UALBANY FLIES TO DALLAS FOR BATTLE VS. SMU

Before the holiday break, UAlbany will head to Texas for the first time since 2001, taking on SMU on Tuesday, December 20th at 8 p.m. ET (7 p.m. CT) in the Moody Coliseum in Dallas.

The game will be broadcast online on ESPN3 and on the radio in Albany on 104.5 the Team with Rodger Wyland and Zach Bye.

UAlbany got back on the win column in its final non-conference home game of the year on Saturday, defeating St. Francis Brooklyn 87-60 to enter Tuesday at 7-5 overall. SMU, as of Sunday, is at 8-3 overall and is playing Stanford on Monday night at home.

This is the first-ever meeting between UAlbany and SMU. UAlbany fell to a different AAC opponent earlier in the year with a 74-51 defeat at Cincinnati on November 14th. SMU hosted an America East team last season, defeating New Hampshire 98-44 at home. UAlbany is playing its first game against an opponent outside of New York since December 3rd.

UAlbany is playing in the state of Texas for the first time since 2001 and first time under head coach Will Brown. The Great Danes played two games in January of that year, falling to Texas-Pan American 84-69 on the 13th and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi 107-78 on the 15th.

CREMO EARNS AE CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

With a pair of 20+ point performances, Joe Cremo was selected as the America East Co-Player of the Week on December 12th. It is his second America East Player of the Week award after netting 29 vs. Colgate and 24 vs. Marist, each victories for UAlbany.

ACCURATE SHOOTERS

UAlbany currently stands third in the America East with a 46.5% field goal rate, 102nd in all of Division I.

Greig Stire is fourth in the league, making 56.1% of his shots, while each Mike Rowley also shoots 56.1% from the floor with nine fewer shots. Each of UAlbany's primary shooting guards, Joe Cremo and David Nichols, shoot at least 43%.

BOX OUT!

UAlbany is eighth in all of Division I in rebounding margin, averaging 10.1 rebounds more than their opponents. It is more than three rebounds more per game than New Hampshire, second in the league.

Two UAlbany players stand in the top-10 in the America East in rebounds per game. Greig Stire and Mike Rowley are both tied for fifth in the league with 6.5 rebounds a contest while Joe Cremo is tied for 14th with 4.8 boards a game.

WILL BROWN APPROACHING 250 WINS AT UALBANY

Into his 16th season with the team, Will Brown is just six wins away from 250 as the head coach at UAlbany. He stands with a career record of 246-229, including five America East Tournament titles and seven seasons with at least 19 victories.

The longest active tenured coach in the league, Brown ranks fourth all-time in victories as coach of an America East. He is three victories away from tying for third with Dennis Wolff, who had 249 victories with Boston University from 1995 to 2009.

PLAY IN THE PAINT, NOT THE PERIMETER

UAlbany stands with the best three-point field goal defense percentage in the America East, holding teams to 33.6% from behind the arc.

In addition, UAlbany has taken the least amount of shots from three-point range in the America East. After 12 games played, UAlbany has taken 159 shots from three, over 75 less than the next conference team (UMBC, 243).

SOPHOMORE SURGE FOR NICHOLS

David Nichols is having a strong start to his sophomore season, averaging 16.3 points per game in his first 12 contests. He has earned 11 double digit scoring games to begin the year after having none last season, averaging 2.7 points per game in 15 contests played in 2015-16.

UALBANY RECEIVING VOTES IN MID-MAJOR POLL

UAlbany is currently receiving votes in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll, released every Monday. UAlbany has 11 points in the current poll on December 12th.

Last season, UAlbany climbed the poll and was at #24 in the poll at the end of the regular season.

UALBANY EARNS FIRST VICTORY OVER BIG TEN TEAM

To begin the season in the Naismith Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament, UAlbany defeated Penn State 87-81 to earn the program's first-ever victory over a Big Ten Conference opponent. It was UAlbany's first win over a Power Five opponent since defeating Washington 63-62 on November 13th, 2012.

THREE PLAYERS NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

Head coach Will Brown announced in October that Mike Rowley, Dallas Ennema and Joe Cremo will serve as team captains for the 2016-17 season.

All three will serve as team captains for the first time in their collegiate careers. Captains were voted on by the players.

STREAKS

Mike Rowley, who scored points in every game last season, stands with a 61-game scoring streak, dating back to January 22, 2015. He has also grabbed at least one rebound each of the past 78 games, including the entire 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons.

The first guard off the bench last season, Joe Cremo has scored points in each of his last 43 games going back to Nov. 19, 2015.

On the rebounding front, Greig Stire has earned at least one board in each of the past 48 games.

WILL BROWN SIGNS FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION

On September 29, UAlbany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced that Will Brown signed a new five-year contract through the 2020-21 season. Brown enters his 16th season as UAlbany head coach this year.

UALBANY REGAINS ALBANY CUP AT SEFCU

With an 81-72 victory over Siena at the SEFCU Arena, UAlbany regained the Albany Cup over its crosstown rival. The Great Danes have now won four of the last five Albany Cups.

