#### LAST TWO AE CHAMPIONS MEET AS UALBANY VISITS STONY BROOK

UAlbany, the America East Tournament champion from 2013-15, and Stony Brook, the 2016 league champion, will play the first of two conference matchups this season on Sunday, January 8th at 2 p.m. at the IFCU Arena.

UAlbany is playing its second of two road games to begin America East play on Sunday, with its conference home opener set for Wednesday, January 11th vs. New Hampshire.

UAlbany fell in its conference opener for the first time in seven seasons on Thursday at UMass Lowell 85-79 to stand at 0-1 in the league and 9-7 overall. Stony Brook won a road contest at New Hampshire 59-56 on Thursday to begin at 1-0 in the America East and 6-8 overall.

Splitting last year's regular season series, UAlbany ended Stony Brook's 18-game winning streak last season with an 82-70 victory at home on February 17, 2016. Including the pre-DI era, UAlbany leads the all-time series 41-28; in the America East era. Stony Brook leads 21-16. UAlbany has won four of the last six meetings, including the America East title games in 2014 at Stony Brook and 2015 at the SEFCU Arena.

UAlbany stands 7-1 against New York-based teams this year.

#### **THE DYNAMIC DUO**

Joe Cremo and David Nichols had been a strong scoring pair this season, with each standing in the top-10 in the America East. Between the two, they have 12 20+ point games and a combined 28 double digit scoring contests this season.

#### **SAME STARTING FIVE**

UAlbany has played the same starting five in 15 out of 16 games this season. Joe Cremo, Marquese Grayson, David Nichols, Mike Rowley and Greig Stire have been the starters in all but one game this year.

#### **BOX OUT!**

UAlbany is 10th in all of Division I in rebounding margin, averaging 9.6 rebounds more than their opponents. It is almost more than two rebounds more per game than New Hampshire, second in the league.

All told, UAlbany has outrebounded its opponents in 12 out of 16 games and has only once been outrebounded by more than three in a game. UAlbany is 8-4 this season when it has more rebounds than its opponent.

Mike Rowley and Greig Stire, who have started every game this year, each average over six rebounds per contest for top-10 in the America East.

#### **WILL BROWN APPROACHING 250 WINS AT UALBANY**

Into his 16th season with the team, Will Brown is just two wins away from 250 as the head coach at UAlbany. He stands with a career record of 248-231, including five America East Tournament titles and seven seasons with at least 19 victories.

The longest active tenured coach in the league, Brown ranks fourth all-time in victories as coach of an America East. He is one victory away from tying for third with Dennis Wolff, who had 249 victories with Boston University from 1995 to 2009.

#### **PLAY IN THE PAINT, NOT THE PERIMETER**

UAlbany stands with the second-best three-point field goal defense percentage in the America East, holding teams to 34.9% from behind the arc.

In addition, UAlbany has taken the least amount of shots from three-point range in the America East. After 16 games played, UAlbany has taken 226 shots from three, 75 less than the next conference team (Vermont, 301). UAlbany averages 14.1 three-point attempts a game, over four less than any other America East team per contest.

#### **SOPHOMORE SURGE FOR NICHOLS**

David Nichols is having a strong start to his sophomore season, averaging 16.2 points per game in his first 16 contests. He has earned 14 double digit scoring games to begin the year after having none last season, averaging 2.7 points per game in 15 contests played in 2015-16.

### SIX WINNING LEAGUE SEASONS IN A ROW

UAlbany has earned a winning record in America East play each of the past six seasons starting in the 2010-11 year, including a combined 28-4 tally from 2015-16. UAlbany has earned nine winning seasons in America East play in the last 11 under Will Brown.

### UALBANY EARNS FIRST VICTORY OVER BIG TEN TEAM

To begin the season in the Naismith Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament, UAlbany defeated Penn State 87-81 to earn the program's first-ever victory over a Big Ten Conference opponent. It was UAlbany's first win over a Power Five opponent since defeating Washington 63-62 on November 13th, 2012.

### THREE PLAYERS NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

Head coach Will Brown announced in October that Mike Rowley, Dallas Ennema and Joe Cremo will serve as team captains for the 2016-17 season.

All three will serve as team captains for the first time in their collegiate careers. Captains were voted on by the players.

### STREAKS

Mike Rowley, who scored points in every game last season, stands with a 65-game scoring streak, dating back to January 22, 2015. He has also grabbed at least one rebound each of the past 82 games, including the entire 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons.

The first guard off the bench last season, Joe Cremo has scored points in each of his last 47 games going back to Nov. 19, 2015.

On the rebounding front, Greig Stire has earned at least one board in each of the past 52 games.

