ point performances. She currently has two, with the record being three, set by Megan Buchanan from 1996 to 2000.

IMANI TATE ON A SOPHOMORE SURGE

After serving as a reserve as a freshman, picking up 4.2 points and 3.1 rebounds a contest, **Imani Tate** is off to an explosive beginning as a sophomore, averaging 14.6 points and 6.5 rebounds, each top-10 in the America East, in her 11 games, including four starts.

Tate led the team in rebounding in each of the first four games and has three 20+ point performances, including 20 points in the road victory at Siena last Saturday.

STREAKS

Shereesha Richards was held without points in UAlbany's contest against Michigan State on November 21st, 2012 as a freshman, since then she has scored in the last 71 games.

Sarah Royals has dished out an assist in each of the past 76 games dating back to her freshman year, including the entirety of the the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons. Also, she has scored in her last 54 games dating back to February 2, 2013.

Margarita Rosario recently had a streak snapped: she notched an assist in 42-straight games until December 15th at Quinnipiac.

SCOUTING NORTHEASTERN:

Northeastern is under the first year of head coach Kelly Cole and is predicted to finish seventh in the Colonial Athletic Association this year.

The team is led by Preseason All-CAA senior guard A'lece Mark, who averages 14.8 points and 6.2 rebounds per game, shooting 41.4% from the field. Junior guard Tiffany Montagne, going 39.3% from behind the arc and getting 12.9 points a contest. 6-foot-2 center Francesca Sally is the team's top rebounder, averaging 7.1 boards and 7.9 points a contest.

BOARDS, BOARDS, BOARDS

In the first 11 games, UAlbany has a +10.1 rebounding advantage, outrebounding its opponents in nine of those 11 contests.

Shereesha Richards leads the team with 8.8 rebounds a game, while **Tiana-Jo Carter** and **Imani Tate** are grabbing 6.6 and 6.5 rebounds a contest respectively. All three had double-digit boards at Penn State.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Great Danes have not lost a league road game in over three calendar years, winning all 24 America East games away from SEFCU in that span. The last time UAlbany fell in an AE road game was on February 26th, 2011, when the Great Danes were defeated by UMBC 62-55.

UALBANY REACHES PRESEASON WNIT SEMIFINALS

Defeating St. Francis Brooklyn at home then defeating Penn State on the road, UAlbany, in its first-ever appearance in the tournament, made a run to the Preseason WNIT semifinals, falling to Western Kentucky in the third round. Shereesha Richards earned All-Tournament honors with 58 points and 26 rebounds in the three games.

UALBANY DOMINATES IN CALIFORNIA

Before the holiday break, UAlbany traveled to California for a pair of games, defeating Pepperdine and Cal State Fullerton for a pair of victories. UAlbany combined to out-score its opponents 133-87 in those two victories, holding each foe to below 50 points.

Last year, UAlbany hosted Cal State Fullerton at the SEFCU Arena, defeating the Titans 71-49 on November 20.

Before this trip, the last time UAlbany played a opponent in California and based in that state was on November 14, 2008. The Great Danes fell to the California Golden Bears 63-39. All-time, UAlbany is 4-3 in games played in California.

ACCURATE SHOOTERS

As a team, UAlbany is 19th in all of Division I and first in the America East with a 46.7% field goal percentage, almost five percentage points higher than second-place UMass Lowell at 41.9%. The team has shot at least 50% in six games this season, going 6-0 in those contests.

Two of the top-35 DI field goal percentage players are Great Danes. **Shereesha Richards** is 17th in DI with a 57.5% field goal percentage this year, while **Imani Tate** is 34th, shooting 55.6% from the field.

IMANI TATE EARNS CO-AE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After leading the team with 21 points, six rebounds and three steals in the road victory against Canisius, Imani Tate earned her first conference weekly honor of her collegiate career, being named America East Co-Player of the Week for the period ending December 1st.

Shooting 9-10 from the field in the game, Tate scored 17 of her 21 points in the second half.

GOING FOR HISTORY

The UAlbany women's basketball team will attempt to do something in the 2014-15 season that has only been done once in America East history, win the conference for the fourth consecutive time.

UAlbany has won the America East Tournament the past three seasons, becoming the first team to achieve that feat since Maine did.

Maine won four consecutive conference titles from 1995-98. The Black Bears were coached by Joanne McCallie, who was assisted at Maine by Coach Abrahamson-Henderson from 1992-94.

The America East three-peat by UAlbany was the first time since Maine from 1996-98. The feat was done by previously by Vermont from 1992-94 and Northeastern from 1984-86.

UALBANY WINS 5TH-STRAIGHT ALBANY CUP

Including a 27-2 spurt, UAlbany outscored Siena 49-27 in the second half for a 76-57 victory at the Times Union Center to earn its fifth-consecutive Albany Cup.

