CENTURY

Tiana-Jo Carter made her 100th career appearance as a Great Dane on December 3 at Holy Cross. Carter, who ranks as one of the best shot-blockers in program history, has won three America East titles during her time at UAlbany, and was named the 2015-16 America East Sixth Player of the Year.

MOVING ON UP

Tiana-Jo Carter jumped two places on the program's all-time career blocked shots list with her two blocks against St. John's. She currently holds a tie for fourth with 127 with Danielle Hutcheson, and trails all-time program leader, Gia Saunders', 151.

ROOKIE RECOGNITION

Freshman Kyara Frames was the first Great Dane this season to win a weekly award, being named America East Rookie of the Week on November 26 for her efforts the previous week. In the team's lone game, against Wagner, Frames scored nine points on three of six shooting from behind the arc and dished five assists. Both totals were then-career bests for Frames.

HOME COOKING

UAlbany finally played a game at home in 2017-18, defeating Fordham in overtime 59-52. It was the second consecutive game against the Rams that needed overtime, after UAlbany lost in double overtime at Fordham a season ago. Redshirt senior Jessica Féquière (27) and junior Chyanna Canada (10) each had career nights in scoring.

FLYING HIGH

Redshirt senior Bose Aiyalogbe scored a career-high 18 points in a victory against Monmouth. Her previous high was 13, and she scored 14 points in the first half alone. The Great Danes trailed 9-5 but used a 37-2 run to pull away from the Hawks. UAlbany got its first road win in its second game in 2017, when in 2016 they team waited until December 10th for their first road victory.

OLD LINE

UAlbany will open the 2017-18 season visiting Maryland, where head coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee served as an assistant coach for four seasons, during which time the Terrapins won one national championship in 2006.

UALBANY PICKED SECOND IN AMERICA EAST

The Great Danes were predicted to finish second in the America East following their sixth-straight conference title. 2016-17 regular season champion New Hampshire, who finished last year with a 15-1 conference record, was selected as the unanimous favorite.

FÉQUIÈRE NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Jessica Féquière earned her first Preseason All-Conference selection after being named All-Conference Second Team following the 2016-17 season. Féquière is the Great Danes' top returning scorer and rebounder.

ROAD TRIPPING

Only five of UAlbany's non-conference games will be played at SEFCU Arena. The remaining eight will be road trips, including a week-long visit to Puerto Rico for the San Juan Classic right before Christmas. There, the Great Danes will play against Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois, before returning home for the holiday break. Other road swings include Maryland, Monmouth, and Holy Cross, and Manhattan.

BAKER'S DOZEN

UAlbany is one of just 13 programs in the country to play in each of the last six NCAA tournaments, joining Baylor, Connecticut, DePaul, Kentucky, Louisville, Maryland, Notre Dame, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Stanford, Tennessee, and Texas A&M. During that time, the Great Danes have gone 1-6, including the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory.

MORE HISTORY

UAlbany won its unprecedented sixth consecutive America East title, breaking their own record of five set the year before. Additionally, The Great Danes have an active streak of 17 consecutive America East tournament victories, breaking the previous record of 15 set by Maine from 1995-99.

JET SETTING

Five of the 15 women on the UAlbany roster hail from international countries. Four are returning players: Mackenzie Trpcic (Canada), Jessica Féquière (Canada), Bose Aiyalogbe (Nigeria), and Kumsal Aslan (Turkey). One newcomer, Colorado State transfer Amanda Kantzy, hails from Sweden. In recent years, the Great Danes have also fielded players from the British Virgin Islands, Jamaica, and New Zealand.

CLIMBING THE RANKS

Tiana-Jo Carter is the only active player ranked in the program record books, currently sitting sixth all time in blocked shots with 119. She trails the all-time program leader, Gia Sanders, by 32. Carter has recorded 37 or more blocks in each of her three seasons at UAlbany.

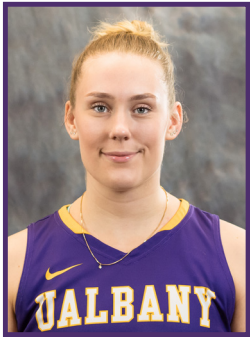

Recap

The University at Albany women's basketball team played the first of three consecutive road games Sunday morning, kicking off the road trip at Holy Cross. In Tiana-Jo Carter's 100th career appearance in a UAlbany uniform, the Great Danes

In a tight first quarter, freshman Emma List scored five of UAlbany's 11 points, eclipsing her previous single-game high of four points. List also hit UAlbany's only three-pointer of the first half, with the team going 0-13 from behind the arc following her first career three.

