UALBANY CONTINUES AMERICA EAST PLAY VS. UMBC

The second half of America East play will begin on Saturday, April 8th as UAlbany hosts UMBC at John Fallon Field at 1 p.m.

UAlbany has won its last eight games dating back to February, coming off a 19-11 road win over Stony Brook. The Great Danes are tied for first place in the America East at 3-0 and 8-1 overall. UMBC defeated UMass Lowell 10-6 on Saturday to stay undefeated in America East play at 2-0, standing 4-5 overall. UAlbany, UMBC and Binghamton are the remaining teams with undefeated America East records.

Following UAlbany's pair of road victories last week over Harvard and Stony Brook, UAlbany went up to #7 in the USILA Coaches Poll and to #7 in the *Inside Lacrosse* Media Poll. UMBC is not ranked in either poll.

UAlbany has won the last seven meetings against UMBC, the last a 15-14 overtime thriller in Baltimore last season, to lead the overall series 11-10. The series includes UAlbany victories over UMBC in the 2013 and 2014 America East title games.

UALBANY PREDICTED TO FINISH FIRST IN AMERICA EAST IN '17

For the fifth season in a row, UAlbany has been predicted to finish first in the America East in the preseason coaches poll. It is the fourth season in the last five that UAlbany was a unanimous pick to finish first. UAlbany is undefeated in America East regular season play since the start of 2013. The rest of the poll is filled out by, in order, Hartford, Vermont, Stony Brook, UMBC, UMass Lowell and Binghamton.

FIELDS - TOP SCORER IN DIVISION I

Through the first couple weeks of the season, **Connor Fields** stands as the top scorer of Division I, averaging 7.22 points per game. He currently totals 65 points off 35 goals and 30 assists. He is first in goals per game and third in assists per game.

Bennett Drake is 46th in DI with 2.22 goals per game, totaling 20, while **Justin Reh** has 3.22 points per game on 22 goals and 29 assists.

FIELDS NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

Connor Fields was one of 50 collegiate players to be named to the 2017 Tewaaraton Watch List on February 28th.

UAlbany has had at least one player on the watch list each of the past 11 years. Fields is earning a spot on the watch list for the second year running and his first time on the original 50.

The Tewaaraton Trophy is given to the top player in college lacrosse. On the men's side, UAlbany's Miles and Lyle Thompson shared the 2014 Tewaaraton Trophy, with Lyle winning it outright in 2015. The list will be narrowed to 25 nominees on April 27th.

UALBANY - LONGEST CONFERENCE WINNING STREAK IN DI

With four consecutive undefeated regular seasons, UAlbany has the longest active winning streak in conference games with 25, dating back the last five years.

UAlbany is the only DI team to go undefeated in league play in 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016. Three schools, UAlbany and Denver, had undefeated conference regular seasons each of the past three years.

UAlbany formerly had a streak of 28 victories against America East opponents until May 5, 2016 after a 11-10 overtime defeat to Hartford in the America East Tournament semifinal round.

FIELDS RISING UP THE RECORD BOOKS

Connor Fields is continuing to rise in the UAlbany record books in goals, assists and points.

On a season basis, his 66 goals in 2015 were second-most in UAlbany history and a freshman NCAA Division I record. The two-time USILA All-American and *Inside Lacrosse* Preseason All-American also has two of the top-15 seasons in points in UAlbany history.

NEW STARTERS DOMINATING

UAlbany players entering starting roles for the first game are ranking among the top in Division I. A first-year starting goalkeeper, **JD Colarusso** is eighth in DI with a 58.2% save rate, allowing just 9.03 goals per game and holding an 8-1 record.

Freshman faceoff man **TD lerlan** is second in DI on the X at 71.8%, winning at least 70% in seven games, and first with 12.33 ground balls per game. At attack, freshman **Jakob Patterson** has 19 goals, including a pair of four-goal games.

UALBANY #7 IN COACHES POLL AND IN MEDIA POLL

In the week eight polls of the season, UAlbany went up one spot in each the USILA Coaches Poll and the *Inside Lacrosse* Cascade/ Mayerik Media Poll.

UAlbany has been in the top-15 of each poll since the start of the season. The Great Danes have been ranked in the top-16 of both polls each week since May 2, 2014.

In the preseason, UAlbany was #13 in the coaches poll and #13 in the media poll. It is the fourth consecutive year that UAlbany has ranked in the top-13 in the preseason.

