### RHODE ISLAND VS. ALBANY - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game is the fifth meeting between Rhode Island and Albany, and it is the third time the Rams have ever been to Bob Ford Field.
- Albany has won the last three meetings in the series, which dates back to 2013.
- Rhode Island is 1-1 at Bob Ford Field, with its victory coming in the first-ever game played at the field. Rhode Island won that contest, 19-3, in overtime.
- Both teams enter the game looking to end losing streaks. Rhode Island has dropped its last four in a row, while Albany has lost four straight games.
- Albany is allowing just 93.0 rushing yards per game, the second lowest per game average among CAA Football teams.
- The Great Danes also are stingy against the pass, giving up just 200.1 yards per game, the third-lowest average in the league.
- Albany leads CAA Football in average time of possession, holding the ball for an average of 33:24 each game. Rhode Island is last in the league at 28:06.

### MATT PIRES NAMED SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Rhode Island freshman **Matt Pires** was been named the CAA Football Special Teams Player of the Week following his record-setting performance against No. 14 Elon Oct 21.
- The Lincolndale, N.Y. native set a Rhode Island record when he broke off a 90-yard punt return for a touchdown late in the third quarter against the Phoenix. At the time, the play gave the Rams a 34-28 lead as Pires fielded the punt at his own 10-yard line, broke through a big crease created by his blockers and then outran the last few defenders for the score.
- The play broke the previous mark for longest punt return, an 86-yard return by **Raji El-Amin** against Merrimack on Sept. 9, 2006. The return by El-Amin also was Rhode Island's most recent punt return for the score, covering a span of 127 games.
- This was the first weekly league honor for Rhode Island in 2017.

## PARKER SETS EXTENDS PROGRAM RECORD TOUCHDOWN STREAK TO NINE GAMES

- Sophomore wide receiver **Aaron Parker's** 19-yard touchdown last week against Elon was his ninth straight game with a touchdown catch, the longest such streak in Rhode Island history.
- He broke **Bobby Apgar's** mark of seven straight games, set in 1994.
- Parker has caught seven touchdown passes this season. Five of them have been for 25 yards or longer.
- His 75-yard touchdown catch at New Hampshire on Sept. 23 was the longest catch of his career.
- Parker has 10 touchdown catches in his last 11 contests, and he has caught at least one pass in 15 consecutive games.
- Parker is second among CAA Football players in touchdown catches (7), fourth in receiving yards (678), fifth in receptions (38) receiving yards (610) and sixth in receptions (33).
- He is one of three players in the league with at least seven touchdown catches. New Hampshire's **Neil O'Connor** leads the league with nine, and Stony Brook's **Ray Bolden** is tied with Parker with seven.
- Parker needs 390 receiving yards over the final four games to become the sixth player in program history to reach 1,000 yards in one season.
- The last player to do so was Apgar, who had 1,042 in 1994.
- Parker needs 135 receiving yards to tie **Robbie Jackson** (2012-14) for 10th place in Rhody history in career receiving yards.
- With 11 touchdown catches, Parker is tied with **T.J. DeSanto** (1980-82) and **Brandon Johnson-Farrell** (2008-12) for 10th place in program history.

## DUNCAN CRACKS TOP 10 SACK LIST

- With a sack two weeks ago at Maine, senior **Jose Duncan** now has 12 for his career.
- He moved past **Dana Hart** (2005-07) for 10th place in program history.
- Duncan also ranks third among CAA Football players with 5.0 sacks through seven games, an average of 0.71 sacks per game.
- Duncan has a pair of two-sack performances, doing it against Harvard (9/16) and at Central Michigan (8/31).
- Duncan has four games in his career with at least 2.0 sacks, tying him with **Frank Ferrara** (1995-98) for the most two-sack games in program history.
- Duncan has 21.0 career tackles for loss and needs four more to move into Rhode Island's top 10 in that category as well.
- Duncan was a CAA Football Third-Team All-Conference selection in 2016.