Shereesha Richards, sidelined with two fouls in the first half, scored 20 points in the second period. **Imani Tate** scored 10 points in each half for 20 points total, while **Tiana-Jo Carter** earned a career-high 16 points off 8-12 shooting.

COACH ABE NEARING 200 WINS...

Along with her five years at Missouri State, Coach Abe has amassed a 196-98 record as a head coach, just four wins away from 200. As a head coach, she has led her teams to six conference titles, including three America East and three Missouri Valley titles, and eight winning seasons in nine years.

...EARNING UALBANY'S 200TH DI WIN

UAlbany has 204 wins since joining the Division I ranks, earning its 200th with its 64-59 victory at Canisius. The DI total record in total is 204-250. Since beginning the program for the 1964-65 season, UAlbany is just above .500 all-time with a 558-556 record.

COACH ABE - 84.6 CONFERENCE WIN %

Coach Abe has led UAlbany to a 55-10 America East league record for a 84.6% conference winning percentage. That mark is second all-time in America East history, only behind Trish Roberts, who had an 89.8% winning percentage at Maine from 1988 to 1992.

In addition, with a 94-33 record coming into the season, Coach Abe had a 74% winning percentage overall at UAlbany, ranking her second among America East coaches all-time. Only Maine's Peter Gavett is higher, who had a 81.3% winning percentage at Maine from 1984-88.

Into her fifth season, Coach Abe is the current longest-tenured women's basketball head coach among the DI State of New York (SUNY) system schools.

Second is Felisha Legette-Jack of Buffalo, going into her third season. Each Binghamton (Linda Cimino) and Stony Brook (Caroline McCombs) have first season coaches going into the 2013-14 season.

TAKING ON THE EMPIRE STATE

Last season, the Great Danes went 8-2 against in-state opponents, earning victories over Siena, Marist, Colgate, Binghamton (three times) and Stony Brook (twice). All eight wins were by double digits.

This year, UAlbany will battle eight different New York teams up and down the state. Opponents include Marist on the road, Siena for the Albany Cup at the Times Union Center and two games each against conference rivals Binghamton and Stony Brook.

So far in the 2014-15 season, UAlbany is 4-2 against in-state opponents.

LAST TIME OUT...

Déjà Vu as UAlbany WBB Defeats Cal State Fullerton 71-49 for Second-Straight Year

FULLERTON, Calif. — Mirroring the score of last year's game between the two, the UAlbany women's basketball team, led by 18 points off the bench from Zakiya Saunders, took down Cal State Fullerton 71-49 on the road to finish the California road trip at 2-0.

UAlbany (7-4) never looked back after taking the lead four minutes into the contest. The Great Danes shot 56.6% in the game, including 62.5% in the first half, and held Cal State Fullerton (4-7) to 34.6% from the field.

"It was our goal to come home for Christmas with two wins under our belt," said UAlbany coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson. "The gameplan was to control their point guard, we wanted to press her and wear her out."

Saunders earned a career-high 18 points and three steals off the bench, hitting eight of her 10 field goal attempts.

"I felt good today, we executed everything that our coaches told us to do, and we got the victory," said Saunders. "There were a lot more opportunities today to catch and shoot outside shots, not just for me but for everyone."

Shereesha Richards scored in double digits for her 11th-straight game, finishing with 13 points and eight rebounds. Sarah Royals also nearly earned a double-dou-

ble with nine assists, her highest single game total in over a calendar year and moving into fourth all-time in UAlbany history with 354 assists, and eight points. Imani Tate went 6-8 on shooting with 14 points and four rebounds.

For CSF, Chante Miles scored 13 points and notched seven assists. Kathleen Iwuoha almost got a double-double with 10 points and nine rebounds.

At the game's start, UAlbany primarily looked to the paint while Fullerton sought shots from the perimeter. The team exchanged early baskets, with at 5-4 home team, an Erin Coughlin kickout three and a Tate putback layup putting UAlbany in front 9-5 through the first four minutes.

UAlbany used the full court press against the Titans, showing dividends midway through the half. Following Miles hitting a three, UAlbany hit four baskets in the paint in a row, the final one with a foul as Richards hit the free throw to complete a 9-0 run and give the Great Danes a 20-10 lead with 10:15 remaining in the 1st.

The UAlbany guards started getting shot chances, with Royals driving baseline for the layup, while Saunders hit a trio of jumpers as the Great Danes kept a 30-17 advantage with 5:48 left in the half.

