HOME COOKING

UAlbany finally played a game at home in 2017-18, defeating Fordham in overtime 59-52. It was the second consecutive game against the Rams that needed overtime, after UAlbany lost in double overtime at Fordham a season ago. Redshirt senior Jessica Féquière (27) and junior Chyanna Canada (10) each had career nights in scoring.

FLYING HIGH

Redshirt senior Bose Aiyalogbe scored a career-high 18 points in a victory against Monmouth. Her previous high was 13, and she scored 14 points in the first half alone. The Great Daned trailed 9-5 but used a 37-2 run to pull away from the Hawks. UAlbany got its first road win in its second game in 2017, when in 2016 they team waited until December 10th for their first road victory.

OLD LINE

UAlbany will open the 2017-18 season visiting Maryland, where head coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee served as an assistant coach for four seasons, during which time the Terrapins won one national championship in 2006.

UALBANY PICKED SECOND IN AMERICA EAST

The Great Danes were predicted to finish second in the America East following their sixth-straight conference title. 2016-17 regular season champion New Hampshire, who finished last year with a 15-1 conference record, was selected as the unanimous favorite.

FÉQUIÈRE NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Jessica Féquière earned her first Preseason All-Conference selection after being named All-Conference Second Team following the 2016-17 season. Féquière is the Great Danes' top returning scorer and rebounder.

ROAD TRIPPING

Only five of UAlbany's non-conference games will be played at SEFCU Arena. The remaining eight will be road trips, including a week-long visit to Puerto Rico for the San Juan Classic right before Christmas. There, the Great Danes will play against Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois, before returning home for the holiday break. Other road swings include Maryland, Monmouth, and Holy Cross, and Manhattan.

BAKER'S DOZEN

UAlbany is one of just 13 programs in the country to play in each of the last six NCAA tournaments, joining Baylor, Connecticut, DePaul, Kentucky, Louisville, Maryland, Notre Dame, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Stanford, Tennessee, and Texas A&M. During that time, the Great Danes have gone 1-6, including the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory.

MORE HISTORY

UAlbany won its unprecedented sixth consecutive America East title, breaking their own record of five set the year before. Additionally, The Great Danes have an active streak of 17 consecutive America East tournament victories, breaking the previous

JET SETTING

Five of the 15 women on the UAlbany roster hail from international countries. Four are returning players: Mackenzie Trpcic (Canada), Jessica Féquière (Canada), Bose Aiyalogbe (Nigeria), and Kumsal Aslan (Turkey). One newcomer, Colorado State transfer Amanda Kantzy, hails from Sweden. In recent years, the Great Danes have also fielded players from the British Virgin Islands, Jamaica, and New Zealand.

CLIMBING THE RANKS

Tiana-Jo Carter is the only active player ranked in the program record books, currently sitting sixth all time in blocked shots with 119. She trails the all-time program leader, Gia Sanders, by 32. Carter has recorded 37 or more blocks in each of her three seasons at UAlbany.

OUT OF STATE

The Great Danes will leave the boundaries of New York State with greater frequency this year than last. Six of eight non-conference games away from SEFCU Arena will take place in other states, while UAlbany will host New York opponents in four of their five non-conference home games.

BACK TO THE WELL

In the last two seasons, the Great Danes have seen the graduation of the top two scorers, Shereesha Richards and Imani Tate, in program history. Richards and Tate combined for a total of 4,002 points in their careers, while no active player on the roster currently ranks within the top-20.

LAST TIME OUT - vs. FORDHAM

Women's Basketball Score: UAlbany 59, Fordham 52 (OT)

Short Story: The UAlbany women's basketball team rode a career-high 27 points from Jessica Féquière, including eight in overtime, to grab a 59-52 victory over Fordham in the home opener.

Key Stats

UAlbany: Jessica Féquière notched 27 points, including 17 in the first half and eight in overtime, passing her earlier career-high of 24 vs. Stony Brook last season. Chyanna Canada had 10 points off the bench while Heather Forster had seven rebounds, two steals and four points, including the game-tying free throw to force overtime.

Fordham: G'mrice Davis had a double-double of 17 points and 17 rebounds, adding three steals. Lauren Holden and Bre Cavanaugh each had 11 points.

Key Situations

7:03-4:09 1st quarter: UAlbany puts together a 6-0 run, including a jumper and a layup down the lane by Jessica Féquière, to give UAlbany a 9-2 advantage. Féquière was 5-for-5 in the first quarter for 12 points.

2:23-0:00 2nd quarter: Chyanna Canada muscles in the paint for a pair of layups in one minute. UAlbany gets the final shot, with Fequiere hitting a kickout three at the first half buzzer for a 29-17 UAlbany lead at the break.