## DUNCAN EXTENDS START STREAK TO 27

- Senior defensive end **Jose Duncan** has the team's longest active starting streak with 27 consecutive games.
- Junior safety **D.J. Stewart** and redshirt sophomore **Dwayne Scott** have started each of the last 18 games.

## LAWSON IMPRESSES IN FIRST START

- Redshirt junior **JaJuan Lawson** fared well in his first career start last week against No. 14 Elon.
- He set new career highs with 247 passing and 80 rushing yards.
- Lawson also threw a pair of touchdown passes for the second straight week.
- On the year, he has completed 56.0 percent of his passes (42-of-75) for 496 yards, four touchdowns and two interceptions.
- Lawson also is second on the team with 195 rushing yards.

## COOPER REACHES 2,000 RUSHING YARDS

- Senior **Harold Cooper** became the ninth player in program history to reach 2,000 career rushing yards. He now has 2,005.
- The last Ram to reach the mark was **Joe Casey** (2,915 yards from 2005-07).
- **Chris Poirier** (2,217 from 1986-89) is one spot ahead of Cooper on Rhody's rushing list.
- Cooper has four career 100-yard performances, including a career-best 155 yards at Elon on Nov. 12, 2016.
- Cooper now has 11 career runs of 30 yards or more, with a career long of 70 yards on a rush against Elon (Nov. 12, 2016).

## BEAUVAIS FINDS THE END ZONE AGAIN

- Redshirt junior **Marven Beauvais** caught a touchdown pass against Elon, his third score in the last two weeks.
- At Maine, Beauvais scored two touchdowns, marking his first career multi-score game.
- He was the first Ram receiver to catch two touchdowns in the same game since **Robbie Jackson** did so at Villanova on Oct. 14, 2014.
- With four games remaining in the season, Beauvais already has set career highs in receptions (32), receiving yards (450) and touchdown catches (4).

## RAMS FORCE YET ANOTHER FUMBLE

- Junior **Tez Wilson** forced a fumble that was recovered by **Mike Ezirike** at Maine.
- It was the ninth forced fumble by the Rhode Island defense in seven games. Only Lamar (11) has forced more fumbles nationally.
- Redshirt sophomore cornerback **Momodou Mbye** leads the country with three recoveries.

## COOPER FOURTH IN ALL-PURPOSE YARDS

- Senior **Harold Cooper** ranks fourth among CAA Football players with 138.0 all-purpose yards per game. Only Maine's **Josh Mack** (169.3), New Hampshire's **Neil O'Connor** (141.6) and Elon's **Malcolm Summers** (138.5) average more.
- Cooper now has 4,396 career all-purpose yards and is the seventh player in program history to reach 4,000.
- He now has topped 100 all-purpose yards 22 times in 38 career games.
- Cooper moved into fifth place on Rhode Island's career all-purpose yardage list, passing **Wendell Williams** (4,346 from 2000-03).
- He needs 119 yards to tie **James Jenkins** (4,515) for fourth place.
- Cooper needs 604 more all-purpose yards to join **Cy Butler** (5,380 from 1993-96) and **Brandon Johnson-Farrell** (5,083 from 2008-12) as the only Rams to reach 5,000 career all-purpose yards.
- Cooper had 1,582 in 2015 and 1,132 last season. He has 654 thus far in 2017.
- The 1,582 yards in 2015 were the sixth most in a single season in program history.
- For his career, Cooper has 2,005 rushing yards, 1,691 kick return yards and 702 receiving yards.
- Cooper has a chance to become the second player in program history with 1,000 yards both rushing and receiving. **Jimmy Hughes** (2005-08) had 1,663 rushing yards and 1,118 receiving yards.
- Cooper is the second player in team history with three kick returns of 90+ yards, joining **Chris Pierce**, who had returns of 98, 96 and 90 yards.