### WILL BROWN SIGNS FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION

On September 29, UAlbany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced that Will Brown signed a new five-year contract through the 2020-21 season. Brown enters his 16th season as UAlbany head coach this year.

### **UALBANY REGAINS ALBANY CUP AT SEFCU**

With an 81-72 victory over Siena at the SEFCU Arena, UAlbany regained the Albany Cup over its crosstown rival. The Great Danes have now won four of the last five Albany Cups.

The two teams had never met at SEFCU previously. This was the first meeting between the two on UAlbany's campus since December 29th, 1976.

### **CAPITAL DISTRICT LOCALS**

Three players local to the Capital District have remained home to suit up for the Great Danes this season.

From nearby Scotia comes Joe Cremo, a three-time Section II Class A champion at Scotia-Glenville, who earned 2015-16 America East Rookie of the Year. Junior forward Greig Stire was a starter as a sophomore in the frontcourt, taking Christian Brothers Academy in Albany to the 2012 Section II title. At Albany Academy, freshman Nick Fruscio took his team to a pair of Federation state titles, including as a senior team captain.

### **ACROSS THE USA.....**

UAlbany's roster has representatives from eight different states across three time zones in the USA. Along with New York, among the represented include California, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan and Texas.

### **.....AND AROUND THE WORLD**

Three UAlbany players across three different continents have come to play for UAlbany this season. Senior team captain Mike Rowley is from Australia, Terrel Martin-Garcia comes from across the Atlantic in England while Devonte Campbell is from Ontario, Canada.

### **WELCOME TO NEW YORK**

UAlbany will play a number of opponents across the Empire State this season, including Siena, Stony Brook (twice), Binghamton (twice), Oneonta, Marist, Colgate, Canisius, St. Francis Brooklyn, Columbia and Cornell. In total, UAlbany has 12 games against New York teams. UAlbany is currently 7-1 against these opponents.

### **AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE!**

Three players native to Australia, Brent Hank, Cameron Healy and Adam Lulka, signed NLIs on Signing Day to join UAlbany starting in the 2017-18 season.

UAlbany has one current player from Australia, Mike Rowley, and three former players, Sam Rowley, Peter Hooley and Luke Devlin.

### **SCOUTING STONY BROOK:**

Stony Brook is coached by Jeff Boals in his first season at the helm. The team's top scorer and three-point threat at 37.5% is senior guard Lucas Woodhouse at 13.3 points per game. Standing seventh in the league in rebounding, junior forward Tyrell Sturdivant averages 11.8 points and 6.4 boards per game.

### COACHES RETURNING TO UALBANY

Will Brown's coaching staff is made up of five members, all with degrees from UAlbany. Only one other men's basketball coaching staff, Duke, has the same situation.

Assistant coach Jon Iati graduated from UAlbany in 2007, assistant coach Jared Knotts and director of operation Lucious Jordan III each earned their degree in 2006 while video coordinator DJ Evans graduated in 2014. Assistant coach Josh Pelletier, a 2009 graduate of Saint Rose, earned his Master's Degree from UAlbany in 2012.

### JOE CREMO NAMED TO AMERICA EAST PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

**Joe Cremo**, the league's Rookie of the Year and Sixth Man of the Year last season, was placed on the 2016-17 America East Preseason All-Conference Team by the league's head coaches. In 33 games last season, Cremo shot 51.4% from the field and 85.9% from the free throw line, earning 10.5 points and 3.8 rebounds a contest. It is the third year in a row where UAlbany has had a player on the AE Preseason All-Conference Team.

### UALBANY PREDICTED TO FINISH THIRD IN AMERICA EAST IN PRESEASON POLL

UAlbany is predicted in the league's preseason coaches poll to finish third in the America East Conference in the 2016-17 season. UAlbany picked up 49 points in the poll. Vermont is predicted to finish first in the preseason poll with six first-place votes and 62 points. New Hampshire is at second with 58 points. After UAlbany, the rest of the poll is filled out by, Binghamton (37), UMass Lowell (31), UMBC (29), Stony Brook (27), Hartford (23) and Maine (8).

### UALBANY HOME GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN3

The America East Conference has announced that beginning in December, all home games by conference institutions, including UAlbany, will be broadcast online on ESPN3.

The media rights agreement between the America East and ESPN will run through the 2026-27 season and will include more than 3,000 events.

11 UAlbany men's basketball regular season home games will air on ESPN3 this season.

## LAST TIME OUT...

### UAlbany MBB Downed 85-79 in Offensive Battle at UMass Lowell

**LOWELL, Mass. –** In a back-and-forth offensive affair where both sides shot over 57% from the field, the UAlbany men's basketball team was edged late by UMass Lowell to fall 85-79 in the conference opener.

