HOME WIN STREAK SNAPPED

The Great Danes' 24-game home win streak was ended on January 16 when the team hosted UMBC. UAlbany had not lost a home game since February 1, 2015, against Maine. The streak spanned 708 days, during which time the team's average margin of victory was 18.1 points. 10 of the 24 victories were decided by 10 or more points.

FÉQUIÈRE EARNS SECOND PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Jessica Féquière was named America East Player of the Week for the second time this season, after two straight games scoring 20 or more points, against UMass Lowell and Stony Brook. In the latter game against the Seawolves, Féquière scored a career-high 24 points. She currently has a streak of 12 consecutive made free throws, and her 93.6% ranks fifth in the country as of January 10.

A NEW YEAR

The new year brought with it the start of conference play, and the first America East opponent on the slate for UAlbany was UMass Lowell. The Great Danes rolled the Riverhawks, scoring a season-high 93 points. Senior Imani Tate and junior Jessica Féquière each scored 20 or more points, and freshman point guard Khepera Stokes, making her second career start, followed up an 11-turnover outing at Dartmouth with a career-high 9 assists and 0 turnover performance against UMass Lowell.

NON-CONFERENCE WRAP-UP

The Great Danes conclude their 13-game non-conference schedule with a 6-7 record, and close December going 3-3 after a 3-4 November. The team remains unbeaten in five games this season at SEFCU Arena, but has just one win away from home.

A STREAK ENDS

Junior Jessica Féquière's streak of 22 consecutive free throws came to an end against Post on December 12. She had not missed a free throw since November 16 against Army, stringing along the streak over nine games.

FÉQUIÈRE NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Jessica Féquière was named America East Week #5 Co-Player of the Week alongside Stony Brook senior Kori Bayne-Walker. Féquière averaged a double-double in two wins against Fairfield and Wagner, including tying a career-high 20 points and grabbing a career-high 14 rebounds at Wagner. Féquière also shot 10-10 from the free-throw line in two games, and is 27-28 for the season. Her 96.4% FT mark is good for fourth in the country as of December 11.

TATE NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For her efforts against Fordham and Siena, senior Imani Tate was named America East Player of the Week for Week #3. Tate averaged 27.5 points in two games for the Great Danes, including a season-high 31 against Fordham, and 24 against Siena, including clutch free throws with eight seconds left to force overtime, leading a group of four Danes in double figures.

UAlbany won the Albany Cup against Siena for the seventh consecutive year. It was also the first time in history the Cup was hosted at SEFCU Arena. The Great Danes trailed late into the fourth quarter, but ended the game on an 11-3 run to force overtime, where UAlbany downed Siena by two points, 88-86.

TRIPLE THREAT

During the game against Miami, senior Imani Tate crossed three career milestone thresholds. She played in her 100th game, she grabbed her 500th rebound, and she recorded her 200th steal. Tate needs just nine more field goals to hit 500, and nine more offensive rebounds to hit 200. Junior Tiana-Jo Carter also reeled in her 200th career defensive rebound against Kentucky.

UALBANY EARNS TWO 2015-16 AE YEARLY AWARDS

Shereesha Richards won her third consecutive America East Player of the Year Award, the latest in her long list of accolades. She also earned spots on the All-Conference First and Defensive Teams, and was named the America East Tournament Most Outstanding Player.

Tiana-Jo Carter was named America East Sixth Player of the year, after being named to the All-Rookie team two seasons ago.

Imani Tate, like Richards, earned spots on the All-Conference First and Defensive Teams, while Zakiya Saunders earned an All-Conference Second Team selection.

UALBANY RANKED NINTH IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Great Danes were picked ninth in the preseason Mid-Major poll. The team surpasses their preseason ranking of 14 from a year ago, before the Great Danes went on to win their fifth consecutive America East championship.

UAlbany, which tallied 470 points, is the only America East squad in the rankings, and one of two schools, along with Iona, from New York.

South Dakota State earned 742 points overall, and 26 first place selections as the top ranked school in the poll. Second-ranked Green Bay and fifth-ranked Gonzaga received two first-place votes each, and tenth-ranked Princeton received one. Star Seniors

UALBANY PICKED AS AMERICA EAST FAVORITE

The Great Danes were selected first in the preseason conference coaches' poll for the fifth consecutive season. UAlbany received five of a possible eight first-place votes, accumulating 60 points total.