Each side continued to trade baskets, with Saunders leading UAlbany with long jumpers and Royals adding shots on running down the baseline. CSF switched tactics and went for layups against UAlbany's frontcourt. At 38-25, Margarita Rosario hit a three on the elbow, followed by Royals hitting a layup. Lakyn Gulley hit a three on the wing with 30 seconds left for CSF to put the halftime score at 43-28 UAlbany.

Tate hit a jumper just inside the arc to start the second period. CSF forced a couple of turnovers and converted for a pair of baskets. UAlbany countered with Saunders free throws, another Royals layup towards the baseline, Royals inbound to Saunders for the layup then Rosario hitting the elbow three to cap the run at 9-0 and push the team up 54-32 with 14:14 left in the 2nd.

CSF pulled to within 15 after another Gulley three to make it 56-41 with 10 minutes left. Richards hit a jumper as the UAlbany defense did not allow a field goal for the next six minutes. Tiana-Jo Carter and Tate added more points in the paint as the run went totaled 9-0 to make it 65-41 UAlbany with 4:50 left.

The Great Danes got their reserves in the latter stages of the game, with Bose Aiyalogbe and Jessica Fequiere each playing in the final minutes. UAlbany took the 71-49 victory.

Craig's Historic 33-Point Day Leads UAlbany to 75-66 Win at Northeastern

BOSTON – Megan Craig's 33-point day, the third-highest single game total in UAlbany women's basketball history, helped the Great Danes earn a 75-66 road win over Northeastern on Saturday afternoon.

"We earned a hard fought victory, playing as a team," says UAlbany head coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson. "Megan [Craig] was a force to be reckoned with today."

Craig shot 13-18 from the field for UAlbany (10-3), concluding with 33 points and eight rebounds. Her single game point total is tied for third all-time in UAlbany history behind a pair of 36-point performances by Jen Schumacher (2005) and Cindy Werner (1978). It is also the highest single game point total in the America East so far this season.

"We earned an important victory with a lot of fight and strong communication," says Craig. "I found my zone today, stayed in control and played with confidence."

Sarah Royals scored 15 points in the game, going 11-14 from the free throw line. Shereesha Richards had 13 points and six boards, while Tammy Phillip matched a career-high 13 rebounds, adding seven points and five assists.

For Northeastern (6-7), Jewel Tunstall had a double-double with 23 points and 13 rebounds. A'Lece Mark scored 18 points with five assists in her first game in almost a month.

The early part of the game saw Craig and Tunstall battling in the paint. Craig scored four of UAlbany's first five baskets as the two sides stayed close early. Richards hitting a pair of layups in a row induced Northeastern to call timeout as UAlbany led 19-14 just after the half's midway point.

UAlbany kept the pressure on as Richards and Royals added baskets and the defense did not allow a field goal in over eight minutes time. The visitors used that time to build a 31-19 advantage, capped by a fastbreak jumper by Richards, with 4:39 left in the 1st.

Led by threes from Mark and Kazzidy Stewart, NU gained ground before the break, but late scores by Craig, including a jumper and one, gave UAlbany a 39-32 lead into halftime.

Shooting woes hindered UAlbany early in the second half as after a Craig jumper, NU went on a 12-4 run, sparked by six points from Mark, to pull within one 45-44.

UAlbany kept going to Craig in the paint as the junior delivered at the basket, scoring five in a row to give the Great Danes some room 54-48 with 9:48 remaining. Later, Craig and Royals attacked the basket to pull UAlbany up to 61-52 at the 5:42 mark.

NU kept getting trips to the charity stripe and inched closer, as Tunstall hit seven in a span to get the home team back within four 63-59 at the final second half media timeout.

NU tried to foul Margarita Rosario to get possession. Rosario hit all four of her free throws to keep UAlbany ahead. Later, Rosario stole the ball from Mark, finding Royals on the breakaway for a layup to go up 69-62 with 2:35 left.

UAlbany faced a pressure defense from Northeastern but held, with Craig and Royals hitting free throws down the stretch to lead to the 75-66 win.

UAlbany begins America East play on Thursday, heading to Burlington to face Vermont on Thursday, January 9th at 7 p.m.

UALBANY - THREE-TIME AMERICA EAST CHAMPION



The University at Albany Great Danes women's basketball team has been the America East champion the past three years, combining to go 78-18 and winning 53 out of 56 games against conference opponents, including going 8-0 in the league tournament. UAlbany won its first three America East championships in those seasons.

In 2012, 2-seed UAlbany defeated UMBC 69-61 for its first-ever America East title. The next season, the Great Danes went undefeated in conference play, earning a 61-52 win over 2-seed Hartford for a second conference title. Then in 2014, 1-seed UAlbany avenged an earlier loss to 2-seed Stony Brook to win 70-46 and take a third-straight America East title.