UAlbany (9-7, 0-1 AE) led for most of the second half, but UMass Lowell (6-9, 1-0 AE) finished on a 6-0 run in the final three minutes to win the game.

"We lost this game on the defensive end of the floor," said UAlbany head coach Will Brown. "We scored plenty of points to win, but we didn't execute at all defensively."

UAlbany had a 57.1% field goal percentage, its highest mark of the season, and outrebounded UMass Lowell 28-18. UMass Lowell on the other end scored on 63.5% of its shots, including 52.2% of attempts from three.

The defeat snaps a six-year streak of UAlbany winning conference openers.

Joe Cremo had a career-high 10 field goals, shooting 10-for-15 with 23 points, six assists and two steals. David Nichols was 9-for-13 from the floor for 19 points, four rebounds and three assists. Mike Rowley added 12 points, six rebounds and two assists.

For UML, Tyler Livingston was 6-for-9 from three for 20 points. Jahad Thomas nearly had a double-double off 13 points, eight assists and five rebounds.

For three possessions to begin, UAlbany hit a basket, then UMass Lowell responded with a score of its own. After UML took a one-point lead, Nichols hit a three from up top of the arc, then drove to the basket and hit a pull-up jumper for a 13-9 UAlbany advantage, 3:40 in.

Each side continued its strong three-point shooting in the following minutes. Livingston assisted one then hit a pair to tie up the game, then after an exchange, Ryan Jones hit a kick out three to send Lowell ahead 23-20 with 11:11 left in the 1st.

UAlbany and Lowell started to exchange shots inside the arc, with each side going through the first 11 minutes shooting 73.3%. Cremo and Nichols combined to begin shooting 10-for-11. A layup and one by Jones gave UMass Lowell a 30-26 advantage with eight minutes left in the opening half.

The Great Danes pulled back in front with a layup and one by Rowley, then Jaraan Lands hit a layup for a 35-32 UAlbany lead. UML again went up at 38-37, when the side continued to trade baskets. With two seconds left in the half, Nichols hit a high-arc shot to give UAlbany a 41-40 advantage at the break.

After Thomas hit a layup to push Lowell ahead in the second, UAlbany responded with an 8-3 run, capped by a Cremo three and assist to Rowley, to make it 50-45 Great Danes. Lowell got four quick points, then UAlbany countered with Rowley and Cremo layups to go back up 54-49 with 14:53 in the 2nd.

The counter-punches continued as UAlbany kept getting up two possessions, primarily from Cremo layups and Dallas Ennema jumpers. Lowell pulled to within three with another Livingston three, then Greig Stire responded with a layup from Cremo to go up 65-60 with 9:25 left.

As the high octane pace continued, UAlbany went up by five again with a Nichols one-hand floater to lead 73-68. UML again got to within a possession, then tied it up with free throws and made it 74-74.

Marqueese Grayson delivered on the next play, hitting a deep three to push UAlbany back in front. Harris went the other way with a corner three, then Jones added a jumper. After a timeout, Nichols hit a free throw line jumper to tie the score at 79-79 with three minutes to play.

UAlbany held on defense for the next two minutes, but did not score. Thomas hit a layup with 1:02 to play, and scored the next two baskets to seal the game 85-79.

### UAlbany MBB Ends Nation's Longest Winning Streak, Downs Stony Brook 82-70 for 18th Straight Home Win

**ALBANY, N.Y.** - In a 2015 America East Championship rematch, University at Albany men's basketball (22-7, 11-3 AE) emerged victorious on Wednesday night, beating Stony Brook (22-5, 13-1 AE) by a score of 82-70. The Great Danes halted the longest active winning streak in Division I men's basketball at 18 games in the win, and handed Stony Brook its first conference loss.

These guys executed our game plan to a tee," said head coach Will Brown. "This game was going to come down to one thing, which is toughness. We were the tougher team for 39 minutes. Making more toughness plays was important. I'm proud of my team; I thought our defense and rebounding was really good. The energy in the building was outstanding."

Both teams showed early-game jitters to start, combining to commit four turnovers in the first three minutes. After the dust settled, the Seawolves took a 12-7 edge as Stony Brook's Rayshaun McGrew heated up. An and-one opportunity for McGrew at the 10:02 mark put the Seawolves up 19-13.

But UAlbany out-played Stony Brook at the three-point line in the first half, going 3-for-4 as the Seawolves went 1-for-4. Dallas Ennema and Peter Hooley drained back-to-back treys to come within three, 22-19. The pair helped

fuel an 8-0 run on 6-for-7 shooting, capturing UAlbany's first lead since the opening moments of the contest, 25-24.