3:45-0:00 4th quarter: Led by seven points by G'Mrice Davis, Fordham takes the lead with an 8-0 run. Heather Forster ties the game with a backend free throw to force overtime.

4:04-3:27 1st overtime: Féquière buries a long three to give UAlbany the lead, then adds a jumper on the next possession for a five-point lead. UAlbany did not relinquish the lead the rest of the way.

Recap

After Fordham came back to force overtime, the UAlbany women's basketball team used an early run sparked by Féquière to win its home opener 59-52 on Sunday afternoon.

UAlbany attacked the basket early in the quarter, focusing primarily on the paint. Jessica Féquière led an early 6-0 run, capped but a short jumper and a layup down the lane, to make it 9-2 UAlbany. Another Fequiere layup, plus a drive down the paint by Chyanna Canada, made it 13-6 UAlbany. Fequiere added a late three to finish the quarter 5-for-5 from the field and give UAlbany a 16-8 lead after one.

UAlbany continued to attack with its forwards, pushing ahead by nine after layups by Alexi Schecter and Tiana-Jo Carter midway through the second. Canada added two more in just over a minute to make it double digits. Kendell Heremaia notched a layup for Fordham to bring the Rams within nine, then Fequiere buried a three at the first half buzzer to make it 29-17 UAlbany.

Into the third quarter, UAlbany kept countering Fordham scores, going back and forth all period. Bose Aiyalogbe kept UAlbany comfortably ahead with a turnaround jumper, then a wide open three off a kickout. UAlbany's defense held against long Fordham shots, taking a 40-29 lead into the fourth quarter.

UAlbany built its lead to 13 with a turnaround layup by Heather Forster with 8:14 left. Fordham countered with seven straight points, including two turnaround layups by G'Mrice Davis, to pull within six. Foster ended the run with a free throw, but Davis added another jumper plus a free throw, then Mary Goulding hit a free throw to pull Fordham within one possession at 45-42 with two minutes left.

Davis scored two more layups for Fordham to give the Rams their first lead of the game at 46-45 with 20 seconds left. On a third chance, Forster got fouled in the act of shooting with 2.7 seconds remaining to force overtime, tied at 46-46.

After an exchange of possessions, Féquière hit a deep three from Mackenzie Trpcic to put UAlbany back ahead. Next possession, Féquière added another jumper. UAlbany held the rest of the way, with late free throws from Canada, Féquière and CeCe Mayo, to win the game 59-52.

LAST TIME vs. WAGNER

STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. – The University at Albany women's basketball program (5-5) has climbed back to .500 on the season after its second consecutive win, this time defeating Wagner (1-8) on the road by a score of 75-50. It was the Great Danes' most lopsided victory of the season, and their first win on the road.

"I thought we came out focused in the first half," said head coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee. "Offensively, in the first half, I thought we moved the ball with purpose and, defensively, moved well and stuck to our plan."

The Great Danes opened on an 8-0 run in the first two and a half minutes before Wagner scored its first points. The Seahawks then scored the next five to bring the game with in three. Senior Bailey Hixson scored her 100th career point with one minute remaining in the first quarter to give UAlbany a 22-9 lead. The score at the end of the first was 24-9 in favor of the Danes.

Junior Jessica Féquière scored her 200th career point on a fast break layup with 8:30 remaining in the second quarter, giving UAlbany a 29-9 lead, and capping a 5-0 run to start the second. Wagner responded shortly afterwards with an open three-pointer. The Great Danes held the Seahawks to just six points in the second quarter, taking a 42-15 lead into halftime. Féquière led the team with 17 points, just three off her career high. She also led the team with eight rebounds. Freshman guard Mackenzie Trpcic had eight assists.

Through the first half, UAlbany had outscored Wagner 20-6 in points in the paint, 17-0 in points off of turnovers, 6-2 in second chance points, 10-2 in fast break points, and 8-2 in points off the bench. The Great Danes had committed seven turnovers and forced 15, and had 12 assists on 16 field goals.

Féquière matched her career-high 20 points with a three-pointer 30 seconds into the third quarter. The Great Dane offense collectively cooled off somewhat during the first part of the quarter, scoring 12 points in eight minutes. Still, UAlbany ultimately outscored Wagner for the quarter 18-13, with Hixson hitting a three at the buzzer to give the Danes a 60-28 lead. Hixson's last basket put her

just one point behind her career-high of 17, which she set on Tuesday against Fairfield.

Wagner opened the fourth quarter on a 12-1 run over the first four minutes, forcing Coach Mac to call a timeout. The Seahawks had cut the lead to 61-40. The run extended to 13-1 after the timeout before UAlbany scored again on a layup by senior Cassandra Edwards.