FIELDS, SIMS NAMED IL PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Connor Fields and **Stone Sims** were selected as *Inside Lacrosse* Face-Off Preseason All-Americans. Fields, a preseason All-American for the second straight year, was placed on the Second Team while Sims got on the Third Team.

UAlbany has had at least one preseason All-American on the first, second or third team every year since 2012, including multiple players three of the last four years.

GREAT DANES IN THE MLL

In the 2016 season, nine Great Danes suited up for four different Major League Lacrosse teams. UAlbany has had a least one player drafted into the MLL nine of the past 10 years, including #1 overall pick Lyle Thompson in 2015 to the Florida Launch.

UAlbany went on a blitz and scored four goals in the span of 70 seconds. A Fields high pass pulled down by Drake for the shot and score, a Lasda run off a won lerlan faceoff, a Fields spinning move to score on the doorstep and an Ierlan goal five seconds after a won faceoff. UAIbany added one more goal in the half, a shovel pass from Osika to Eccles for a hard shot and score, completing an 8-0 run and giving UAlbany a 12-3 lead at the half.

SBU scored first in the early part of the 3rd, then UAlbany got it back with another long range shot and score from Eccles. The Seawolves scored the next four goals to pull within five at 13-8. UAlbany MLAX Earns Fourth Straight America East Regular Season with 15-14 OT Win at UMBC

BALTIMORE – The UAlbany men's lacrosse team earned its fourth straight perfect America East regular season on Saturday with a Kyle McClancy overtime goal leading the Great Danes to a 15-14 win at UMBC.

"Give [UMBC] a ton of credit for sticking with their gameplan and playing really hard in the second half," said UAlbany coach Scott Marr. "But, I'm proud of my team for being able to get into overtime and getting a W."

UAlbany (12-2, 6-0 AE) is the first program to earn a perfect America East regular season four straight times since Hofstra from 1995-98.

After its opponent came back from down six to force overtime, UAlbany had possession in all of overtime due to an earlier UMBC (4-10, 1-5 AE) penalty. After a couple of missed shots by UAlbany, McClancy netted his close shot with 15 seconds left for the sudden victory.

Seth Oakes tied a career-high with six goals while Connor Fields had three goals and three assists. Zach Ornstein set a new UAlbany record for ground balls in a game with 22 after going 25-29 on faceoffs, adding an assist, while John Maloney had two goals and three assists. Blaze Riorden got the victory in goal with eight saves.

For UMBC, Nate Lewnes set a program record with 10 goals, including the final four for the Retrievers. Max Maxwell had a goal and four assists while Max Haldeman had two goals and three assists. Ruston Souder got the loss with 11 saves and 15 goals allowed.

UMBC struck first on a man-up chance as Nate Lewnes on a line drive under the crossbar. UAlbany countered with two quick goals as off a restart on a faceoff win, Seth Oakes hit a

laser shot, then off another Zach Ornstein faceoff win, John Maloney passed off to Connor Fields, who rifled a shot inside the left post for the score. UMBC got the goal back minutes later from Lewnes to tie it up at 2-2.

Ornstein's won faceoffs continued to set up opportunities for UAlbany. Bennett Drake grabbed a ground ball near a double team and passed off to Adam Osika, who hit a shot while falling straight away. Next possession, Maloney, from left of cage, passed to John Glancy on the doorstep for the point blank range goal, sending UAlbany up 4-2 with 7:07 left.

Twice Riorden stopped UMBC possessions with saves near the crossbar. In the final minutes of the quarter, Fields scored from far side off a dodge around a defender, then Fields passed behind his back to Oakes, who shot behind his back to score. UAlbany led 6-2 after one quarter.

Immediately into the 2nd, Derrick Eccles passed away from a double team near the out-of-bounds line to Oakes, who hit the long range line drive 16 seconds in. Oakes added his fourth minutes later after a catch and shoot from Justin Reh. Riorden and the defense held its ground as Maloney got two close range goals in succession, one off a behind-the-back pass from Fields and another off his own caused turnover on a man-up shot, to complete an 8-0 UAlbany run for a 10-2 lead. UMBC added a late goal from Max Haldeman as UAlbany led 10-3 at the break.

Oakes added another goal two minutes into the third after Kyle McClancy passed through two defenders to Oakes for the catch and shoot score. UMBC scored on its next three possessions, Lewnes twice off quick shots from passes, and Haldeman on a run to the cage. Later, after two UAlbany shots on a man-up possession were saved, Lewnes hit another shot off a bouncer inside the left post to bring the home team within four at 11-7.