UMBC, Maine, and Binghamton were selected second, third, and fourth respectively, with only four points separating the three teams. UMBC and Maine received two first-place votes each.

TATE NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

2016-17 is the second consecutive season Tate has been named to the preseason team. Last season, Tate was named to the America East All-Conference First Team and All-Defensive team. The year before, Tate was named America East Sixth Player of the Year, and selected for the America East All-Conference Second Team and the All-Tournament Team.

ROAD TRIPPING

Only five of UAlbany's non-conference games will be played at SEFCU Arena. The remaining eight will be road trips, including the opening weekend in Lexington, Kentucky, where the Great Danes will face the host Wildcats and then the Miami (FL) Hurricanes as part of the Kentucky Classic. Other road swings include Fordham, St. John's, and Yale.

MORE HISTORY

The Great Danes made program history last year by winning their first-ever NCAA tournament game. They made conference history by winning a fifth-consecutive title, a feat unmatched by any women's or men's America East team. UAlbany looks to extend their historical streak while defending their five-straight titles.

JET SETTING

Five of the 13 women on the UAlbany roster hail from international countries. Two of this year's freshmen, Mackenzie Trpcic (Canada) and Kumsal Aslan (Turkey) join a squad of players that includes Bose Aiyalogbe (Nigeria), Cassandra Edwards (Canada), and Jessica Féquière (Canada). In recent years, the Great Danes have also fielded players from the British Virgin Islands, Jamaica, and New Zealand.

UALBANY HOSTS ALBANY CUP

The Women's Albany Cup, the annual matchup between local rivals UAlbany and Siena, will be held at SEFCU Arena for the first time in history. Traditionally, the game is held in the Times Union Center. The last time Siena played a game at UAlbany was February 2, 1981. Last year, the Great Danes defeated the Saints 61-42, the sixth year in a row UAlbany has claimed victory in the Albany Cup.

CLIMBING THE RANKS

Imani Tate ranks sixth all-time in program history in career scoring, 12th in steals, 14th in assists, and 18th in rebounds. Tiana-Jo Carter ranks 10th in program history in career blocks. Last season, Tate surpassed the 1,000-point barrier, and needs 436 points to pass Ebone Henry for second place in program history.

2016-17 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - @ MAINE

BANGOR, Maine – Three days after clinching their first road victory in-conference, and only their second road win of the season, the University at Albany women's basketball team found themselves in the first of two regular season meetings with Maine, the Danes' opponent in last year's America East title game. On Maine's home court, UAlbany started strong, taking a 43-32 lead into halftime, but ultimately fell to the Black Bears 84-71.

"It was a really frustrating second half for us," said head coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee. "I think our intensity faltered on the defensive end, and, rebounding-wise, we just didn't crash and do the same things we did in the first half."

"We shot the ball extremely well in the first half," said Coach Mac, "perhaps the best half of shooting we've had all season. I knew that could continue, but also that it could not continue, so you need to maintain the consistency on defense, and that's where we dropped off a bit in the second half."

After sophomore Heather Forster won the opening tip, redshirt-junior Jessica Féquière hit at three on UAlbany's first possession. Maine took a 5-3 lead a few possessions later on a three of their own. Seniors Bailey Hixson and Imani Tate hit threes on the Danes next two possessions. By the mid-way point, the Great Danes held an 11-8 lead.

Maine tied the game at 16 with just over a minute to go in the first. Hixson hit her third three pointer of the quarter to give UAlbany back the lead. Freshman Khepera Stokes ended the quarter with a running teardrop in the paint to give the Danes a 21-16 lead.

With just 3:32 remaining in the second, UAlbany had opened a 12-point lead, thanks in part to five consecutive points by Féquière. By halftime, UAlbany led 43-32. Tate led the team with 15 points, followed by Féquière with 11, and Hixson with nine. Tate also led the team with four rebounds, and Stokes led with three assists. For the first half, the Great Danes shot 6-9 from three.

UAlbany led Maine 20-18 in points in the paint, 15-6 in points off of turnovers, 5-3 in second chance points, and 4-0 in fast break points. Maine held an 11-4

advantage in bench points.

Maine came out firing in the third quarter, opening up with an 11-2 run in the first four minutes to cut the lead to two. Maine took a two-point lead immediately after the media timeout, extending the run to 17-4.