Junior Bose Aiyalogbe scored back-to-back threes to give the Great Danes a 73-46 lead with two minutes remaining in the fourth quarter. She added two free throws to make it eight consecutive points. The final score was 75-50 in favor of UAlbany.

Four Great Danes scored in double figures. Aiyalogbe scored a career-high 13 points. Féquière and sophomore Heather Forster each tied their career-high with 20 and 11 points, respectively. And Hixson fell one point shy of her career-high with 16 points on the afternoon. Féquière led the team with a career-high 14 rebounds, and Trpcic led with a career-high 12 assists. Freshman Alexi Schecter also had a career-high five points.

"It was really the tale of two halves," said Coach Mac. "I thought we came out a little lackadaisical in the second half, which is sometimes easy to do when you have a big lead. I'm a little disappointed in the way we defended in the second half, but happy to come out with a win."

UAlbany outscored Wagner 34-12 in points in the paint, 24-8 in points off of turnovers, 15-4 in fast break points, and 15-2 in points off the bench. The teams tied in second chance points with nine apiece.

UAlbany returns to SEFCU for the final home game of 2016 and the non-conference schedule on Monday, December 12 to face Post University. Tipoff is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

"I hope for Monday we really concentrate on the areas where we need to improve," said Coach Mac.

JOANNA BERNABEI-MCNAMEE - SECOND SEASON AT UALBANY



University at Albany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced Friday, April 15th, 2016 the hiring of Joanna Bernabei-McNamee as the 11th head women's basketball coach in program history and fourth head coach in the Great Danes' Division I era.

Bernabei-McNamee enters her second season as head coach in 2017. Her first season saw the Great Danes win an unprecedented sixth-consecutive America East title and NCAA tournament berth behind a 21-12 overall record and 12-4 conference record. Coach Mac earned her 100th career victory as a head coach with a win over Vermont in the quarterfinals of the America East tournament, and oversaw two freshman point guards, Mackenzie Trpcic and Khepera Stokes, surpass the existing freshman single season assists record. After meeting and defeating Maine in the America East championship game,

the Great Danes drew top overall seed Connecticut in the NCAA tournament. Defensively, the 2016-17 Great Danes set a program record for total blocks in a single season with 142.

Bernabei-McNamee (pronounced Bern-uh-BEE Mac-Na-MEE), a native of Weirton, W.Va., comes to UAlbany after three seasons as the head coach of the University of Pikeville in Pikeville, Ky. There, McNamee racked up 63 wins and led the program to back-to-back National Tournament berths, including a program-record 26 victories and an NAIA Final Four appearance in 2016. McNamee was named the 2016 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) NAIA Regional Coach of the Year, and was also named the 2015 Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to Pikeville, McNamee coached at the NCAA Division I level for 10 years. She served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Maryland for four seasons from 2003 to 2007, and helped pilot the Terrapins to the 2006 National Championship. Maryland beat Duke 78-75 in overtime for the title and finished with a record of 34-4. During her tenure, she brought in four straight nationally ranked recruiting classes, including three in the top 10.

McNamee spent two years at West Virginia University as an assistant coach where she was a scout, position coach and recruiting coordinator. Before her time as a Mountaineer, McNamee had a two-year stint at Eastern Kentucky where she was responsible for scouting, individual player development, as well as serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Coach Mac gained head coaching experience in 1998 at West Virginia Wesleyan where she compiled an 18-9 record and a third-place finish in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC), while also acting as the school's Senior Women's Administrator.

McNamee attended West Liberty State where she was a Division II All-American and a four-time first-team All-WVIAC selection as a point guard. Named the 1997 WVIAC Player of the Year, she still holds the NCAA Division II career assists record of 1,107 and the record for assists in a game with 24. She is one of only four players in NCAA history to record over 1,000 points and 1,000 assists, finishing her stellar career with 1,317 total points.

McNamee also holds NCAA records for average assists per game (9.5), and the school and conference marks for assists in a game, season (294) and career. She led her team to an 80-36 record over four years and is listed on West Liberty's Top 20 All-Time Best Athletes list. She was the first woman to be named first-team All-West Virginia Athletic Conference for four years and was inducted into the West Liberty State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002 and the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Hall of Fame in 2011.

McNamee earned her bachelor's degree in exercise physiology in 1997 from West Liberty and a master's degree from Eastern Kentucky in sports administration in 1999.

Joanna and her husband Joe McNamee have two sons, Luke and Caden. McNamee took a nearly four-year hiatus from coaching (2009-13) to focus on raising her children.

Coach Mac takes over a UAlbany program that has won a combined nine America East Conference tournament and regular season titles in the last five seasons, and has made five consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. In the 2015-16 season, UAlbany defeated No. 5 Florida for the program's first-ever Division I NCAA Tournament victory.