After building a two-point advantage through the first 10 minutes, the Danes started to pull away midway through the second, leading by as many as 11 as the first half came to a close. When the halftime horn sounded, UAlbany held a 27-19 lead.

UAlbany had buzzer beaters disallowed upon review at both the end of the first and second quarters. Heather Forster hit a layup at the end of the first quarter and CeCe Mayo hit a three-quarter court shot right before halftime, with both shots just late. The Danes scored seven points off of 14 first-half Crusader turnovers, and outscored Holy Cross 14-0 in bench points through the first 20 minutes.

Both offenses came alive in the third quarter, with the teams combining for 26 points in the first 6:02. Each team had scored 13 points during that stretch, but UAlbany outscored Holy Cross 9-5 for the remainder of the quarter. By the end of the third, both Féquière and Carter had scored in double figures and UAlbany led by 12.

After List's first three-pointer of the game, the Great Danes missed their next 20 from behind the arc until Patricia Conroy ended the drought with a three midway through the fourth to put UAlbany up 54-43.

With 1:17 left in the fourth, Holy Cross' press defense forced a turnover, setting up a three to cut the Dane lead to six. The Crusaders forced another turnover in their defensive half, taking over possession with less than a minute remaining. After drawing a blocking foul, Holy Cross hit one of two free throws and trailed by five with 33.4 seconds remaining.

With 31.4 seconds left, Holy Cross started fouling. Kyara Frames went to the line with 23.0 seconds remaining, and hit one of two to put UAlbany back up by six. UAlbany forced a five-second violation on the ensuing in-bounds play. After List knocked down two free throws, Holy Cross scored a layup with 14.5 seconds left. List was sent back to the line and hit one of two shots to put UAlbany up seven. An out of bounds on the ensuing rebound gave UAlbany back the ball. Féquière received the in-bounds play, got fouled, and hit both free throws to finally ice the game for the Great Danes, 65-56.

By the end of the game, four Great Danes scored in double figures, including List, who scored a career-best 12. Forster recorded a double-double and matched her career-high with 11 rebounds. As a team, UAlbany recorded 45 rebounds and forced 25 turnovers.

Next: The Great Danes will continue their three-game road trip when they visit Manhattan on December 6.

LAST TIME vs. MANHATTAN

Riverdale, N.Y. - Felicia Johnson scored a career-high 21 points and made the go-ahead jumper in leading UAlbany to a 49-48 victory over Manhattan on Friday, Nov. 19 at Draddy Gymnasium. The Great Danes, under first-year head coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, have opened a season with three victories for the first time since 1986-87.

Manhattan (2-1) led 27-18 early in the second half, but the Great Danes held their opponent scoreless for the next six-plus minutes and in the process ran off 13 unanswered. Ebone Henry, who tallied nine of her 14 points after the break, buried a three-point field goal, before Johnson made a short bank shot from left of the lane to draw their team even. Julie Forster scored in the lane from a driving Henry and Cassandra Callaway converted a layup off her steal to finish off the run.

UAlbany (3-0) extended its margin to as much as six on four occasions, including 43-37 on Forster's two free throws. Still trailing 47-42, the Jaspers went back ahead on a pair of conventional three-point plays. Schyenne Halfkenny was fouled as connected in the lane off Nadia Peters' feed. Abby Wentworth, who led her team with 17 points, drove from the top of the circle and tacked on a free throw with 2:24 to play.

Johnson, a junior guard, later made a 12-footer in the lane off the dribble to regain the lead. After Henry missed the front end of a one-and-one free throw opportunity with 19 seconds remaining, Manhattan set up for the last shot. But Halfkenny misfired on the right baseline in the closing seconds.

"We started to move Ebone (Henry) around to look for open shots and placed

Julie in the high post to get movement on the baseline," said Abrahamson-Henderson, as her team combated Manhattan's zone defense. "Felicia Johnson carried us the whole game. She is relentless and a proven winner."

In the first half, Manhattan used an aggressive zone and three-quarter court pressure to hold UAlbany to 17.9-percent shooting and force nine turnovers. The Jaspers led 8-7, but then tallied 10 of the game's next 12 points. Halfkenny made two free throws and canned a three-pointer from the right corner off a skip pass to lead the outburst. Wentworth sank a jumper in the lane and split a pair of foul shots for a nine-point lead.

The Great Danes closed the gap to 20-16 behind the play of Johnson, who added five steals, four assists and four rebounds to her scoring total. The junior guard fed Julie Forster in transition and made a three-point shot from left of the key. Manhattan had the final two baskets in the half when Toni-Ann Lawrence completed a cut in the lane and Wentworth drilled a jumper off a screen.