## HARRIS THIRD IN PASSING YARDAGE

- Redshirt junior quarterback **Tyler Harris** is fourth among CAA Football quarterbacks in total passing yards per game (225.7).
- In six games, he has passed for 1,354 yards, the fourth highest total in the conference.
- He needs 646 more passing yards to become the 11th Ram to pass for 2,000 in one season.
- The last Rhode Island quarterback to do so was **Derek Cassidy**, who had 2,759 in 2008.
- Harris' nine touchdown passes is sixth best in the league.
- He passed for 284 yards and three touchdowns at Central Michigan in his first career start, the most passing yardage and touchdown passes by a player making his Ram starting debut. Both numbers also represented the most ever by a Rhode Island player against an FBS opponent.

## BROWN LEADING RAMS IN BREAK UPS

- Redshirt freshman **Kwadir Brown** broke up one pass at Maine, giving him a team-high five break ups on the season.
- Each of his break ups came during a three-game span from Sept. 23 through Oct. 14.
- Redshirt sophomore **Momodou Mbye** is tied for the team lead with five break ups, while junior **D.J. Stewart** has four.
- In 18 career games, Mbye has 13 pass break ups. He needs just two more to move into the program's top 10 all-time.

## MACK WORKS WAY INTO BACKFIELD

- Rhode Island sophomore defensive end **L.B. Mack III** ranks fifth in the conference with 1.21 tackles for loss per game.
- He also ranks fifth in the conference with 8.5 tackles for loss this season.
- Mack had a monster performance at Brown on Sept. 30, recording a career-high 10 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss.
- His 4.5 tackles for loss were the most by a Ram since **Doug Johnson** had 5.0 against Massachusetts on Nov. 23, 2011.

# JIM FLEMING

## Head Coach - Fourth Season

Jim Fleming was named Rhode Island's 20th head coach in December of 2013.

For the second consecutive season, Fleming's team set a program mark for number of players to earn CAA Football Academic All-Conference recognition. The Rams had 22 players earn the honor in 2016, after having 18 receive the recognition in 2015. In 2016, Fleming had two players earn CAA Football All-Conference honors, as kick returner Harold Cooper was named to the second team and defensive end Jose Duncan took home third-team honors. Fleming also led the team to its first Governor's Cup victory since 2011 as the Rams defeated Brown 28-13 in the annual in-state battle.

In his second season the Rams earned eight spots on the CAA Football All-Conference Team, the most for Rhode Island since 1995. Sophomore Harold Cooper was a first-team selection as a kick returner and a third-team pick at running back. He also was named to the 2015 Division I All-New England Football Team as a kick returner. Also earning CAA Football All-Conference honors were left tackle Tyler Catalina (second team), linebacker Adam Parker (second team), safety Tim Wienclaw (second team), defensive lineman Mike Ezirike (third team), tight end Charlie McKeeman (third team) and cornerback Myles Holmes (third team).

In Fleming's first season in Kingston, five players - linebacker Andrew Bose, fullback Justin Favreau, wide receiver Robbie Jackson, offensive tackle Tyler Catalina and kick returner

Myles Holmes earned a spot on the CAA Football All-Conference Team. Bose was the first Rhody linebacker to earn first-team honors in 16 seasons. He and freshman tight end Charlie McKeeman earned All-America honors from TonySoftli.com. Rhode Island also had 12 players earn a spot on the CAA Football Academic All-Conference Team.

Following the season, Bose signed as an undrafted free agent with the NFL's Baltimore Ravens, while running back Lyle McCombs signed with the Canadian Football League's Toronto Argonauts. Fleming came to Rhode Island from the University of Central Florida, where he was the defensive coordinator for the No. 15 Knights. In 2013, Fleming helped UCF earn a spot in the Tostitos Fiesta Bowl.

The 2013 season marked the second straight year that Fleming has helped guide UCF to a bowl game. In 2012, the Knights had the top-ranked scoring and pass defense in Conference USA and were ranked 29th nationally in scoring defense en route to a spot in the Beef O'Brady Bowl, where they defeated Ball State, 38-17.