"Maine was able to convert on some of our turnovers," said Coach Mac, "because instead of post passes to the interior, the turnovers came on the perimeter, which were easy to turn into two points in the other direction."

Féquière gave UAlbany a 54-41 lead on a three-point play with two minutes left in the third. By the end of the quarter, Maine led 58-57, having outscored UAlbany 26-14 in the period. The Black Bears, who shot 2-8 from three in the first half, shot 3-6 in the third.

Maine opened the fourth with a three-point play to take a four-point lead. The Black Bears started heating up from behind the arc, opening up an 11-point lead on consecutive three-pointers. With just over five minutes remaining, Maine had outscored UAlbany 14-4 in the quarter.

Maine's lead extended to 16 with 3:37 remaining. Forster ended UAlbany's scoring drought with a backdoor layup off a sideline pass from Tate. Maine answered right back with a layup on the other end. A quick 4-0 run and a couple of defensive stops had cut the lead to 12 with 2:20 remaining. The Great Danes would come no closer, and UAlbany ultimately fell by a score of 84-71.

Tate led all scorers with a season-high 32 points. She also led the Danes with eight rebounds, and Stokes finished with five assists. For the game, UAlbany shot 13-14 from the free throw line, and 6-11 from three.

Maine led UAlbany 38-36 in points in the paint, 24-19 in points off of turnovers, and 24-10 in bench points. UAlbany led 8-2 in fast break points, and the teams tied 13-13 in second chance points.

Next, the Great Danes return home for the final two games of their first cycle of America East opponents. The team will host Vermont on Thursday, January 26 for Commitment to Education Day for a 12:00 p.m. tipoff, and will then host Hartford on Saturday, January 28 for a 2:00 p.m. start.

2016-17 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

LAST TIME vs. VERMONT

VESTAL, N.Y. – The 1-seed UAlbany women's basketball team took care of business in the America East Tournament quarterfinals with a 95-43 victory over 8-seed Vermont to advance to the semifinal round tomorrow at 4:15 p.m.

Three players for UAlbany (25-4) scored at least 20 points as the Great Danes never trailed after taking the lead in the first minute against Vermont (9-21).

"I thought we came out really strong and focused," said UAlbany head coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson. "We really want to concentrate on defense all the time. We knew they were a really good three-point shooting team; they took a lot of threes, and we were fortunate that they didn't make them, so we really wanted to guard them more in the press."

The four-time defending America East champion UAlbany earns its 12th consecutive victory in the league tournament. UAlbany will take on 5-seed Binghamton in the semifinal round at 4:15 p.m.

UAlbany's 54-point first half is the second-largest in the program's DI history (56 vs. Vermont) and the third-biggest in America East Tournament history.

95 points marks the highest amount in the Division I era for UAlbany. The team's previous high of points in the DI era was 94 in a 45-point victory at Vermont on January 9th, 2014.

Shereesha Richards scored 32 points in 24 minutes of play, going 12-for-17 from the floor and 7-for-9 from the free throw line, adding six rebounds. Richards moved into fourth in America East history in scoring with 2,339 points in her career.

"It is always great when everyone is hitting shots, and we just keep pushing," said Richards. "It is fun when the defense is creating offense and you are making shots and getting stops."

As a team, UAlbany had 18 steals to Vermont's two and shot 55.6% from the field, holding its opponent to 28.6%. No Vermont player earned double digit scoring in the game.

Imani Tate tallied up 21 points, seven assists, five steals and five rebounds. Zakiya Saunders finished with 20 points off 8-for-12 shooting, five assists and five steals while Bailey Hixson shot a perfect 3-for-3 from beyond the arc for nine points.

UAlbany's zone defense forced pressure on Vermont, leading to a couple of steals. The other way, Richards put up mid-range jumpers, hitting three of her first four shots plus two free throws for an early 10-2 advantage.

UAlbany continued to force steals as Vermont tried to force action under the basket. Saunders led the next charge on offense from 12-foot jumpers on the elbow as at 12-6, UAlbany went the final 4:07 with a 12-0 run, with Saunders, Richards and Tate all hitting multiple field goals, to lead 24-6 after one quarter.

The Purple and Gold continued that run into the second quarter, with Saunders and Richards adding baskets to complete the run at 16-0. Following a Candice Wright putback jumper, Tiana-Jo Carter led a 6-0 sprint with two baskets to build UAlbany's advantage to 34-8 with 7:23 left in the 2nd.