Meanwhile, Steve Pikiell's squad went 2-for-8 (.250) from the field with four turnovers. The Purple & Gold went 4-for-5 to close the first half with a 37-30 advantage, including a step-back Evan Singletary three for the exclamation point. Brown's squad shot 5-for-8 (.625) from three and 15-for-26 (.577) from the field in the opening stanza.

With 20 minutes to go and a sellout crowd looking for a show, UAlbany continued to shoot well to kick off the second half. When Mike Rowley picked up his third foul just 10 seconds in, the Danes responded by shooting 7-for-9. Greig Stire made room around McGrew to score six points in the spurt, while Richard Peters made a statement against Jameel Warney. The junior hit two shots, but also played solid defense to reject Warney at the rim as UAlbany registered a 50-38 lead.

After scoring 13 points in the first half, McGrew went scoreless in the second. The Seawolves went 0-for-8 from the field for a five-minute field goal drought mid-way through the period. Pikiell's squad also experienced its fair share of foul trouble between McGrew, Ahmad Walker and starting point guard Carson Puriefoy.

With the shooting disparities, the Danes began to extend their lead. Hooley hit his second trey of the contest to mark the game's widest margin, 57-42 with 8:44 on the clock.

Stony Brook brought the game back to 10, but Joe Cremo stepped up to score four points and record an assist on the next three possessions. With five minutes to go, the Seawolves failed to narrow the margin and resorted to fouling down the stretch. Hooley, Ray Sanders and Cremo hit from the charity stripe to put the game out of reach.

The Purple & Gold became the second team all season to drop 80 or more points on the Seawolves, the other being ACC powerhouse Notre Dame on Dec. 8 in an 86-61 loss. The Great Danes ended the longest active winning streak in the nation by shooting 54.7% (29-53) from the field and 7-for-15 (.467) from three. Brown's squad also out-rebounded the Seawolves 37-32.

Five Great Danes recorded double figures in scoring, including Joe Cremo (16, 10-10 FT), Peter Hooley (14), Greig Stire (13), Ray Sanders (12) and Mike Rowley (10). Stire matched his career high, while Hooley went for his third career double-double with 14 & 12.

Will Brown is in his 16th season overall as the University at Albany's men's basketball head coach, after spending one season in an interim capacity. Brown, the longest tenured coach in the America East Conference, has led the program to five conference championships, five NCAA Tournament appearances, a CollegeInsider.com CIT Postseason Tournament appearance, CBI Postseason appearance and an unparalleled success in the classroom.

The Great Danes made their first program appearance in the CBI in 2015-16, marking the fifth consecutive year with national postseason attention for Brown's squad. UAlbany won an all-time best 24 regular season games, going 24-7 prior to the postseason. Brown & co., reached 20 wins at the fastest pace in program history en route to a 13-3 clip in America East Conference play. The 2015-16 Danes won 19 straight games in the confines of SEFCU Arena, including ending Stony Brook's nation-best 18-game winning streak on Feb. 17. The Purple & Gold was also a national leader in free throws made, free throws attempted, free throw percentage and three-point field goal percentage defense.

2014-15 was an unprecedented season for the Great Danes, earning their best Division I winning percentage (24-9, .727) and tying their highest win total. UAlbany went 15-1 in America East Conference play and 8-0 on the road to earn its second regular season title and No. 1 seed in the league tournament. Playing all three conference postseason games in the confines of SEFCU Arena, Brown earned his third consecutive and fifth overall America East Tournament title, 51-50 over Stony Brook. Peter Hooley hit a last-second three from the top of the key for the victory. The Danes continued on to Columbus, Ohio in the East Regional to face No. 3 seed Oklahoma as the 14-seed in the NCAA Second Round. UAlbany fell 69-60 in its fifth Division I NCAA Tournament appearance. In the midst of its 15-1 America East record, the Purple & Gold went on a Division I record 13-game winning streak from Jan. 3-Feb. 13. Brown also took his 200th career victory on Jan. 14 against Binghamton, 73-58.

Brown earned the program's first NCAA Division I Tournament win in 2013-14 when the Purple & Gold took down Mount St. Mary's in the First Four 71-64 in Dayton, Ohio. He led UAlbany to its second-straight America East title in 2013-14, as the No. 4 seed. The Great Danes repeated their feat as the lowest seed to ever win the tournament, once again knocking off the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds and taking the title on the road.

He was also named the top value coach among Division I head coaches in 2013-14 by HoopDirt.com.

Brown was appointed as UAlbany's head coach on March 13, 2002, and has worked on the collegiate level since 1995. He became the 15th head coach in the history of the program.