In two seasons as head coach Sacred Heart, he was a two-time Northeast Conference Coach of the Year while posting a 21-1 record. His team won the 2001 Mid Major I-AA National Championship to cap off a perfect 11-0 season. In his first year with the Pioneers, Fleming

orchestrated the nation's best turnaround. Inheriting a team that had gone 2-9 the previous season, Fleming led Sacred Heart to a 10-1 mark in 2000, ending the season ranked No. 5 in the nation.

A veteran of 30 seasons of college football, Fleming has coached for teams in CAA Football, the AAC, the ACC, Conference USA, the MAC, the former Atlantic 10 (now CAA Football), the NEC, the Ivy League and the Big Sky Conference.

Fleming's 2012 defense included safety Kemal Ishmael, the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year and seventh-round draft pick for the Atlanta Falcons. Defensive end Troy Davis was an All-C-USA First Team pick, cornerback A.J. Bouye was a second team pick and lineman Deion Green was on the all-freshman team. Bouye, Davis, Cam Henderson and Ray Shipman all signed rookie free-agent deals.

At Kent State in 2010, Fleming coached the linebackers for the Mid-American Conference's top-ranked defense. The Golden Flashes led the conference in sacks and tackles for loss, and Fleming's linebackers were a major reason. Middle linebacker Cobrani Mixon earned a spot on the All-MAC First Team by collecting 11.5 tackles for loss, 6.5 sacks, one interception, two forced fumbles and 82 overall tackles, while All-MAC Third Team selection Dorian Wood led the Golden Flashes with 96 tackles (11.5 for loss). Luke Batton delivered 68 tackles at the other outside linebacker position.

Fleming spent six seasons at Akron (2004-09) as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach. He helped the Zips win their first MAC Championship and qualify for the Motor City Bowl in 2005. Under Fleming, the defense produced four All-MAC honorees, including the league's second-leading tackler in freshman Brian Wagner and the program's second-ever three-time All-MAC selection in Almondo Sewell. Fleming's defenses at Akron consistently performed among the nation's best, ranking 32nd in total defense in 2005, and 31st in passing defense in 2009.

Prior to Akron, Fleming spent two years (2002-03) as the defensive backs coach at North Carolina. That stint came after his remarkable two-year run as the head coach of Sacred Heart. During their championship run, the Pioneers ranked second in the nation in scoring, pass efficiency and turnover margin, fourth in total defense and seventh in scoring defense and passing yards allowed. Fleming was named the Northeast Conference Coach of the Year in both 2000 and 2001.

A native of New York, N.Y., Fleming also spent two years as defensive coordinator/defensive backs coach at Villanova (1998-99) and four years (1994-97) coaching linebackers (1994) and defensive backs (1995-97) at East Carolina. His 1997 squad ranked second in Conference USA in pass defense, while in 1995, the Pirates finished 9-3 and earned a berth in the Liberty Bowl where they defeated Stanford, 19-13. That season, the ECU defense ranked seventh nationally in pass efficiency defense, producing 33 takeaways and 19 interceptions.

Fleming spent 1993 as the defensive coordinator at Brown, where the Bears went from 0-10 and last place in the Ivy League, to 4-6 and a tie for fourth place in the conference. From 1987-92, he was at Boise State, including the final three seasons as defensive coordinator. His 1991 Broncos' defense led the nation in rushing defense, was third in turnover margin and led the Big Sky Conference in every statistical category. In 1990, BSU finished 10-4 and advanced to the semifinals of the Division I-AA playoffs, leading the conference in scoring defense.

Fleming is a 1982 graduate of the University of the South with a degree in English. While there, he was a four-year starter in football and baseball, earning all-conference honors as a tight end in 1981. Fleming began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at South Carolina in 1985.

He and his wife, Leslie, have four children: Jimmy, Will, Kate and Meg. Will played tight end/fullback for Akron from 2009-12 and is now on the Rhode Island staff.