The two teams had never met at SEFCU previously. This was the first meeting between the two on UAlbany's campus since December 29th, 1976.

CAPITAL DISTRICT LOCALS

Three players local to the Capital District have remained home to suit up for the Great Danes this season.

From nearby Scotia comes Joe Cremo, a three-time Section II Class A champion at Scotia-Glenville, who earned 2015-16 America East Rookie of the Year. Junior forward Greig Stire was a starter as a sophomore in the frontcourt, taking Christian Brothers Academy in Albany to the 2012 Section II title. At Albany Academy, freshman Nick Fruscio took his team to a pair of Federation state titles, including as a senior team captain.

ACROSS THE USA.....

UAlbany's roster has representatives from eight different states across three time zones in the USA. Along with New York, among the represented include California, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan and Texas.

.....AND AROUND THE WORLD

Three UAlbany players across three different continents have come to play for UAlbany this season. Senior team captain Mike Rowley is from Australia, Terrel Martin-Garcia comes from across the Atlantic in England while Devonte Campbell is from Ontario, Canada.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK

UAlbany will play a number of opponents across the Empire State this season, including Siena, Stony Brook (twice), Binghamton (twice), Oneonta, Marist, Colgate, Canisius, St. Francis Brooklyn, Columbia and Cornell. In total, UAlbany has 12 games against New York teams. UAlbany is currently 5-1 against these opponents.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE!

Three players native to Australia, Brent Hank, Cameron Healy and Adam Lulka, signed NLLs on Signing Day to join UAlbany starting in the 2017-18 season.

UAlbany has one current player from Australia, Mike Rowley, and three former players, Sam Rowley, Peter Hooley and Luke Devlin.

SCOUTING SMU:

SMU boasts the 20th ranked scoring defense in Division I, allowing 61.4 points per game. A transfer from Duke, redshirt junior forward Semi Ojeleye is the leading scorer and rebounder with 17.6 points and 7.5 boards a game. Running the point is sophomore guard Shake Milton, who averages 12.2 points and 3.8 assists each contest.

COACHES RETURNING TO UALBANY

Will Brown's coaching staff is made up of five members, all with degrees from UAlbany. Only one other men's basketball coaching staff, Duke, has the same situation.

Assistant coach Jon Iati graduated from UAlbany in 2007, assistant coach Jared Knotts and director of operation Lucious Jordan III each earned their degree in 2006 while video coordinator DJ Evans graduated in 2014. Assistant coach Josh Pelletier, a 2009 graduate of Saint Rose, earned his Master's Degree from UAlbany in 2012.

JOE CREMO NAMED TO AMERICA EAST PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

Joe Cremo, the league's Rookie of the Year and Sixth Man of the Year last season, was placed on the 2016-17 America East Preseason All-Conference Team by the league's head coaches. In 33 games last season, Cremo shot 51.4% from the field and 85.9% from the free throw line, earning 10.5 points and 3.8 rebounds a contest. It is the third year in a row where UAlbany has had a player on the AE Preseason All-Conference Team.

UALBANY PREDICTED TO FINISH THIRD IN AMERICA EAST IN PRESEASON POLL

UAlbany is predicted in the league's preseason coaches poll to finish third in the America East Conference in the 2016-17 season. UAlbany picked up 49 points in the poll. Vermont is predicted to finish first in the preseason poll with six first-place votes and 62 points. New Hampshire is at second with 58 points. After UAlbany, the rest of the poll is filled out by, Binghamton (37), UMass Lowell (31), UMBC (29), Stony Brook (27), Hartford (23) and Maine (8).

UALBANY HOME GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN3

The America East Conference has announced that beginning in December, all home games by conference institutions, including UAlbany, will be broadcast online on ESPN3.

The media rights agreement between the America East and ESPN will run through the 2026-27 season and will include more than 3,000 events.

11 UAlbany men's basketball regular season home games will air on ESPN3 this season.

UAlbany MBB Earns +29 Rebounding Margin over St. Francis Brooklyn, Taking Victory 87-60

ALBANY, N.Y. – The UAlbany men's basketball team, aided by the comeback of Brooklyn-native Travis Charles, outrebounded St. Francis 50-21 en route to an 87-60 victory for a win in its final non-conference home game of the season.

Down 33-30 with 2:56 left in the first half, UAlbany (7-5) scored the next 17 points over a span of eight minutes to go ahead for good over St. Francis (2-9).

"I thought our kids competed hard all game; in the second half, we stopped hurting ourselves," said UAlbany head coach Will Brown. "I thought we got good shots and we had multiple stops (on defense), that latter one is something we take pride in."

UAlbany's +29 rebounding margin is the highest of the season against a Division I opponent, surpassing +17 against Penn State and Holy Cross. Six Great Danes had at least five rebounds, compared to no Terriers doing the same. The Great Danes also scored 40 points in the paint to St. Francis's 28.