Kylie Atwood stopped UAlbany's run with a wing three, then UAlbany began another. After two Tate free throws, Richards continued the attack with a jumper, two free throws and a hand-off three at the top of the arc.

Continuing the half court traps and pressure defense, Saunders hit a couple more jumpers to finish another UAlbany run, this one 8-0. A last minute Vermont basket made it 54-18 UAlbany at the half.

A Richards stutter step jumper and four free throws from Saunders after fast break attacks built the UAlbany lead to 42 three minutes into the 3rd.

The two teams exchanged some points as UAlbany layups were countered by Kylie Butler free throws. UAlbany built the lead to over 50 in the next three minutes 13-2 streak, powered by seven Richards points. A couple of late points by Vermont made it 78-29 after three.

With the reserves primarily playing in the fourth quarter, the Great Danes held Vermont to one field goal in the opening six minutes. Three-pointers from Hixson and free throws from Heather Forster led to a quarter-opening 14-5 run as UAlbany led 92-34 with just under four minutes left.

Butler added some late points for Vermont. Cassandra Edwards hit a late basket for the eventual 95-43 final score in favor of UAlbany.

In other America East action, 2-seed Maine defeated 7-seed New Hampshire 58-47 while 3-seed Stony Brook picked up a 60-42 victory over 6-seed Hartford.

COACH JOANNA BERNABEI-MCNAMEE - FIRST SEASON AT UALBANY



University at Albany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced Friday, April 15th, 2016 the hiring of Joanna Bernabei-McNamee as the 11th head women's basketball coach in program history and fourth head coach in the Great Danes' Division I era.

Bernabei-McNamee (pronounced Bern-uh-BEE Mac-Na-MEE), a native of Weirton, W.Va., comes to UAlbany after three seasons as the head coach of the University of Pikeville in Pikeville, Ky. There, McNamee racked up 63 wins and led the program to back-to-back National Tournament berths, including a program-record 26 victories and an NAIA Final Four appearance in 2016. McNamee was named

the 2016 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) NAIA Regional Coach of the Year, and was also named the 2015 Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to Pikeville, McNamee coached at the NCAA Division I level for 10 years. She served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Maryland for four seasons from 2003 to 2007, and helped pilot the Terrapins to the 2006 National Championship. Maryland beat Duke 78-75 in overtime for the title and finished with a record of 34-4. During her tenure, she brought in four straight nationally ranked recruiting classes, including three in the top 10.

McNamee spent two years at West Virginia University as an assistant coach where she was a scout, position coach and recruiting coordinator. Before her time as a Mountaineer, McNamee had a two-year stint at Eastern Kentucky where she was responsible for scouting, individual player development, as well as serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Coach Mac gained head coaching experience in 1998 at West Virginia Wesleyan where she compiled an 18-9 record and a third-place finish in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC), while also acting as the school's Senior Women's Administrator.

McNamee attended West Liberty State where she was a Division II All-American and a four-time first-team All-WVIAC selection as a point guard. Named the 1997 WVIAC Player of the Year, she still holds the NCAA Division II career assists record of 1,107 and the record for assists in a game with 24. She is one of only four players in NCAA history to record over 1,000 points and 1,000 assists, finishing her stellar career with 1,317 total points.

McNamee also holds NCAA records for average assists per game (9.5), and the school and conference marks for assists in a game, season (294) and career. She led her team to an 80-36 record over four years and is listed on West Liberty's Top 20 All-Time Best Athletes list. She was the first woman to be named first-team All-West Virginia Athletic Conference for four years and was inducted into the West Liberty State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002 and the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Hall of Fame in 2011.

McNamee earned her bachelor's degree in exercise physiology in 1997 from West Liberty and a master's degree from Eastern Kentucky in sports administration in 1999.

Joanna and her husband Joe McNamee have two sons, Luke (9) and Caden (8). McNamee took a nearly four-year hiatus from coaching (2009-13) to focus on raising her children.

Coach Mac takes over a UAlbany program that has won a combined nine America East Conference tournament and regular season titles in the last five seasons, and has made five consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. In the 2015-16 season, UAlbany defeated No. 5 Florida for the program's first-ever Division I NCAA Tournament victory.