The last two minutes saw the action go high-paced as Osika threaded the needle to Reh in front of the goal circle for the close range goal. Jack Andrews got the goal back with 42.1 seconds left in the 3rd for UMBC, then Ornstein burst through three players on a faceoff win and passed off to Oakes for the shot and score, putting UAlbany up 13-8 after three.

The offense started the fourth with another highlight reel goal off a quick pass from Maloney to Fields in front of the goal for the score. UMBC picked up a trio of goals, one off a foiled UAlbany clear and goal on the open net, another off Max Maxwell scoring off a spin near the crease and Lewnes hitting a high shot to make it 14-11 UAlbany with 10:46 remaining.

UAlbany kept winning faceoffs, but UMBC forced turnovers on the ride and on defense. Lewnes added two more in the span of 64 seconds to bring UMBC within one at 14-13 with 4:58 left in the 4th.

UMBC got possession back with a chance to tie, and with 1:58 left, went man-up for one minute. Mid-way through the penalty, a pass from Andrews went out of bounds, and Lewnes retrieved it and shot and scored to tie the game. UAlbany got a man-up scenario in the last minute of overtime and had possession and the end of regulation to have the ball to begin overtime, tied 14-14.

UAlbany cleared the ball and fired away at the cage with chances from Oakes, McClancy and Fields missing wide. With 15 seconds left in overtime, McClancy went towards the cage and got inside of his defender and scored close range.

Scott Marr begins his 17th season as UAlbany's head coach. The only coach hired in the Division I era at the University at Albany, Marr, a five-time America East Coach of the Year, has coached the Great Danes to seven America East Tournament titles, eight appearances in the NCAA Tournament and a trio of NCAA Tournament victories. He has a 148-108 career record at UAlbany and has coached Tewaaraton winners in 2014 and 2015, 23 All-Americans, five Tewaaraton finalists, two Lt. Raymond J. Enners Award winners for Most Outstanding DI Player, two Lt. Col. J.L. Turnbull Award winners for the best Attackman in the nation, seven America East Players of the Year and 92 all-conference players.

2016 saw UAlbany return to the top-5 in the rankings for the first time since 2007, going as high as #4 at the start of May, as Marr earned his fifth America East Coach of the Year honor and third in four years. The Great Danes earned their fourth consecutive undefeated America East regular season and first-ever at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament, going 12-4 overall and 6-0 in America East play. UAlbany earned victories over then ranked opponents Yale and Stony Brook, including a nine-game winning streak. The Great Danes finished the year ranked #9 in the USILA Coaches Poll and #11 in the Inside Lacrosse Cascade/Maverik Media Poll. Connor Fields and Blaze Riorden each were selected as Tewaaraton nominees while they, John Maloney and Seth Oakes all were chosen as USILA All-Americans. Six UAlbany players earned America East All-Conference honors while three were on the All-Rookie Team and four were placed on the America East All-Academic Team. Marr's team ranked seventh in Division I in goals per game with 12.94 and also was in the top-10 in assists per game, points per game, man-up offenseshot percentage, caused turnovers per game and clearing percentage.

As an assistant on Dick Edell's Maryland staff for six years, Marr served as both assistant coach and offensive coordinator. Maryland made five NCAA Tournament appearances during that period and was the Division I national runner-up in 1995, 1997 and 1998. The Terrapins shattered the school's single-season scoring record with 236 goals when the program captured the '98 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season and tournament titles. Maryland's attack averaged 12.5 goals under Marr's direction from 1995-2000. All-Americans Matt Hahn and Andrew Whipple became two of the most storied scorers in school history.

Marr served as one of three assistants for the 2006 U.S. Men's Lacrosse Team that won the silver medal. Syracuse's John Desko was the U.S. team's head coach. The 2006 International Lacrosse Federation World Championship was held in London, Ontario from July 13-22.

Marr began his coaching career as the University of Delaware's offensive coordinator, where he worked with the school's all-time leading scorer Anthony DiMarzo. From 1992-94, the Blue Hens captured three consecutive North Atlantic Conference championships and earned a top-20 national ranking in each season. Marr was also an assistant on the United States team that won the 1999 World Cup.

As a collegiate player at Johns Hopkins University, Marr was an attackman on the 1987 national championship squad and the '89 national runner-up team. The Blue Jays garnered four straight NCAA berths during his career. He received a B.S. in social and behavorial sciences in 1991.

A native of Yorktown, N.Y., Marr was a high school All-American who twice led his team to the state's semifinal round. He and his wife, Traci, a special education teacher, have three children, Kyle, Jordyn and Keeley.