Henry, a sophomore, recorded her third consecutive double-double by grabbing 10 rebounds and made three of her four 3-pointers in the final stanza. Toni-Ann Lawrence added 10 points for the Jaspers, who playing for the first time at home this season.

Paw Prints: UAlbany has won its opening three games for the first time as a Division I program ... Felicia Johnson's previous career-high was 20 points against Vermont on Feb. 6, 2010 ... Julie Forster added six points and eight rebounds ... the Great Danes improved to a more respectable 46.2-percent shooting in the second half ... Manhattan won the only other meeting between these programs, a 74-56 victory on Nov. 30, 1999 ... the Jaspers were picked to finish fourth in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference preseason poll.

2017-18 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

JOANNA BERNABEI-MCNAMEE - SECOND SEASON AT UALBANY



University at Albany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced Friday, April 15th, 2016 the hiring of Joanna Bernabei-McNamee as the 11th head women's basketball coach in program history and fourth head coach in the Great Danes' Division I era.

Bernabei-McNamee enters her second season as head coach in 2017. Her first season saw the Great Danes win an unprecedented sixth-consecutive America East title and NCAA tournament berth behind a 21-12 overall record and 12-4 conference record. Coach Mac earned her 100th career victory as a head coach with a win over Vermont in the quarterfinals of the America East tournament, and oversaw two freshman point guards, Mackenzie Trpcic and Khepera Stokes, surpass the existing freshman single season assists record. After meeting and defeating Maine in the America East championship game,

the Great Danes drew top overall seed Connecticut in the NCAA tournament. Defensively, the 2016-17 Great Danes set a program record for total blocks in a single season with 142.

Bernabei-McNamee (pronounced Bern-uh-BEE Mac-Na-MEE), a native of Weirton, W.Va., comes to UAlbany after three seasons as the head coach of the University of Pikeville in Pikeville, Ky. There, McNamee racked up 63 wins and led the program to back-to-back National Tournament berths, including a program-record 26 victories and an NAIA Final Four appearance in 2016. McNamee was named the 2016 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) NAIA Regional Coach of the Year, and was also named the 2015 Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to Pikeville, McNamee coached at the NCAA Division I level for 10 years. She served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Maryland for four seasons from 2003 to 2007, and helped pilot the Terrapins to the 2006 National Championship. Maryland beat Duke 78-75 in overtime for the title and finished with a record of 34-4. During her tenure, she brought in four straight nationally ranked recruiting classes, including three in the top 10.

McNamee spent two years at West Virginia University as an assistant coach where she was a scout, position coach and recruiting coordinator. Before her time as a Mountaineer, McNamee had a two-year stint at Eastern Kentucky where she was responsible for scouting, individual player development, as well as serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Coach Mac gained head coaching experience in 1998 at West Virginia Wesleyan where she compiled an 18-9 record and a third-place finish in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC), while also acting as the school's Senior Women's Administrator.

McNamee attended West Liberty State where she was a Division II All-American and a four-time first-team All-WVIAC selection as a point guard. Named the 1997 WVIAC Player of the Year, she still holds the NCAA Division II career assists record of 1,107 and the record for assists in a game with 24. She is one of only four players in NCAA history to record over 1,000 points and 1,000 assists, finishing her stellar career with 1,317 total points.

McNamee also holds NCAA records for average assists per game (9.5), and the school and conference marks for assists in a game, season (294) and career. She led her team to an 80-36 record over four years and is listed on West Liberty's Top 20 All-Time Best Athletes list. She was the first woman to be named first-team All-West Virginia Athletic Conference for four years and was inducted into the West Liberty State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002 and the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Hall of Fame in 2011.

McNamee earned her bachelor's degree in exercise physiology in 1997 from West Liberty and a master's degree from Eastern Kentucky in sports administration in 1999.

Joanna and her husband Joe McNamee have two sons, Luke and Caden. McNamee took a nearly four-year hiatus from coaching (2009-13) to focus on raising her children.

Coach Mac takes over a UAlbany program that has won a combined nine America East Conference tournament and regular season titles in the last five seasons, and has made five consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. In the 2015-16 season, UAlbany defeated No. 5 Florida for the program's first-ever Division I NCAA Tournament victory.

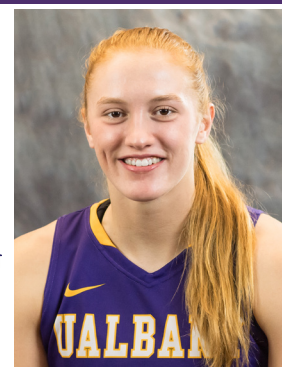