In the 2012-13 season, UAlbany went a perfect 16-0 in the conference and won the tournament. The Great Danes were the first team to go undefeated in league play and win the tournament since Maine did in the 1995-96 season.

After graduating the top senior class in program history, UAlbany did not lose a beat as the Great Danes went 15-1 in the America East in the 2013-14 season and won its third-consecutive title. America East Player of the Year Shereesha Richards set a program record for single-season record for scoring, averaging 20 points a game. UAlbany became the first program to win three-straight America East titles since Maine did it from 1995-97.

In those three seasons, UAlbany has had some of its best players in program history. Eb-one Henry graduated as the school's leading scorer and three-time America East Defensive Player of the Year. Julie Forster, a three-time all-conference player, finished as the program's all-time rebounder, and Lindsay Lowrie, who finished fifth all-time in program history in three-point shooting. Shereesha Richards may join that list with two years of eligibility remaining. Henry, Forster and Lowrie all graduated in 2013.

Taking the program reins, Shereesha Richards set a new season-scoring record in 2014, helped by Sarah Royals, who set a new single-season assists record the same year. Royals, Megan Craig and Margarita Rosario have been part of all three championships.

Coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson

5th Year at UAlbany

2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 America East Coach of the Year



Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, a three-time America East Coach of the Year, enters her fifth season at the helm of the Great Dane program after leading UAlbany to three-consecutive America East titles with a combined 74-18 overall tally and 45-3 conference record in those three years.

Under Coach Abe's tenure, UAlbany won 38-consecutive America East regular season contests from Feb. 1, 2012 through Feb. 26, 2014, setting a new league record and holding the then-longest conference winning streak in all of Division I. The new streak surpassed the old record of 37-straight set by Maine from 1995-97 under coach Joanne P. McCallie, the mentor of Coach Abe at Maine and Michigan State.

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, UAlbany has had two America East Players of the Year, three AE Defensive Players of the Year, an AE Scholar-Athlete of the Year, an AE Rookie of the Year, six All-America East First Team selections, 11 total All-America East players, nine AE All-Defensive Team players and four AE All-Academic Team players.

Abrahamson-Henderson, the 10th head coach in the UAlbany program's history, was previously the associate head coach at Indiana University. She also served as Missouri State University's head coach from 2002-07, leading that program to three NCAA Tournament appearances. In her coaching career, she has helped four different teams reach the NCAA Tournament and six reach postseason play.

After losing its stellar four-person senior class the previous year, the 2013-14 Great Danes did not lose a beat, earning a three-peat as America East champion, going 28-5 with a 15-1 conference record. The team earned the 1-seed in the America East Tournament after winning its first 15 league games, defeating Binghamton, Hartford and Stony Brook in succession for the conference title. UAlbany got a 15-seed in the NCAAs and pushed 2-seed West Virginia to the brink before falling 76-61 in the NCAA First Round.

The Great Danes dominated all conference opposition in the 2012-13 season with a 27-4 overall record, winning all games against America East opponents including 16 regular season games and all league championship contests. UAlbany became the first team to go undefeated in the America East and win the conference since the 1995-96 season.

After posting a record turnaround in her first season with the Great Danes, Abrahamson-Henderson led UAlbany to its then-best record in Division I history in the 2011-12, going 23-10 overall. The Great Danes brought home their first-ever America East Conference title, and represented the league in the NCAA Tournament. UAlbany visited defending National Champions Texas A&M, and held with the Aggies for most of the game, showing how far the program has come in a short period of time.

At Missouri State, she guided that program to three Missouri Valley Conference tournament championships, two MVC regular-season titles and three NCAA berths. The Bears, who also won the 2005 WNIT championship, posted a 95-61 record during her five seasons. In addition, she coached a pair of MVC players of the year, 11 all-conference honorees, two of the program's all-time leading scorers and 13 MVC scholar-athletes.

Abrahamson-Henderson and her husband, Michael, have two daughters, Savannah and Brooklyn. Michael also had a celebrated college basketball career and played for the Harlem Globetrotters. He led Long Island-C.W. Post to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and scored 1,173 career points from 1981-84.

Keyana Williams - 1st Season (UAlbany '13)

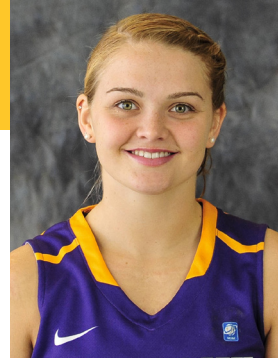

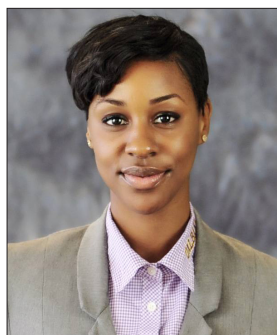