Charles, who returned after missing a couple of games, had 15 points off 4-5 shooting and 7-9 from the free throw line. He was one of five Great Danes in double figure scoring, led by Joe Cremo, who had 20 points, including

4-for-5 from three-point range, plus five rebounds and five assists.

Marqueese Grayson scored 13 points and grabbed six boards while Greig Stire nearly had a double-double with 10 points and eight rebounds. Dallas Ennema had a career-high 10 rebounds, also having points, four assists and two blocks.

Stire was UAlbany's target early, hitting a layup on the team's first possession then being fouled on a layup attempt next. Down 4-2, Grayson sparked a quick 9-2 spurt with a deep three, adding a jumper and two free throws to make it 11-6 UAlbany just over five minutes in.

The visitors were kept away from the paint area but fired away from long range. St. Francis hit four of the next five shots in the game, capped by two baskets in a row by D.J. Porter, to lead 16-13. Cremo hit a kick-out three, then drew contact the next possession and scored two free throws to push UAlbany ahead 18-16 with under 10 minutes left in the 1st.

A fast break by David Nichols to a racing Mike Rowley for a layup put UAlbany back up with 8:14 left in the 1st. The teams kept trading as Sanabria hit a fadeaway then a three off the screen for the Terriers, which was countered by two Charles free throws then a Cremo deep three for a 25-23 advantage.

The exchanges continued as UAlbany looked to break the St. Francis fullcourt press. After each side had a two-possession run, Ennema hit two free throws, blocked a Terrier shot, hit a three off a pass then drew a double for the pass to Rowley for the layup and one to make it 38-33 in the closing minutes of the half. UAlbany took that five-point lead into the locker room.

The UAlbany defense continued to hold down St. Francis, keeping the Terriers without points for almost five minutes to start the second, combining for almost eight minutes from the first period. Spearheaded by another half's starting run by Stire, UAlbany totaled 17-0 in the run, dating back to the last half, to surge ahead 47-33 in the first four minutes of the 2nd.

St. Francis continued to press, leading to a 7-0 run with scores from three different players to pull within 10 at 54-44, leading to a UAlbany timeout with 11 minutes left.

UAlbany's aggressive stance on the boards and fast play led to another run, as Nichols scored five points on an 11-2 spurt, capped by a second chance three with 9:10 left, for a 65-46 advantage. Relying on play in the paint, Charles and Cremo added to the advantage stood ahead 75-48 with 5:46 left.

UAlbany kept a strong advantage the rest of the way, including a corner three by Costa Anderson, to earn the 87-60 victory.

16th Year at UAlbany
2014-15 America East Coach of the Year



Will Brown is in his 16th season overall as the University at Albany's men's basketball head coach, after spending one season in an interim capacity. Brown, the longest tenured coach in the America East Conference, has led the program to five conference championships, five NCAA Tournament appearances, a CollegelInsider.com CIT Postseason Tournament appearance, CBI Postseason appearance and an unparalleled success in the classroom.

The Great Danes made their first program appearance in the CBI in 2015-16, marking the fifth consecutive year with national postseason attention for Brown's squad. UAlbany won an all-time best 24 regular season games, going 24-7 prior to the postseason. Brown & co., reached 20 wins at the fastest pace in program history en route to a 13-3 clip in America East Conference play. The 2015-16 Danes won 19 straight games in the confines of SEFCU Arena, including ending Stony Brook's nation-best 18-game winning streak on Feb. 17. The Purple & Gold was also a national leader in free throws made, free throws attempted, free throw percentage and three-point field goal percentage defense.

2014-15 was an unprecedented season for the Great Danes, earning their best Division I winning percentage (24-9, .727) and tying their highest win total. UAlbany went 15-1 in America East Conference play and 8-0 on the road to earn its second regular season title and No. 1 seed in the league tournament. Playing all three conference postseason games in the confines of SEFCU Arena, Brown earned his third consecutive and fifth overall America East Tournament title, 51-50 over Stony Brook. Peter Hooley hit a last-second three from the top of the key for the victory. The Danes continued on to Columbus, Ohio in the East Regional to face No. 3 seed Oklahoma as the 14-seed in the NCAA Second Round. UAlbany fell 69-60 in its fifth Division I NCAA Tournament appearance. In the midst of its 15-1 America East record, the Purple & Gold went on a Division I record 13-game winning streak from Jan. 3-Feb. 13. Brown also took his 200th career victory on Jan. 14 against Binghamton, 73-58.

Brown earned the program's first NCAA Division I Tournament win in 2013-14 when the Purple & Gold took down Mount St. Mary's in the First Four 71-64 in Dayton, Ohio. He led UAlbany to its second-straight America East title in 2013-14, as the No. 4 seed. The Great Danes repeated their feat as the lowest seed to ever win the tournament, once again knocking off the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds and taking the title on the road.

He was also named the top value coach among Division I head coaches in 2013-14 by HoopDirt.com.

Brown was appointed as UAlbany's head coach on March 13, 2002, and has worked on the collegiate level since 1995. He became the 15th head coach in the history of the program.
